POSTGAME NOTES

STANFORD (30-4)

- * Stanford improves to 53-20 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.
- * The Cardinal moves to 4-0 in the postseason against Big West Conference schools.
- * Stanford wins its 17th straight game and has not lost since a 57-54 setback at No. 11/9 California on Jan. 18.
- * Jayne Appel reached double figures in scoring for the third straight game and the 27th time this season.
- * Jayne Appel led all scorers with 15 points and added 11 rebounds to log her 12th double-double of the year.
- * Kayla Pedersen scored in double figures for the 20th time this year. Pederson finished with 10 points and 9 rebounds.
- * Jeanette Pohlen hit the double-figure scoring plateau for the 21st time this season. She finished with 13 points.
- * Nnemkadi Ogwumike scored 13 points to log her fourth straight double-figure scoring effort. She has 18 such performances on the season.
- * Nnemkadi Ogwumike posted her fourth double-double of the season. She finished with 13 points and 11 rebounds, her sixth double-digit rebounding performance of the year.
- * Sarah Boothe collected a team-high tying 11 rebounds (Appel, Ogwumike), marking her second double-digit rebound effort of 2008-09.

UC SANTA BARBARA (22-10)

- * Despite the loss, UC Santa Barbara ends the season by winning five of its last six games, including the Big West Conference Tournament title.
- * Whitney Warren finished with 10 points to log her seventh double-figure scoring performance. It was her first since scoring 12 vs. UC Irvine on Feb. 7.
- * Jenna Green grabbed 10 rebounds to produce her eighth double-figure rebounding game of the season and her third in a row.
