### **STARTLING THE SCARLET KNIGHTS**

Led by eighth-year head coach Kristen Butler, the Rutgers Scarlet Knights prepare for their final series of the 2024 season boasting a 31-20 overall record in addition to a 12-8 mark against Big Ten competitors, good enough for the third-best record in the league. Rutgers is in the midst of a program-defining turnaround, securing back-to-back 30-win seasons following last weekend's series victory over Michigan State. The Scarlet Knights have won a program-record five Big Ten series through their first six opportunitites, downing Ohio State, Purdue, Wisconsin, Minnesota and Michigan State with a doubleheader sweep of Maryland. Senior utility Morgan Smith has been one of the most dominant individual athletes in the B1G in 2024, leading the B1G in home runs (19), RBI (65) and RBI per game (1.27) while also spending 126.2 innings in teh circle for the Scarlet Knights. Staff ace Mattie Boyd has thrown 165.2 innings and leads the team with a 2.32 ERA coupled with 139 strikeouts against just 63 walks in her fifth season.

### **STORY OF THE SERIES**

In a competitive all-time series spanning multiple conference realignments, Penn State boasts a 39-28 record against Rutgers since the first meeting of the two programs in softball in 1980. PSU and Rutgers first squared off as mutual members of the Atlantic 10 Conference before PSU departed for the B1G ahead of the 1991-92 academic year. The Nittany Lions and Scarlet Knights gear up for their 26th, 27th and 28th matchups since both programs renewed their conference rivalry in 2014-15. The Blue & White have established recent dominance over Rutgers since the arrival of head coach Clarisa Crowell in the 2021 spring season, with PSU logging an 8-2 record in the last 10 meetings. Penn State recorded a three-game series sweep of the Scarlet Knights at Nittany Lion Softball Park a year ago, with a Maddie Gordon grand slam putting a punctuation mark on the set in an 8-3 win on Sunday, April 16.

### **BYE ON THE LINE**

Entering the final weekend of the Big Ten season, the Northwestern Wildcats and Michigan Wolverines sit atop the league table with both teams having the opportunity to clinch the BIG regular season title in their respective series this weekend. Penn State joins seven other teams in contention for a first round bye in the league's postseason tournament next week in Iowa City. The Blue & White currently stand tied for sixth in the league alongside Indiana and Purdue with 11-9 records. Rutgers, Minnesota, Nebraska and Ohio State each remain in mathematical contention for a top-four seed in the BIG Tournament in 2024. PSU seeks its first bye in the first round of the league's postseason evenet since the 2016 team earned the No. 4 seed and reached the semifinals at Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field.

### **ON THE RECORD**

Penn State's win over SFU saw the NIttany Lions publish their 33rd overall victory, with PSU currently boasting a 33-15 overall record paired with an 11-9 B1G mark. PSU's 33 wins are the eighth-most in a single season in program history, in addition to being the most wins in Happy Valley since the 2008 team published a 34-22 overall record. Penn State needs just six more victories to meet the all-time program record for wins in a single season set by the 2006 squad. PSU published a 39-17 overall record and advanced to both the Big Ten and NCAA Tournaments. The 2006 edition of the Blue & White battled their way to the Hempstead Regional Final, defeating Hofstra and LIU before dropping their finale to Arizona State.

#### **THE BIG SHOW**

Entering the seventh and final weekend of Big Ten Conference regular-season competition, Penn State ranks prominently in the B1G in multiple statistical categories. PSU stands second in the league in doubles (84), doubles per game (1.75), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.18) and triples per game (0.35).

The Nittany Lions also rank inside the top four in the conference in fewest hit batters (fourth, 23), stolen bases per game (fourth, 0.96), total stolen bases (fourth, 46) and winning percentage (fourth, 688). Individually, Bridget Nemeth ranks first in the Big Ten in multiple pitching statistics, including innings pitched with 169.2, strikeoutto-walk ratio with a 4.74 tally and overall victories with 21 so far in 2024. Senior third baseman Emily Maddock also owns a leagueleading strikeout percentage, striking out in one out of every 30.2 at-bats on average over the course of the year.

### **GORDON'S GREATNESS**

Junior utility Maddie Gordon has surged into the spotlight in the 2024 campaign, with the Shenandoah, Virginia, native leading the Blue & White in multiple statistical categories. Gordon paces the Nittany Lions in at-bats (156), runs scored (42), hits (52) doubles (15), home runs (10), total bases (99) and stolen bases (12). Gordon ranks third in the Big Ten Conference in both doubles and doubles per game (0.31), ranking inside the top 75 nationally in both respective categories. Gordon currently boasts the fourth-most doubles in a single season in Penn State program history and became the 13th Nittany Lion to hit 10-or-more homers in a campaign earlier this year.

### KNOW THE NEMETH

In a release on Thursday, April 25, freshman pitcher Bridget Nemeth garnered national acclaim as a member of the Top-25 Watch List for the NFCA Division I Freshman of the Year Award. One of the most decorated freshman athletes in Penn State history, Nemeth achieved her second National Freshman of the Week accolade of the 2024 season on April 9 following PSU's series win over Nebraska. Nemeth already owns the Penn State single-season record for Big Ten weekly awards with four, surpassing Bailey Parshall's single-season record of two earlier this season. With PSU's win against Saint Francis, Nemeth continued her ascendence through the Nittany Lion record book, moving into

sole possession of third all-time at PSU for victories in a single season following her 21st winning decision. Nemeth, a native of Glendora, California, now trails Nittany Lion legends in Parshall and Kelly McCann for the most wins all time, needing just one more victory to tie and two to pass the record of 22.

Nemeth ranks as one of the most dominant pitchers in the nation and Big Ten Conference, leading the league with a 21-5 individual record while ranking seventh nationally in total victories. PSU's ace currently boasts a 1.57 season ERA, the second-best mark in the Big Ten and 30th-best nationally while simultaneously managing a 4.74 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the best tally in the B1G and 26th-best in Division I.

### **KAITLYN'S CORNER**

Senior Kaitlyn Morrison is in the midst of her most productive collegiate season to date, ranking prominently on the PSU roster and in the Big Ten Conference in multiple statistical categories. Morrison, a native of South Park, Pennsylvania, ranks fourth in the Big Ten in doubles (14) and 55th nationally, while ranking fourth in the league and 74th nationally with 0.30 doubles per game. She leads the Penn State roster in triples with six this season, booking her most recent three-bagger on April 23 against SFU. Morrison's six triples rank as the third-most in the BIG and ninth-most nationally, while her 0.13 triples per game rank third in the BIG and 14th in Division I. Morrison has been an absolute menace for opposing pitchers, with the veteran offensive star already surpassing her single-season career highs in walks and hit by pitches, drawing 19 and five, respectively. Her .432 on-base percentage ranks second on the PSU roster among qualified starters.

#### GABY GAR(SEE-YA)

Senior Stephen F. Austin transfer catcher Gaby Garcia has been a power hitting and defensive weapon for the Nittany Lions over the course of her final collegiate season, tied for the team lead in home runs with 10 while pacing the team in RBI (39), putouts (282) and fielding percentage (1.000). The Southlake, Texas, native transferred to PSU after an All-WAC season that featured a league-leading 18 home runs last year while with the Ladyjacks. After leaving the yard against Michigan last weekend, Garcia became the 14th woman in program history and second student-athlete this year at PSU to record 10-or-more home runs in a single season. Garcia and teammate Maddie Gordon rank 13th in the B1G in total homers this year.

### **BACK IN BLUE**

Senior infielder Emily Maddock returns to PSU for her final season after becoming the first Nittany Lion position player to land First Team All-B1G accolades since 2017. Maddock was an NFCA First Team All-Region choice as well, booking the second-best singleseason batting average in Penn State history with a .439 mark. Graduate infielder Kaitlyn Morrison returns to the field after her most productive collegiate season in 2023, shattering career highs in practically every statistical category. Morrison booked a .338 average with 145 at-bats, 49 hits, 14 doubles and seven homers. Senior outfielder Liana Jones continues her career in the Blue & White in 2024 after a 2023 season which saw her crank six homers and a career-best 16 RBI. Junior outfielder Maddie Gordon rounds out the four PSU starters returning from last season. The Shenandoah, Virginia, native hit the only Nittany Lion grand slam in 2023 in the series finale against Rutgers, powering an 8-3 win in the process.

### **POWER TO THE PORTAL**

PSU welcomed a trio of transfers last summer, including Pitt transfer outfielder Haylie Brunson, SFA transfer catcher Gaby Garcia and Coastal Carolina transfer pitcher Mady Volpe. Brunson spent two years with the Panthers, clocking a .294 average last season with a .871 OPS, establishing herself as the team's starting right fielder.

Garcia, a native of Southlake, Texas, hit .315 last year while ranking second in the WAC and 14th nationally with 18 home runs. Garcia's reputation as an All-Conference performer is built on 37 career home runs and 34 doubles while booking a .992 fielding percentage. Volpe arrives in Happy Valley after a two-year career at Coastal Carolina. The Lansdale, Pennsylvania, native booked a 2.66 ERA last year with an impressive 9-1 individual record.

### **FRESH FACES**

- PSU boasts six new freshmen on the 2024 roster, including pitcher Bridget Nemeth, infielder Brooke Klosowicz, outfielder Michela Barbanente, infielder Jiselle Hernandez, infielder Gianna Poletti and catcher Audree Mendoza. Poletti is not currently eligible to participate following a mid-year transfer from Auburn, but the remaining five Nittany Lions are expected to make an immediate impact on the diamond.
- Penn State hauled in the nation's 24th-ranked recruiting class in the 2025 signee cycle according to Extra Inning Softball, comprised of right-handed pitcher Abigail Britton, catcher Macy Chamberlin and outfielder Natalie Lieto. The Nittany Lion class ranked third in the Big Ten Conference behind Northwestern (#21) and Michigan State (#23).

#### **UP NEXT**

Penn State softball awaits its seeding in the 2024 Big Ten Conference Softball Tournament hosted by the University of Iowa at Pearl Field in Iowa City. The Nittany Lions will enter the postseason for the third year in a row under the direction of fourth-year head coach Clarisa Crowell, and will begin competition on either Wednesday, May 8, or Thursday, May 9. All BIG Tournament matchups will air on the Big Ten Network, with streaming available on the FOX Sports App.

## CLARISA CROWELL HEAD COACH | FOURTH SEASON AT PSU

Then-Penn State University Vice President for Athletics Sandy Barbour named Clarisa Crowell as the eighth head coach of the Nittany Lion softball program on August 3, 2020. Crowell enters her fourth season at the helm of the Blue & White in the 2024 campaign.

Crowell returns to Happy Valley following her second consecutive 30-win season with the Nittany Lions, the first instance of back-to-back 30-win campaigns at PSU since the 2005 and 2006 teams accomplished that feat. Penn State published a 31-16 overall record in Big Ten Conference play, ensuring that the Nittany Lions would finish at or above .500 in the league in consecutive seasons, also for the first time since 2005-06.

Under Crowell's direction, the Nittany Lions saw continued success on the Big Ten's biggest stage in 2023, winning a conference tournament game in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 2016 and 2017 squads did so. PSU also recorded consecutive postseason appearances for the first time in five seasons, reaching back-to-back Big Ten Tournaments for the first time since the Nittany Lions appeared in five-straight from 2013 to 2017.

As the program's pitching coach, Crowell directed the most effective pitching staff in the Big Ten Conference. The Nittany Lions finished as the conference's leader in overall earned run average, rounding out the year with a 2.18 mark. The Blue & White also recorded the third-best strikeout-to-walk ratio in the league and 15th-best nationally, striking out 3.59 batters for every walk surrendered. Crowell's pitching direction also culminated in multiple program records being shattered by fifth-year left-hander Bailey Parshall, who set PSU records in career strikeouts (783) and shutouts (21).

In the classroom, PSU published a perfect Academic Progress Rate of 1,000 and saw 18 Nittany Lion student-athletes land Academic All-Big Ten honors. Penn State also mustered 12 Easton/NFCA Scholar Athletes, seven Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honors and five College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-District accolades, reflecting Crowell's commitment to comprehensive excellence on and off the field.

In recognition of her exemplary record in the classroom and on the diamond, senior first baseman Lexie Black secured two of the highest honors bestowed by the Big Ten Conference in 2023. Black, a native of Omaha, Nebraska, landed the Big Ten Postgraduate Scholarship in preparation for her continuing education in veterinary medicine at the University of Nebraska. Additionally, Black garnered the Big Ten Medal of Honor, bestowed upon one male and female graduating student-athlete from each BIG member institution.

Penn State finished the 2022 campaign with a 25-win improvement from the previous season, marking the largest single-season turnaround for a team in

NCAA Division I. The Nittany Lions also reached the 30-win mark and finished above .500 in Big Ten Conference play for the first time since 2016. Penn State completed the campaign with 32 wins, which at the time marked the most wins for PSU in a season since 2008. As a result of the program's meteoric rise to prominence, Crowell was honored as the 2022 ECAC Coach of the Year.

On the defensive side, the Blue and White registered 12 shutouts on the year, the most by any Nittany Lion squad since the 2008 team accomplished that feat. At the dish, the Nittany Lions' 75 doubles ranked tied for second in program history, while their 43 home runs and 207 RBI ranked third in program history.

Parshall led the way on an individual basis, earning NFCA All-America Third Team honors to go along with NFCA First-Team All-Region and First-Team All-Big Ten accolades. Parshall was selected as the Female Penn State Athlete of the Year for the 2021-22 academic year as a result. Parshall became just the fifth NFCA All-American in program history and the first Penn State pitcher to earn All-American recognition since Ashley Esparza did so in 2005. Parshall was dominant in the circle in 2022, posting a 22-9 individual record with a 1.68 ERA and nine shutouts in 212.1 innings pitched.

In addition to Parshall's nationallyacclaimed statistical season, junior catcher Cassie Lindmark collected NFCA All-Region Third Team and All-Big Ten Second Team laurels. Lindmark provided and immediate offensive pop for the Nittany Lion lineup, hitting .400 in the leadoff spot in addition to building a striking .508 onbase percentage. She became just the sixth Nittany Lion to hit .400 in a season and ranked tied for sixth on the program's single-season batting average leaderboard.

The Nittany Lions maintained consistent success in the classroom, tying a then-program record by placing 16 student-athletes on the Academic All-Big Ten team for the second consecutive year. Six student-athletes were designated as Big Ten Distinguished Scholars. Fourteen student-athletes made the Dean's list during spring semester and the squad compiled a 3.45 GPA, posting the highest cumulative GPA for the program in at least a decade. Under Crowell's leadership, Claire Swedberg was selected as the 2022 Big Ten Postgraduate Award winner, a recipient of the Fulbright grant and was also selected to be the Grand Marshal for the Penn State Health and Human Development Department.

In her first season at the helm in Happy Valley in 2O21, Crowell led the Nittany Lions to a win over No. 23 Minnesota, the program's first victory over a ranked opponent since 2017. Penn State also had wins over four other Big Ten programs in a COVID-maligned conference-only calendar during the 2O21 spring semester, including three-straight wins and a series victory over Rutgers. The consecutive victories against the Scarlet Knights marked the first time ONE NCAA REGIONAL APPEARANCE

Crowell also mentored Parshall in her ongoing success in the circle, as the thenjunior pitcher recorded two double-digit strikeout games and moved into sixth alltime in the Penn State record books with 396 career strikeouts and third all-time with seven career saves. In the classroom, a program-record 16 student-athletes earned Academic All-Big Ten honors in Crowell's first season of leadership, immediately setting the tone for multiple seasons of academic excellence that followed.

Prior to her arrival at Penn State, Crowell spent eight years as head coach at Miami (Ohio). Crowell and the RedHawks made a MAC Tournament appearance every season in which a tournament was held, winning the league tournament title and making an NCAA Regional appearance in 2016.

Crowell coached 12 student-athletes to first team All-MAC honors, 10 to secondteam honors, nine All-MAC Freshman Team recipients and six National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-Region honorees. RedHawk student-athletes also excelled in the classroom with 40 Easton/ NFCA Scholar-Athletes and 32 Academic All-MAC honorees during Crowell's tenure in Oxford.

In the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, Crowell's RedHawks were selected as the MAC preseason favorites. Junior pitcher Courtney Vierstra ranked fifth nationally and first in the conference in strikeouts with 140 over 18 appearances. Crowell's tutelage of Vierstra saw the junior star finish fifth nationally in strikeouts per seven innings with 12.5 at the season's suspension mark.

In the spring of 2019, Crowell led Miami to a 35-16 overall record and a 16-4 ledger in conference play, as the RedHawks captured their first MAC regular-season title in program history. Miami posted 10-straight wins against MAC opponents, the longest win streak in conference play in the history of the RedHawk program. The team also ranked first in the MAC for pitching and team defense with an overall ERA of 2.55 coupled with a .972 fielding percentage. Crowell was named the 2019 MAC Coach of the Year while seven student-athletes earned All-MAC selections and two more were named NFCA All-Region honorees. Vierstra headlined the list of All-Region recipients after boasting the third-best strikeouts-per-seven innings ratio in the country (10.3).

Crowell's 2017 team excelled offensively, ranking second all-time in Miami history for runs scored (265), runs per game (5.00), RBI (235), doubles (74) and home runs (47). Crowell led Michaela Schlattman to NFCA All-Region recognition, marking the thirdstraight season a RedHawk player garnered regional accolades. The RedHawks went 29-24 in 2017, highlighted by a dominant 16-2 record at home.

### HEAD COACH CLARISA CROWELL

In 2016, Crowell led Miami to a 35-23 overall record and 15-7 record in MAC competition, finishing just half a game short of the MAC regular-season title. The RedHawks made up for that with a perfect 4-0 record in the MAC Tournament to earn the program's fourth conference tournament crown and a spot in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2012. Miami went on to beat No. 23 Notre Dame, 3-2, in the opening game of the Ann Arbor Regional.

The 2016 RedHawks broke six offensive school records, including runs (302), runs per game (5.21), RBI (274), doubles (83), home runs (56) and walks (200). Miami also held a .977 fielding percentage, a school record, and the seventh-best fielding percentage in the nation. Crowell coached senior outfielder Taylor Shuey to become the first softball player in school history to be named MAC Player of the Year after breaking Miami's career RBI record with 114. Senior pitcher Amber Logemann was also named the MAC Tournament MVP after going 4-0 individually with a domineering 0.65 ERA in 32.1 innings pitched.

Crowell's third season in 2015 saw senior outfielder Tiyona Marshall garner NFCA All-Mideast Region First-Team honors after Marshall set school records in hits (86), runs scored (50) and batting average (.446).

Prior to Miami, Crowell spent six seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma State where she primarily worked with the pitchers and catchers. In 2010, both of her pitchers earned spots on the All-Big 12 and NFCA All-Midwest Region teams. In 2011, Crowell coached catcher Courtney Totte to an All-Big 12 first-team appearance and recognition as a Third Team All-American. Crowell helped lead the Cowgirls back to national prominence, as Oklahoma State returned to the Women's College World Series for the first time since 1998 in the 2011 campaign. The coaching staff also hauled in NFCA Midwest Region Coaching Staff of the Year accolades at season's end.

Crowell's previous stop at Syracuse as an assistant coach in 2006 saw the Orange land four players as NFCA All-Region designees and five players secure All-Conference honors. All-American and Big East Player of the Year Alexis Switenko led the way, while Tonye McCorkle, the Big East Co-Rookie of the Year, published a dominant season of her own. Crowell began her collegiate coaching career at Ohio University, where she served as an assistant for two years.

Crowell was a decorated student-athlete at Virginia Tech as a four-year letterwinner and a three-time All-Conference performer for the Hokies. In 2013, Crowell was inducted into the Virginia Tech All-Sports Hall of Fame.

Crowell graduated from Virginia Tech in 2002 with a Bachelor of Science degree in psychology. She earned a Master of Science in recreation and sports sciences from Ohio University in 2005.

### **NITTANY LION SOFTBALL PARK & BEARD FIELD**

A facility years in the making, stateof-the-art and second to none – that is what Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field provides to the Penn State athletic community. With numerous donations and the Penn State Board of Trustees' approval, construction of the \$10.2 million complex was completed in time for the 2011 season. The facility houses the Nittany Lion softball team and allows the program to compete with the best in the country.

The complex features 1,084 permanent seats with fantastic sight lines, accessible seating, concession stands, permanent bathrooms and merchandise areas for fans. On the softball side of things, the field with irrigation, dugouts, batting cages and tunnels, bullpens, scoreboard and a state-of-the-art lighting system make Nittany Lion Softball Park a collegiate softball gem.

The complex consolidates the team's resources into one area with new training rooms, media center, video room, study space, locker rooms and coaches' offices all housed at the softball park. A new press area behind home plate was constructed, which further enhanced the amenities of the stadium.

Key benefactors of the project allowed Nittany Lion Softball Park to take shape and get off the ground. The playing field was named Beard Field in recognition of a generous donation from Lee and William Beard in October 2009. The Penn State locker room was named the Fran Vanden Locker Room, recognizing a gift from George and Frances Vanden. Another major donation came from the James M. and Margaret V. Stine Foundation to name both the Softball Office Complex and Media Center in honor of the Stine Family. Art and Paige Nagle also contributed to the project and one of the assistant coaches' offices dons their names.

Penn State's first game in its new home was March 26, 2011, a thrilling 8-5 victory over Wisconsin. Plenty of firsts were delivered that afternoon and none more memorable than Lisa Akamine's inside-the-park home run as Penn State overcame a three-run deficit to win the inaugural game. For the season, Penn State boasted an 11-8-1 record on Beard Field in its first campaign. It was the first winning season at home since 2007 for the Nittany Lions, which coincided with PSU's last trip to the NCAA Tournament before 2011. The stadium paid dividends immediately for the Nittany Lion program as Penn State hosted the 2011 NCAA University Park Regional.

The event marked the first time PSU hosted NCAA Softball in 28 years as Oregon, Fordham and Albany competed with Penn State for the right to go to the NCAA Super Regionals. In the three-day event, nearly 1,900 fans streamed through the turnstiles. Oregon would eventually advance, but not before an exciting 16-inning midnight thriller between Penn State and Fordham. The Nittany Lions prevailed, 5-2, in the second-longest game in PSU history.

As if the NCAA event wasn't exciting enough. Penn State then hosted the PIAA Softball Championships. Four games in one day on a sparkling afternoon in mid-June had nearly 3,000 fans attend. The first game of the day featured local powerhouse Philipsburg-Osceola and Brandywine Heights with a standing room-only crowd of 1,800 spectators. The PIAA is still a committed partner of Penn State Athletics, as Nittany Lion Softball Park and Happy Valley Hospitality earned rave reviews. Penn State's University Park campus has played host to the PIAA Championships in every season since Beard Field opened in 2011.

Nittany Lion Softball Park is located on the corner of Park Avenue and University Drive, facing the Bryce Jordan Center, Mount Nittany and Beaver Stadium to the southeast, providing spectacular views and a gorgeous setting for all who attend softball games.

"Bill and I are both very pleased to be a small part of this very impressive facility. For us, the decision to give to this facility, to this program, was easy because one of our big passions is certainly the students of this university, but in particular the softball program. Our passion to help the softball program is because we've watched this program grow. There are some common links to this group [of donors]: Fran and George [Vanden], the Stine Family, Peter and Ann Nagle, Bill and I all have in common a link in believing that this is a program that deserves the typical Penn State, first-class facility to be successful."
