

EVANSTON, Ill. - Northwestern wanted to prove a point against No. 21 Stanford, and the Wildcats drove it home with a strong running game and solid defense that produced a season-opening surprise.

Northwestern Defeats Stanford

Freshman Clayton Thorson ran for a 42-yard touchdown while playing turnover-free ball at quarterback, Justin Jackson added 134 yards rushing, and the Wildcats beat the Cardinal 16-6.

If Northwestern felt like a caged bull, well, back-to-back 5-7 seasons will do that. The recent losing ended a five-year run of bowl appearances that included a 10-win season in 2012.

Anthony Walker broke up two passes and had a fumble recovery, and Kyle Queiro intercepted Kevin Hogan in the end zone with about a minute left to seal the win.

Thorson scored the game's only touchdown in the second quarter. He was steady overall, completing 12 of 24 passes for 105 yards, but was fortunate not to have any interceptions considering he threw a few into double and triple coverage.

Jackson rushed 28 times. Jack Mitchell kicked three field goals, including a career-long 49-yarder that made it 16-6 with 3:38 left in the game, and the Wildcats started the season on a winning note for the first time against a ranked team since 1995.

Hogan had a rough afternoon, going 20-of-35 with 155 yards and an interception. He was sacked three times.

Christian McCaffrey ran for 66 yards, but the Cardinal managed just 240 yards on offense and scored their fewest points since 2007.

The Cardinal showed some of the form that carried them to four straight seasons with at least 11 wins on the game's opening possession. But Northwestern tightened its defense, forcing Stanford to settle for a 29-yard field goal by Conrad Ukropina to finish a 12-play drive.

The Wildcats tied the game on a 31-yard field goal by Mitchell with 52 seconds left in the first quarter. Thorson, who starred at suburban Wheaton North High School about 40 miles from Ryan Field, made it 10-3 midway through the second when he took advantage of a big hole on the left and scored on a 42-yard keeper.

Northwestern had a chance to add to the lead after Walker recovered a fumble by McCaffrey a few plays later. The Wildcats took over on the Stanford 38, but a 48-yard field-goal attempt by Mitchell sailed wide left with 2:35 remaining in the half.

The Wildcats picked up their first win over the Cardinal since 1958.

Hogan Leads Stanford Past UCF

STANFORD, Calif. - It took a trick play to get Stanford's offense finally going this season. Afterward, it was as if the floodgates had opened.

Kevin Hogan connected on a 53-yard flea flicker to Michael Rector to highlight a three-touchdown night as Stanford bounced back from a disappointing loss in its season opener to beat UCF 31-7.

The deep strike to Rector was Stanford's first touchdown of the season. Hogan added a 7-yard touchdown pass to Christian McCaffrey and a 93-yarder to Bryce Love in the second half.

Hogan finished with 341 yards, including three passes of more than 40 yards.

The Knights struggled to generate any sort of offense with starting quarterback Justin Holman leaving early with an injury. Freshman Bo Schneider came in and went 7 for 19 for 46 yards with an interception.

After being held to six points in a lackluster opener, Stanford's offense finally broke through late in the first half with help from a trick play. Hogan handed the ball to Barry Sanders, who flipped it back to the quarterback. Hogan then launched a deep pass to Rector, who got past the defense for the first score of the game.

Conrad Ukropina added a 52-yard field goal in the final minute of the half.

Hogan's 42-yard pass to Love set up the short touchdown pass to McCaffrey in the third quarter. Hogan then hit Love again on a short pass on a third-and-20 and Love raced past the Knights defense for the score that made it 24-0.

While Hogan got the passing game going, the Cardinal struggled to run consistently for a second straight week. McCaffrey gained just 58 yards on 20 carries and the team finished with 130 yards on the ground with 40 coming on a late drive capped by Sanders' 20-yard touchdown run.

The defense was dominant, holding UCF off the scoreboard until Tyler Harris threw a 36-yard touchdown pass to Tre'Quan Smith with 1:22 to play.

The Cardinal easily handled the untested Schneider, who made his debut after Holman hurt his hand when he hit a helmet on UCF's first drive.

The Knights had just one productive drive until the late score but that ended in the second quarter when William Stanbeck fumbled inside the Cardinal 40. Four plays later, Hogan hit Rector on the flea-flicker.

Hogan Leads Steady Stanford

LOS ANGELES - In Stanford's pregame meeting, coach David Shaw asked every player who has played in two Pac-12 championship games to stand. Nearly half the room arose.

That big-game experience shined through repeatedly while the Cardinal revitalized their season with yet another major win at the Coliseum.

Kevin Hogan passed for 279 yards and two touchdowns, Remound Wright rushed for three more scores and Stanford opened Pac-12 play with a 41-31 victory over No. 6 USC.

Austin Hooper and Devon Cajuste caught touchdown passes as Hogan beat USC for the first time in his career, snapping the Trojans' two-game winning streak in the lively in-state rivalry.

Christian McCaffrey rushed for 115 yards for the Cardinal, who scored just six points in their stunning season-opening loss at Northwestern. They looked more like their usual powerhouse selves during a 474-yard offensive performance at the Coliseum.

Cody Kessler was 25-of-32 for 272 yards and three touchdowns, but USC couldn't match the steady production of Hogan, who went 18-for-23, and his dominant offensive line.

Steven Mitchell Jr. caught two touchdown passes and JuJu Smith-Schuster caught another, but preseason Pac-12 favorite USC failed its first test of the season after beating two Sun Belt opponents by a combined 99 points earlier this month.

After USC's impressive start, Stanford took a 24-21 halftime lead with two touchdowns in the final 3:53. Wright's third touchdown run put the Cardinal up 38-28 with 11:21 to play, and Conrad Ukropina hit a 46-yard field goal with 2:27 left, essentially sealing Stanford's sixth win over USC in their last nine meetings.

Stanford and USC began their football meetings in 1905, but the past several years of the rivalry have been particularly memorable.

Hogan didn't excel in either of his first two clashes with Kessler and USC, which largely relied on its defense to beat Stanford twice. Hogan and Kessler both were in elite form for this meeting, but Stanford's offensive line largely made the difference against USC's defense.

USC won the opening coin toss and ran the ball right at the Cardinal, going 76 yards on a methodical opening drive capped by Tre Madden's 5-yard touchdown run.

Hogan and his teammates quickly found the groove they missed in their first two games. The senior quarterback had plenty of time to pick apart USC's secondary for 221 yards passing in the first half, including Hooper's 16-yard touchdown catch late in the first half.

Smith-Schuster put the Trojans up 21-10 with a 54-yard catch-and-run touchdown in the second quarter, but Stanford scored twice in the final 3:53 of the first half. Cajuste put the Cardinal up 24-21 with 3 seconds left with a 17-yard touchdown catch when Adoree Jackson slipped and fell.

Jackson also had an early 97-yard kickoff return for a touchdown erased by a penalty.

Stanford Gets Pac-12 Road Win

CORVALLIS, Ore. - No. 21 Stanford cruised to a 42-24 victory over Oregon State. Kevin Hogan, a game-time decision, completed nine of 14 passes for 163 yards and two touchdowns.

Christian McCaffrey ran for a career-high 206 yards and ended up with 303 all-purpose yards for Stanford, which held just a 21-17 lead at the half over the Beavers before a pair of third-quarter

Oregon State true freshman Seth Collins hit Jordan Villamin with a 40-yard scoring pass to open the fourth quarter and the Beavers pulled within 35-24, but Stanford answered with Barry Sanders' 65-yard touchdown run and Oregon State couldn't catch up.

Collins passed for 275 yards and a touchdown, while rushing for another score. Villamin caught seven passes for 138 yards.

Sanders rushed for 97 yards and two scores for the Cardinal.

Oregon State first-year coach Gary Andersen said Stanford was the more physical team in the end.

Hogan was a question mark for the game after injuring his left ankle in the second half of an upset of then-No. 6 USC. He threw for 279 yards and two touchdowns in that one, gritting out a 41-31 win that put Stanford back in the rankings.

He deftly moved the Cardinal downfield on the opening series of the game against the Beavers. Remound Wright capped the drive with a 1-yard scoring run.

Collins answered for the Beavers with a 1-yard touchdown run after finding Victor Bolden in traffic with a 7-yard pass to get close.

After Hogan hit Austin Hooper with a 42-yard touchdown pass to make it 14-7, Collins again led Oregon State on a successful drive that ended with redshirt freshman Ryan Nall's 5-yard scoring run, the first touchdown of his career.

Stanford went up 21-14 in the second quarter on Wright's 2-yard scoring run. But Cardinal starting defensive end Aziz Shittu was injured before the half and had to be helped from the field.

Shittu's injury wasn't the only blow sustained by the Cardinal defensive line, as senior defensive end Brennan Scarlett also went down.

Garrett Owens made a 24-yard field goal for Oregon State just before halftime that cut the margin to 21-17.

Collins fumbled on the opening series of the second half and Stanford recovered on the Oregon State 9-yard line, but the Beavers' defense held and the Cardinal had to settle for a 28-yard field goal attempt- which missed wide left.

Stanford began to pull away midway through the third quarter when Hogan hit Michael Rector with a 49-yard touchdown pass that extended the lead to 28-17.

Sanders added an 11-yard scoring run for the Cardinal later in the quarter.

Kevin Anderson, Stanford's second-leading tackler, did not play because of an undisclosed injury. Teammates wrote his number on arm and elbow wraps.

Linebacker Joey Alfieri made his first career start against the Beavers. His dad, Phil, played defensive end at Oregon State from 1983-88.

It was Stanford's sixth straight victory over Oregon State.

Stanford Beats Arizona

STANFORD, Calif. - Christian McCaffrey ran for 156 yards and a touchdown, Remound Wright scored three times and No. 18 Stanford overwhelmed Arizona, 55-17.

Kevin Hogan threw for 217 yards and two touchdowns to help the Cardinal win its fourth straight after an opening loss to Northwestern. Hogan also moved into fifth place on Stanford's career passing yardage list.

Hogan played his second game on a sore left ankle, an injury that kept him in the pocket most of the night.

Barry Sanders added a 65-yard touchdown run for Stanford, which has scored 40 or more points in three straight games for the first time in 14 years. The Cardinal have scored at least 37 points in five straight against the Wildcats.

Jerrard Randall passed for 178 yards and a touchdown and rushed for another 67 yards for Arizona. The Wildcats were coming off a 56-30 home loss to UCLA.

Nick Wilson, who entered the game as the conference's leading rusher, was held to 46 yards, though he had a touchdown.

Stanford's brute force along the offensive line and McCaffrey's nimbleness, proved too much for the Wildcats, who were without All-America linebacker Scooby Wright. The Cardinal gained 314 yards on the ground and 570 in total offense.

McCaffrey, who rushed for a career-high 206 yards and ended up with 303 all-purpose yards one game earlier at Oregon State, became the first Stanford runner to have three consecutive 100-plus yards in more than two years.

Hogan completed 17 of 19 passes, including scoring tosses of 16 yards to Wright and 18 yards to Michael Rector. Conrad Okropina connected on a pair of field goals. Backup Keller Chryst completed all four of his passes, including his first career touchdown strike, a 6-yarder to Rollins Stallworth.

Arizona starting quarterback Anu Solomon did not make the trip after sustaining a concussion against UCLA. Randall opened the game in Solomon's absence and never got untracked in the first half, leading the Wildcats on one scoring drive, a 26-yard field goal by Casey Skowron.

Brandon Dawkins took over in the fourth quarter without much success and the Wildcats dropped their fourth straight to Stanford and 10th in 13 overall.

Randall guided the Wildcats on an eight-play, 75-yard drive to open the second half. Arizona faced a second-and-25 play early in the drive, but Randall completed a 21-yard pass to Johnny Jackson and ran for another 28 to help set up his 15-yard scoring toss to Jackson.

McCaffrey, the son of former NFL star Ed McCaffrey, returned the ensuing kickoff 67 yards and Stanford's scoring spree continued.

McCaffrey Sets Rushing Record

STANFORD, Calif. - One jaw-dropping catch by Francis Owusu nearly overshadowed a recordsetting performance from Christian McCaffrey.

Owusu pinned the ball on the back of a defender in the end zone for one of the most memorable catches in recent memory and McCaffrey did most of the rest with a school-record 243 yards rushing and four touchdowns in No. 15 Stanford's 56-35 victory over No. 18 UCLA.

McCaffrey scored on a 70-yard run out of the wildcat, returned a kick 96 yards to set up another score and ran for three more touchdowns in a virtuoso performance that broke Toby Gerhart's school record of 223 yards rushing in a game set in 2009.

McCaffrey finished with 369 all-purpose yards as the Cardinal beat the Bruins for the eighth straight time.

For all the accolades McCaffrey earned in this game, the lasting memory was provided by Owusu on his 41-yard touchdown catch.

It started with McCaffrey taking a direct snap in the wildcat and handing to Bryce Love on a jet sweep. Love then flipped the ball to quarterback Kevin Hogan, who had lined up as a receiver on the play. Hogan set himself in the backfield and threw deep to Owusu.

Despite being interfered with by a face-guarding Jaleel Wadood in the end zone, Owusu still managed to trap the ball against Wadood's back while not even being able to see it. Owusu managed to keep his hand on the ball to maintain control as the two fell to the ground.

Shaw had already assumed it would be incomplete and was looking at his chart for the next play when he was told Owusu made the catch. The usually stoic Shaw then cracked a smile on the sideline

Hogan threw for 131 yards and three touchdowns on eight completions and McCaffrey took over the national lead in all-purpose yards.

Josh Rosen threw for 325 yards and three touchdowns. Paul Perkins ran for 104 and a score, but the Bruins still dropped their second straight contest to fall further back in the Pac-12 South race.

Stanford maintained its dominance in this series with its most overwhelming performance in decades. The Cardinal have outscored the Bruins 277-131 during the current streak and had its highest-scoring game against the Bruins since a 57-0 win in 1929.

The Bruins' injury-depleted defense had no answer for the power running and trick plays from Stanford's offense. The Bruins have lost star linebacker Myles Jack and three other defensive starters to season-ending injuries, and the absences showed against the Cardinal.

The offenses had their way for most of the first half, but Stanford went into the break with a 35-17 lead thanks to a 31-yard interception return for a touchdown by Alijah Holder that opened the scoring, a 96-yard kickoff return for McCaffrey that set up another score and two more touchdown runs by McCaffrey.

UCLA receiver Kenneth Walker was ejected late in the first half for a targeting penalty on a block on Stanford linebacker Blake Martinez.

Cardinal Gets Sixth Straight Win

STANFORD, Calif. - Christian McCaffrey caught a touchdown pass, ran for another score and gained 300 all-purpose yards in another sterling all-around performance to lead No. 10 Stanford to its sixth straight victory, 31-14, over Washington.

Kevin Hogan threw for 290 yards and two scores for the Cardinal.

McCaffrey, who entered the game with an FBS-best 253 all-purpose yards per game, had a 50-yard touchdown catch and 7-yard scoring run in the third quarter. In all, he ran 23 times for 109 yards, caught five passes for a career-high 112 yards and added 79 yards on kick returns in his third 300-yard all-purpose game of the season.

The Huskies were no match for the Cardinal, especially with starting quarterback Jake Browning watching after he appeared to hurt his right shoulder late in last week's loss to Oregon. Backup K.J. Carta-Samuels completed just 9 of 21 passes for 118 yards as Washington didn't even cross midfield until the third quarter.

Huskies freshman running back Myles Gaskin ran for 108 yards and a score for his third straight 100-yard game. Gaskin ran five times for 57 yards on the opening drive of the third quarter to cut Stanford's lead to 17-7.

McCaffrey took over from there. He sneaked out of the backfield on the next drive and hauled in a deep pass from Hogan before outrunning the defense for the touchdown.

McCaffrey then iced the game with his touchdown run to cap the next drive, making it 31-7. McCaffrey became the first Stanford player to top 100 yards receiving and rushing in the same game since Glyn Milburn did it in 1991 against Oregon State.

The matchup between the Pac-12's top offense and top defense was one-sided from the start. Stanford took the opening kickoff and drove 62 yards in six plays for the score on Hogan's 21-yard pass to Austin Hooper.

The Huskies struggled to move the ball in Carta-Samuels' his first career start. He entered with three career pass attempts, was frequently off-target and could not even make the easy completions. The Huskies had just two first downs and 58 yards in the first half and never stood a chance.

The Cardinal methodically moved the ball downfield on their third drive, going 90 yards on 15 plays capped by Remound Wright's 1-yard dive.

A late 28-yard field goal by Conrad Ukropina made it 17-0 at the break.

Ukropina's Field Goal Lifts Stanford

PULLMAN, Wash. - Washington State kicker Erik Powell missed wide right on a 43-yard field goal as time expired, allowing Stanford to escape with a 30-28 win on a day Powell tied Drew Dunning's 2003 school record with five makes despite rainy, windy conditions.

Conrad Ukropina kicked a 19-yard field goal with 1:54 left to put Stanford ahead.

Kevin Hogan ran for 112 yards and two touchdowns for Stanford to help keep the Cardinal undefeated in Pac-12 play.

Hogan completed just 10 of 19 passes for 86 yards. But he ran 14 times, including a 59-yard touchdown run, and even out-rushed teammate Christian McCaffrey, who finished with 107 yards rushing to go over 1,000 for the season.

Washington State had a three-game winning streak snapped.

Stanford punted while trailing 28-27 with 5:08 left, but got the ball back on Quenton Meeks' second interception of the game with 3:27 remaining. That set up Ukropina's field goal.

Stanford scored first on Ukropina's 32-yard field goal, but then Powell hit four straight kicks -- including makes from 46 and 47 yards -- to put Washington State up 12-3 at halftime.

The Cougars opened the second half by driving to the Stanford 11, but two incomplete passes killed the drive and Powell kicked a 28-yard field goal for a 15-3 lead.

Stanford replied with the game's first touchdown on Remound Wright's 2-yard dive. The score was set up by Hogan's 39-yard bootleg scramble.

Washington State came right back with a 75-yard drive in four plays, the final a 19-yard touchdown pass from Luke Falk to Marks for a 22-10 lead.

Ukropina kicked a 32-yard field goal late in the third, then Hogan's 59-yard touchdown run cut the Washington State lead to 22-20.

On the next series, Meeks intercepted Falk, giving Stanford the ball on Washington State's 17. Hogan ran 6 yards untouched up the middle to give Stanford a 27-22 lead in the opening seconds of the fourth.

Washington State came back with an 81-yard drive that ended with Falk hitting River Cracraft for a 1-yard touchdown pass. Falk's conversion pass failed and the Cougars led 28-27.

After Ukropina's kick, Washington State marched to the Stanford 29 and Powell hooked his attempt wide.

Falk completed 35 of 61 passes for 354 yards and two touchdowns, along with two interceptions.

Washington State gained 442 yards of offense in the game, to 312 for Stanford.

McCaffrey Leads Cardinal Past Colorado

BOULDER, Colo. - Christian McCaffrey posted 220 all-purpose yards and threw a touchdown pass on a trick play in Stanford's 42-10 rout of Colorado.

McCaffrey's 28-yard touchdown toss to tight end Austin Hooper was the highlight of his homecoming in front of family and friends who drove up from nearby Denver, where he starred at Valor Christian High School and where his father, Ed, starred for the Broncos in the 1990s.

McCaffrey's touchdown toss came on the first play of the fourth quarter and was his last play of the game.

Kevin Hogan surpassed Andrew Luck as the school's winningest quarterback with his 32nd victory.

Before his beautiful spiral into the end zone, McCaffrey chipped in 220 all-purpose yards.

His day might have been even better, but a 13-yard touchdown on Stanford's opening drive was overturned upon review when he was ruled down a foot shy of the goal line.

Hogan threw two touchdown passes and ran for another as the Cardinal bounced back from a scare at Washington State in which they escaped with a two-point win on a shanked field goal as time expired.

After answering Stanford's touchdown on its opening drive with one of their own, the Buffs gave up three consecutive touchdowns, including Hogan's 1-yard run with 2 seconds left in the second quarter, and trudged to the locker room trailing 28-7 at halftime.

The Buffaloes, who have lost 21 consecutive games to ranked teams, kicked a short field goal on their opening drive in the second half, then tried an on-side kick. Only, Rollins Stallworth, whom the Buffs expected to turn and run downfield as he'd been doing, instead stayed put and recovered the ball at the Colorado 47.

Freshman running back Bryce Love scored on the next play to make it 35-10.

Tedric Thompson's 71-yard interception return gave the Buffaloes some hope and their offense the ball at the Stanford 3. But again they were stuffed and on fourth down they went for it. But Liufau threw incomplete.

The Cardinal offense responded to the defensive stop with a 13-play, 95-yard drive that McCaffrey capped with his touchdown toss eight seconds into the fourth quarter.

Oregon Upends Stanford

STANFORD, Calif. - Vernon Adams Jr. had Oregon's big-play offense clicking. Stanford was able to grind it out behind Kevin Hogan and Christian McCaffrey.

When it came down to it, two botched snaps and a failed two-point conversion spoiled the Cardinal's playoff hopes and kept the Ducks alive in the Pac-12 race.

Adams threw for 205 yards and two touchdowns and Oregon used its quick-strike offense and the late two-point stop to beat Stanford, 38-36.

In a game dominated by offenses that combined for more than 900 yards, it was a defensive stop on the two-point attempt with 10 seconds left that sealed the win for Oregon and kept the Ducks' hopes for a conference title alive.

After Hogan lost two fumbles on snaps in the fourth quarter, Stanford tied it on Hogan's 4-yard touchdown pass to Greg Taboada. Needing a two-point conversion to tie it, Hogan tried to find tight end Austin Hooper over the middle against the blitz. But linebacker Joe Walker got a finger on the ball and the Ducks held on for the win.

Royce Freeman ran for 105 yards and a score and Charles Nelson scored on a 75-yard run on one of the Ducks' three touchdowns of more than 45 yards.

Hogan lost one fumble near midfield midway through the fourth quarter with the Cardinal down five. After Oregon kicked a field goal to make it 38-30, Stanford drove inside the 20 before Hogan lost another snap with 2:06 to play.

Stanford still had a chance to tie it but missed on the 2-point attempt.

Hogan threw for 304 yards and two touchdowns and ran for another score. McCaffrey set a Stanford record with his eighth straight 100-yard rushing game, running for 147 yards and a touchdown.

The Ducks gained 436 yards on 48 plays, averaging 9.1 yards per play.

Trailing 23-21 at the half, the Ducks took control in the third quarter. They took the opening kick and easily drove down to score on Freeman's 19-yard run.

The Ducks then stopped Hogan for 1 yard on a third-and-3 and Conrad Ukropina missed a 43-yard field goal attempt.

The teams then traded three-and-outs before Oregon struck with another big play when Adams found Taj Griffin open down the sideline for a 49-yard touchdown catch that made it 35-23.

Hogan's two touchdown passes to Taboada helped Stanford nearly overcome the deficit but the Cardinal fell short.

The contrast in styles between grind-it-out Stanford and fast-break Oregon was stark as Stanford took a 23-21 halftime lead.

The Cardinal got touchdown runs from Hogan and McCaffrey and powered their way to 276 yards on 43 plays in 21:32 of possession.

The Ducks relied on the big plays with Nelson scoring on a 75-yard run and Adams hitting Darren Carrington on a 47-yard pass in the final minute to gain 268 yards on 23 plays in 8:28.

STANFORD, Calif. - Christian McCaffrey ran around and through the Cal defense on a 49-yard touchdown catch and also scored on a 98-yard kickoff return to help Stanford clinch a spot in the Pac-12 Championship Game by winning the Big Game, 35-22.

The Axe Stays With Stanford

McCaffrey ran for 192 yards and gained a school-record 389 all-purpose yards in another highlight-reel performance that gave the Cardinal its sixth straight win over the Golden Bears.

Remound Wright ran for two short touchdowns and Bryce Love added a 48-yard scoring run for Stanford, which clinched the Pac-12 North with the win.

Jared Goff threw for 386 yards and two touchdowns but the Bears settled for field goals three times in the red zone and fell short once again against their fiercest rival.

McCaffrey broke Glyn Milburn's Stanford all-purpose record of 379 yards set in the 1990 Big Game.

McCaffrey posted a school-record nine straight 100-yard rushing game while topping 300 all-purpose yards for the fourth time on the season.

Cal dominated the third quarter with two scoring drives and finally got into the end zone when Goff hit Darius Powe on a 3-yard pass that cut Stanford's lead to 21-16.

But the Cardinal responded after Cal gave them good field position with a short kickoff that kept the ball out of McCaffrey's hands. McCaffrey ran for 44 of the 61 yards on the touchdown drive that was capped by a 1-yard run by Wright, who has six touchdowns in the past two Big Games.

After Stanford stopped Cal on a fourth down, Love iced the game with his long run and ensured that the Cardinal would retain the coveted Axe for another year.

The game was especially meaningful to graduate transfer defensive lineman Brennan Scarlett, who spent his first four years at Cal before finishing his career with the Cardinal.

Cal moved the ball well for much of the game but three times settled for field goals by Matt Anderson after getting inside the 20.

McCaffrey made the Bears pay by beating them with big plays.

On the first, he caught a screen pass from Kevin Hogan and broke a tackle behind the line. He broke more tackles while weaving his way through the overmatched Cal defense to give Stanford a 14-3 lead.

The Bears then cut the lead with a field goal with 51 seconds left but were unable to carry that good feeling into the half when McCaffrey ran back the ensuing kick untouched for another score.

Captain Clutch

STANFORD, Calif. - Kevin Hogan threw four touchdown passes and drove the 13th-ranked Cardinal to the winning 45-yard field goal by Conrad Ukropina on the last play of a 38-36 victory over No. 4 Notre Dame.

Hogan threw for 269 yards and calmly led the winning drive in the final 30 seconds for the

DeShone Kizer had given the Irish a one-point lead on his 2-yard run with 30 seconds left only to see Hogan drive Stanford to the winning score.

The drive was aided by a facemask penalty on Isaac Rochell on the first play and then Hogan connected on a 27-yard pass to Devon Cajuste to get Stanford in field goal range. After a short run by Christian McCaffrey, Ukropina came on and drilled the field goal setting off a wild celebration with the fans rushing the field.

McCaffrey gained 228 all-purpose yards to become the third FBS player top 3,000 in a season, but was held to 94 on the ground to have a nine-game streak of 100-yard games snapped.

Kizer threw for 234 yards and ran for 128 more for the Irish. Josh Adams added 168 on the ground but it wasn't enough. Notre Dame now awaits its bowl bid, but the Irish's hopes of making the playoff are gone after being dealt their second loss.

The game was a contrast in styles with Notre Dame thriving on big-play scores with Stanford moving the ball efficiently down the field and dominating on both sides of the ball in the red zone.

The Irish were held to field goals on their first three trips inside the 20, costing them a chance to build a substantial lead. Notre Dame was actually more potent from farther away from the end zone, getting three touchdowns of more than 60 yards on the game.

The Cardinal turned all five of their red zone trips into touchdowns with Hogan throwing for four and Remound Wright running in one. Hogan's 10-yard pass to Austin Hooper on the opening play of the fourth quarter put Stanford up 35-29.

Notre Dame had taken the lead the previous possession when Adams burst through the line for a 62-yard touchdown run as the offenses dominated.

The defenses then combined to force four straight punts before the two late scoring drives.

Notre Dame lived by the big play in an odd first half that saw Stanford run the first 23 plays from scrimmage in the game. The Cardinal drove 75 and 78 yards the first two times they had ball, leading to touchdown passes from Hogan to Remound Wright and Devon Cajuste.

In between, C.J. Sanders returned a kickoff 93 yards for a touchdown. The Irish then took the lead late in the half when Fuller got behind the defense for a 73-yard touchdown catch that made it 20-14.

The Cardinal then easily moved the ball down the field for Hogan's third touchdown pass with 48 seconds left to Rector to make it 21-20 at the break.

Kizer lost a fumble in the closing seconds one play after his 48-yard scramble put the Irish in the field goal position.

Pac-12 Champions

SANTA CLARA, Calif. - Run, pass and catch. Christian McCaffrey did it all in a record-setting performance as Stanford advanced to a third Rose Bowl in four years.

McCaffrey ran for 207 yards and a score, threw a touchdown pass, caught another and broke Barry Sanders' single-season all-purpose yards record to lead Stanford to the Pac-12 title with a 41-22 win over Southern California.

Kevin Hogan caught the touchdown pass from McCaffrey, threw one and ran for a third and Solomon Thomas scored on a 34-yard fumble return for the Cardinal.

Cody Kessler threw for 187 yards and a touchdown and ran for another score for the Trojans, who lost in their first game since removing the interim tag from coach Clay Helton.

Stanford took control of the game with a pair of touchdowns in a span of just over three minutes late in the third quarter. After blowing an early 13-point lead, the Cardinal faced a third-down in their own territory. Hogan then found McCaffrey open in the middle of the field and he ran with for a 67-yard reception down to the USC 7. Hogan ran it in on the next play to put Stanford back on top.

Blake Martinez then sacked Kessler and caused a fumble on the next possession that Thomas scooped up and ran in for the score that made it 27-16.

After USC scored to make it a one-possession game, McCaffrey put the capper on another Stanford win with a 27-yard touchdown reception when he was left wide open in the middle of the field.

McCaffrey added 105 yards receiving and 149 return yards to give him a Stanford record 461 allpurpose yards for the game and 3,496 for the season. That broke Sanders' single-season record of 3,250 yards set in 1988, although McCaffrey took two extra games to do it.

After being thoroughly outplayed for the first 25 minutes, the Trojans got right back into the game with three straight scoring drives. Kessler led a 15-play drive in the closing minutes of the half to lead to a 40-yard field goal by Alex Wood that cut Stanford's lead to 13-3.

Kessler then threw a 1-yard touchdown pass to Jahleel Pinner to open the third quarter to cut it to 13-9 and Ronald Jones II scored on a 27-yard run on the next possession to give the Trojans their first lead at 16-13.

The Cardinal dominated the game early but led only 13-0 because of problems converting in the red zone. Stanford held a 210-9 advantage in yards gained but was unable to break the game open.

A holding penalty on Rollins Stallworth negated a touchdown on the first drive, forcing Stanford to settle for a field goal. Stanford later was stopped at the 1-yard line, leading to another short field goal by Conrad Ukropina and Hogan got sacked on a fourth down from the 1.

The only touchdown in the first half came on McCaffrey's trick play. Hogan pitched to Barry Sanders, who then flipped it to McCaffrey, who had lined up as a receiver. McCaffrey then threw to a wide-open Hogan for his second touchdown pass of the season.

Rose Bowl Romp

PASADENA, Calif. - The first time Christian McCaffrey touched the ball in the 102nd Rose Bowl, he took it 75 yards for a spectacular touchdown. A few hundred yards later, Stanford's star had smashed the oldest bowl game's record for all-purpose yards while leading the Cardinal to a blowout win over lowa.

McCaffrey caught a touchdown pass on the opening snap and returned a punt 66 yards for another score while racking up 368 all-purpose yards, propelling No. 5 Stanford to a 45-16 victory over the sixth-ranked Hawkeyes.

McCaffrey was sublime in his Rose Bowl debut, breaking the all-purpose yards record set by Wisconsin's Jared Abbrederis in 2012. The speedy running back turned in one of the most dynamic performances in the Rose Bowl's lengthy history.

The world was wide awake to see McCaffrey in Pasadena -- and he scored 11 seconds in. Hogan's throw to McCaffrey was the second-longest touchdown pass in Rose Bowl history and the longest play given up all season by the stingy lowa defense.

McCaffrey finished with 172 yards rushing, 105 yards receiving and 91 on kick returns, putting an appropriate cap on the season in which he set the NCAA record for all-purpose yards. He also became the first player ever to rack up more than 100 yards rushing and 100 yards receiving in a Rose Bowl -- and he even became the single-season rushing leader in Stanford history with 2,109 yards on the ground.

With a powerful offensive line and a sturdy defense, Stanford ruined the first Rose Bowl in 25 years for the Hawkeyes, who followed up their remarkable 12-0 regular season with two postseason losses

C.J. Beathard passed for 239 yards and two fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Hawkeyes, whose thousands of fans proudly filled the venerable stadium with old gold and black. The faithful had painfully little to cheer after lowa fell behind on the first snap, putting a daylong damper on Kirk Ferentz's first Rose Bowl after 17 years as a head coach.

The Cardinal had the highest-scoring first quarter and first half in the Rose Bowl's lengthy history. After McCaffrey's opening touchdown, Hogan rushed for an 8-yard score and Quenton Meeks returned an interception 66 yards for another touchdown in the first 11 minutes.

Iowa had never trailed by more than seven points at any point in its magical season, which included the first 12-0 start in school history before a narrow loss to Michigan State in the Big Ten title game. But the rout was really on after McCaffrey made his 63-yard touchdown return in the opening minute of the second, juking Iowa linebacker Josey Jewell on the way.

Stanford even got creative -- or cruel, depending on your perspective. Hogan appeared to fake a fumbled handoff to McCaffrey in the second quarter before popping up and throwing to an untouched Michael Rector for a 31-yard score, making it 35-0 at halftime.
