STANFORD, Calif. - Stanford continues its longest road stretch of the season this weekend when it travels to Tuscaloosa, Alabama, for the Easton Crimson Classic.

The Cardinal (10-5) will play five games in three days and take on a group of quality teams, including No. 11 Alabama. The trip is the second of a back-to-back as Stanford played five games in three days this past weekend in Cathedral City, California, at the Mary Nutter Classic.

Stanford opens the weekend Friday with games against Drake (9 a.m. PT) and Jacksonville (11:30 a.m.). The Cardinal plays the Dolphins for a second time on Saturday morning (9 a.m.) before taking on the Crimson Tide (11:30 a.m.). Stanford concludes play Sunday with its second game against Drake at 9 a.m.

Stanford's game against Alabama will be televised on the SEC Network+ and can be streamed online with a subscription.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Stanford went 3-2 this past weekend, earning wins against Bethune-Cookman, St. John's and Purdue. The Cardinal dropped a decision against No. 1 Florida State and suffered a walk-off defeat against San Diego State.
- Alyssa Horeczko led the Cardinal offensively, batting .538 (7-for-13) with five runs, two walks, a stolen base and a triple.
- Bessie Noll registered team-highs in RBIs (8) and slugging percentage (.824), going 9-for-17 (.529) with five runs, two doubles and a home run.
- Teaghan Cowles hit .500 or better for the third straight weekend, going 9-for-18 (.500) with six runs, two doubles, a triple, two RBIs and two walks.
- Carolyn Lee (4-4) went 0-2 in the circle last weekend but continued to be Stanford's ace. She limited No. 1 Florida State to four runs through the first six innings and racked up a career-high eight strikeouts. She gave the Cardinal a chance to win against San Diego State, limiting the Aztecs to five runs three earned with four strikeouts in 6.2 innings.
- Kiana Pancino had a breakout weekend at pitcher, earning the first victory of her collegiate career and finishing the weekend with a 2-0 record and 2.00 ERA.

#### **COWLES' HOT START**

- Teaghan Cowles has hit .500 or better each weekend this season. She hit .619 (13-for-21) at the season-opening Kajikawa Classic, hit .700 (7-for-10) at the Stanford Nike Invitational and batted .500 this past weekend at the Mary Nutter Classic.
- Cowles leads Stanford in batting average (.547), runs (17), hits (29), triples (2), total bases (36) and stolen bases (2).
- Cowles was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week after the Kajikawa Classic (Feb. 14), becoming the first Stanford player to win a conference award since May 13, 2013, when Kayla Bonstrom ('16) was named the Player of the Week.

#### **NOLL PICKS UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF**

- Bessie Noll had a breakout season offensively during her junior year in 2016 and was named to the NFCA All-West Region third team. She has picked up where she left off and is second on the team with a .444 batting average. Noll leads the squad with six doubles, 13 walks, a .694 slugging percentage and a .604 on-base percentage.
- Noll grew up playing baseball in Tokyo, Japan, and only played softball during the summers of her high school years before committing to the sport fulltime in college.

## SORENSON LEADS THE WAY

- Kylie Sorenson led Stanford in batting in two of her first three years. She has continued to deliver in the batter's box and is third on the team with a .407 batting average. She is second on the team with 16 RBIs, 22 hits and five doubles.
- Sorenson and Noll are co-captains this season and are the unquestioned leaders on and off of the field.

#### **BREAK-OUT START FOR BERTOY**

• Lauren Bertoy is having a breakout start to her season, hitting a career-high .390 with two home runs, two doubles a triple and seven RBIs. She has already logged single-season career highs in runs (11), hits (16), triples (1) and home runs (2).

#### FRESH ADDITIONS

- Stanford welcomed nine freshmen this season and many are making significant immediate impacts.
- Teaghan Cowles leads the team in batting (.547) and has been one of the Cardinal's most dangerous hitters at the plate.
- Alyssa Horeczko has established her place in the lineup, hitting .419 on the year with 10 runs, a .516 slugging percentage and a .455 on-base percentage.
- Kristina Inouye has played nearly every inning at second base and is hitting .333 with 12 RBIs, seven runs and seven walks.

- Montana Dixon has split time with Arden Pettit behind the plate and has thrown out 3-of-5 attempted base stealers this season. Dixon is contributing offensively with a .333 average.
- Nikki Bauer, Kiana Pancino and Kayler Detmer have been solid additions to the Stanford pitching staff. Bauer holds a 4-1 record, Pancino has provided quality innings in relief and Detmer has gotten outs when needed.

#### **FULL STAFF**

- Stanford has five players listed on the roster as part of the pitching staff. It is the first time the Cardinal has had five players listed as pitchers on its roster since 2005.
- Carolyn Lee leads the group as a starting pitcher with a 2.61 ERA and has excelled against top competition. Nikki Bauer has been the primary second starting pitcher. Kiana Pancino, Haley Snyder and Kayler Detmer have primarily come in as relief.

#### **BURKS' BIG BAT**

- Whitney Burks has provided plenty of power to start the season and leads the team with 19 RBIs. She provided the game-winning walk-off hit against Western Michigan and provided a game-tying sacrifice fly against Bethune-Cookman to send the game to extra innings.
- Burks has already set single-season career highs in hits (16), doubles (3) and RBIs (19).

#### LEE, PETTIT STUDY ABROAD

• Carolyn Lee and Arden Pettit studied abroad last summer as part of the Rubenstein-Bing Student-Athlete Civic Engagement Program (ACE Program) - a joint program between Stanford and Duke designed to provide student-athletes the opportunity to study abroad in a three-week immersive summer service experience. Lee studied in Vietnam and Pettit studied in China.
