## **POSTGAME NOTES**

## **Stanford Notes:**

- Stanford is 31-5 on the season and has won seven in a row.
- Making its 31<sup>st</sup> appearance and the 30<sup>th</sup> season in a row Stanford is 83-28 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.
  - o The Cardinal are 19-6 in Sweet 16 games.
  - Stanford is 12-6 in Elite Eight contests.
- Stanford leads the series vs. Texas, 8-4.
  - o On Nov. 14 of this season, Texas defeated Stanford 71-59.
- Trailing 36-29 at halftime, Stanford took over with a big third quarter, outscoring the Longhorns 25-13 during that period, and held on in the fourth quarter.
- Key stat: Stanford claimed 13 offensive rebounds, leading to a 20-10 advantage in second-chance points.
- Senior forward Erica McCall led the with with 23 points and 12 rebounds, her 14<sup>th</sup> double-double of the season.
- Three others scored in double figures, Karlie Samuelson with 15 including four 3-pointers Brittany McPhee with 12 and Alanna Smith with 10.

## **Texas Notes:**

- Texas finishes the season 25-9.
- Making its 30<sup>th</sup> visit to the NCAA Tournament, the Longhorns have an all-time record of 40-29 in the event.
  - o Texas is 9-5 in Sweet 16 games.
- Freshman forward Joyner Holmes continued to show the promise of her future with 15 points and seven rebounds.
- Junior guard Ariel Atkins led the Longhorns with 18 points, her highest scoring game since Feb. 13.
- Senior center Kelsey Lang concluded her career with four points, 12 rebounds, four assists and four blocked shots.
