Post-Game Notes

Stanford Cardinal (32-1)

SO F Nnemkadi Ogwumike led the Cardinal with 19 points against UC Riverside. It is the 14th game this season that she has led the team in scoring. She has scored in double-figures in 11 consecutive games and 30 games overall. With 11 rebounds Ogwumike also earned her 14th double-double this season.

JR G Kayla Pedersen led Stanford with 12 rebounds and added 15 points for her 13th double-double of the season and earned her team-leading 14th consecutive game scoring in double-figures.

Tonight's final score of 79-47 marks 19 straight double-digit wins for the Cardinal.

The win tonight elevates Stanford's NCAA Tournament home game record to 23-4. The team's home winning streak now stands at 45, the second-longest in program history.

SR C Jayne Appel extended her Stanford and Pac-10 career rebounding record to 1,230 with two rebounds against the Highlanders.

With seven points tonight Appel has 2,071 career points, just six points shy of third place on the all-time Stanford scoring list.

UC Riverside Highlanders (17-15)

UC Riverside is appearing in its fourth postseason in five years in Division I. The last time they faced a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament was in 2006, when they played North Carolina.

FR G Tre 'Shonti Nottingham led the Highlanders with 10 points against Stanford, the first time she has led the Highlanders in scoring this season.

SR F Marissa Rivera led the Highlanders with five rebounds tonight to lead the squad in the category for the 12th game this season.

After hitting six three-pointers tonight, the squad set a new program single-season record of 180 three-point baskets made in a season.

The Highlanders are a combined 4-19 against Pac-10 squads in program history.

JR G/F Brittany Waddell, a 90.1 percent free throw shooter on the season, was 1-4 from the charity stripe against Stanford.

JR G Alyssa Morris, the team's leading scorer (14.9 ppg) and leading rebounder (6.3 rpg) collected five points and three rebounds tonight against Stanford.
