The Nebraska softball team travels to Cedar Falls, Iowa this weekend for a five-game tournament at the UNI Dome. The tournament begins with a game against Omaha Friday at 9 a.m. followed by a game against tournament-host Northern Iowa at 1:30 p.m. On Saturday, the Huskers will take on Iowa State at 8 a.m. and Drake at 10:15 a.m. The final game of the tournament is set for 9 a.m. on Sunday against South Dakota State.

This weekend's tournament features three teams that made it to the NCAA Tournament in 2021. Northern Iowa, Iowa State and South Dakota State all reached the Regional round of the post-season.

The Huskers have 14 returners including Courtney Wallace, an NFCA All-Midwest Region selection, and Billie Andrews, a first-team All-Big Ten selection. NU returns all five pitchers from the 2021 roster, including senior Olivia Ferrell. Three newcomers were added to the 2022 roster. Freshmen Mckinley Malecha and Ava Bredwell both add depth to the catching position. Junior-transfer Mya Felder joins the Huskers after spending two years at Oregon and one year at New Mexico State and is expected to start at first base.

A live video stream of each game will be available on ESPN3, while a free radio call will be available on Huskers.com, courtesy of the Husker Radio Network.

### QUICK HITTERS

- This is Nebraska's third time playing at the UNI Dome Tournament.
- Nebraska returns all five pitchers from last year to the 2022 roster.
- The Huskers added **Mya Felder** to the 2022 roster. Felder was a NFCA All-Pacific Region selection at Oregon.
- NU is 9-0 at the UNI Dome Tournament under Head Coach Rhonda Revelle.
- The Big Red will face South Dakota State two more times after this weekend.
- Iowa State and NU meet against next weekend at the Troy Cox Classic.
- The Huskers face Omaha to start their season. The last time NU saw the Mavs was in 2019, when Nebraska won 4-3. NU currently leads the series, 21-11.
- NU holds a 20-4 record against Northern Iowa. The last meeting between these two teams was in 2016, when the Huskers won 7-4.
- Nebraska will face Iowa State for the first time since 2017. This will be the 89th meeting between the two teams. NU currently leads the series. 69-19.
- South Dakota State and Nebraska meet on Sunday for the first time since 2019. The Huskers are 19-0 against the Jackrabbits.

A first-team Big Ten selection, **Billie Andrews** is expected to make an impact in the lineup. The sophomore ranked 5th in the Big Ten in RBIs, 6th in runs and 7th in home runs in 2021.

## NEBRASKA 2022 SEASON NOTEBOOK

- Nebraska's roster features 18 players from seven different states.
- The roster features seven Nebraska natives.
- The roster features three newcomers including two freshmen and one transfer.
- **Rhonda Revelle** is in her 30th season leading her alma mater in 2022. Revelle is the second-longest serving female head coach in the history of Nebraska Athletics.
- Revelle owns 1,020 wins at Nebraska. She is the all-time wins leader (male or female) in the history of Nebraska Athletics.
- Associate Head Coach **Lori Sippel** is in her 33rd year at Nebraska. Sippel is the longest-tenured female assistant coach in the history of Nebraska Athletics.
- Revelle (1981-83) and Sippel (1985-88) also played for NU. Including their playing and coaching careers, Revelle and Sippel have been a part of 1,324 of Nebraska's 1,501 all-time victories (88 percent).
- Assistant coach **Diane Miller** rounds out the Husker coaching staff. In her 14th season, Miller has helped Nebraska's offense set more than 40 school records.
- Fifth year senior **Olivia Ferrell** took advantage of the NCAA waiver for an extra year of eligibility due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- **Courtney Wallace** and **Mya Felder** both received NFCA All-Region honors after their performances during the 2021 season. Wallace earned NFCA All-

Midwest Region second team honors. Felder earned NFCA All-Pacific Region honors after her performance at Oregon.

- **Billie Andrews** had a standout freshman season in 2021. The Gretna, Neb., native, was one of only two freshmen named to the 18-player All-Big Ten first team. Andrews will look to repeat those honors during the 2022 season.
- NU added two freshmen catchers to the roster. **Mckinley Malecha** and **Ava Bredwell** are both expected to add depth to the position.
- The Huskers face their first non-conference opponent since March 8, 2020. NU is set to face 25 non-conference opponents during the 2022 season.
- Nebraska will travel to eight different states during the 2022 season including Iowa, New Mexico, Arkansas, California, Kansas, Michigan, Wisconsin and Ohio.
- The Big Red will host 17 games at Bowlin Stadium in 2022. The schedule will feature only 15 home dates as two of the dates will be doubleheaders.

**NEBRASKA RETURNERS EXPECTED TO MAKE IMPACT IN LINEUP**

Nebraska hit .250, scored 190 runs and slugged 37 homeruns in 2021 against a difficult conference-only schedule. The Huskers return 14 to the roster, all of which are expected to be impactful in the offensive lineup.

- **Billie Andrews** will continue to be a leader for the Huskers offensively. The first-team All-Big Ten selection ranked 5th in the Big Ten in RBIs (31), 6th in runs (32) and 7th in home runs (7) in 2021.
- Although expected to spend most of her time in the circle, **Olivia Ferrell** can make an impact offensively as well. The fifth-year senior averages a .211, tallying 27 hits and 19 RBIs during her career at NU.
- **Brooke Andrews** is a versatile player from Gretna, Neb., that will help the Big Red. Andrews added 20 hits and 14 RBIs for NU in 2021.
- Sophomore **Sydney Gray** returns to the lineup after suffering a season-ending injury at the start of 2021. In just 15 games, Gray tallied 15 hits, five doubles, one homerun and 8 RBIs.
- **Peyton Glatter** started 33 games last season and is expected to be a constant in lineup this year. Glatter tallied 19 RBIs on 20 hits and finished the season reaching base safely in a career-high eight straight games.
- Sophomore **Kaylin Kinney** started a team-high 20 games as the designated player in 2021. Kinney will most likely play a critical role as the DP this season after notching 20 hits, four homeruns and 11 RBIs last year.
- The NFCA All-Midwest Region selection, **Courtney Wallace**, will serve as a leader of the 2022 team.
- **Abbie Squier**, the Lincoln, Neb., native, made 10 starts as a freshmen in the outfield and is looking to make a bigger impact offensively this year. In 2021, Squier added five hits and two doubles on the season.
- Earning 21 starts last season, **Caitlynn Neal** is expected to see time in the outfield and in the circle.
- Senior **Anni Raley** will the Huskers behind the plate as the projected starting catcher. Raley adds offensive experience, hitting .245 and with 7 RBIs in 2021.
