## SEASON IN REVIEW

Individual accomplishments highlight 2017 season

**STANFORD, Calif.** – Numerous academic honors, a top-10 Pac-12 win and career-years for multiple players highlighted Stanford's 2017 season.

The Cardinal was led by a veteran trio and a wealth of young talent. Senior Kylie Sorenson led the team in batting (.366) for the third time in four seasons, while classmates Bessie Noll hit a career-best .311 and Lauren Bertoy registered career highs in nearly every offensive category.

Stanford regularly started at least three freshmen and eight of its 11 underclassmen played in at least half of the Cardinal's games.

Stanford led the Pac-12 with nine all-academic honors, including a conferece-best seven members on the first and second teams. It is the third consecutive year Stanford has led the Pac-12 in first- and second-team selections.

Noll was named the first Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year in program history.

Sorenson was named an NFCA All-West Region third team selection and claimed Pac-12 All-Conference recognition for the fourth time of her career.

The Cardinal graduated three senior starters but the future remains bright with 17 letterwinners returning and a talented incoming freshman class.

### ALL-REGION RECOGNITION

- Kylie Sorenson earned the first National Fastpitch Coaches Association All-West Region honor of her career. She was selected to the third team at shortstop.

### DUO EARN CONFERENCE HONORS

- Kylie Sorenson earned All-Pac-12 second team honors and Bessie Noll was named to the All-Defensive team.

- It is the fourth year Sorenson has earned all-conference recognition and the third time she has been named to the second team.

- Noll claimed the first all-defensive honor of her career. Noll boasted one of the strongest arms in the country and prevented extra-base hits with her coverage in the gaps as a center fielder.

### BEST IN CLASS

- Bessie Noll was named the first Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year in Stanford softball history. Noll excelled in the classroom as a mechanical engineering major and held a 3.73 GPA.

### COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT RECOGNITION

- Stanford was one of six NCAA Division I softball programs to have three players earn academic all-district honors. Stanford was represented by its senior class with Lauren Bertoy (biomechanical engineering, 3.88 GPA), Bessie Noll (mechanical engineering, 3.75) and Kylie Sorenson (psychology, 3.69) earning recognition.

### LEADING THE PAC-12 IN ACADEMICS

- Stanford earned a program-record five Pac-12 All-Academic first team selections. The Cardinal led the conference with nine selections overall, including a conference-best seven members on the first and second teams. It is the third consecutive year Stanford has led the Pac-12 in first- and second-team selections.

- Stanford was represented on the first team by Lauren Bertoy (biomechanical engineering, 3.87 GPA), Kaitlyn Lagattuta (computer science, 3.77), Carolyn Lee (mechanical engineering, 3.99), Bessie Noll (mechanical engineering, 3.73) and Kylie Sorenson (psychology, 3.68).

- Victoria Molina (psychology, 3.68) and Lauren Wegner (biology, 3.68) represented the Cardinal on the second team, while Whitney Burks and Arden Pettit earned honorable mention recognition.

### STRONG ON DEFENSE

- Stanford's defense was excellent in Pac-12 play, committing just six errors in 98.0 innings prior to the UCLA series (May 28-30). The Cardinal ran into trouble in the second game against the Bruins (April 29), committing six errors, but were sound on defense in the other two contests.

While there were contributions from players in every position, the Cardinal's middle infield and catching were particularly impressive.

- Shortstop Kylie Sorenson and second baseman Lauren Wegner made difficult plays look routine and had flashes of brilliance. Wegner committed just two errors in 253 chances and turned a team-high 12 double plays.

- Arden Pettit shouldered a majority of the catching responsibilities and did well to manage a young staff that consisted primarily of one sophomore and three freshmen. She threw out three baserunners attempting to steal bases in the finale against Arizona State (April 15).

### SORENSEN LEADS THE WAY

- A four-time All-Pac-12 selection, Sorenson led the Cardinal in batting for the third time in four years with a career-high .366 batting average. She led Stanford in hits (60), RBIs (36), runs (37), slugging percentage (.537) and fewest strikeouts (9).

### BREAK-OUT YEAR FOR BERTOY

- Lauren Bertoy had a breakout season, hitting a career-high .301 with three home runs – including a grand slam – seven doubles, a triple and 22 RBIs. She logged single-season career highs in hits (40), runs (27), doubles (7), triples (1) and home runs (4).

### NOLL PICKS UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

- Bessie Noll had a big season offensively during her junior year in 2016 and was named to the NFCA All-West Region third team. She picked up where she left off and finished third on the team with a career-high .311 batting average. Noll led the squad in doubles (13) and walks (40), and boasted a .467 slugging percentage and .503 on-base percentage.

- Noll's 40 walks is the second-most for any Stanford player in a single season in program history. Her 105 career walks rank fourth all-time.

- Noll grew up playing baseball in Tokyo, Japan, and only played softball during the summers of her high school years before committing to the sport fulltime in college.

### COWLES' BIG FRESHMAN CAMPAIGN

- Freshman Teaghan Cowles hit .500 or better in each of the first three weekends of the season. She hit .619 (13-for-21) at the season-opening Kajikawa Classic, hit .700 (7-for-10) at the Stanford Nike Invitational and batted .500 at the Mary Nutter Classic.

- Cowles led Stanford in triples (4), and was second among Stanford players in batting average (.313), hits (52), runs (29), total bases (67) and stolen bases (3), and third in RBIs (26).

- Cowles was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week after the Kajikawa Classic (Feb. 14), becoming the first Stanford player to win a conference award since May 13, 2013, when Kayla Bonstrom ('16) was named the Player of the Week.

### FRESH ADDITIONS

- Stanford welcomed nine freshmen this season and many made significant impacts.

- Teaghan Cowles was second on the team in batting (.313) and was one of the Cardinal's most dangerous hitters at the plate.

- Kristina Inouye played nearly every inning at second or first base and hit .274 with 19 RBIs, 11 runs and 12 walks.

- Montana Dixon split time with Arden Pettit behind the plate and threw out five base stealers.

- Nikki Bauer, Kiana Pancino and Kayler Detmer were solid additions to the Stanford pitching staff. Bauer held a 5-4 record, Pancino was 6-6 and provided quality innings in relief and Detmer was productive in getting outs when needed.

- Alyssa Horeczko had established her place in the lineup, hitting .400 on the year with 15 runs, a .455 slugging percentage and a .431 on-base percentage. However, she suffered a hand injury during Stanford's final game before Pac-12 play and was finished for the season.

### STANFORD COMPLETES CLASS OF 2021

- Caity McGinley (C/INF) and Carmina Nicolas (OF/UTL) signed National Letters of Intent to join the Cardinal in the fall, completing its Class of 2021 which also includes Maddy Dwyer (P) and Tally Thomas (OF).
