THE MATCHUP

Looking to complete unfinished business from last season, the Nebraska wrestling team heads to St. Louis for the 2021 NCAA Championships in the quest for a national title. The three-day event will consist of six sessions beginning Thursday morning at the Enterprise Center.

Nine grapplers compose the field for Nebraska at this year's national championship. Eight earned automatic bids as a result of their finishes at the Big Ten Championships, including Chad Red Jr. (141), Ridge Lovett (149), Caleb Licking (157), Peyton Robb (165), Mikey Labriola (174), Taylor Venz (184), Eric Schultz (197) and Christian Lance (285). Liam Cronin, who finished ninth at the conference championship at 125 pounds, earned an at-large bid.

Last Time Out: Nebraska finished third at the 2021 Big Ten Championships with 105.5 points. Lovett, Schultz and Venz led the team with second place finishes as eight Huskers finished top eight.

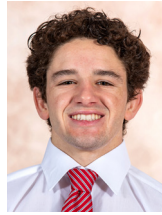

2019-20 RECAP

EIGHT GARNER ALL-AMERICA HONORS

Eight Huskers received All-America accolades at the conclusion of 2020 season. Chad Red Jr., Isaiah White, Taylor Venz and Eric Schultz rounded out the Huskers on the first-team. Collin Purinton and Mikey Labriola earned second-team honors. Ridge Lovett and Peyton Robb picked up Honorable Mention recognition.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Huskers finished second with 132 points at the 2020 Big Ten Championships, the program's best finish as a member of the conference. Eric Schultz (2nd -- 197 pounds) was the top individual finisher for Nebraska. Chad Red Jr. (141), Collin Purinton (149), Peyton Robb (157), Isaiah White (165) and Taylor Venz (184) placed third in their respective weight classes.

REGULAR SEASON

Nebraska finished the season No. 4 in the final national dual rankings with an 11-3 record. Nebraska went 6-3 in the Big Ten, which was good enough to tie for fourth in the regular-season Big Ten standings. The Huskers posted a 6-5 mark against ranked opponents.

NEBRASKA FINISHES THIRD AT BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Nebraska wrestling team finished third at the 2021 Big Ten Championships with 105.5 points for the program's seventh top-five finish at the event and sixth in as many years. The team was led by second-place finishes from Ridge Lovett (149), Taylor Venz (184) and Eric Schultz (197) and eight Huskers clinched automatic bids to the NCAA Championships.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The Huskers were rolling into the 2020 NCAA Championships following a program-best second-place finish at the Big Ten Championships and qualifying the entire lineup for the national championships when the event was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Huskers return to the national championship stage this year ready to finish what they set out to last season. Seven of Nebraska's 2021 qualifiers earned bids to last year's championships with three of them set to make their championships debut. The group returns to the national championship mats in search of the sixth consecutive top ten finish.

ALL-AMERICANS BACK FOR MORE

Six Huskers who were named All-Americans following the 2019-20 season return to the national champion stage once more. Nebraska's returning First-Team All-Americans include Chad Red Jr., Taylor Venz and Eric Schultz. Mikey Labriola earned Second-Team All-America honors last season and Ridge Lovett and Peyton Robb both earned Honorable Mention All-America accolades.

HUSKER VETERANS AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Four Huskers hit the NCAA Championships mats with prior experience competing at the event. Chad Red Jr., Eric Schultz and Taylor Venz are the most veteran Huskers to take the national championship stage, having qualified for the tournament every year since the 2017-18 season. Red Jr. leads the returners with three All-America honors, having placed seventh in 2018 and eighth in 2019. Venz earned his highest finish, and first All-America honor with a fourth-place finish at the 2018 championships. Mikey Labriola, who has competed at the championships once before and qualified twice prior to this season, earned his first All-America nod in 2019 with a sixth-place finish. Schultz is 4-4 overall at the tournament but has not placed in either of his previous two outings.

FIVE MAKE THEIR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS DEBUT

Nebraska's NCAA Championship lineup features five wrestlers who will be taking the national championship mat for the first time in their careers. Liam Cronin, Ridge Lovett and Peyton Robb each qualified for the 2020 championships, but would not have the opportunity to take the mat. Caleb Licking and Christian Lance both earned their first career NCAA Championships qualification this season following their performances at the Big Ten Championships to clinch a trip to St. Louis.

UNDEFEATED AT HOME

The win over Wisconsin on Jan. 31 closed the Huskers' 2021 regular season home schedule. Nebraska finished 4-0 at the Bob Devaney Sports Center this season, including wins over the Badgers, Minnesota, Northwestern and Maryland. The team finished undefeated at home for the first time since the 2007-08 season during which NU also hosted four duals.

CRONIN SHINES IN FIRST SEASON AT NEBRASKA

In his first season at Nebraska, Liam Cronin posted a 7-1 dual record for the Huskers, including two wins over ranked opponents. In his second consecutive appearance at the Big Ten Championships at 125 pounds, he finished ninth and earned an at-large bid to the 2021 NCAA Championships. His trip to St. Louis marks his second qualification for the national tournament and first time competing at the event.

BACK POINTS

RED JR. EYES FOURTH ALL-AMERICA HONOR

Headed into the 2021 NCAA Championships, Chad Red Jr. leads the Huskers with two prior All-American finishes at the national championship tournament. He earned his highest finish in 2017, coming in seventh place for the Huskers. The senior placed eighth in 2018 and earned an NWCA All-America honor last season despite the cancellation of the championships. He is a combined 9-5 at the tournament in two outings. Entering the NCAA Championships, he most recently finished fourth at the Big Ten Championships and has an overall record of 10-3 this season.

LOVETT CARRIES B1G CONFERENCE SUCCESS INTO NCAAs

Following a runner-up finish at the Big Ten Championships, Ridge Lovett looks to continue his momentum into the NCAA Championships. In the quarterfinals of the conference tournament, he defeated two seed Max Murin (Iowa) to put him on his way to the 149-pound title match. During the regular season, he was one of three Nebraska wrestlers to finish undefeated. The sophomore earned three wins in extra matches against grapplers from Iowa, Northwestern and Michigan State. In varsity duals, he added bonus points for the Huskers, with a major decision over Michigan State's Peyton Omania and a technical fall over Danny Pucino.

LICKING RIDES RECENT SUCCESS INTO FIRST NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS APPEARANCE

After a slow start to the 2020-21 season, Caleb Licking looks to continue his recent success into the national championship tournament. Earning the starting spot at 157 pounds this season, Licking made his first Big Ten Championships appearance for his career, finishing seventh and earning an automatic qualification to NCAAs. Following an 0-3 start to the season, the Norfolk, Neb. native earned his first win of the season against Maryland on Jan. 23. The senior is 5-6 overall this season.

ROBB SET FOR FIRST NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS OUTING

Following a fourth-place finish at the 2021 Big Ten Championships, Peyton Robb will take his first trip to the NCAA Championships this season. He qualified last season, but would not see any action with the cancellation of the tournament in 2020. The sophomore is 9-5 on the year for Nebraska headed into the national championship weekend.

LABRIOLA AIMS TO EXTEND 2020-21 SUCCESS INTO THE POSTSEASON

Mikey Labriola earned a career-high third place finish at the Big Ten Championships this season to automatically qualify for the NCAA Championships. He has competed at the national championships once before, finishing sixth to earn All-America honors. He finished the 2020-21 regular season undefeated in eight duals, including four major decisions and one fall. He is 11-1 on the season and 61-20 overall for his career.

VENZ READY FOR ANOTHER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP TRIP

Taylor Venz makes his third trip to the NCAA Championships this weekend after earning his fourth bid with a second place finish at the Big Ten Championships. The runner-up finish is his best result at the conference championship, after improving every year since placing fourth in 2019. The senior is 9-4 at the NCAA Championships and earned his best finish in 2018, coming in fourth.

SCHULTZ AIMS TO EXTEND WINNING SEASON

Eric Schultz, who finished second at the conference championship, enters the NCAA Championships as the highest seeded Husker at No. 2 at 197 pounds. Schultz continued his winning ways into the postseason, picking up two wins in his first two matches, but ultimately fell in the title match. He has qualified for four NCAA Championships in his career and has an overall record of 4-4 at the event. He looks to place for the first time at the event this year.

LANCE MAKES NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS DEBUT

As the Huskers' starter at heavyweight this season, Christian Lance has earned himself a spot in the Nebraska NCAA Championships lineup. This will be his first NCAA Championships appearance. After splitting time at starter with David Jenson last season, Lance emerged as the front-runner for the Huskers this season and finished the regular season 5-3 in duals. Highlighting his regular season wins includes a sudden victory 4-2 decision against then-ranked No. 7 Trent Hillger to secure the Huskers' win over Wisconsin on Jan. 31. Lance went on to finish 5th at the Big Ten Championships to earn an automatic qualification to the NCAA Championships.

MANNING CONTINUES NEBRASKA WRESTLING'S EXCELLENCE IN DECADE NO. 3 AT THE HELM

In his third decade at the helm of the Huskers, Nebraska wrestling Head Coach Mark Manning has amassed a 264-97-3 record at Nebraska with seven wins this season. Manning led Nebraska to yet another successful season as the team earned its most conference wins in a single season since winning seven duals against Big Ten foes in 2017-18. The Huskers' seven victories this year ties the team's most conference victories since joining the Big Ten Conference. Though abbreviated compared to years past, this season is the first time since 2014-15 that the Huskers have only given up one dual loss on the year.

NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

- The 2021 NCAA DI Wrestling Championships are set for March 18-20 at the Enterprise Center in St. Louis, Mo.
- The Big Ten boasts nine of the 10 top-seeded wrestlers, including Iowa's Spencer Lee (125), Jaydin Eierman (141), Alex Marinelli (165) and Michael Kemerer (174) and Ohio State's Sammy Sasso (149), Northwestern's Ryan Deakin (157), Penn State's Aaron Brooks (184), Michigan's Myles Amine (197) and Minnesota's Gable Steveson (285).
- This year marks the first time in two years that wrestlers will set foot on the NCAA Championship mats. Before the 2020 NCAA Championships were canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Nebraska qualified its entire lineup for the national championships for the first time since 2016. Eric Schultz led the group with a three-seed at 197 pounds and Isaiah White (165) followed with a No. 5 seed. Chad Red Jr. (141) was seeded sixth followed by Taylor Venz (184) and Collin Purinton (149) with No. 7 seeds. Rounding out the top ten seeded Huskers was Mikey Labriola (174) at No. 10.
- The Huskers are led by two-seed Eric Schultz at 197 pounds.
- The Huskers have had 11 NCAA Champions, 24 NCAA finalists, 120 All-Americans and 23 top-10 team finishes. NU has finished in the top 10 in the past five NCAA Championships. Take a look at Nebraska's NCAA finishes over the last 10 years:
