HUSKERS HEAD TO CROOKED STICK FOR BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIP

The Nebraska men's golf team begins postseason play this weekend by competing at the 2021 Big Ten Championship in Carmel, Ind., April 30-May 2.

The Huskers will be part of a 14-team field on the 7,325-yard, par-72 layout at Crooked Stick Golf Club, which was the first great golf course designed by Pete Dye in 1964. Dye also designed Firethorn Golf Club in Lincoln, which played host to Nebraska's last tournament - the Git-R-Done Husker Invitational (April 17-18).

The Big Ten Championship will cover three days of competition, beginning with tee times on Friday, April 30 at 8 a.m. (CT). The tournament continues with the second round on Saturday at 8 a.m., before concluding with Sunday's final round at 7 a.m. (CT).

Live scoring for the event will be available at GolfStat.com.

Nebraska's five-player lineup in count-four scoring will be led by freshman Jack Lundin, who owns three straight top-12 finishes, including a tie for fifth at the Git-R-Done Husker Invitational with a career-best even-par 213 (April 17-19). Lundin, who is a contender for Big Ten Freshmanof-the-Year honors, tied for fourth at the Hoosier Invitational (April 3-4) in his last trip to Indiana. He also tied for 12th at the Aggie Invitational (April 9-11) and leads Nebraska with a 73.67 stroke average through 12 rounds this season.

Tom Westenberger has added three straight top-20 finishes for the Big Red, including top-10 showings at the Aggie Invitational with a career-best 217 and at the Hoosier Invitational. Westenberger ranks second among the Huskers with a 74.58 stroke average this season.

HUSKER NEWCOMERS MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT ON LINEUP

While the Nebraska roster features eight returning lettermen from 2019-20, the Huskers also showcase a talented five-player class of freshmen.

Jack Lundin, who was a two-time high school state champion and the South Dakota Men's Amateur Champion in 2019, was Nebraska's top finisher by tying for fourth (71-75-75) at the Hoosier Invitational (April 3-4). He followed that up with a 218 (71-77-70) to tie for 12th in a 96-player field at a loaded Aggie Invitational (April 9-11), before notching a tie for fifth with a career-best 213 (70-72-71) at the Git-R-Done Husker Invitational (April 17-18).

"We are looking forward to the competition this weekend," Lundin said. "We will be focused on playing our best golf possible and just staying in the moment. We are worried about expectations or the other Big Ten teams, we are just going to focus on us and playing our best golf."

Lundin also led the Huskers with a 3-1 individual record at the 2021 Big Ten Match Play.

Redshirt freshman Jeremy Sisson (Skaneateles, N.Y.) played out of the top of Nebraska's lineup in Indiana after making his competitive debut as NU's top finisher at the Lamkin San Diego Classic with a 231. His opening-round 73 in Indiana was a key to NU's first-round 296 team score. He added a 74 in the final round at the Aggie Invitational to help the Huskers to a 294 in the final round.

Sisson, who produced Nebraska's best individual round at the Nebraska Open with a final-round 66 (-6) during the fall, redshirted at Arkansas in 2019-20.

Freshman Gentry Scheve (Emporia, Kan.) led the Nebraska Open entering the final day after rounds of 68 and 67 to head to the last 18 holes at 9-under par. Scheve was a two-time first-team Kansas Class

5A all-state selection in high school. He closed 2019 ranked No. 42 nationally in the Golfweek ratings.

Fellow Kansas standout Will Harding also brings a distinguished background to the Big Red roster. Harding was the Midwest PGA Student-Athlete of the Year in 2019 and was a first-team Kansas Class 6A all-stater as a junior after leading Shawnee Mission East to its second straight state title.

True freshman Reed Malleck (York, Neb.) rounds out Nebraska's group of newcomers. The No. 1 golfer in the state of Nebraska in the class of 2020, Malleck was the 2020 Nebraska Junior Match Play Champion after earning first-team Nebraska Super-State accolades in 2019.

EXPERIENCED GOLFERS GIVE HUSKERS REASON FOR OPTIMISM

NJCAA All-American Tom Westenberger has been a consistent force for the Huskers near the top of the lineup throughout the season. The senior from Wuppertal, Germany was Nebraska's top finisher at the Aggie Invitational (April 9-11), tying for sixth with a career-best 217 (71-73-73).

Westenberger also tied for seventh a week earlier at the Hoosier Invitational. Most recently, he added a third straight top-20 finish by tying for 18th at the Git-R-Done Husker Invitational (April 17-18).

Senior Mark Foelbaek, who was an NJCAA All-American in 2019 before transferring to Nebraska, had an outstanding summer and fall after adjusting to NCAA Division I competition as a junior in 2019-20. Foelbaek won the Nebraska Open (Sept. 11-13) at Elks Country Club in Columbus with a 204 (-12) with rounds of 69-68-67.

Foelbaek earned a lineup spot for the Big Ten Championship on the strength of an NU careerbest 213 to tie for fifth at the Git-R-Done Husker Invitational. Foelback's performance included a Husker career-best final-round 67 (-4).

A third Husker NJCAA All-American, Branden Meyer competed in all 12 rounds and four matches at the Big Ten Match Play this season. However, he did not crack the lineup for the Huskers at the Big Ten Championship.

Junior Caleb Badura joined Foelbaek in earning lineup spots for the conference tournament by matching Foelbaek and Jack Lundin in a tie for fifth with a career-best 213 (72-68-73) at the Git-R-Done Husker Invitational. Badura's performance came outside the NU lineup at Firethorn and marked his first three stroke play rounds of the spring.

Badura tied for ninth at the Nebraska Open with a 209 (-7) and was a significant contributor in a shortened 2019-20 season, including a historymaking 4-0 record at the 2020 Big Ten Match Play.

Sophomore Will Marshall earned a lineup spot for the fourth straight event at the Big Ten Championship. Marshall's final-round 72 at the Hoosier Invitational was NU's best score of the day, as he finished in a career-best tie for 39th (232). He added consistent rounds of 77-76-77 to finish at 230 and provide scores in all three rounds at Texas A&M.

"I have learned a lot and my game is improving," Marshall said. "I am trying to just stay committed to every shot, see the flight of the ball and use my athleticism to play some good golf. I think we are developing a great culture with guys who care about each other a lot and love playing golf."

Nebraska's individual stroke average leader the past two seasons, graduate student Tanner Owen returns for a fifth season after being granted an additional year of eligibility along with other NCAA golfers because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

In 2018-19, Owen posted a 72.86 average and tied for 16th at the Big Ten Championship.

HANKINS IN THIRD SEASON AS NEBRASKA'S HEAD COACH

An outstanding coach with a record of success at the NCAA Division I and Big Ten Conference levels, Mark Hankins has the Nebraska men's golf program on the rise as he enters his third season in Lincoln.

In 2020-21, a senior-laden roster that includes fifth-year golfer and graduate student Tanner Owen, will lead the Big Red. The five-player class includes three 2019 NJCAA All-Americans (Mark Foelbaek, Branden Meyer and Tom Westenberger).

Hankins led Nebraska to its best Big Ten Match Play Championship finishes in history by taking fourth in 2019 and 2020. He also guided the Huskers to their best-ever Big Ten finish by capturing fifth at the 2019 conference tournament.

One of only three active coaches to lead a team to a Big Ten Conference men's golf title, Hankins came to Nebraska after serving as an assistant athletic director at Iowa. He enters his fifth year as a member of the NCAA Division I Men's Golf Committee.

Overall, in 17 seasons as a Big Ten men's golf head coach, Hankins has coached five All-Americans, 21 golfers who earned All-Big Ten honors, including two Big Ten Players of the Year and a Big Ten Freshman of the Year. His student-athletes also earned a total of 55 Academic All-Big Ten accolades and 12 All-America Scholar awards from the Golf Coaches Association of America (GCAA).

2020 SPRING SEASON RECAP

Nebraska opened 2020 at the Big Ten Match Play Championship, Feb. 7-8, at Hammock Beach Resort in Palm Coast, Fla. Nebraska won by tiebreaker in a 3-3 match against No. 4 seed Ohio State. Later the same day, the Huskers improved to 2-0 with an impressive 3.5-2.5 victory over Michigan State.

The Huskers secured a fourth-place finish despite a 4-2 loss to Northwestern and a 3.5-2.5 loss to Maryland on the final day. Caleb Badura provided the biggest highlight by becoming the first Husker to go 4-0 at the Big Ten Match Play. Meyer added a 3-1 match play performance for the Big Red.

Badura led the Huskers a month later at the Desert Mountain Intercollegiate in Arizona (March 7-8). The Aurora, Neb., native tied for 21st with a 223 (+7), while Meyer added a tie for 32nd (226) to help Nebraska to a ninth-place team finish.

The Aggie (April 4-5), Git-R-Done Husker (April 11-12), the Hawkeye (April 18-19) invitationals and the Big Ten Championships (May 1-3) were canceled.

Tanner Owen capped his 2020 season by earning his bachelor's degree from Nebraska, while being named a Golf Coaches Association of America Scholar All-American, a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar and Academic All-Big Ten. Owen was also NU's Big Ten Sportsmanship Award winner.

Branden Meyer joined Owen as a GCAA Scholar All-American, while Daniel Pearson and Patrick Clare added Academic All-Big Ten honors of their own.
