### BATTLE OF THE BAY

Stanford and California will add a new chapter to the rivalry when the Bay Area schools meet Friday at 7 p.m. PT at Maples Pavilion in a game broadcast on FS1 and KNBR 1050 AM. The Cardinal has won six of the past nine in the series, including the last two played on The Farm.

### AGAINST CAL

California leads the all-time series, 146-120. The Cardinal dropped a 66-55 decision to the Golden Bears in Berkeley on Jan. 29. In the most recent contest played at Stanford, the Cardinal earned a 77-71 win on Jan. 14, 2016. Stanford owns a 66-62 all-time record against Cal at home and has won 20 of the last 23 games against the Bears on The Farm. Senior Grant Verhoeven is the lone Cardinal to have played in a loss to Cal at Maples Pavilion (Jan. 2, 2014).

### R2T2 IS ONE OF THE PAC-12'S BEST

Reid Travis "R2T2" is among the conference leaders in many categories. The Cardinal junior forward, who missed four games in a six-game span in the month of January, returned to the court five games ago. In those five games vs. Cal, Colorado, Utah, Arizona and Arizona State, he is averaging 19.4 ppg and 6.5 rpg. He has posted double-doubles in each of the last two games (26 pts., 11 rebs. at Arizona, 17 pts., 11 rebs at ASU).

Travis is the only Pac-12 player to rank in the top-six in the league in scoring and rebounding.

## EARLIER THIS SEASON AGAINST CAL

Three Cardinal scored in double digits as Stanford's second-half rally fell short in a 66-55 defeat to California at Haas Pavilion on Jan. 29. Reid Travis scored 12 of his team-high 17 points in the second half, while Michael Humphrey added 10 points and nine rebounds and Robert Cartwright finished with 11 points against the Bears.

## THE PAC-12 STANDINGS

Stanford entered the week tied with Washington State for ninth in the Pac-12 standings with five games remaining in the regular season. Four of those five contests are against teams ahead of them in the standings in Oregon (second), California (fourth), Utah (sixth) and Colorado (seventh). The Cardinal (4-9) is a game behind both Colorado and Arizona State in the standings.

## GETTING DEFENSIVE

Stanford has forced 70 turnovers over its last four games against Colorado (23), Utah (17), Arizona (13) and Arizona State (17). Led by senior Marcus Allen's nine steals, the Cardinal has recorded 36 steals in the four contests. The 40 combined forced turnovers against Colorado and Utah was the most in a two-game stretch in conference play in more than 12 years, since Stanford forced 41 combined miscues against USC (21 turnovers - Jan. 22, 2005) and UCLA (20 turnovers - Jan. 20, 2005). Stanford ranks second in the Pac-12 in steals (6.6 spg).

## STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Stanford has played the fourth toughest schedule in the nation, according to ESPN's daily strength of schedule rankings as of Feb. 15. The Cardinal has played seven games against teams in the top-25 of the RPI as of Feb. 15. Stanford checks in at No. 75 in the latest edition of the NCAA's RPI. Look no further than a daunting nonconference slate that featured the likes of Miami, Seton Hall, No. 12/13 Saint Mary's, No. 4/5 Kansas and SMU. Earlier in conference play, Stanford also faced No. 18/18 Arizona, No. 25/RV USC and No. 4/5 UCLA in succession, representing its first three-game stretch against top-25 foes since 2002.

## TRAVIS, HUMPHREY ANCHORING POST

Junior forwards Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey have combined to average 38.9 percent (26.7 out of 68.7) of the team's scoring and 43.4 percent (15.1 out of 34.8) of the team's rebounding average. The duo leads the Cardinal in conference play, with Travis averaging 16.4 ppg and 6.9 rpg and Humphrey contributing 11.7 ppg and a team-best 8.7 rpg.

### ALLEN'S STANDOUT PERFORMANCE IN THE LAST EIGHT GAMES

Marcus Allen has been one of the Cardinal's leaders on both ends of the floor over the last eight games. He is averaging 12.5 ppg (second on team), while leading the team in steals (16) and ranking second in assists (21) during this span. After averaging 4.4 ppg in his first 17 contests, Allen is averaging more than eight points better per game in his last eight contests.

### ADDITIONAL NOTES ON ALLEN'S RECENT PLAY

- The guard is 3-of-5 (.600) from three-point range in Stanford's last three games, after going 5-of-32 (.156) in the first 22 contests.
- He has recorded 14 steals in the last six games and ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in steals per game (1.7) during conference play
- His 112 career steals has moved into a tie with Wolfe Perry (1975-79) for 12th on Stanford's career steals list.

### HUMPHREY CONTROLLING THE GLASS

Michael Humphrey has totaled 94 rebounds (9.4 rpg) over the last 10 games. He ranks fifth in the Pac-12 in rebounding at 8.7 rpg during league play. Humphrey has played more than 30 minutes in eight of the last 11 contests, after not reaching the 30-minute mark in any of the first 14 games. At UCLA on Jan. 8, Humphrey set a career-high with 27 points and finished one shy of his career-best with 14 rebounds for his first double-double of the year. He was one rebound shy of a double-double (10 points, nine rebounds) at California Jan 29. The junior finished with 16 points and 13 rebounds last time out at Arizona State.

### PICKENS ON TARGET FROM BEYOND THE ARC

Junior Dorian Pickens has posted at least one three-pointer in 22 games, with multiple three-pointers in 14 contests. He has totaled 11 three-pointers in his last four games. Pickens is shooting 37.3 percent from three-point range, with a team-best 47 three-pointers. He registered a career-high seven (7-of-10) vs. Idaho. Pickens connected on the game-winning trifecta against Indiana State with 2.0 seconds left.

### THE JUNIOR CLASS

Stanford's four-member junior class - Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens, Michael Humphrey and Robert Cartwright - has accounted for 66.8 percent of the team's overall scoring. Travis (17.2 ppg), Pickens (12.0 ppg), Humphrey (9.5 ppg) and Cartwright (7.2 ppg) are among Stanford's top five scoring leaders. Cartwright is listed as a sophomore after receiving a medical redshirt for the 2015-16 season.

### FLOOR BURNS STAT COMES TO THE FARM

During his standout collegiate career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court, diving for loose balls and taking charges, whatever he could do to help his team win. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" stat was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 in the 1996-97 season. This season, Stanford is tracking floor burns as an official stat throughout the year.

**CARTWRIGHT ON POINT**

Junior Robert Cartwright has taken over as the Cardinal's starting point guard, starting the last nine contests. He ranks seventh in the Pac-12 in assists (4.2) during conference play, and sixth in the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1) overall.

**TRAVIS TIMELINE**

Junior Reid Travis returned to the lineup five games ago at California, leading the team with 17 points and five rebounds after having missed four of the previous six games with a right shoulder injury. After totaling nine points and five rebounds against Colorado on Feb. 2, the forward posted 26 points, five rebounds and three steals in 26 minutes against Utah on Feb. 4. He followed that up with 26 points and 11 rebounds at Arizona and 17 points and 11 rebounds at ASU last week. Travis sat out both games of Stanford's Southern California trip before returning to the lineup Jan. 12 against Washington State, totaling 17 points and six boards in 20 minutes. Two days later against Washington, Travis aggravated the injury after playing 12 minutes in the first half and did not return. Travis did not play in road games at Oregon State and Oregon.

**TRAVIS FROM THE LINE**

Despite missing four of the last 11 games with a right shoulder injury, Reid Travis still ranks among the nation's leaders in free throws attempted (101st, 142) and free throws made (184th, 93) as of Feb. 15. At Kansas on Dec. 3, he set Stanford single-game records for free throws made (19) and attempted (22), while also breaking the same free throw marks by a Kansas opponent. While Travis is getting to the charity stripe much more, his free throw percentage has also improved from last year.

**SHEFFIELD JOINS TOMSIC WITH PERFORMANCE LAST TIME AGAINST ASU**

Sophomore Marcus Sheffield poured in a career-high 35 points on 11-of-15 shooting in Stanford's last matchup with Arizona State, on Dec. 30. Sheffield was just the second underclassman in the history of the program (Ron Tomsic, 39 vs. Bradley and 38 vs. USC in 1952-53) to score 35 or more points in a game. Sheffield was the first Cardinal to record a 30-point game since Chasson Randle collected 35 against Rhode Island on March 22, 2015.

**PAC-12 HALL OF HONOR**

Mike Montgomery will be honored as Stanford's representative for induction into this year's Pac-12 Men's Basketball Hall of Honor. A member of the 2016 National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame induction class, Montgomery retired in 2014 after 32 years as a collegiate head coach. Montgomery registered a school-record 393 wins in 18 seasons as head coach at Stanford from 1987-2004, directing the Cardinal to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances and a spot in the 1998 NCAA Final Four.

**VERHOEVEN AN IMPACT IN THE PAINT**

Senior Grant Verhoeven, averaging 4.2 points in 14.3 minutes per game this season, has played in every game with nine starts in 2016-17. His defensive presence has been key for the Cardinal, drawing several charges. In the win over Seton Hall, he drew five charges and caused six turnovers. Verhoeven averaged 7.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in two starts at Oregon State and Oregon.



## CARDINAL IN THE NBA

Five former Stanford standouts – Brook Lopez (Brooklyn Nets), Robin Lopez (Chicago Bulls), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Chasson Randle (Philadelphia 76ers) and Josh Huestis (Oklahoma City Thunder) – are on NBA rosters. Brook Lopez leads the Nets in scoring (20.6 ppg) and ranks second in rebounding (5.2 rpg). Robin Lopez is second on the Bulls in rebounding (6.9 rpg). Powell is averaging 6.9 ppg off the bench for the Mavericks. The 76ers signed Chasson Randle to a three-year contract in January. He has averaged 5.3 ppg in eight games.

## HAASE TIES LEAD TO FUTURE GAMES WITH KANSAS AND NORTH CAROLINA

Stanford has agreed to play both Kansas and North Carolina over the next several years. The Cardinal began a four-game series with Kansas this season and will play North Carolina each of the next two seasons. Stanford and Kansas will play Dec. 21, 2017 at Golden 1 Center in Sacramento, before the Cardinal returns to Lawrence on Dec. 1, 2018, and hosts the Jayhawks at Maples Pavilion Dec. 29, 2019. Jerod Haase was a standout guard for Jayhawks from 1995-97. Stanford will host the Tar Heels on Monday, Nov. 20, 2017 at Maples Pavilion. The second game in the series will be played in Chapel Hill, North Carolina, on Monday, Nov. 12, 2018. After playing three seasons for head coach Roy Williams at Kansas, Haase spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels.

## STAR-STUDED 2017 PHIL KNIGHT INVITATIONAL

Stanford will compete in the prestigious 16-team PK80 – Phil Knight Invitational – over Thanksgiving week of 2017. The event, which will honor Nike co-founder and Stanford alumnus Phil Knight MBA '62 in advance of his 80th birthday, will be contested in Portland, Oregon over Thanksgiving week during the 2017-18 season. Stanford will be joined in the elite 16-team field by Arkansas, Butler, Connecticut, Duke, Florida, Georgetown, Gonzaga, Michigan State, North Carolina, Ohio State, Oklahoma, Oregon, Portland, Portland State and Texas. This highly-anticipated event will be one of the largest regular-season tournaments in college basketball history.

## TRAVIS NAMED CAPTAIN

Junior Reid Travis was named the Cardinal's team captain at the beginning of the season. It was the first time in Jerod's Haase's five years as a head coach he has named a team captain.

## PICKENS NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

After averaging 18.3 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.3 steals in three games in the Advocare Invitational, Dorian Pickens was named to the five-member all-tournament team.

## OKPALA AND DA SILVA SIGN WITH CARDINAL

Head Coach Jerod Haase unveiled his first recruiting class with the Cardinal, as standouts Kezie Okpala and Oscar da Silva signed with the program on Nov. 9. Okpala, a 6-8, 185-pound small forward from Esperanza High School in Anaheim, California, and da Silva, a 6-9, 210-pound forward from Ludwig Gymnasium in Munich, Germany, will begin competing for the Cardinal in the 2017-18 season.

## HEAD COACHES IN THEIR STANFORD DEBUTS

With Stanford's win over Harvard in the season opener in Shanghai, China, Jerod Haase posted a victory in his first game as the head coach of the Cardinal. Head coaches are now 16-2 all-time in their Stanford debuts.

## PICKENS THE WORLD TRAVELER

The 2016 Pac-12 China Game was Dorian Pickens' third international basketball trip in a 15-month span. He has traveled more than 20,000 miles around the globe and spent more than 80 hours on an airplane during his international basketball adventures. In addition to the game in Shanghai, Pickens was selected to play on the Pac-12 All-Star Team that competed in two games against the Australian Olympic Team in Melbourne this past July. He also competed in all six games during Stanford's 2015 tour of Italy. He visited Rome, Florence, Venice and Como during the exhibition tour.

## INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION

Stanford's trip to China was the third international trip during the regular season in the 102-year history of the men's basketball program. The Cardinal now owns a 3-3 all-time record in regular-season games played outside of United States territories following last week's win over Harvard in Shanghai. Stanford also competed in Cancun, Mexico, in 2009 and Paradise Island, Bahamas in 2012.

## THE 25,000-MILE SEASON-OPENING JOURNEY

The Cardinal completed a whirlwind 25,000-mile journey across the globe during its first 11 games. The 2016-17 campaign opened in Shanghai, China on Nov. 11. Following its trip to China, Stanford played games in Orlando, Florida, Lawrence, Kansas and Dallas, Texas. The four trips, which included six games, totaled 25,598 miles and more than 56 hours on an airplane.

Jerod Haase was named Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball by Jaquish & Kenninger Director of Athletics Bernard Muir on March 25, 2016.

Haase, the 18th head coach in the history of the program, arrives on The Farm after four seasons as the head coach at UAB. He led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance in 2015. Haase improved the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-7 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in 2015-16, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25.

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen – all players recruited by Haase and his staff – and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game.

During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games.

Prior to arriving at UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003.

When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Calif., Haase attended California in 1992-93 before transferring to Kansas. He helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacque Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection.

Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase started 23 games in 1992-93 as a freshman at California, teaming with Jason Kidd in the backcourt.

Haase, 42, and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (10), Garrett (7) and Gabrielle (4).
