NONCONFERENCE FINALE

Stanford closes nonconference play Thursday as the Cardinal welcomes Idaho to Maples Pavilion for a 7:30 p.m. PT tip-off. Coming off a setback to SMU on Monday in Dallas, Stanford begins a three-game homestand with Thursday's contest. The Cardinal will host Arizona State on Dec. 30 and Arizona on Jan. 1.

THE 25,000-MILE SEASON-OPENING JOURNEY

The Cardinal will spend the next 14 days at home, its longest stretch of the season, after completing a whirlwind 25,000-mile journey across the globe during its first 11 games. The 2016-17 campaign opened in Shanghai, China on Nov. 11. Following its trip to China, Stanford played games in Orlando, Florida, Lawrence, Kansas and Dallas Texas. The four trips, which included six games, totaled 25,598 miles and more than 56 hours on an airplane.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

In its first 11 games, Stanford (49 in RPI) has played five teams that are projected to be in the 2017 NCAA Tournament field, according to ESPN's Joe Lunardi. All five of those teams - Kansas (5), Saint Mary's (22), Miami (31), Seton Hall (35) and SMU (47) - also rank among ESPN analyst Jay Bilas list of "Top 68 Teams In The Land." The Cardinal played only one of these teams, Saint Mary's, on its home floor. Stanford's strength of schedule as of Dec. 21 ranks 13th nationally.

TRAVIS' IMPACT

After missing the final 22 games last season, Reid Travis has made a strong impact in his return this year. He has posted five of his six career double-doubles in the first 11 games of this season. His team-leading 17.5 ppg ranks third in the Pac-12, and his team-best 9.6 rpg ranks fourth in the conference. He ranks 39th nationally in rebounding as of Dec. 20.

TRAVIS FROM THE LINE

Reid Travis ranks seventh in the nation in free throws attempted (94) and 23rd in the country in free throws made (65) as of Dec. 20. At Kansas on Dec. 3, he set Stanford single-game records for free throws made (19) and attempted (22), while also breaking the same free throw marks by a Kansas opponent. While Travis is getting to the charity stripe much more, his free throw percentage has also improved from last year.

AGAINST IDAHO

Stanford and Idaho have faced each other nine times previously, with the Cardinal owning a 6-3 edge in the all-time series. The two teams have not played since the 1958-59 season. They played twice per year from the 1956-59 seasons. Stanford has won all five home contests against Idaho.

AGAINST THE BIG SKY

Stanford is 23-5 all-time against current members of the Big Sky Conference. Stanford's only defeats to members of the conference are to Idaho (6-3) and Montana (3-2). The Cardinal owns unblemished records vs. Montana State (2-0), Northern Arizona (1-0), Portland State (2-0), Sacramento State (5-0), Southern Utah (3-0) and Weber State (1-0). Idaho marks the second Big Sky opponent this season, as Stanford defeated Weber State on Nov. 17.

PICKENS ON TARGET FROM BEYOND THE ARC

Junior Dorian Pickens has posted at least one three-pointer in nine of Stanford's 11 games, with multiple three-pointers in five contests. He is shooting 41.5 percent from three-point range (14th in Pac-12), with a team-best 17 three-pointers on the year. He registered a season-high four (4-of-6) vs. Colorado State. Pickens connected on three trifectas in the win over Indiana State, including the game-winner with 2.0 seconds left.

CONVERTING FROM THE LINE

Dorian Pickens also excels from the free throw line, where he ranks fourth in the Pac-12 with a free throw percentage of 85.3 (29-of-34). He converted 14 straight free throws, from Nov. 25 through Dec. 19.

PICKENS NAMED TO ADVOCARE INVITE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

After averaging 18.3 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.3 steals in three games in the Advocare Invitational, Dorian Pickens was named to the five-member all-tournament team at the conclusion of the event.

VERHOEVEN AN IMPACT IN THE PAINT

Senior Grant Verhoeven is averaging 5.7 points and 3.5 rebounds in 14.3 minutes per game this season. Verhoeven, who was inserted into the starting lineup two games ago, has become a force in the paint for each of Stanford's opponents, drawing several charges throughout the year. In the Cardinal's win over Seton Hall, he drew five charges and caused six turnovers by the Pirates overall. While his minutes average is relatively the same, he is averaging 2.4 more points and 1.5 more rebounds this season.

BIGS PROVIDE BOOST

Stanford's group of Reid Travis, Michael Humphrey and Grant Verhoeven have provided a strong presence in the paint through the season's first 11 games. The trio has combined to score 335 points (30.5 ppg) and collect 193 rebounds (17.5 rpg) this season. The Harvard game was the first time all three scored in double figures in the same game.

THE JUNIOR CLASS

Stanford's four-member junior class - Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens, Michael Humphrey and Robert Cartwright - has accounted for 64 percent (471-of-736) of the scoring this season. Travis (17.5 ppg), Pickens (12.0 ppg), Humphrey (7.2 ppg) and Cartwright (6.1 ppg) rank one, two, three and four, respectively, among Stanford's scoring leaders. Cartwright is listed as a sophomore after receiving a medical redshirt for the 2015-16 season. The group was part of Stanford's 2014 signing class.

VETERAN GROUP

Boasting one of the most experienced rosters in the Pac-12, four starters - Reid Travis, Michael Humphrey, Marcus Allen, and Christian Sanders - and 10 of the top 11 scorers from last season are back. Including the first 11 games of this season, Stanford's roster has combined for 719 appearances.

CARTWRIGHT, SANDERS RUNNING POINT

The duo of sophomore Robert Cartwright and senior Christian Sanders run the point for the Cardinal. Sanders, who has started all 11 games, ranks sixth in the Pac-12 with an average of 3.8 assists in 19.4 minutes per game. Cartwright, who is back on the court after missing all of last season with an arm injury, is averaging 2.6 assists in 22.8 minutes per contest.

PICKENS THE WORLD TRAVELER

The 2016 Pac-12 China Game was Dorian Pickens' third international basketball trip in a 15-month span. He has traveled more than 20,000 miles around the globe and spent more than 80 hours on an airplane during his international basketball adventures. In addition to the game in Shanghai, Pickens was selected to play on the Pac-12 All-Star Team that competed in two games against the Australian Olympic Team in Melbourne this past July. He also competed in all six games during Stanford's 2015 tour of Italy. He visited Rome, Florence, Venice and Como during the exhibition tour.

TRAVIS NAMED CAPTAIN

Junior Reid Travis was named the Cardinal's team captain at the beginning of the season. It was the first time in Jerod's Haase's five years as a head coach he has named a team captain.

STANFORD AND KANSAS AGREE ON FOUR-GAME SERIES

Stanford and Kansas have announced an agreement on a four-game series. In addition to the Dec. 3 game in Lawrence, Kansas, the Cardinal and Jayhawks will meet each of the next three seasons. The two teams will meet Dec. 21, 2017 at Golden 1 Center in Sacramento, before Stanford returns to Lawrence on Dec. 1, 2018, and hosts the Jayhawks at Maples Pavilion Dec. 29, 2019. Stanford Head Coach Jerod Haase was a standout guard for Jayhawks from 1995-97.

CARDINAL IN THE NBA

Four former Stanford standouts - Brook Lopez (Brooklyn Nets), Robin Lopez (Chicago Bulls), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks) and Josh Huestis (Oklahoma City Thunder) - are on NBA rosters. Brook Lopez leads the Nets in scoring (20.3 ppg) and ranks second in rebounding (5.4 rpg). Robin Lopez leads the Bulls in rebounding (7.5 rpg). Powell is among the Mavericks' scoring leaders at 7.3 ppg.

A pair of former Cardinal standouts are playing in the NBA Development League. Chasson Randle is averaging 22.3 ppg with the Westchester Knicks (New York Knicks affiliate) and Anthony Brown is averaging 26.0 ppg with the Erie BayHawks (Orlando Magic affiliate). Brown played nine games earlier this season with the New Orleans Pelicans, averaging 3.8 ppg in 15.8 mpg.

Huestis, currently on assignment from the Thunder, has played 10 games with OKC's NBADL affiliate, Oklahoma City Blue. He is averaging 12.1 ppg and 6.1 rpg with the Blue.

STANFORD PART OF STAR-STUDED 2017 PHIL KNIGHT INVITATIONAL

Stanford will compete in the 16-team PK80 - Phil Knight Invitational - over Thanksgiving week of 2017. The event, which will honor Nike co-founder and Stanford alumnus Phil Knight MBA '62 in advance of his 80th birthday, will be contested in Portland, Oregon. Stanford will be joined in the elite 16-team field by Arkansas, Butler, Connecticut, Duke, Florida, Georgetown, Gonzaga, Michigan State, North Carolina, Ohio State, Oklahoma, Oregon, Portland, Portland State and Texas. This highly-anticipated event will be one of the largest regular-season tournaments in college basketball history.

Jerod Haase was named Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball by Jaquish & Kenninger Director of Athletics Bernard Muir on March 25, 2016.

Haase, the 18th head coach in the history of the program, arrives on The Farm after four seasons as the head coach at UAB. He led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance in 2015. Haase improved the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in 2015-16, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25.

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen – all players recruited by Haase and his staff – and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game.

During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games.

Prior to arriving at UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003.

When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Calif., Haase attended California in 1992-93 before transferring to Kansas. He helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacque Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection.

Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase started 23 games in 1992-93 as a freshman at California, teaming with Jason Kidd in the backcourt.

Haase, 42, and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (10), Garrett (7) and Gabrielle (4).
