CARDINAL HEADS SOUTH FOR THURSDAY BATTLE WITH TROJANS IN LA

After not making the trip to Los Angeles to play USC for the first time in 59 years last year due to Pac-12 scheduling, the Cardinal will head south to face the No. 25 Trojans Thursday at the Galen Center. Prior to last season, the last time Stanford did not face USC in Los Angeles was during the 1956-57 season.

The Cardinal, 8-6 overall and 0-2 in the Pac-12, will face a USC team that is coming off its first loss of the year. The Trojans are 14-1 overall and 1-1 in the league following Sunday's 84-61 defeat to No. 21 Oregon. Stanford, 84-64 winners at Maples Pavilion last season, has won five straight against USC, its longest winning streak over the Trojans since the early 1990s.

THREE CONSECUTIVE RANKED FOES FOR FIRST TIME IN 15 YEARS

Stanford's current stretch of games has the Cardinal facing three consecutive teams ranked in the Associated Press national poll. The Cardinal, who opened the stretch with a loss to No. 18 Arizona on Sunday, will face No. 25 USC on Thursday and No. 4 UCLA on Sunday in Los Angeles. It is the first time Stanford will play nationally-ranked teams in three consecutive games since the 2001-02 season, when ironically the Cardinal faced the same three teams. Stanford lost to No. 20 USC and No. 25 UCLA at home, before winning at No. 14 Arizona.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

In its first 14 games, Stanford played six teams that are projected to be in the 2017 NCAA Tournament field, according to ESPN's Joe Lunardi. All six of those teams - Kansas (5), Saint Mary's (22), Arizona (27), Miami (31), Seton Hall (35) and SMU (47) - also rank among ESPN analyst Jay Bilas' list of "Top 68 Teams In The Land." The Cardinal played only two of these teams (Arizona and Saint Mary's) at home. Stanford's strength of schedule as of Jan. 3 ranks 12th nationally.

STANFORD AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Stanford is 0-3 against nationally-ranked opponents in the Associated Press poll this season and 48-56 against ranked foes since 2000. Thursday marks the Cardinal's second time this season playing back-to-back nationally-ranked opponents, with setbacks to No. 12 Saint Mary's (66-51) and No. 4 Kansas (89-74) in consecutive games earlier this year. Thursday's game at No. 25 USC comes after this past Sunday's meeting with No. 18 Arizona.

JEROD HAASE AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Head Coach Jerod Haase owns a 2-11 all-time record against nationally-ranked teams. He played 10 ranked foes as the head coach at UAB, leading the Blazers to a win over No. 9/10 Iowa State (60-59) in the second round of the NCAA Tournament on March 19, 2015 in Louisville, and a victory over No. 16/16 North Carolina (63-59) in Birmingham, on Dec. 1, 2013.

AGAINST USC

Thursday marks the 249th all-time meeting between Stanford and USC. The Cardinal has won the last five games between the two teams and holds a 125-123 edge in the all-time series. The current Cardinal roster is undefeated against the Trojans in Los Angeles. Dorian Pickens had 25 points in Stanford's loan meeting with USC last season on The Farm.

TRAVIS AMONG RARE COMPANY

Reid Travis is one of five individuals in the top six conferences (Pac-12, Big 12, Big Ten, ACC, SEC and BIG EAST) to rank in the top five of his league in scoring and rebounding. (*as of Jan. 3*)

TRAVIS' IMPACT

After missing the final 22 games last season, Reid Travis has made a strong impact in his return this year. He has posted six of his seven career double-doubles in the first 14 games of this season.

TRAVIS FROM THE LINE

Reid Travis ranks fourth in the nation in free throws attempted (116) and 20th in the country in free throws made (79) as of Jan. 3. At Kansas on Dec. 3, he set Stanford single-game records for free throws made (19) and attempted (22), while also breaking the same free throw marks by a Kansas opponent. While Travis is getting to the charity stripe much more, his free throw percentage has also improved from last year.

SHEFFIELD'S CAREER NIGHT AGAINST ARIZONA STATE

Sophomore Marcus Sheffield poured in a career-high 35 points on 11-of-15 shooting against Arizona State. He was just the second underclassman in the history of the program (Ron Tomsic, 39 vs. Bradley and 38 vs. USC in 1952-53) to score 35 or more points in a game. Sheffield was the first Cardinal to record a 30-point game since Chasson Randle collected 35 against Rhode Island in the 2014-15 season.

PICKENS ON TARGET FROM BEYOND THE ARC

Junior Dorian Pickens has posted at least one three-pointer in 12 games, with multiple three-pointers in seven contests. He is shooting 41.5 percent from three-point range (13th in Pac-12), with a team-best 27 three-pointers. He registered a career-high seven (7-of-10) against Idaho. Pickens connected on the game-winning trifecta against Indiana State with 2.0 seconds left.

PICKENS NAMED TO ADVOCARE INVITE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

After averaging 18.3 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.3 steals in three games in the Advocare Invitational, Dorian Pickens was named to the five-member all-tournament team at the conclusion of the event.

FLOOR BURNS STAT COMES TO THE FARM

During his standout collegiate career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court, diving for loose balls and taking charges, whatever he could do to help his team win. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" stat was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program today. Haase totaled 167 in the 1996-97 season. This season, Stanford is tracking floor burns as an official stat throughout the year.

THE JUNIOR CLASS

Stanford's four-member junior class - Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens, Michael Humphrey and Robert Cartwright - has accounted for 63.1 percent (610-of-967) of the scoring this season. Travis (17.5 ppg), Pickens (13.2 ppg), Humphrey (7.5 ppg) and Cartwright (5.9 ppg) rank one, two, four and five, respectively, among Stanford's scoring leaders. Cartwright is listed as a sophomore after receiving a medical redshirt for the 2015-16 season.

CARTWRIGHT, SANDERS RUNNING POINT

The duo of sophomore Robert Cartwright and senior Christian Sanders run the point for the Cardinal. Sanders, who started the first 11 games, ranks eighth in the Pac-12 with an average of 3.9 assists in 18.6 minutes per game. Cartwright, who missed all of last season with an arm injury, has started Stanford's last three contests. He is averaging 5.9 points and 2.9 assists in 23.5 minutes per contest.

VETERAN GROUP

Boasting one of the most experienced rosters in the Pac-12, four starters - Reid Travis, Michael Humphrey, Marcus Allen, and Christian Sanders - and 10 of the top 11 scorers from last season are back. Including the first 16 games of this season, Stanford's roster has combined for 753 appearances.

VERHOEVEN AN IMPACT IN THE PAINT

Senior Grant Verhoeven, averaging 4.8 points in 13.6 minutes per game this season, was inserted into the starting lineup five games ago. His defensive presence has been key for the Cardinal, drawing several charges. In the win over Seton Hall, he drew five charges and caused six turnovers.

PICKENS THE WORLD TRAVELER

The 2016 Pac-12 China Game was Dorian Pickens' third international basketball trip in a 15-month span. He has traveled more than 20,000 miles around the globe and spent more than 80 hours on an airplane during his international basketball adventures. In addition to the game in Shanghai, Pickens was selected to play on the Pac-12 All-Star Team that competed in two games against the Australian Olympic Team in Melbourne this past July. He also competed in all six games during Stanford's 2015 tour of Italy. He visited Rome, Florence, Venice and Como during the exhibition tour.

TRAVIS NAMED CAPTAIN

Junior Reid Travis was named the Cardinal's team captain at the beginning of the season. It was the first time in Jerod's Haase's five years as a head coach he has named a team captain.

CARDINAL IN THE NBA

Four former Stanford standouts - Brook Lopez (Brooklyn Nets), Robin Lopez (Chicago Bulls), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks) and Josh Huestis (Oklahoma City Thunder) - are on NBA rosters. Brook Lopez leads the Nets in scoring (20.3 ppg) and ranks second in rebounding (5.3 rpg). Robin Lopez leads the Bulls in rebounding (7.3 rpg). Powell is among the Mavericks' scoring leaders at 7.8 ppg. Huestis, currently on assignment from the Thunder, has played 12 games with OKC's NBADL affiliate, Oklahoma City Blue. He is averaging 11.5 ppg and 5.7 rpg with the Blue.

HAASE TIES LEAD TO FUTURE GAMES WITH KANSAS AND NORTH CAROLINA

Stanford has agreed to play both Kansas and North Carolina over the next several years. The Cardinal began a four-game series with Kansas this season and will play North Carolina each of the next two seasons. Stanford and Kansas will play Dec. 21, 2017 at Golden 1 Center in Sacramento, before the Cardinal returns to Lawrence on Dec. 1, 2018, and hosts the Jayhawks at Maples Pavilion Dec. 29, 2019. Jerod Haase was a standout guard for Jayhawks from 1995-97. Stanford will host the Tar Heels on Monday, Nov. 20, 2017 at Maples Pavilion. The second game in the series will be played in Chapel Hill, North Carolina, on Monday, Nov. 12, 2018. After playing three seasons for head coach Roy Williams at Kansas, Haase spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels.

THE 25,000-MILE SEASON-OPENING JOURNEY

The Cardinal completed a whirlwind 25,000-mile journey across the globe during its first 11 games. The 2016-17 campaign opened in Shanghai, China on Nov. 11. Following its trip to China, Stanford played games in Orlando, Florida, Lawrence, Kansas and Dallas Texas. The four trips, which included six games, totaled 25,598 miles and more than 56 hours on an airplane.

Jerod Haase was named Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball by Jaquish & Keninger Director of Athletics Bernard Muir on March 25, 2016.

Haase, the 18th head coach in the history of the program, arrives on The Farm after four seasons as the head coach at UAB. He led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance in 2015. Haase improved the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-7 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in 2015-16, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25.

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen – all players recruited by Haase and his staff – and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game.

During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games.

Prior to arriving at UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003.

When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Calif., Haase attended California in 1992-93 before transferring to Kansas. He helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacque Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection.

Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase started 23 games in 1992-93 as a freshman at California, teaming with Jason Kidd in the backcourt.

Haase, 42, and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (10), Garrett (7) and Gabrielle (4).
