Nebraska Post-Game Notes

Nebraska vs. #5 Ohio State, Sept. 28, 2019, Memorial Stadium, Lincoln, Neb.

- Nebraska lost for just the third time in its past 24 home night games, with two of those losses coming against top-10 Ohio State teams.
- Nebraska dropped to 1-7 against Ohio State, with the Buckeyes winning the past five meetings between the teams.
- Senior defensive lineman **Khalil Davis** had an eight-yard third-quarter sack, giving him three sacks this season. Davis had two tackles for loss, giving him six on the season.
- Junior linebacker **Collin Miller** tied a career high with six tackles, matching his six-tackle effort at Colorado earlier this season.
- Nebraska recorded three sacks in the game, marking the fourth time in five games Nebraska has had at least three sacks.
- Senior receiver JD Spielman caught a pass for the 26th straight game, extending the sixth-longest streak in school history.
- Dedrick Mills recorded his sixth touchdown of the season on a nine-yard rush in the third quarter.
- Lamar Jackson broke up a pair of passes, his eighth and ninth of the season. Jackson entered the season with 10 career pass break-ups over his first three seasons. Jackson's nine pass break-ups lead the team Dicaprio Bootle ranks second with four.
