Stanford vs. Oregon | February 3, 2018

Oregon Head Coach Dana Altman

On The Game

“This game was decided with those big runs (24-7 in 8:25 to start the second half after Stanford took a 16-point halftime lead). We couldn't stop them.

“They said that was only the second time in eight years (that Oregon had lost by as many as 35)--it's hard to take. You get outrebounded by 13, they shoot 62 percent, Pickens got easy looks. We just didn't do a good job. Their freshmen (Davis and Okpala) played well--Daejon really moved the ball well. They got to the basket on us.”

On Dorian Pickens

“Pickens we knew was going to shoot threes. We obviously didn't want to give him the good looks that he got. He got really easy looks in the first half. We did a decent job on their bigs; we didn't let them get to the rim that often. Reid (Travis) did get 17, he got in there, we knew zero (Okpala) was going to drive it, and he got to the rim on us.”

On Oregon's effort

“I don't know if effort was the problem. Our energy level wasn't good. We sure didn't get any stops. Defensively, we weren't communicating well. We didn't talk much. We gave up a lot of easy looks. Offensively, 15 turnovers, 10 assists--that's obviously not what we want.

“I told our guys that I was disappointed and we have to get a lot better on the boards and on defense.”
