STANFORD AND ARIZONA STATE CLASH IN PAC-12 TOURNAMENT OPENER

Stanford enters the Pac-12 Tournament as the No. 9 seed, where it will face No. 8 seed Arizona State on Wednesday at noon PT in the first game of the conference tournament at the new T-Mobile Arena. The Cardinal completed the regular season tied with Washington State for ninth in the conference and earned the No. 9 seed over the Cougars by virtue of its 84-54 win over WSU at home on Jan. 12 in the lone meeting between the two teams this season.

CARDINAL IN THE CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT

- 16-18 all-time record in the conference tournament.
- Defeated Washington (77-66) March 13, 2004 to capture its only conference tournament title.
- 3-1 all-time against Arizona State in the conference tournament.
- Enters the conference tournament as the No. 9 seed for the second consecutive year and the third time overall.
- 1-2 overall as the No. 9 seed. In 2009, Stanford defeated No. 8 seed Oregon State (62-54) in its opening-round game and lost to Washington (85-73) in the quarterfinals. Last season, the Cardinal dropped a 91-68 decision to the eighth-seeded Huskies in the first round.

STANFORD-ARIZONA STATE IN THE CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT

2010 – Stanford won, 70-61, as a No. 7 seed over No. 2 seeded ASU in the quarterfinals.
 2012 – Stanford won, 85-65, as a No. 7 seed over No. 10 seeded ASU in the first round.
 2013 – ASU won, 89-88, in OT as a No. 9 seed over No. 8 seeded Stanford in the first round.
 2014 – Stanford won, 79-58, as a No. 6 seed over No. 3 seeded ASU in the quarterfinals.

AGAINST ARIZONA STATE

Stanford leads the all-time series against Arizona State, 48-36. Despite the Sun Devils taking both contests during the regular season and winning the last three meetings, the Cardinal has captured 10 of the last 16 games against the Sun Devils. Stanford dropped a 98-93 decision to ASU at home in its Pac-12 season opener on Dec. 30, and surrendered a lead in the final minute in a 75-69 setback to the Sun Devils in Tempe, Arizona, on Feb. 11.

TRAVIS EARNS FIRST TEAM ALL-PAC-12 HONORS

Junior Reid Travis "R2T2" is a First Team All-Pac-12 selection in a vote by the conferences coaches. The forward ranks in the top eight in the conference in seven different categories and is the only Pac-12 player to rank in the top five in scoring (17.2 ppg, third) and rebounding (8.8 rpg, fifth). The junior has posted nine of his 10 career double-doubles this season. In his last eight games, Travis is averaging 19.4 ppg and 9.6 rpg, including three double-doubles. He is one of two players (TJ Leaf) to rank in the top eight in the league in scoring, rebounding and field goal %. Travis' honor marks the fifth straight season Stanford has been represented on the All-Pac-12 First Team, including Rosco Allen (2016), Chasson Randle (2015), and Dwight Powell (2013 and 2014). It's the seventh time in the last eight seasons a Cardinal has earned first-team honors.

Despite missing four games with a right shoulder injury, Reid Travis still ranks among the Pac-12 leaders in free throws attempted (second, 173) and free throws made (third, 113). At Kansas, he set Stanford single-game records for free throws made (19) and attempted (22), while also breaking the same free throw marks by a Kansas opponent. While Travis is getting to the charity stripe much more, his free throw percentage has also improved from last year.

ALLEN NAMED TO PAC-12 ALL-DEFENSIVE TEAM

Senior Marcus Allen was voted to the Pac-12's five-member All-Defensive Team. He ranks fifth in the Pac-12 in steals (1.6 spg) in conference play and continues to move up the Stanford record books where he is currently 12th with 119 career steals. Allen has recorded 21 steals in his last 11 games, and leads the Cardinal with 38 thefts overall. The guard has recorded multiple steals in 12 games, with a season-best four against Colorado in February.

ALLEN'S LAST EIGHT GAMES

Over his last eight games, Marcus Allen is averaging 14.4 ppg (second on team), while leading the team in steals (12) and ranking third in assists (20) during this span. After averaging 5.7 ppg in his first 22 contests, Allen is averaging nearly nine points better per game in his last eight contests.

- Made five three-pointers in last seven games, after five in first 22 contests.
- Recorded 21 steals in last 11 games.
- His 119 career steals rank 12th on Stanford's all-time steals list.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Stanford ranks second in the Pac-12 in steals at 6.7 spg overall. The Cardinal is averaging 7.3 steals per game in its last 12 contests and has held eight of its last 12 opponents below their season scoring averages. Stanford is forcing 15.4 turnovers per game on average over its last 12 games. The Cardinal forced 41 combined turnovers in consecutive games against Cal (20) and Oregon State (21) - the most in a two-game stretch in conference play in more than 12 years, since Stanford also forced 41 combined miscues vs. USC (21 turnovers - Jan. 22, 2005) and UCLA (20 turnovers - Jan. 20, 2005).

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Stanford has played the sixth toughest schedule in the nation, according to ESPN's strength of schedule rankings on March 5. The Cardinal has played eight games against teams in the top-20 of the RPI. Stanford's RPI is 87, while its average RPI loss is 49, according to the March 5 NCAA report. Look no further than a daunting nonconference slate that featured Miami, Seton Hall, No. 12/13 Saint Mary's, No. 4/5 Kansas and SMU. In conference play, Stanford faced No. 18/18 Arizona, No. 25/RV USC and No. 4/5 UCLA in succession, its first three-game stretch vs. top-25 foes since 2002.

PICKENS ON TARGET FROM BEYOND THE ARC

Junior Dorian Pickens has posted at least one three-pointer in 26 games, with multiple three-pointers in 18 contests, including seven of his last eight games. He has totaled 27 three-pointers and has shot 45.9 percent from three-point range in his last nine games. In February, Pickens had a streak of seven consecutive games with multiple three-pointers. The junior owns a team-best 63 three-pointers on the year, including a career-high seven (7-of-10) vs. Idaho earlier this season. Pickens connected on the game-winning trifecta against Indiana State with 2.0 seconds left.

Pickens' games with four or more three-pointers

TRAVIS, HUMPHREY ANCHORING POST

Junior forwards Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey have combined to average 38.1 percent (26.3 out of 69.1) of the team's scoring and 43.1 percent (14.9 out of 34.6) of the team's rebounding average. In conference play, Travis is averaging 16.7 ppg and 8.0 rpg in 14 games, and Humphrey is contributing 10.4 ppg and 7.4 rpg in 17 contests.

HUMPHREY CONTROLLING THE GLASS

Michael Humphrey (6.1 rpg overall) is averaging 7.4 rpg in Pac-12 play. At UCLA, Humphrey set a career-high with 27 points and finished one shy of his career-best with 14 rebounds. He was one rebound shy of a double-double (10 points, nine rebounds) at Cal. The junior finished with 16 points and 13 rebounds at Arizona State. Humphrey has played more than 30 minutes in eight of the last 15 contests, after not reaching the 30-minute mark in the first 14 games.

THE JUNIOR CLASS

Three members of Stanford's junior class - Reid Travis, Dorian Pickens and Michael Humphrey - have accounted for 56.3 percent of the team's overall scoring average (38.9 out of 69.1). Travis (17.2 ppg), Pickens (12.6 ppg) and Humphrey (9.1 ppg) are Stanford's top three scoring and rebounding leaders.

CARTWRIGHT, SANDERS SHARE THE POINT

Senior Christian Sanders and redshirt sophomore Robert Cartwright have shared point guard responsibilities this season. Each has played in all 30 games, with Sanders starting 16 contests and Cartwright getting the starting nod in 12 games. Sanders has started at the point the last five games, while Cartwright started the previous nine contests. Cartwright ranks sixth in the Pac-12 in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.3) overall and seventh in the assists per game (4.2) during conference play.

SHEFFIELD JOINS TOMSIC WITH PERFORMANCE VS. ASU

Sophomore Marcus Sheffield poured in a career-high 35 points on 11-of-15 shooting in Stanford's home matchup with Arizona State, on Dec. 30. Sheffield was just the second underclassman in the history of the program (Ron Tomsic, 39 vs. Bradley and 38 vs. USC in 1952-53) to score 35 or more points in a game. Sheffield was the first Cardinal to record a 30-point game since Chasson Randle collected 35 against Rhode Island on March 22, 2015.

VERHOEVEN AN IMPACT IN THE PAINT

Senior Grant Verhoeven, averaging 3.9 points in 12.9 minutes per game this season, has played in all but one game with 10 starts in 2016-17. His defensive presence has been key for the Cardinal, drawing several charges. In the win over Seton Hall, he drew five charges and caused six turnovers. Verhoeven averaged 7.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in two starts at Oregon State and at Oregon. He has played in 116 career games, the third most on the roster.



FLOOR BURNS STAT COMES TO THE FARM

During his standout collegiate career at Kansas, Jerod Haase was known for his energy and passion on the court, diving for loose balls and taking charges, whatever he could do to help his team win. During his time with the Jayhawks, the "floor burns" stat was created in his honor and is still tracked by the program. Haase totaled 167 in the 1996-97 season. This season, Stanford is tracking floor burns as an official stat throughout the year.

PAC-12 HALL OF HONOR

Mike Montgomery will be honored as Stanford's representative for induction into this year's Pac-12 Men's Basketball Hall of Honor. A member of the 2016 National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame induction class, Montgomery retired in 2014 after 32 years as a collegiate head coach. Montgomery registered a school-record 393 wins in 18 seasons as head coach at Stanford from 1987-2004, directing the Cardinal to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances and a spot in the 1998 NCAA Final Four.

CARDINAL IN THE NBA

Five former Stanford standouts – Brook Lopez (Brooklyn Nets), Robin Lopez (Chicago Bulls), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Josh Huestis (Oklahoma City Thunder) and Chasson Randle (New York Knicks) – are on NBA rosters. Brook Lopez leads the Nets in scoring (20.6 ppg) and ranks third in rebounding (5.1 rpg). Robin Lopez leads the Bulls in rebounding (6.7 rpg). Powell is averaging 6.4 ppg off the bench for the Mavericks. Huestis has played in one game with OKC, scoring seven points and collecting four rebounds against the Bulls on Feb. 1. Randle signed with the New York on Feb. 27 and has played in one game with the Knicks. He played in eight games with the 76ers earlier this season.

HAASE TIES LEAD TO FUTURE GAMES WITH KANSAS, UNC

Stanford has agreed to play both Kansas and North Carolina over the next several years. The Cardinal began a four-game series with Kansas this season and will play UNC each of the next two seasons. Stanford and Kansas will play Dec. 21, 2017 at Golden 1 Center in Sacramento, before the Cardinal returns to Lawrence on Dec. 1, 2018, and hosts the Jayhawks at Maples Pavilion Dec. 29, 2019. Jerod Haase was a standout guard for Jayhawks from 1995-97. Stanford will host the Tar

Heels Monday, Nov. 20, 2017 at Maples Pavilion. The second game in the series will be played in Chapel Hill, Monday, Nov. 12, 2018. After playing three seasons for head coach Roy Williams at Kansas, Haase spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels.

STAR-STUDED 2017 PHIL KNIGHT INVITATIONAL

Stanford will compete in the prestigious 16-team PK80 – Phil Knight Invitational – over Thanksgiving week of 2017. The event, which will honor Nike co-founder and Stanford alumnus Phil Knight MBA '62 in advance of his 80th birthday, will be contested in Portland, Oregon over Thanksgiving week during the 2017-18 season. Stanford will be joined in the elite 16-team field by Arkansas, Butler, Connecticut, Duke, Florida, Georgetown, Gonzaga, Michigan State, North Carolina, Ohio State, Oklahoma, Oregon, Portland, Portland State and Texas. This highly-anticipated event will be one of the largest regular-season tournaments in college basketball history.

TRAVIS NAMED CAPTAIN

Junior Reid Travis was named the Cardinal's team captain at the beginning of the season. It was the first time in Jerod's Haase's five years as a head coach he has named a team captain.

OKPALA AND DA SILVA SIGN WITH CARDINAL

Head Coach Jerod Haase unveiled his first recruiting class with the Cardinal, as standouts Kezie Okpala and Oscar da Silva signed with the program on Nov. 9. Okpala, a 6-8, 185-pound small forward from Esperanza High School in Anaheim, California, and da Silva, a 6-9, 210-pound forward from Ludwig Gymnasium in Munich, Germany, will begin competing for the Cardinal in the 2017-18 season.

PICKENS THE WORLD TRAVELER

The 2016 Pac-12 China Game was Dorian Pickens' third international basketball trip in a 15-month span. He has traveled more than 20,000 miles around the globe and spent more than 80 hours on an airplane during his international basketball adventures. In addition to the game in Shanghai, Pickens was selected to play on the Pac-12 All-Star Team that competed in two games against the Australian Olympic Team in Melbourne this past July. He also competed in all six games during Stanford's 2015 tour of Italy. He visited Rome, Florence, Venice and Como during the exhibition tour.

INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION

Stanford's trip to China was the third international trip during the regular season in the 102-year history of the men's basketball program. The Cardinal now owns a 3-3 all-time record in regular-season games played outside of United States territories following last week's win over Harvard in Shanghai. Stanford also competed in Cancun, Mexico, in 2009 and Paradise Island, Bahamas in 2012.

THE 25,000-MILE SEASON-OPENING JOURNEY

The Cardinal completed a whirlwind 25,000-mile journey across the globe during its first 11 games. The 2016-17 campaign opened in Shanghai, China on Nov. 11. Following its trip to China, Stanford played games in Orlando, Florida, Lawrence, Kansas and Dallas, Texas. The four trips, which included six games, totaled 25,598 miles and more than 56 hours on an airplane.

Jerod Haase was named Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball by Jaquish & Keninger Director of Athletics Bernard Muir on March 25, 2016.

Haase, the 18th head coach in the history of the program, arrives on The Farm after four seasons as the head coach at UAB. He led the Blazers to a regular-season Conference USA championship in 2016 and the program's 15th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance in 2015. Haase improved the Blazers' win total every year.

Tabbed the 2016 Gene Bartow Conference USA Coach of the Year, Haase led the Blazers to a 26-7 overall record and a 16-2 conference mark while capturing their first regular-season title since 2011. Along the way, UAB established school records for overall victories (26), conference wins (16), road wins (10) and consecutive victories (14). Also named the 2016 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) All-District Coach, Haase directed the Blazers to an NIT berth for the 12th time in school history. UAB also finished 16-0 at home in 2015-16, extending the nation's fifth-longest home winning streak to 25.

Under Haase's guidance, UAB returned to the NCAA Tournament in 2015, shocking No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, in the second round for the Blazers' first NCAA victory since 2005. UAB reached the Big Dance after claiming the program's first Conference USA Tournament title despite being seeded No. 4. The triumph marked UAB's first league tournament title since 1987, when the Blazers won the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. Haase successfully developed a roster comprised of 10 underclassmen – all players recruited by Haase and his staff – and finished 20-16 overall while guiding the third-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

The Blazers made impressive strides under Haase's leadership during the 2013-14 campaign, finishing 18-13 overall. Of UAB's 18 victories, perhaps none were more impressive than the Blazers' 63-59 home win against No. 16 North Carolina. UAB was ranked in the top five nationally in rebounding throughout the season and finished the year ranked second in the country at 44.5 boards per game.

During Haase's first year with the Blazers in 2012-13, UAB won six of its final nine regular-season Conference USA games.

Prior to arriving at UAB, Haase played for Roy Williams at Kansas and spent 13 years on Williams' staff with the Jayhawks and Tar Heels. A 1997 graduate of Kansas with a degree in business administration, Haase got his start as Kansas' Director of Operations from 1999-2003. During that time, the Jayhawks reached the 2002 Final Four and the national championship game in 2003.

When Williams was named head coach at North Carolina prior to the 2003-04 season, he brought Haase with him as an assistant coach and director of operations, a title Haase held from 2003-09. Haase then served exclusively as an assistant coach during his final three seasons with the Tar Heels.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, Calif., Haase attended California in 1992-93 before transferring to Kansas. He helped lead the Jayhawks to three consecutive conference titles and finished his career ranked in the school's top 10 in assists, three-point field goals and steals. Haase started 99 of 101 games at Kansas and scored 1,264 points, averaging 12.5 per game and reaching double figures 74 times. While at Kansas, Haase was a candidate for the Naismith and Wooden Awards.

As a senior in 1996-97, Haase started alongside Jacque Vaughn, Scot Pollard, Paul Pierce and Raef LaFrentz as Kansas finished with a 34-2 record while averaging 12.0 points per game despite playing with a broken wrist. As a sophomore in 1994-95, Haase averaged 15.0 points and was named the Big Eight Conference Newcomer of the Year and also tabbed a second-team all-conference selection.

Haase was a first-team GTE Academic All-American as a senior, a second-team Academic All-American as a junior and a three-time academic all-conference pick. The Jayhawks' Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year in 1997, Haase later earned a master's degree in business at Kansas in 2000.

Haase started 23 games in 1992-93 as a freshman at California, teaming with Jason Kidd in the backcourt.

Haase, 42, and his wife, the former Mindy Meidinger, have three children: Gavin (10), Garrett (7) and Gabrielle (4).

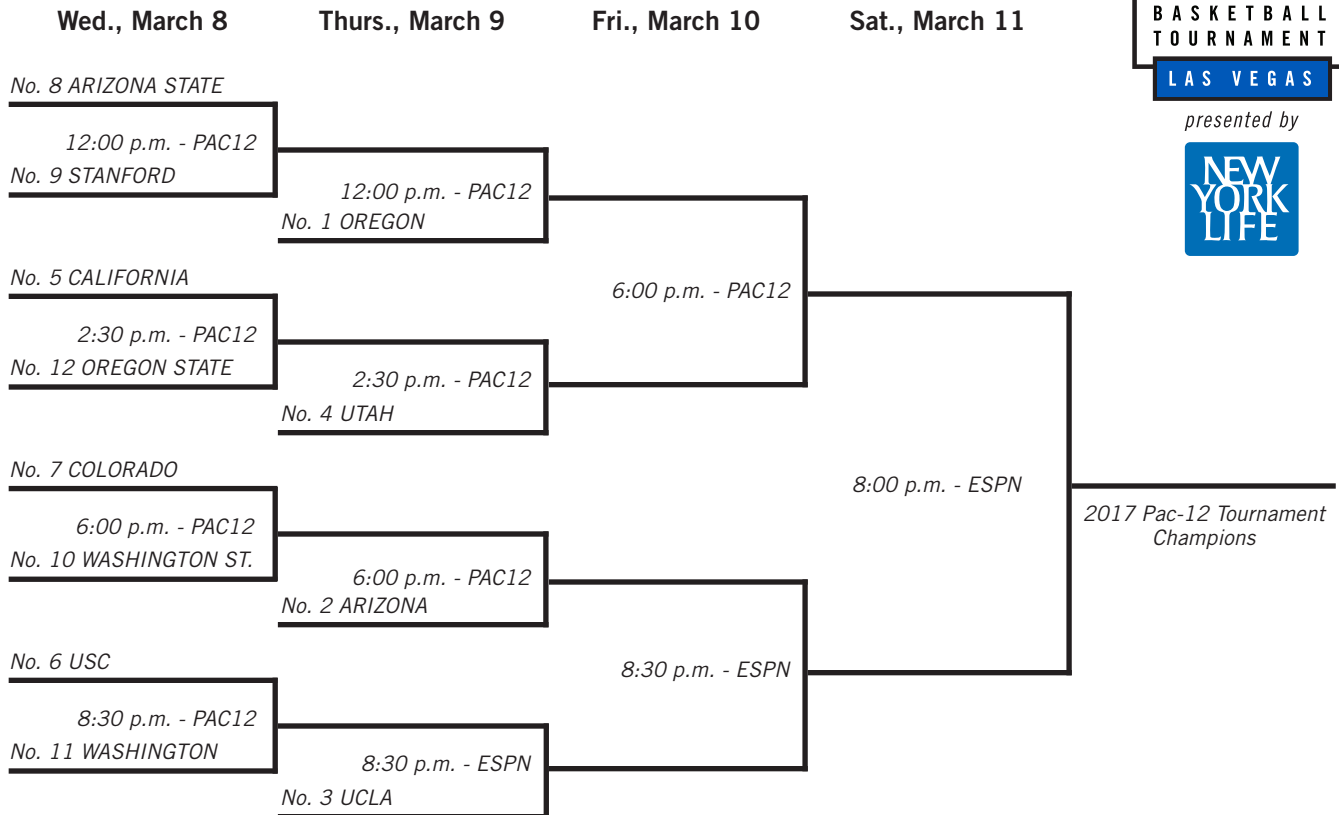
