Head Coach John Cook

Opening Statement

"Congratulations to Campbell for getting here. I hope they enjoyed the atmosphere. It was kind of a little bit of an adjustment to go from Wisconsin to Purdue to Campbell, but we are happy we got a win. We have another big match to take care of tomorrow. Tomorrow will be a great challenge. Glad we got out of here in three tonight."

On starting strong

"I thought we came out firing the ball around a little bit, and we passed great tonight. We held them to a negative. Anytime you hold someone to a negative hitting percentage, your defense has done a good job."

On Nebraska's passing tonight
