RE: Managing Pitching

"KP (Kyle Perry), we felt like we liked the match-up there and after what Shay (Schanaman) had given us in the first game to help set that up with KP there. He's gradually built himself up, we're gonna let him go as far as he could tonight, within reason. He was probably at the end of his rope there, one batter too long honestly. We wanted to leave him in there to get the lefty and it put Spencer (Schwellenbach) in a tough spot there. We were hoping to get him through four initially and then five, maybe getting a little greedy there. I thought his stuff was outstanding. His fastball was great, the command was good. He flipped the breaking ball in there. I thought he just competed with the heart of a champion tonight. It was very, very impressive."

"It actually worked out the way that we planned it out. Hand it off to Schwelly, after Perry. If we had to go to somebody else, if Schwelly just couldn't get through the game then we were gonna do that. It worked out, Schwelly gave us everything that he had. Every last drop of everything in his being, he gave it to his team and it was pretty special."

RE: Defining Team

"Win or lose, you have to have that dog in you. You have to have that fight. You've gotta have that heart, to where no matter what's going on around you you're gonna be all about the throwdown and that's what these guys have been about all year long. We've had double headers. We've been in tough spots. I knew our guys were going to come out and compete today. We didn't come here just to do that, we've got another game to finish tomorrow. It was what we've seen all year long and that's what we're gonna hang our hats on."

"Just in general, sparking. They had the leadoff home run yesterday, we had the home run in the first inning today. Just kind of gives you that extra boost in your dugout and being on the barrel early in the game. I thought we had a lot of good at bats. I thought we squared a lot of balls up. Just setting the tone in the first inning sometimes can be a big difference."

GRIFFIN EVERITT, Nebraska Catcher

RE: Emotions After The Win

"It was nothing but pure joy and happiness. We all love each other and we're not ready to be done yet. We know we have to come back tomorrow and beat them again. Definitely going to cherish this and remember it forever, but we have to come back tomorrow and win a game."

RE: Base Hit In The Fifth Inning

"Coach Bolt told me to stay on the fastball and not get away from it. I went up there and I think I got, first pitch breaking ball and I took it and I was just waiting for that fastball. Just trusting my approach and slowing the moment down trying not to let it get too much to me and putting a good swing on the ball."

"I think that showed today at the highest level. This is an electric atmosphere, fans were on their feet. Do or die game for us. I think all the preparation that we've had leading up to this really showed tonight."

"Hit your spots. Throw a lot of strikes. No free bags. Mix up your pitches. I did that tonight and it paid off."

"I was running out of gas. That was probably my longest outing of the year. My whole body was sore and just trying to fight through it and I wasn't really nervous at all. I've been in big moments and I got through it. That's all that matters."
