## PAC-12 CONFERENCE NAMES GYMNASTICS ALL-ACADEMIC TEAMS

To be eligible for selection to an All-Academic Team, a student-athlete must have a minimum 3.0 overall grade-point average and must have participated in at least fifty percent of competitions this regular season. First-year student-athletes are not eligible for Pac-12 All-Academic Teams.

In keeping with the Pac-12's tradition of academic and athletic excellence, these student-athletes are indicative of Pac-12 athletics departments' commitment to student-athlete success in all areas of their lives.
