Fahey vs Nebraska: 0-4

- OPENING TIP: The Fighting Illini face their first road test of the 2020-21 season, opening Big Ten Play against the host Nebraska Cornhuskers at Pinnacle Bank Arena in Lincoln, Nebraska. Tipoff between the Illini (2-1) and the Huskers (2-0), is set for 7 p.m. CT. The game will be televised live on Big Ten Network with Larry Punteney (play-by-play) and Brenda VanLengen (analyst). Mike Koon will call the action for the Illini on WDWS 1400-AM. Streaming audio and live stats are also available at FightingIllini.com.
- ABOUT NEBRASKA: Nebraska enters Thursday's game with a 2-0 record after notching home victories over Oral Roberts (90-61) and Idaho State (64-51). Freshman F Annika Stewart leads a quartet of double-digit scorers for Nebraska, averaging a team-high 13.5 points in a reserve role through two contests. Sophomore F Isabelle Bourne (11.5 ppg), senior C Kate Cain (11.0), and junior G Sam Haiby (10.0) are also averaging double-figures scoring. Haiby also leads the team in rebounding (9.5 rpg) and assists (5.0 apg). The Huskers average 77.0 points per game, while holding opponents to 56.0 per contest. The team ranks among the NCAA leaders in several categories including No. 3 in defensive rebounding (39.5 per game), No. 7 in total rebounds per game (52.0), No. 7 in blocked shots per game (7.0), and No. 11 in field goal percentage defense (.293).
- SERIES VS. NEBRASKA: Thursday's matchup is the 20th in the series between the Illini and the Huskers, and the 15th since Nebraska joined the Big Ten prior to the 2011-12 season. Nebraska holds a 14-5 edge, including a 7-1 advantage in games played in Lincoln. The Illini are looking to snap a four-game Nebraska win streak; the last Illini win in the series was March 1, 2017, a 79-59 Illini win at the Big Ten Tournament in Indianapolis, Indiana. Illinois is also in search of its first road win in the series since a 62-52 triumph on Jan. 17, 2013. Nebraska has won five straight at home vs. the Illini.
- UP NEXT: The Illini are slated to continue Big Ten play, hosting No. 19/20 Mlchigan at State Farm Center on Saturday, Dec. 19. The Wolverines, off to a 4-0 start, are scheduled to host Butler on Wednesday, Dec. 9. The tip time and broadcast information for the matchup between the Illini and the Wolverines is still to be determined.
- BIG TEN OPENERS: Illinois opens its 39th season of Big Ten women's basketball on Thursday. The Illini are 14-24 all-time in conference openers, and are looking to snap a three-game skid in league openers. Illinois last began Big Ten Play 1-0 after a 70-65 home win over lowa to open the 2016-17 Big Ten schedule. The Illini have begun conference play on the road just once in the past 12 years 2017-18 at Maryland (L, 100-65) and are in search of their first conference-opening road win since 2007-08 at Northwestern (W, 58-44).

- THE FAHEY ERA CONTINUES: The Illini enter their fourth season under the direction of head coach Nancy Fahey in 2020-21.
- > In Fahey's first season, she led the Illini to a 9-5 non-conference record, which marked the best start to the season since Illinois also earned nine non-conference victories in the 2014-15 campaign (9-3). Illinois won four of its last five games leading up to league play, with the streak marking the most consecutive victories for the program since the start of the 2015-16 season. Junior Alex Wittinger garnered All-Big Ten Second Team, and also matched the school record for single-season offensive rebounds (125). Wittinger earned the program's second-ever triple double during the 2017-18 campaign, and set a new single-game record for blocked shots (11).
- > In her second season at the helm of the Illini, Fahey's squad opened the year with a 7-0 record on Lou Henson Court for the first time since the 2006-07 season. The Illini opened the 2018-19 campaign with at 8-3 (.727) in non-conference play, the best for an Illini squad since starting the 2014-15 campaign with a 9-5 non-conference record (.750). Fahey's squad improved statistically in several categories under her leadership. The Illini averaged seven more points per game than in 2017-18, and improved their field goal percentage by more than four percent.
- > Year 3 saw continued growth under Fahey's leadership. The Illini finished the year with an overall record of 11-9, the third straight year with an improved win total. The 11 wins also marked the most by the Illini since the 2014-15 season (15 wins). Illinois finished its non-conference schedule with a 9-2 record. It marked the best 11-game start for Illinois since the 2006-07 season. The non-conference was capped by a 58-51 Braggin' Rights win over rival Missouri on Dec. 20 in Columbia, the first win over the Tigers since the 2008-09 season, and the first road win in the series since 2007-08.
- ONE OF THE GREATS: Entering 2020-21 with a career record of 767-194 (.798), Illinois head coach Nancy Fahey ranks among the greatest coaches in NCAA history. Among active NCAA coaches at all levels (Divisions I, II, and III), she is ninth in total victories and 21st in win percentage; all-time she is 21st by percentage and 20th in victories. And during her accomplished career she has become the fourth-fastest to reach 600 victories (706 games) trailing only Brian Morehouse of DIII Hope College (690), Mark Campbell of DII Union (TN) University (691), and Baylor's Kim Mulkey (700) and the second-fastest coach to 700 victories (826 games), trailing only UConn's Geno Auriemma (822).
- MORE HONORS FOR FAHEY: Illini head coach Nancy Fahey added another honor this offseason when she was selected for
 induction into the Missouri Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2020. It is the fifth Hall of
 Fame honor for Fahey, who became the first NCAA Division III representative to be inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall
 of Fame in 2012, and is also a member of the WashU Sports Hall of Fame (2012), Missouri Sports Hall of Fame (2014), and
 St. Louis Sports Hall of Fame (2016).

- KEY ILLINI RETURNERS: Illinois enters the 2020-21 with eight returning letterwinners, including four players junior J-Naya Ephraim (16 starts) and sophomores Jeanae Terry (11), Jada Peebles (11) and Kennedi Myles (29) that started at least 10 games in 2019-20. Myles, who recorded freshman records with eight double-doubles and 251 rebounds last year, ranks as the Illini's returning leader in scoring (8.9 points per game), rebounding (8.7 rpg), blocks (21) and steals (61). Terry led the Illini with 91 assists.
- SEVEN NEWCOMERS: The 2020-21 Illini roster also includes seven newcomers. The 2020 recruiting class is ranked 27th by BlueStar Basketball. Mid-year transfer Eva Rubin, a 6-5 redshirt junior center who returned to her home state after two seasons at Arizona State, gives the Illini a boost in the paint. The Illini also added size with 6-3 junior college forward/center Geovana Lopes, 6-1 sophomore forward Solape Amusan, and 6-3 freshman forward Erika Porter. Illinois signed a pair of all-state guards from Michigan in Aaliyah McQueen and Aaliyah Nye, plus walk-on junior guard Tara O'Malley, who starred as a prep at Chicago's Mother McAuley High School.
- LAST TIME OUT: The Fighting Illini pulled out a tight win, 53-50, over the Omaha Mavericks on Sunday (Dec. 6) afternoon at State Farm Center, behind double-digit scoring performances from Jada Peebles, Kennedi Myles, and Eva Rubin. Peebles led the Illini with 15 points. The sophomore guard shot 3-for-6 from three-point range, before sealing the win with a pair of free throws with just four seconds left in the contest. Myles recorded her second-consecutive double-double with 13 points and 14 rebounds. Rubin added a career-high 11 points.
- THIRD QUARTER THRIVING: After staking to a 24-22 halftime lead in the team's last outing vs. Omaha, the Fighting Illini outscored the Mavericks 19-11 in the third quarter to push the lead to double-digits. The strong start to the second half continued a trend for the Illini in 2020-21. Through three games, Illinois has outscored opponents in the third quarter by a combined 60-36, an average of eight points per contest.
- WINNING THE BATTLE OF THE BOARDS: The Fighting Illini have been an excellent rebounding team through three games to start the 2020-21 season. The Orange and Blue have finished with the rebounding edge in each of their contests, out-boarding Indiana State 42-40 in the opener, securing a 14-rebound edge, 47-33, vs. Valpo, and notching a 45-28 (+17) advantage against Omaha. The Illini enter Thursday's contest against Nebraska with an average margin of +11.0 rebounds per game, which ranks 32nd nationally, and first in the Big Ten.
- **GETTING DEFENSIVE:** Though two games, the Illini rank among the top-50 nationally in several defensive categories. The team has posted 14 total blocks thanks to seven rejections in the opener vs. Indiana State which ranks the Illini 45th in NCAA Division I. Overall, the team has allowed opponents to shoot just 33.3 percent, good enough to rank 34th nationally in field goal percentage defense. The Orange and Blue are also holding opponents to just 53.7 points per game, which ranks 23rd nationally.
- STRONG STARTS: The Illini have come out strong in each of the team's first three games this season, building early leads by stifling the opponents' offense in the first quarter. In the opener vs. Indiana State the Illini opened the game on an 8-0 run and led 10-1 before the Sycamores connected on their first field goal. Against Valpo, the Illini stormed out to a 10-2 lead in the first six minutes of the contest and led 13-6 heading into the second quarter. The Illini also held a 12-11 lead over Omaha, the third consecutive contest in which the team has led after the opening stanza. Combined, the Illini have allowed opponents to shoot just 11-for-36 (.301) in the opening stanza of games, including just 2-for-16 (.125) from beyond the arc. By contrast, the Illini have shot 16-for-43 (.372) overall while hitting 3-for-11 (.272) from three-point range. The Illini's aggressive starts have also led to more than double the first-quarter free-throw attempts (10) than their opponents (4).
- POST PRESENCE: A pair of Illini post players Eva Rubin and Geovana Lopes made their Orange and Blue debuts in the Illini's season-opening win over Indiana State. Rubin tallied career-high marks in minutes (23), rebounds (6) and blocks (4), eclipsing marks established during her time at Arizona State. Lopes Impressed in a reserve role, posting 12 points, six boards, two assists and a pair of steals in 15 minutes off the bench. Lopes started Game 2 vs. Valparaiso in place of the injured Rubin, and posted six points and five rebounds. And after returning to the lineup vs. Omaha (Dec. 6), Rubin posted a career-high 11 points.
- GUARDS GETTING TO THE LINE: The Fighting Illini's starting guard trio of J-Naya Ephraim, Jeanae Terry, and Jada Peebles, have been excellent at getting to the free-throw line, and converting. Through three games, the backcourt mates have combined to shoot 23-for-34 from the charity stripe. Ephraim is averaging a team-leading 4.7 attempts per game and shooting 9-for-14 (.643) while Terry has connected on 80 percent (8-for-10), and Peebles has been perfect (6-for-6), including a pair of clutch free-throws to seal the Omaha victory with four seconds left in the contest.
- YOUTH MOVEMENT: Through three games to open the 2020-21 season, the Fighting Illini underclassmen including four sophomores (Solape Amusan, Kennedi Myles, Jada Peebles and Jeanae Terry) and two freshmen (Aaliyah McQueen and Aaliyah Nye) have combined to play 356 of 600 (59 percent) of the team's available minutes. That young core has accounted for 67 percent of the team's scoring, 60 percent of rebounds, 70 percent of assists, 67 percent of steals and 64 percent of blocks. Those numbers could also see a boost as the Illini are still waiting for freshman F Erika Porter to make her debut in Orange and Blue.

- DOUBLE-DOUBLE PART 2: Sophomore G Jeanae Terry posted her first-career double-double in Illinois' game vs. Valparaiso (Dec. 2), finishing with 16 points, and a career-best 13 rebounds. With teammate Kennedi Myles notching a 14-point, 11-rebound double-double vs. the Crusaders, the sophomore duo became the first Illini teammates to record double-doubles in the same game since Nov. 24, 2018 when Alex Wittinger (32 points, 10 rebounds) and Brandi Beasley (10 points, 12 assists) accomplished the feat against Sacramento State.
- HOME SWEET HOME: Under head coach Nancy Fahey the Illini have found great success
 against non-conference opponents at State Farm Center. With a 2-1 mark in such games to
 open the 2020-21 season, the Illini are now 23-5 at home against non-conference foes under
 Fahey, following Sunday's win over the Omaha Mavericks. The Illini are slated to host one
 more non-conference game, Dec. 22 vs. Southern Illinois, following a pair of mid-December
 Big Ten matchups at Nebraska (Dec. 10) and vs. .Michigan (Dec. 19).
- PERSISTENCE OF PANAGIOTOPOULOU: After battling through injury for her first two-plus seasons at Illinois, redshirt-junior forward Nancy Panagiotopoulou entered the 2020-21 season in a position to contribute right away for the Illini, and has played 20 minutes combined in the Illini's first three games. Panagiotopoulou, who made her Illini debut Jan. 23, 2020 vs. No. 20 Maryland, saw action in eight of the Illini's final 12 games last season, and has now played in eight consecutive contests dating back to last season. Her 11 minutes vs. Valpo (Dec. 2) matched a career-high initially set during her Illini debut vs. Maryland last year.
- MOVING UP: The Illini added significant size to their roster for 2020-21. The 2019-20 roster averaged 70.7 inches or 5 feet, 11 inches with four players listed at 6 feet or above. This year, the average height of the team jumped by nearly two inches to 72.5 inches or 6-feet, ½ inch with seven Illini listed at or above 6 feet: Eva Rubin (6-5), Mackenzie Blazek (6-3), Geovana Lopes (6-3), Nancy Panagiotopoulou (6-3), Erika Porter (6-3), Kennedi Myles (6-2), and Solape Amusan (6-1)
- **RETURNING PRODUCTION:** Despite graduating six seniors who left their mark on the Illini record book, Illinois returns almost 60 percent of its production in nearly every major statistical category, except for scoring (41%).

- VALUING POSSESSIONS: The Illini continued a trend of minimizing turnovers under head
 coach Nancy Fahey In 2019-20. The Orange and Blue averaged 14.6 turnovers per contest,
 the fifth-best mark in program history. In Fahey's three seasons, the Illini have posted three
 of the top-five marks in the program record book including the fewest turnovers per game
 in a season (12.97) in 2018-19. At 14.6 turnovers per game, the Illini finished the season
 ranked sixth in the Big Ten and 102nd nationally.
- TERRY TAKIN' CARE: Sophomore guard Jeanae Terry recorded a team-leading 91 assists (3.1 per game) as a freshman for the Illini in 2019-20. With only 50 turnovers, she also paced the team with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.82, seventh in the Big Ten and 81st nationally. Her assist-to-turnover ratio ranked sixth in the nation among freshmen. Terry's 91 assists ranked sixth in a single-season by a freshman at Illinois. Through three games to open the 2020-21 season, Terry has dished out a team-leading eight assists, 2.7 per contest.


- YEAR 4 UNDER FAHEY: The 2020-21 campaign marks the fourth under Nancy Fahey, whose offseason contract extension ensures that the five-time national champion and Women's Basketball Hall of Famer will remain on the sideline for the Illini through at least the 2024-25 season. Under Fahey's guidance, the Fighting Illini have improved their win total each year, culminating with last season's 11-win campaign, the most for the program since 2014-15. The Illini opened the year with a 9-2 record against non-conference opponents, also the best mark for the program in 13 years, culminating with a 58-51 Braggin' Rights win over Missouri in Columbia.
- NEW FACES ON STAFF: Nancy Fahey added two veteran assistant coaches to the Fighting Illini coaching staff in the offseason, bringing Scott Merritt and Vernette Skeete from Marquette to Illinois where they complete the coaching staff along with John Patterson who returns for his second season as an assistant with the Illini. Merritt and Skeete each spent the previous six seasons with the Golden Eagles, helping build the program into a national power. Merritt, who helped lead MU to a 2003 Final Four as a player, returned to coaching at his alma mater following a nine-year professional playing career. Skeete, a native of Florida, who played at Alcorn State and Gulf Coast State College, joined Marquette after two seasons as the head coach at GCSC. Prior to that, she also served as an assistant at Miami, helping to build the Hurricanes into a top-25 program.
