Game:

1st Star: Stanford improves to 7-0 all time vs Oregon St in the Pac-12 Tournament & have won 15 straight overall vs OSU
2nd Star: Cardinal trailed by as many as 16 in the game & trailed by 8 at half for the 2nd straight game
3rd Star: Cameron Brink's 9 assists were a career high & tied for the 2nd most assists by a Stanford player in a Pac-12 Tournament game

#4 Oregon St (24-7) - 57

- 1-3 all-time in the Pac-12 Tournament semifinals
 - All 3 losses have been to Stanford
- Only their 2nd loss when leading at halftime (17-1 previously)
- 0-6 when held under 58 PT (2 of those losses to Stanford)
- Closed 1st quarter on a 17-2 run & had a 21-2 run to take a 16 PT lead in the 2nd quarter which was their largest of the game
 - Outscored 47-22 after they held their largest lead
- Missed their final 10 shots of the 1st half, had a stretch of 13 consecutive missed shots continuing into the 2nd half
 - Did not score from 5:10 left in the 1st half until 7:11 left in the 3rd quarter
- 11 of their 23 total made FG came in the 1st quarter (47.8%)
- Had more lead time in the game than Stanford
 - 20:52 to Stanford's 16:50
- **Raegan Beers** 17 PT, 7/15 FG, 7 Reb, 2 BLK
 - 3rd career Pac-12 Tournament game in double figures
 - 10 PT, 5/8 FG in the 1st quarter
- **Timea Gardiner** 11 PT, 3/12 FG, 1/5 3PT, 7 Reb
 - 12th straight game scoring double figures
 - 3rd straight in the P12 Tournament
- **Dom Paourova** 10 PT, 4/11 FG, 2/7 3PT, 5 Reb, 6 Ast
 - 10+ PT in both games of Pac-12 Tournament, 1st time all season she's scored in double figures in consecutive games

#1 Stanford (28-4) - 66

- 7th Pac-12 Title game appearance in last 8 seasons
 - Have appeared in the title game in 20 of possible 23 years
- 15-2 all time in the semifinal round as the #1 seed
- 7-0 all time vs Oregon St in the Pac-12 Tournament
 - 15th straight win overall vs Oregon St
- 2nd straight game trailing at halftime, only time this season trailing at halftime in consecutive games (also down 8 at half yesterday)
 - Now 3-2 this season when trailing at the half
- Trailed by as many as 16, but closed the 1st half on an 8-0 run
 - Turned 3 PT deficit into 9 PT lead with a 12-0 3rd quarter run
 - Never trailed after that 3rd quarter run
- 44-0 all time in P12 Tourney when holding opponent under 60 PT
- 25 assists on 31 made FG (81% assist rate)
- **Hannah Jump** 20 PT (tied season high), 8/13 FG, 4/7 3PT
 - Most points in 12 career Pac-12 Tournament games
 - 4th career tourney game in double figures
 - Cardinal are 65-5 in her career when she scores 10+ PT
- **Cameron Brink** 16 PT, 7/20 FG, 12 Reb, 9 Ast (career high)
 - T2nd most assists by a Stanford player in a Pac-12 Tournament game (Most was 12 by Marta Snizek)
 - 4th straight double-double in P12 Tournament, 6th in career
 - 2nd vs OSU (24 PT, 11 Reb in 2021 semifinals)
 - 5th straight Pac-12 Tournament game with at least 15 PT
- **Kiki Iriafen** 14 PT, 7/16 FG, 9 Reb, 4 Ast
 - 8th straight game with at least 14 points
 - Picked up 3rd foul with 8:21 left in 3rd quarter (Stan trailed 35-30). Did not return until start of 4th quarter
 - Stan outscored OSU 20-8 when she was out
