THE OPENING TIP

- » The No. 15 Northwestern Wildcats resume Big Ten play after a holiday break at Nebraska on the road Thursday. Tip off is set for 1 p.m. CT on Big Ten Network at Pinnacle Bank Arena.
- » The Wildcats remained at No. 15 in the latest AP Poll after just one game last week, a 79-50 win over Eastern Kentucky at home. The 'Cats forced 33 turnovers and grabbed 26 offensive rebounds.
- » Northwestern leads the country in ball control, ranking first nationally in turnover margin (+14.2), second in turnovers forced per game (26.3) and in the top-15 in fewest turnovers committed per game (12.0).
- » The 'Cats rank third in the country in steals per game with 14.8, led by the reigning Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year Veronica Burton (4.5, first in the Big Ten) and Sydney Wood (3.3, second in the Big Ten)
- All five starters for NU are averaging over eight points a game, and Burton, Wood and Pulliam have scored double digits in every contest so far.
- » Last year, Northwestern rallied from an nine-point second hallf deficit to beat Nebraska 60-56 at home. Pulliam scored a go-ahead jumper to break a tie with 28 seconds left.

NUMBERS TO KNOW



The Wildcats force a turnover on 26.2% of opposing team's possessions, the highest percentage in the country, per Her Hoop Stats. The Wildcats offensive rebounding rate ranks seventh in the country, per Her Hoop Stats. The Wildcats have never had an ORB rate above

33.5% since at least the 2015-16 season.



Veronica Burton is one steal away from becoming the seventh Wildcat all-time to register 200 career steals, as just a junior.

THE STEAL SISTERS: The Wildcats have the top two players in the conference in steals per game in Veronica Burton (4.5) and Sydney Wood (3.3). Along with the help of Jordan Hamilton (2.5) and Lindsey Pulliam (2.0), Northwestern owns the third highest steals per game mark as a team in the country.

THE BACKCOURT BURGLAR: Burton, who is currently leading the conference in steals per game, finished atop that leaderboard at the conclusion of the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons. She was last year's Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year. She now has 199 career steals, one away from seventh place on the all-time list at NU.

BLIZZARD TO AVALANCHE: Joe McKeown's patented Blizzard defense has wreaked havoc on opposing backcourts this season. The 'Cats rank second in the country in turnovers forced per game (26.3) and are using their defensive activity to jumpstart their offense, where they are averaging 31.8 points off of turnovers.

RANK THAT: The Wildcats are ranked No. 15 in the latest AP Top 25 Poll. They climbed one spot in each of the last two weeks from their preseason ranking of 17. They are the second-highest ranked team in the Big Ten behind 5-1 Maryland.

SIMPLE WINS: NU is dominating in ball control metrics for the second straight season. In addition to their superior turnover numbers on defense, the 'Cats are committing the 13th fewest turnovers per game in the country (12.0) while recording the 12th most assists per game nationally (19.5). It comes out to an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.62, the fifth-best mark in the country after finishing fourth in the same category last season.

THE POINT GODDESS: Veronica Burton has been otherworldly to start the season, averaging 21.5 points, 5.5 assists and 4.5 steals through four games. Northwestern's assists and steals stats are elite nationally, and Burton is also scoring the rock efficiently, shooting 56% from the field and 50% from deep, the second best mark in the Big Ten.

THE SWISS ARMY KNIFE: Sydney Wood is averaging a career-best 14.3 points per game and has scored in double-digits in all four games so far after doing so just three times last season. She ranks second in the conference in steals per game and is also chipping in nearly five boards per game.

STEP UP SHAW: Courtney Shaw has taken on her bigger role this season with aplomb. She is averaging 9.3 points and 6.5 rebounds in 24.5 minutes per game. She set career-highs in rebounds (9), assists (3) and minutes (29) against Purdue.

SCRAPPY AND HUNGRY: Jordan Hamilton (J. Ham) has seized on her return to the starting lineup this season, averaging 8.5 points, 3.8 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 2.5 steals in 29.5 minutes per game. She started all but one game in her first two seasons.

RECORD ESOTERICA: The 'Cats are playing their second daytime game of the season after going 1-0 against EKU. They were 12-3 in matinee matchups last season. The 'Cats are 2-0 on Thursday this season and 2-0 on Big Ten Network. Last year on New Year's Eve, Northwestern knocked off then-No. 12 Maryland, 81-58. for its first-ever program win over the Terps.

LINDSEY LEGEND: Senior Guard Lindsey Pulliam was named the Big Ten Preseason Player of the Year by the media. Additionally she was named to three National Player of the Year Watchlists (Wade Trophy, Naismith Trophy, Wooden Award) and the watch list for best shooting guard in the country (Ann Meyers Drysdale Award).

SUPERNOVAE: Senior Lindsey Pulliam and junior Veronica Burton were both named to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team. NU was only one of two schools in the Big Ten with two selections to the ten-player list.

THE CLIMB, PT. 1: Pulliam officially debuted on the top ten career scoring list at Northwestern just one game into her senior season. Through four games she is tied for seventh place with 1,693 points and six away from sixth place.

THE CLIMB, PT. 2: Pulliam entered the season ranked eigth all-time on the NU free throws made list. At 387 in her career, she is tied fifth place with Katrina Hannaford (1993-97).

THE CLIMB, PT. 3: Veronica Burton cracked the top 10 of the all-time steals list at Northwestern just one game into her junior season. She currently is at 199 and one away from seventh and five away from fifth. Burton is on pace to finish the season around the ballpark of 270 steals, which would place her second all-time on the list as just a junior.

FLIRTING WITH HISTORY: Veronica Burton's scoring average of 21.3 points per game, while just fourgames old, would rank fourth all-time in program history. Her three-point percentage of 50% would top the single season leaderboard as well. Less susceptible to volatility is her career three-point percentage of 36%, which ranks eighth all-time at Northwestern.

THE AWARDS: Five Wildcats received All-Big Ten selections last year with three returners: Pulliam was a unanimous first-team selection. Burton was the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, a selection to the Big Ten All-Defensive Team, and an All-Big Ten second team selection. Junior guard Sydney Wood was named All-Big Ten honorable mention by the media. No other Big Ten school returns three All-Big Ten student-athletes.

COAAAACH: Head Coach Joe McKeown won 2020 Big Ten Coach of the Year, as selected by coaches and media, becoming the first Wildcat to win the honor since Don Perelli did so in 1990. He finished as one of three finalists for the Naismith Trophy Women's College Coach of the Year, along with Adia Barnes (Arizona) and Kelly Graves (Oregon).

HEAT CHECK: Pulliam finished last season ranked third in the Big Ten with 18.8 points per game. She tallied nine 25-point games, which led the Big Ten and 14 games with 20+ points. Six of her nine 25-point games last season came on field goal percentages of 50% or better.

ALL-TIME SCORER: Pulliam became the third-fastest player to 1500 points on a per game basis earlier this season against Michigan State. With 1,637 points, she is just 3 away from Kristina Divjak and top-ten career points list at NU. She finished with 563 points after the end of the regular season, the 10th most points in a single season in NU history. Her 595 points as a sophomore was the sixth best single-season output.

THE BACKCOURT BURGLAR: Veronica Burton won Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, marking the third time in five years that a Wildcat has won the award after Ashley Deary did so in 2016 and 2017. Burton ranked ninth in the country and first in the Big Ten last season with 3.3 steals per game. Burton finished with 100 steals on the season, the third best single-season total in program history , behind Deary's two best seasons. With 181 career steals, Burton is two steals away from entering the topten list for career steals at NU before playing a game as a junior.

THE POINT GODDESS: Burton ranked fourth in the Big Ten last season in assists per game with 5.1 and second in assist-to-turnover ratio with a mark of 2.37. **WOOD CARVING**: Sophomore guard Sydney Wood owned the third-best assist-to-turnover ratio in the Big Ten last season with a mark of 2.26. Wood protected the rock exceedingly well against Big Ten defenses, recording 60 assists to just 24 turnovers in conference-only play. Her assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.5 in Big Ten play led the field. Wood also ranks fifth in the conference in Big Ten play in steals per game with 2.0.

MR. 700: Head Coach Joe McKeown earned his 700th career win against East Carolina on Dec. 20, 2019. He became just the 13th active head coach in NCAA Division I to pass this milestone and the fourth coach in the Big Ten. He also earned his 200th career win at Northwestern against Michigan on Jan. 30, becoming just the second coach in program history to do so after Don Perelli.

WHATEVER IT TOOK: Northwestern won five postseason games in 2018-19 to advance to the finals of the WNIT, before falling to the Arizona Wildcats ... This tied the 'Cats' best finish in the tournament in program history with their run to the NWIT final in 1996, when they also faced Arizona.
