HUSKERS CLOSE REGULAR SEASON AT LADY BUCKEYE INVITATIONAL

The Nebraska women's golf team returns to action after a month off from competition to take on a strong 10-team field at the Lady Buckeye Invitational in Columbus, Ohio, April 15-16.

The Huskers, who are fighting to stay in contention for an NCAA Regional bid, have spent the past month focusing on their individual games after a tie for 11th at the 17-team Briar's Creek Invitational in South Carolina (March 14-15).

The Lady Buckeye will serve as a final tune-up for the Big Ten Championship, which will be held in Pittsburgh (Fox Chapel CC), April 22-24. The Lady Buckeye's 10-team field is filled with seven Big Ten schools, including No. 25 Illinois, No. 35 Michigan State, the hosts and No. 57 Ohio State, No. 62 Maryland, No. 70 Nebraska, No. 92 Penn State and No. 117 Rutgers. Perennial No. 44 Kent State, Xavier and NCAA Division II power Indianapolis round out the field.

The Huskers will travel to Ohio on Wednesday and take part in Thursday's practice round before the first two rounds of competition begin with a shotgun start at 7:30 a.m. (CT) on Friday. Saturday's final round is set to begin with tee times at 7:30 a.m. (CT).

Live scoring for the Lady Buckeye Invitational will be provided by GolfStat.com.

The Lady Buckeye features a six-count-four scoring format identical to the Big Ten Championship. Nebraska senior Kirsten Baete will play out of the top spot in the Husker lineup, ahead of No. 2 Megan Whittaker, who has posted six consecutive top-25 finishes. Vanessa Bouvet will occupy the No. 3 spot, while freshman Miu Takahashi will play out of the No. 4 position. Michaela Vavrova and Nicole Hansen round out the Big Red's lineup in Ohio.

EXPERIENCED HUSKERS BUILDING ON HISTORY-MAKING 2021 SEASON

Coach Lisa Johnson looks to complete her first full season as Nebraska's head coach in her third overall year in Lincoln. Johnson's first year at Nebraska ended abruptly in 2019-20 because of the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic.

In 2020-21, Big Ten schools did compete as teams during the fall campaign, but Johnson led the Huskers to one of the best springs in school history.

Powered by 2021 Big Ten Champion Kate Smith, the Huskers stormed to a tie for second at the Big Ten Championship - Nebraska's best conference tournament finish since 1984 (2nd, Big Eight).

The Huskers earned their 12th NCAA Regional bid in school history, hearing their name called for the first time since 2008.

Nebraska tied for 15th in the 18-team Columbus Regional, and the returning collection of Huskers are hoping to build on the success of 2020-21.

Although All-American Kate Smith and graduate Alice Duan are both gone from the Big Red lineup, the Huskers return four of their top six golfers from the 2021 Big Ten Championship run.

Kirsten Baete (T16, 218) and Megan Whittaker (T18, 219) lead Nebraska's lineup on and off the course as experienced veterans. Michaela Vavrova and Lindsey Thiele were also major contributors in their first seasons at Nebraska in 2020-21 and could be poised to show significant gains in their games.

BAETE, WHITTAKER PROVIDING LEADERSHIP FOR 2022 HUSKERS

Kirsten Baete, who is in her fifth season, owns Nebraska's best scoring average (73.88) this season and NU's top returning average from a year ago.

The Beatrice, Neb., native helped spark Nebraska's late-season run in 2021 with her fourth-place finish to help the Huskers claim the team title at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Intercollegiate.

Baete added a final-round 70 (-2) to help the Big Red surge to a tie for second at the Big Ten Championship, as she tied for 16th individually with a season-best 218. She won the Nebraska Women's Match Play Championship to highlight a solid summer of preparation for the 2021-22 campaign.

Baete closed the 2021 fall season with the best performance of her career in winning the White Sands Intercollegiate in the Bahamas (Oct. 22-24). Baete fired a career-best 206 that included back-to-back rounds of 67 before closing with a final-round 72. She led the Huskers to a runner-up team finish that included wins over 2021 NCAA qualifiers Miami and Mercer. Not only did Baete bag her first

collegiate title, she added the first Big Ten Golfer-of-the-Week award of her career (Oct. 27).

Baete opened the fall as Nebraska's top finisher at the Wolverine Invite, tying for 40th at 223, including an even-par 71 in the first round. She added a tie for fifth to lead NU's "A" lineup at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invite (Sept. 20-21). She tied for 14th (219) at the Dale McNamara Invitational (Oct. 11-12).

Baete notched back-to-back ties for 17th (Tulane Classic, Westbrook Invitational) to open the spring and owns five top-25 finishes on the season. She matched her career best with a second-round 66 (-6) at Tulane, before adding a 215 (-1) at Westbrook that included a final-round 68 (-4).

Fellow Nebraskan Megan Whittaker was also a major player in NU's postseason push in 2021. The second generation Husker from Elkhorn tied for 18th at the Big Ten Championship with a season-best 219.

A consistent contributor for four seasons, Whittaker produced one of the best performances of her career with a tie for sixth at 215 (-1) with teammate Vanessa Bouvet at the Dale McNamara Invitational (Oct. 11-12). She closed the fall with a tie for 13th (218) at the White Sands Intercollegiate.

Whittaker opened the spring by going 3-0 at the Big Ten Match Play before adding a top-25 finish at the Tulane Classic. She produced the best effort of her career to tie for seventh with a career-best 209 (-7) at the Westbrook Spring Invitational (Feb. 27-28) on her way to the first Big Ten Golfer-of-the-Week award of her career (March 2).

Whittaker claimed her sixth straight top-25 finish with her tie for 18th at the Briar's Creek Invitational (March 14-15). Her 73.95 stroke average ranks second among the Huskers this season.

A three-time WGCA Scholastic All-American alongside Baete, Whittaker is the daughter of former Husker women's golfer Kim (Lefler) Whittaker, who was a member of Nebraska's first-ever NCAA Regional team in 1994.

BOUVET RETURNS TO LINEUP WITH THREE TOP-10 FALL FINISHES

Vanessa Bouvet produced a breakout 2021 fall campaign with three consecutive top-10 finishes.

A fourth-year Husker from Brunei by way of France, Bouvet had an outstanding season as a true freshman in 2018-19, posting a 75.79 stroke average over 24 rounds. A big hitter with an aggressive approach, Bouvet was unable to crack Nebraska's lineup last season after playing just six rounds in a COVID-19 shortened campaign in 2019-20.

However, Bouvet's game continued to improve and she represented Nebraska at the 2021 PGA WORKS Collegiate Championship, where she tied for fifth with teammate Noor Ahmed to earn a Symetra Tour Invite to the Guardian Championship.

Bouvet just missed a lineup spot to open the fall of 2021 at Michigan, before tying for fifth at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21). She added a tie for seventh at The Molly Collegiate (Sept. 27-28), before leading the Huskers with a tie for sixth (215, -1) at the Dale McNamara Invitational (Oct. 11-12). She closed the fall with a tie for 17th (221) at the White Sands Intercollegiate (Oct. 22-24).

Bouvet tied for 13th with a career-best 213 (-3) at the Westbrook Spring Invitational (Feb. 27-28) to help Nebraska to a runner-up team finish.

SOPHOMORES VAVROVA, THIELE HELP SOLIDIFY HUSKER LINEUP

Two more regulars in Nebraska's 2021 spring lineup return with second-year golfers Michaela Vavrova and Lindsey Thiele.

Vavrova, a member of the Slovakian Elite National Team, competed in all 21 rounds in the Husker lineup last season and posted Nebraska's fourth-best stroke average (76.33). She notched three consecutive top-25 finishes at the Arizona Wildcat, Allstate Sugar Bowl and Indiana Spring Invitational tournaments. Vavrova also put up a solid 224 to tie for 33rd individually in helping Nebraska at the Big Ten Championship, before posting NU's No. 2 finish at the NCAA Columbus Regional with her tie for 45th (229). She closed her first season in Lincoln with 16 consecutive rounds of 78 or better.

Vavrova captured her first career collegiate title by firing a career-best 217 (+1) over three rounds at the Stampede at The Creek in Elkhorn, Neb. (Oct. 4-5). She was named the Big Ten Co-Golfer of the Week (Oct. 6, 2021), and closed the 2021 fall campaign strong with her tie for 10th (217) that included a career-best second-round 69 (-3) to help the Huskers to a runner-up team finish.

Thiele competed in 15 rounds for the Huskers last season. The Wahoo, Neb., native who is the most recent of three sisters (Haley, Hannah) to play golf for the Big Red, was NU's sixth golfer in the count-four format at the Big Ten Championship.

Thiele's freshman season was highlighted by a tie for 23rd with a season-best 229 to help NU to the team title at the Allstate Sugar Bowl Intercollegiate.

She produced a career performance when she shared medalist honors with Nicole Hansen at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invite (Sept. 20-21). Thiele opened with the best two rounds of her career (70-71) on her way to a career-best 219 (+3) at Colbert Hills. Thiele's effort earned her Big Ten Co-Golfer-of-the-Week honors with Hansen (Sept. 22).

An outstanding student, Thiele is a Regents Scholar at Nebraska and was one of six Huskers to earn WGCA Scholastic All-America honors in 2021.

FRESHMEN MAKING IMPACT

In addition to Nebraska's six returning golfers, three freshmen have made impacts for the Huskers.

Miu Takahashi (Nasu-machi, Japan) has been the most consistent newcomer to the Big Red lineup. She owns a 76.39 stroke average over 23 rounds and has made six lineup appearances.

Takahashi produced a career-best 219 (+3) to tie for 30th at the Westbrook Spring Invitational (Feb. 27-28). She tied for fifth individually with a 222 to help Nebraska's "B" lineup to the team title at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21).

Takahashi earned a lineup spot to open her college career at the 2021 Wolverine Invitational (Sept. 13-14). She closed the fall with three straight lineup appearances, including a tie for 18th (226) at The Molly Collegiate and a tie for 25th (224) at the White Sands Intercollegiate. 22-24).

One of the top young golfers in Colombia, Andrea Velez spent the 2021 spring semester in Lincoln after having her initial arrival to campus delayed by COVID-19 restrictions in the fall of 2020.

Velez broke through on the international stage with an 11th-place finish at the Optimist

International Junior Golf Championship at Trump National Doral in July of 2019. She was also the 2018 Colombian Junior Champion.

In her collegiate debut, Velez helped Nebraska's "B" lineup to the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational title by producing a top-20 individual finish with three rounds of 75 (225, +9).

Lena Hassert (Kreuzau, Germany) is a two-time Austrian Junior Stroke Play champion and a German National Championship runner-up (2017). Hassert made her college debut inside NU's five-player lineup at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21).

SUTHERLAND ADDS EXPERIENCE TO BIG RED COACHING STAFF

Long-time college head coach Jeanne Sutherland was named the Associate Head Coach for the Husker women's golf program on July 1, 2021.

Sutherland came to Nebraska after spending the past 10 seasons (2011-21) as the head coach at SMU. She previously spent 15 seasons as the head coach at Texas A&M (1992-2007).

In 2018, Sutherland was named the inaugural winner of the WGCA Kim Evans Award. She also earned the WGCA Founders Award in 2017.

A four-time conference coach of the year at Texas A&M (3 Big 12, 1 Southwest Conference), Sutherland was also a two-time NCAA Regional Coach of the Year (1997, 2007). She led 13 Texas A&M teams to NCAA Regional play, including four NCAA Championship appearances in 1997 (17th), 2004 (24th), 2005 (22nd) and 2006 (19th).

ALL-AMERICAN SMITH ETCHES NAME IN HUSKER GOLF HISTORY IN 2021

Kate Smith won Nebraska's first-ever Big Ten women's golf individual title and the Huskers produced their best conference finish since a runner-up finish in the Big Eight in 1984, as the Huskers tied for second at TPC River's Bend in Maineville, Ohio.

Smith tied her own school record with a final-round 64 (-8) to finish at 207 (-9) to defeat runner-up Irene Kim from Northwestern by three strokes. Smith became Nebraska's first conference champion since Sarah Sasse won the Big 12 in 2003. Smith is just the third individual champion in school history, also joining Big Eight champ Rachele Tacha in 1996.

Smith went on to earn third-team All-America honors from Golfweek after capturing honorable-mention accolades from the Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA). She also became the first Husker in history to represent Nebraska at the Augusta National Women's Amateur Championship, before becoming the first Husker golfer (men's or women's) to represent Nebraska at the Palmer Cup. She went 3-1 to help Team USA to a 33-27 win over the International collegians.

HUSKERS SET PACE IN CLASSROOM

Nebraska leads NCAA Division I with 347 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans all-time across all sports, including seven in 2020-21. The Huskers also lead all schools in history with 18 NCAA Top 10 Award winners across all sports.

Nebraska women's golf leads the nation with 87 WGCA Scholastic All-Americans since 1989, including five in 2020-21. NU also owns a 95 percent graduation success rate across all student-athletes.
