## TAR HEEL TIDBITS

2023 marks North Carolina's 45th season as a program, all under head coach Anson Dorrance. » This season will be Dorrance's 47th year as a head coach at UNC. • The Tar Heels have won eight consecutive season openers. » UNC is 37-5-2 all-time in their first game of the season. » This marks UNC's first season opener on the road since 2013. This will be the ninth meeting between the Tar Heels and Nittany Lions in program history. » UNC leads the all-time series at 6-2. » This will be the second meeting between the two foes in University Park, Pa., with Carolina seeking its first road win in the series. The national runner-up in 2022, North Carolina checked in at No. 2 in the United Soccer Coaches preseason poll. » Sam Meza also earned a spot on the United Soccer Coaches Midfielders to Watch list while Avery Patterson was named a forward to watch. » The program was also No. 2 in the College Soccer News preseason poll. The conference runner-up a season ago, UNC was picked first in the ACC preseason coaches poll with 10 first-place votes and 166 points. » Maycee Bell, Sam Meza and Ally Sentnor were all named to the Preseason All-ACC Team, and UNC's three honorees were the most in the league. As elected by the team, this year's captains include Maycee Bell, Talia Dellaperuta, Kai Hayes and Avery Patterson. » Bell was also voted team captain in 2022. North Carolina will be seeking its 23rd national championship in 2023. » The team's 21 NCAA championships (plus one AIAW) are tied for the fifth-most by any program in Division I history. » Carolina is the only team in the country to appear in all 41 NCAA Tournaments since the first one was held in 1982. » The Tar Heels have appeared in 31 NCAA College Cups, 18 more than the second closest team. UNC will be seeking its 23rd ACC championship in 2023. » No other ACC team has more than nine conference titles. The Tar Heels will also be seeking their 26th ACC regular season title. » No other ACC team has more than five regular season titles. » In 2022, UNC was the regular season co-champion with Florida State. The Tar Heels had two exhibition games during preseason. » UNC topped the College of Charleston, 8-1, and East Carolina, 2-0. » Eight different players scored at least once across both contests. North Carolina is returning 25 players, including nine starters, from 2022. » UNC has returned 69.8% of its goals scored from 2022, as well as 85.7% of its assists, 74.7% of its points, 84.6% of its shots and 81.7% of its shots on goal. » UNC's nine returners from last year's Starting XI are the most returners of any teams in the 2022 College Cup. The Tar Heels have welcomed seven true freshmen and one grad transfer to its 2023 roster. » UNC's freshman class is the No. 1 recruiting class in the country. 20 Tar Heels passed UNC's preseason fitness test standards, the most in program history. » Tessa Dellarose, a sophomore, broke her own program record with a score of 63 on the beep test. » Olivia Thomas, a freshman, set a new team standard for fastest speed after clocking in at 7.54 m/s. That equates to a 4.8 in the 40-yard dash. » Maycee Bell, a redshirt senior, broke the program record for the vertical jump with a height of 34.5 inches. » Maddie Dahlien, a sophomore, owns the program record for agility at 13.87. Her time of 14.14 this year still ranked Nio.1 on the team.

**Chasing 23 in '23** ... "Chasing 23 in '23." That's the motto in 2023 for the University of North Carolina women's soccer program. The Tar Heels are seeking their 23rd national title (they currently have 21 NCAA, one AIAW) in program history, all under head coach Anson Dorrance. The number 23 is legendary at UNC, especially in 2023 – dubbed the "Jordan Year" as a tribute to UNC basketball legend and NBA Hall of Famer Michael Jordan.

A national championship this season would be all the more meaningful for the Tar Heels, who came within 16 seconds of clinching No. 23 last season. The most dominant women's soccer program in history, the Tar Heels own 21 of the NCAA's 41 titles since the event's inception in 1982. UNC's last national crown came in 2012.

**Preseason Praise** ... North Carolina was picked to finish first in the ACC Preseason Coaches poll, topping the rankings with 166 points and 10 first-place votes. Florida State garnered 146 points and two first-place nods to be chosen second, followed by Virginia (139), Notre Dame (134) and Duke (126). The Cavaliers and Blue Devils both received one first-place bid.

Maycee Bell, Sam Meza and Ally Sentnor were all selected to the Preseason All-ACC

Team, as voted on by the league coaches. UNC's three picks are the most of any school in the conference.

**Wealth of Experience** ... Of the 11 starters in the 2022 national championship game, nine have returned in 2023 – the most returners of any of the four teams (Alabama, Florida State, UCLA) in the College Cup.

Three Tar Heels on the current roster have been part of three College Cup teams – Maycee Bell, Isabel Cox and Julia Dorsey – who were also on the 2019 ACC championship team. Talia Dellaperuta, Sam Meza, Avery Patterson, Riley Quinlan and Paige Tolentino have been members of two College Cup squads.

In 2023, North Carolina is returning 69.8% of its goals scored from a year prior, as well as 85.7% of its assists and 74.7% of its points. UNC is also returning 84.6% of its shots and 81.7% of its shots on goal.

**First Class** ... Carolina's freshman class, which signed back in November 2022, is the top-ranked cohort in the country according to Top Drawer Soccer. Led by associate head coach and lead recruiter Damon Nahas, the Tar Heels have signed a top-four recruiting class for six consecutive years and have had a top-five class in eight of the last nine

The class includes forward Melina Rebimbas (No. 3), defender Evelyn Shores (No. 6), defender Savy King (No. 10), forward Olivia Thomas (No. 12) forward Mia Oliaro (No. 18) and goalkeeper Abby Gundry (No. 24), as well as midfielder Ella Smith.

Gundry, King, Oliaro and Rebimbas played together on the 2022 United States U-17 Women's Youth National Team that won the Concacaf Women's U-17 Championships to clinch its berth in the 2022 FIFA U-17 World Cup. All four were selected to the World Cup roster, but Oliaro withdrew due to injury.

**Home Sweet Home** ... UNC won't have to pack its bags often this season, as 10 of its 18 regular season matches will be played at Dorrance Field (both of their preseason exhibition contests were played at home, too). Furthermore, three of their eight road games are in the state of North Carolina: NC State (Sept. 30), Duke (Oct. 8) and Wake Forest (Oct. 13). For postseason competition, both the ACC Championship and the NCAA College Cup will be held in nearby Cary at the WakeMed Soccer Park.

The Tar Heels are 402-32-18 at home, a winning percentage of .912. UNC has outscored its opponents 1,676-223 all-time in Chapel Hill in its 454 home games since the program started in 1979.

Of the 44 completed seasons in program history, 25 of them have seen the Tar Heels go undefeated at home. Carolina has never lost more than three games at home in a single season. Only four losses have happened at Dorrance Field since its opening in 2019.

**Competitive Schedule** ... North Carolina has no shortage of top-tier teams to face throughout the 2023 season. The Tar Heels are set to face nine teams during the regular season that finished in the top-25 of the final United Soccer Coaches poll last year. Those teams include Florida State (No. 3), Alabama (No. 4), Notre Dame (No. 5), Duke (No. 6), Virginia (No. 7), Arkansas (No. 8), South Carolina (No. 9), Penn State (No. 13) and USC (No. 24).

Of UNC's 18-game regular-season slate, 13 of its opponents competed in the 2022 NCAA Tournament. Florida State and Alabama also played in the College Cup, while Arkansas, Notre Dame, Duke and Virginia advanced to the quarterfinals.

At the conclusion of the 2022 campaign which saw the Tar Heels earn a national runner-up finish, Carolina ranked third in NCAA DI women's soccer for its RPI. That ranked second in the ACC behind Florida State. Nine of UNC's opponents this season ranked in the top-25 for PRI last year, including six in the top-10.

#### **University of National Champions** ....

Across all sports, North Carolina has the eighth-most titles in NCAA history with 49 (13 men and 36 women). The women's soccer program owns 21 of them, plus an AIAW

title in 1982 for 22 total national championships. No other Division I women's soccer team has more than three.

One of the preeminent programs across all of college sports, North Carolina's unrivaled women's soccer dominance saw nine straight NCAA titles between 1986-1994. The team's 21 NCAA championships are tied for the fifth-most by any program in DI history.

Carolina is the only team in the country to appear in all 41 NCAA Women's Soccer Tournaments since the first one was held in 1982. The Tar Heels have appeared in 31 NCAA Women's College Cups, 18 more than the second closest team.

The Tar Heels have also won 289 ACC championship titles (148 men and 141 women), 137 more than any other current ACC school. The women's soccer program has won 22 conference titles (plus 25 regular season titles). No other ACC women's soccer team has more than nine conference championships (no one else has more than five regular season titles, either).

Sentnor was one of four players on the U.S. squad with a previous U-20 Women's Youth National Team cap.

The foursome led Team USA to a runner-up finish in the Dominican Republic. Sentnor -the team's co-captain - and Dahlien were the USA's leading scorers with four goals each. Dellarose scored once while King started all five matches, and Dahlien and Dellarose accounted for all four goals in a 4-0 win over Jamaica.

Sentnor was also part of the USA's FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup roster in 2022. She played in all three matches at the U-20 World Cup in Costa Rica, even scoring against Ghana. King was part of the U.S. 2022 FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup team.

Current freshmen Abby Gundry, Mia Oliaro, Melina Rebimbas and King played together on the 2022 United States U-17 WYNT that won the Concacaf U-17 Championships in the Dominican Republic.

Additionally, Dellarose, Nona Reason, Sentnor, King, Oliaro, Rebimbas and Evelyn Shores were called in for the 2023 WYNT U-18/U-19 combined training camp at the U.S. Soccer National Training Center in California back in January. All of them are age-eligible for the 2024 FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup next summer.

World Cup ... Seven Tar Heel alumnae participated in the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup and Australia and New Zealand this summer.

Crystal Dunn and Emily Fox were selected as part of the 23-person roster for the United States. Dunn made her second consecutive World Cup appearance while Fox was one of 14 players making their debut.

Playing for one of the host countries was Katie Bowen for New Zealand with her third straight World Cup appearance. Lucy Bronze, Lotte Wubben-Moy and Alessia Russo, as well as manager Sarina Wiegman, represented England. Bronze competed in the World Cup for the third time while Wubben-Moy and Russo made their first appearance. England advanced to the semifinals after Russo netted the game-winner.



The 1974 North Carolina graduate has won a combined 1,093 games at his alma mater (921 women and 172 men).

Inducted in the National Soccer Hall of Fame on 8/2/08 on the "Builders of the Game" ballot, being inducted in his first year of eligibility.

• Winner of the prestigious Werner Fricker Builder Award in 2016 from U.S. Soccer, given to an individual who has dedicated at least 20 years of service to the sport, working to establish a lasting legacy in the history and structure of soccer in the United States.

• Has one 921 games as head coach of the UNC women's program. He is No. 1 all-time in wins in the sport's history.

• Won his 1,000th game as a collegiate head coach (including 172 wins as UNC's men's head coach from 1977-88) when he won his 828th women's game against Ohio State on 8/18/18.

• Carolina's 2012 NCAA Championship was his 20th NCAA title, making him the first coach in NCAA history to win 20 NCAA championships in a single sport.

 Is the all-time leader in Division I NCAA championships in any sport with 21. UCLA men's volleyball coach AI Scates and Arkansas men's indoor track and field coach John McDonnell are second with 19. Dorrance is tied for second in all-time NCAA titles with 21 (all divisions).

• Has accounted for 21 of North Carolina's 46 total NCAA championships.

• UNC women's soccer's 21 NCAA championships are tied for the fifth-most by any program in Division I history. Oklahoma State wrestling has 34, Southern California men's outdoor track and field 26, Denver skiing 24, Iowa wrestling 24 and UNC women's soccer, USC men's tennis and Yale men's golf have won 21.

• In 2020, the Tar Heels went undefeated in the regular season, advanced to the ACC title game and made its unprecedented 30th appearance in the NCAA College Cup. Five Tar Heels, representing three nations, played in the 2020 Olympics in Tokyo (played in 2021).

• Beckett Entertainment named the 1982-2000 Tar Heels the sixth-most successful sports dynasty of the 20th century, trailing only the 1957-69 Boston Celtics, 1947-62 New York Yankees, 1963-75 UCLA men's basketball, 1991-98 Chicago Bulls and 1953-60 Montreal Canadians.

• Led Carolina to a 103-game unbeaten streak (97-0-6) from 1986 to 1990 and a 101-game unbeaten streak (99-0-2) from 1990 to 1994.

• Head Coach of the United States Women's National Team from 1986-94, leading Team USA to the title in the first-ever Women's World Cup in China in 1991. • Led the Carolina men's soccer team to the 1987 NCAA Final Four.

 Coached 19 different players to National Player-of-the-Year honors, including three-time recipient Cindy Parlow (current president of U.S. Soccer) and Mia Hamm, who was selected the Greatest Female Athlete in the ACC's first 50 years.

• Seven-time National Coach of the Year (1982, 1986, 1997, 2000, 2003 and 2006 with the women and 1987 with the men).

#### DAMON NAHAS ASSOC. HEAD COACH



Damon Nahas is beginning his eighth complete season as a full-time assistant women's soccer coach at the University of North Carolina in the fall of 2023. He officially joined the Tar Heel staff in November 2015.

Nahas brought with him an extensive background from 15 years in player development, club coaching and national team coaching. In 2000, he developed a U7-U11 technical academy, Next Level Academy (NLA), which not only played a major role in his development as a coach but, along with the NLA staff, continues to be a leader in player development in the Triangle area. He served as the technical director of one of the most successful youth clubs in the country, Capital Area Soccer League (CASL), in Raleigh since 2000.

He also served as head coach of the U.S. U15 Girls National Team from 2011-14 and began a stint as an assistant coach for the U.S. U17 Women's National Team in 2014.

Nahas attended and played soccer at NC State from 1992-96 and then played professionally with the Wilmington Hammerheads and Capital Express. Among his past head coaching experiences have been stints with Cary Clarets PDL (head coach), Carolina RailHawks (assistant coach 2007-09) and Cardinal Gibbons High School in Raleigh (men's head coach 1999-2002).

A native of East Northport, N.Y., Nahas earned his bachelor's degree from Southern New Hampshire University in 2021. He and his wife, Nicole, have two sons, Crew and Grayson, and a daughter Harper.

#### NATHAN THACKERAY ASST. COACH



Nathan Thackeray was hired as an assistant coach at North Carolina during the 2021 season and is responsible for working with the Tar Heel goalkeepers.

Thackeray simultaneously serves as a firstteam assistant and goalkeeper coach for the North Carolina courage of the NWSL. He joined the Courage in 2017, while concurrently serving as the Director of Goalkeeping for the USL's North Carolina FC.

He spent five years with North Carolina FC (2016-21) and during his time with the organization, NCFC developed 24 goalkeepers into intercollegiate players, had six players sign home grown contracts and eight had regular integration with either men's or the women's professional teams.

Thackeray was responsible for overseeing the largest goalkeeper program in the United States. With more than 300 goalkeepers. He also served as an assistant coach for both boys' and girls' U15 – U19 academy teams.

He joined the staff of the North Carolina FC in 2016 after serving as Head of Academy Goalkeeping with Major League Soccer's Houston Dynamo for four seasons.

In addition to serving as an assistant coach with the Dynamo, Thackeray was responsible for overseeing the development of all goalkeepers from age levels U11 to U23.

He earned his bachelor's degree in communications and media studies from William Woods University in 2010.

#### ALEXANDRA KIMBALL ASST. COACH



Alex Kimball was hired as director of team development for UNC women's soccer in 2022 after serving as a volunteer assistant coach. In 2023, she was elevated to assistant coach.

As the director of team development, Kimball oversaw community outreach programs, harvested relations with local youth soccer programs and promoted the sale of tickets for home matches. She also assisted head coach Anson Dorrance with player development and associate head coach Damon Nahas with recruiting operations.

A four-year letterwinner for Dorrance, Kimball played in 91 games during her UNC career and helped the Tar Heels reach two College Cups (2016, 2018) and captured two ACC regular season championships. She finished her career with nine goals and seven assists with more than 2800 minutes played.

Kimball began her professional career in January 2019 when she was selected by Utah Royals FC in the fourth round of the NWSL College Draft.

After suffering an injury during the 2019-20 season, Kimball work as an individual skilled trainer at GL Soccer training facility in Salt Lake City before becoming the director of development at Sporting io.

Kimball represented Peru in the Copa America tournament in Cali, Colombia in summer of 2022.

She graduated from UNC with a bachelor's degree in sports administration.
