STANFORD, Calif. – Stanford takes on its fifth top-15 opponent of the season when it plays host to No. 12 UCLA this weekend for a three-game series.

The Cardinal (18-24, 1-14 Pac-12) will look to ride the momentum of a series-finale victory at Oregon State, but will face a tough Bruins (33-12, 8-7 Pac-12) team that has been ranked among the top 15 teams nationally all season.

The series begins Friday at 6 p.m. (PT) and continues Saturday at 1 p.m. The teams will wrap up weekend play Sunday at noon.

The games on Friday and Sunday will be streamed on GoStanford.com. Live statistics will be available for each game via GoStanford.com.

LAST TIME OUT

- Stanford went 2-2 last week, picking up wins against Santa Clara and Oregon State.
- Bessie Noll hit a two-out RBI-double in the bottom of the sixth inning to help lead Stanford to a 6-5 victory against Santa Clara. The victory snapped a 12-game losing streak for the Cardinal and extended its winning streak against the Broncos to 47, dating back to 1995.
- Stanford went 1-2 at Oregon State and capped its weekend with an 8-6 victory in eight innings. Teaghan Cowles hit a two-RBI triple in the top of the eighth inning to secure the win.
- Kiana Pancino stole the show in the circle, holding Oregon State to three runs on five hits and one walk with two strikeouts in a season-high 7.1 innings of relief. The freshman pitcher permitted just one baserunner in the final four innings, retiring 12 of the Beavers' final 13 batters to seal the victory.

THE UCLA SERIES

- Stanford is 20-65 all-time against UCLA and went 0-3 against the Bruins last year. The Cardinal's most recent series win against UCLA came in 2013 when Stanford won two-of-three games.

STRONG ON DEFENSE

- Stanford's defense has been excellent in Pac-12 play, committing just six errors in 98.0 innings. While there have been contributions from players in every position, the Cardinal's middle infield and catching have been particularly impressive.
- Shortstop Kylie Sorenson and second baseman Lauren Wegner have made difficult plays look routine and shown flashes of brilliance. Wegner has a perfect fielding percentage in 217 chances and turned a team-high 10 double plays.
- Arden Pettit has shouldered a majority of the catching responsibilities and done well to manage a young staff that consists primarily of one sophomore and three freshmen. She threw out three baserunners attempting to steal bases in the finale against Arizona State (April 15).

SORENSEN LEADS THE WAY

- Kylie Sorenson led Stanford in batting in two of her first three years. She has continued to deliver offensively and is tied for first on the team with a .355 batting average. She leads the team in RBIs (28) and runs (32), and is second in hits (49), doubles (11) and triples (2).
- Sorenson and Bessie Noll are co-captains this season and leaders on and off of the field.

BREAK-OUT YEAR FOR BERTOY

- Lauren Bertoy is having a breakout season, hitting a career-high .297 with three home runs – including a grand slam – six doubles, a triple and 19 RBIs. She has logged single-season career highs in hits (31), runs (22), doubles (7), triples (1) and home runs (3).

NOLL PICKS UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

- Bessie Noll had a big season offensively during her junior year in 2016 and was named to the NFCA All-West Region third team. She has picked up where she left off and is third on the team with a .316 batting average. Noll leads the squad in doubles (13) and walks (38), and boasts a .524 slugging percentage and .510 on-base percentage.
- Noll ranks first among Pac-12 players in walks (38), and is second in on-base percentage (.524), doubles (13) and walks (29).
- Noll grew up playing baseball in Tokyo, Japan, and only played softball during the summers of her high school years before committing to the sport fulltime in college.

COWLES' BIG FRESHMAN CAMPAIGN

- Freshman Teaghan Cowles hit .500 or better in each of the first three weekends of the season. She hit .619 (13-for-21) at the season-opening Kajikawa Classic, hit .700 (7-for-10) at the Stanford Nike Invitational and batted .500 at the Mary Nutter Classic.
- Cowles leads Stanford in batting average (.355), hits (50) and triples (4), and is second in runs (29), total bases (65) and stolen bases (3), and third in RBIs (25).
- Cowles was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week after the Kajikawa Classic (Feb. 14), becoming the first Stanford player to win a conference award since May 13, 2013, when Kayla Bonstrom ('16) was named the Player of the Week.

FRESH ADDITIONS

- Stanford welcomed nine freshmen this season and many are making significant immediate impacts.
- Teaghan Cowles leads the team in batting (.355) and has been one of the Cardinal's most dangerous hitters at the plate.
- Kristina Inouye has played nearly every inning at second or first base and is hitting .299 with 17 RBIs, nine runs and 12 walks. She is second among Cardinal players in Pac-12 play with a .279 batting average.
- Montana Dixon has split time with Arden Pettit behind the plate and has thrown out five base stealers this season.
- Nikki Bauer, Kiana Pancino and Kayler Detmer have been solid additions to the Stanford pitching staff. Bauer holds a 5-4 record, Pancino is 5-4 and has provided quality innings in relief and Detmer has been productive in getting outs when needed.
- Alyssa Horeczko has established her place in the lineup, hitting .400 on the year with 15 runs, a .455 slugging percentage and a .431 on-base percentage. However, she suffered a hand injury during Stanford's final game before Pac-12 play and is out for the immediate future.

FULL STAFF

- Stanford has five players listed on the roster as part of the pitching staff. It is the first time the Cardinal has had five players listed as pitchers on its roster since 2005.
- Carolyn Lee leads the group as a starting pitcher with a 4.95 ERA and has excelled against top competition. Nikki Bauer has been the primary second starting pitcher. Kiana Pancino, Haley Snyder and Kayler Detmer have primarily come in as relief.

IN THE PAC-12

- Among Pac-12 teams, Stanford ranks fourth in doubles (59), fielding percentage (.970) and triples (8), and fifth in walks (140).

STANFORD COMPLETES CLASS OF 2021

- Caity McGinley (C/INF) and Carmina Nicolas (OF/UTL) signed National Letters of Intent to join the Cardinal in the fall, completing its Class of 2021 which also includes Maddy Dwyer (P) and Tally Thomas (OF).

LEE, PETTIT STUDY ABROAD

- Carolyn Lee and Arden Pettit studied abroad last summer as part of the Rubenstein-Bing Student-Athlete Civic Engagement Program (ACE Program) - a joint program between Stanford and Duke designed to provide student-athletes the opportunity to study abroad in a three-week immersive summer service experience. Lee studied in Vietnam and Pettit studied in China.
