

## **2011 NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament**

### **Stanford Cardinal (30-2)**

- Stanford is appearing in its 25th NCAA Tournament, 24th in a row.
- Stanford extended its home winning streak to 62 games and 24 wins overall.
- The Cardinal is now 62-22 in tournament play all-time.
- Stanford now has a record of 22-3 in the NCAA first and second rounds at Maples Pavilion.
- Junior forward **Nnemkadi Ogwumike** had 12 points at the half.
- All five starters for the Cardinal scored in double figures; N. Ogwumike (22 points), junior guard **Lindy La Rocque** (14), senior guard **Jeanette Pohlen** (11), senior guard/forward **Kayla Pedersen** (11) and freshman forward **Chiney Ogwumike** (10). Freshman guard **Toni Kokenis** came off the bench to score 11 points also.
- The Cardinal forced 15 turnovers and put away 20 points off those steals.
- Stanford shot 13-of-22 for 59.1 percent from three-point range, putting away the most three-pointers as a team this season. The previous high was 12 at Arizona on Feb. 3, 2011.
- La Roque tied her career and season highs with four three-pointers made, as she went 4-for-5.
- Kokenis tied her career and season highs in three-pointers made, as she shot 3-for-4.
- Pedersen tied a season high as she went 3-for-4 from the three-point line.

### **UC Davis Aggies (24-9)**

- The Aggies made their first NCAA Division I postseason appearance.
- The Cardinal and Aggies have now met 14 times in school history, with the Aggies holding an 8-5 series advantage.
- Senior center **Paige Mintun** had 11 points at the half and finished with 17.
- UC Davis shot 46.8% from the floor and matched the Cardinal with 28 points in the paint.
- The Aggies forced 10 turnovers.
- Head coach Sandy Simpson coached his final game at the reins for the Aggies, as he is set to retire. He was the head coach at UC Davis for 14 seasons.
- The Aggies have posted back-to-back 20 win seasons.
