Noteworthy: A nine-yard touchdown rush by David Bell with 1:08 left in the game completed a 31-27 come-from-behind victory over Nebraska last season in Ross-Ade Stadium. After quarterback Jack Plummer was injured on the previous possession, Aidan O'Connell engineered a 12-play, 82-yard drive that was capped by Bell's rush. O'Connell was 6 for 6 passing for 62 yards on the final drive. King Doerue rushed 15 times for 71 yards and a touchdown in the game. Tight end Brycen Hopkins caught a gamehigh eight passes for 97 yards in the win. Defensively, Ben Holt led the Boilermakers with 10 total tackles, while Derrick Barnes, Jalen Graham and Kai Higgins each tallied 2.0 TFLs.

Jack Plummer's 367 yards passing at Minnesota marked the second 300-yard passing game by a Purdue QB this season (also Aidan O'Connell 371 yards at Illinois) and the 16th such effort during head coach Jeff Brohm's tenure with the Boilermakers.

Branson Deen's sack in the end zone against Rutgers last week marked the first safety recorded by a Boilermaker since 2016 when Jake Replogle posted a pair of points against Indiana.

Under Jeff Brohm's leadership, Purdue has seen 24 games with at least one player top 100 yards receiving, including eight games with two players over the century mark and one with three different players. The Boilermakers have at least one player with 100 or more yards receiving in all four games in 2020 (two twice).

Triple Digits Receiving by a Running Back

Zander Horvath's 100 yards receiving on nine catches against Northwestern were the most by a Purdue running back since Edwin Watson had five receptions for 102 yards vs. Oklahoma State in the 1997 Alamo Bowl. Horvath followed up his 100-yard receiving game against Northwestern with 118 allpurpose yards (68 rushing and 50 receiving) at Minnesota and 162 all-purpose yards (101 rushing, 61 receiving) vs. Rutgers.

Grinding It Out on the Ground

Zander Horvath's three games with over 100 yards rushing (129 vs. Iowa, 102 at Illinois and 101 vs. Rutgers) are the most by a Purdue running back in the same season since D.J. Knox equaled that number in 2018 (152 vs. Eastern Michigan, 150 at Illinois and 128 vs. Ohio State). The last Boilermaker to rush for over 100 yards four times in the same year was Jerod Void in 2005 (101 vs. Akron, 107 at Arizona, 134 vs. Michigan State and 102 vs. Illinois). Horvath has four career 100-yard games at Purdue.

Club Century

Four different Purdue players have gone over 100 yards in a game nine times in five contests this season. Zander Horvath leads with way with three 100-yard rushing games (129 vs. Iowa, 102 at Illinois and 101 vs. Rutgers) and a 100-yard receiving game (100 vs. Northwestern). David Bell has three

Wright is in the club with a 100-yard receiving game (100 at Illinois) and Rondale Moore joined during his season debut with 120 receiving yards at Minnesota.

A Purdue Record

Sophomore wide receiver David Bell kicked off the 2020 season just the way he ended the 2019 campaign - with back-to-back 100-yard receiving games. Bell wrapped up last season with three straight 100-yard games via the pass en route to being name the Big Ten Freshman of the Year, and opened this year with two more - against lowa in the opener and at Illinois. Bell is the only player in school history to record five consecutive games with 100 or more yards receiving. The previous Purdue record of four straight was shared by Rodney Carter (1985) and Keith Smith (2009). He has broken the century mark in receiving yards nine times in 16 career games at Purdue.

David Bell enters the Nebraska game fifth in the NCAA and first in the Big Ten with an average of 8.6 receptions per game. He is 16th in the NCAA and first in the Big Ten with seven receiving touchdowns on the year and 24th among all FBS players third in the conference with 98.6 receiving yards per game.

Moving On Up

Despite having played in merely 19 career games (actually 18 1/4 games after getting injured in the first quarter against Illinois last season), sophomore Rondale Moore is already climbing up the career receiving record book at Purdue. He enters the week 10th in receptions (165), 17th in receiving yards (1,837), tied for 15th in receiving touchdowns and 18th in all-purpose yards (3,009) at Purdue.

Purdue fans have been waiting for what seems to be an eternity to see a healthy Rondale Moore and David Bell on the field at the same time. Against Minnesota it finally happened to the tune of 240 yards of total offense on 23 receptions and three carries for three touchdowns (two receiving by Bell and one rushing by Moore). Despite the limited time together on the field, Moore and Bell have posted massive numbers individually throughout their careers.

Rondale Moore enters the Nebraska game first in the Football Bowl Subdivision among ACTIVE players in career receptions per game with an average of 8.7 catches per game (David Bell is second at 7.6). Additionally, Moore is 17th in the FBS nationally among ACTIVE players in career receptions with 165 grabs despite having played in merely 19 collegiate games (the 16 active players ahead of him have played an average of 41.9 career games).

It's Been Done Merely Twice Before in 23 Years at Purdue

After rushing 23 times for 164 yards (7.1 ypc) and a pair of touchdowns against Indiana to end the 2019 season, then opening 2020 with 21 carries for 129 yards (6.1 ypc) against lowa and following that up with 102 yards and a TD on 22 carries at Illinois, Zander Horvath became the first Purdue player to rush for over 100 yards in three consecutive games since Kory Sheets had 144 yards vs. Central

Boilermaker to have three straight games over 100 yards rushing against Big Ten teams when he had 115 yards vs. Michigan State, 133 yards vs. Penn State and 163 yards at Indiana to end the 1997 regular season.

Behind Enemy Lines

The Boilermaker defense teamed up for 11.0 tackles for loss against Northwestern on Nov. 14. It was the most stops behind the opposition's line of scrimmage by a Purdue team since tallying 11.0 TFLs vs. Nevada in 2016 and the most against a Big Ten opponent since recording 11.0 TFLs at Indiana to wrap up the 2011 regular season. Junior DaMarcus Mitchell led the Boilers with a career-high 3.0 TFLs against the Wildcats, followed by senior Derrick Barnes' 2.5.

Many Happy Returns

Jalen Graham's scoop-and-score on a fumble return at Illinois marks the seventh straight season Purdue has recorded a defensive TD. Graham's return was Purdue's first score on a fumble return since Danny Ezechukwu rumbled 90 yards against Virginia Tech Sept. 19, 2015.

Dependable Derrick

Senior Derrick Barnes has been a mainstay in Purdue's defensive lineup in his four seasons at Purdue. He has appeared in 42 career games, including 30 starts. He has been among the top tacklers on the team each of the last two seasons, finishing second with 63 stops last season and posting a career-high 92 tackles in 2018 to finish third for the Boilermakers. He tied for the team lead in sacks last season with George Karlaftis (7.5). Barnes posted a career-high 14 tackles, including 2.5 TFLs, against Northwestern and enters the Nebraska game eighth in the Big Ten with an average of 9.0 tackles per game. Barnes will miss the first half of the Nebraska game after getting called for targeting last week vs. Rutgers.

Going The Distance

Dating back to last season, eight of Purdue's last nine games have been decided by seven points or less (including all five games in 2020). The Boilermakers are 4-4 in those eight contests.

First in a While For a True Freshman on the O-Line

Gus Hartwig's starts at Minnesota and vs. Rutgers last week were the first by a <u>true</u> freshman on the offensive line since Ken Plue in 2008. Plue appeared in all 12 games and started six of them in Joe Tiller's final season as head coach. Classmate Dennis Kelly appeared in six games as a reserve that same season.

Back-to-Back

Rondale Moore (2018) and David Bell's (2019) back-to-back Thompson-Randle El Big Ten Freshman of the Year honors are Purdue's first since Brian Fox and Eric Hunter were feted in 1988 and 1989, respectively, and merely the fifth time in conference history for players from the same school to be recognized in consecutive years (also Michigan's Steve Breaston and Mike Hart in 2003 and 2004, Wisconsin's Chris Borland and James White in 2009 and 2010, and Penn State's Deion Barnes and Christian Hackenberg in 2011 and 2012).

Honoring Morgan Burke

The Boilermakers will honor the life and legacy of former vice president and director of athletics Morgan J. Burke with a sticker on the rear of their helmets this season. Burke passed away June 15 after a year-long battle with amyloidosis (a rare disease that occurs when an abnormal protein builds up in organs and interferes with their normal function). He was 68. Burke headed up Purdue athletics from 1993 to 2016. Burke is survived by his wife, Kate, three children – Joyce (husband Ryan), Morgan Jr. (wife Molly) and Patrick (wife Courtney) – and four grandchildren: Kate, Andrew, Parker June and Emily.
