Stanford vs. Ohio State

Stanford Notes

Stanford will be making its 13th appearance in a regional final and second in a row. The Cardinal defeated Maryland, 98-87, in the Spokane Regional last season. Stanford went on to play in the national title game in which it lost, 64-48, to Tennessee.

Stanford will play Iowa State in Monday's Berkeley Regional Final at 6 p.m. It will mark the second meeting of the season between the two teams. Stanford, which leads the series 3-0, defeated Iowa State, 83-45, at the Waikiki Beach Marriott Classic in November.

Stanford is 4-3 all-time against the Big 10 in the NCAA Tournament

Stanford has outrebounded its three opponents in the NCAA Tournament, by a 148-84 margin. The Cardinal outrebounded Ohio State, 42-32, Saturday night.

Jeanette Pohlen made one 3-pointer against Ohio State to tie Candice Wiggins (2006-07) for fourth place on Stanford's single-season list with 82.

Pohlen collected 10 rebounds to establish a career-high. Her previous career-best was seven, accomplished five times.

Jayne Appel scored 25 points and grabbed 11 rebounds for her 14th double-double of the season and third in a row.

Stanford evened its all-time series against Ohio State at 1-1. The Cardinal avenged a 79-47 setback to the Buckeyes on Dec. 28, 1984.

Ohio State Notes

Ohio State finishes its season 29-6.

Sophomore center Jantel Lavender collected six rebounds to increase her Ohio State and Big Ten single-season record to 374.

The Buckeyes fell to 24-2 when making more free throws than their opposition and 42-2 over the last two seasons when accomplishing that feat. Ohio State held a 15-13 advantage from the charity stripe against Stanford.

Ohio State is 19-9 all-time against the Pac-10 Conference.
