ALL-BIG TEN BAETE EARNS BID TO NCAA STANFORD REGIONAL

Kirsten Baete will represent Nebraska at the 2022 NCAA Stanford Regional in California (May 9-11). Baete, who earned an individual bid to the regional on the strength of a fourth-place finish at the 2022 Big Ten Championship, enters the postseason at No. 186 in the GolfStat individual

Baete has produced one of the best individual seasons by a Husker in school history. Her 74.00 stroke average through 30 rounds this season trails only All-American Kate Smith and Audrey Judd on NU's single-season list. Her performance at the Big Ten Tournament earned her a spot on the Big Ten All-Championship Team and helped her secure second-team All-Big Ten honors. It will be Baete's second straight NCAA Regional bid after helping the Huskers to a team berth at the 2021 NCAA Columbus Regional. She tied for 87th individually in Ohio last season.

Baete's preparation for the regional will begin on the par-71, 6,291-yard layout at Stanford this weekend, before competition gets underway on Monday, May 9 at 10 a.m. (CT). The second round continues on Tuesday at 10 a.m. (CT), before the final round tees off on Wednesday at 10 a.m. (CT). Live scoring for the tournament will be available at GolfStat.com.

Baete faces a regional field that includes national No. 1 Stanford along with No. 12 USC, No. 14 LSU, No. 24 Texas Tech and No. 25 Kentucky, No. 36 Iowa State, No. 37 Northwestern, No. 48 Purdue, No. 51 UNLV, No. 69 Cal Poly, No. 82 Princeton and No. 184 Sacred Heart.

As a team, Nebraska finished No. 67 in the GolfStat rankings after finishing seventh at the 14-team Big Ten Championship.

JOHNSON JOINS BAETE AT NCAAS **BEFORE DEPARTING NEBRASKA**

Lisa Johnson will help Kirsten Baete complete her Husker career at the NCAA Stanford Regional, before Johnson leaves her head coaching position at Nebraska.

Johnson led the Huskers for three seasons, including a Big Ten runner-up finish and an NCAA Regional berth in 2021. All-American Kate Smith, the 2021 Big Ten Champion, helped Nebraska to its best conference finish since 1984 and its first NCAA Regional bid as a team since 2008.

Johnson's departure at Nebraska follows the naming of her husband, John, as the Athletic Director at Portland State.

BAETE LEADS 2022 HUSKERS

Kirsten Baete, who is completing her fifth season, owns Nebraska's No. 1 scoring average (74.00) this season after firing a three-round total of 212 (71-73-68) at the Big Ten Championship at Fox Chapel Golf Club in Pittsburgh, Pa. (April 22-24).

Baete produced seven top-25 finishes in 2021-22, including her first career tournament title at the White Sands Intercollegiate in Nassau, Bahamas (Oct. 22-24). She added a fourth-place individual finish at the Big Ten Championship and earned another top-five finish with her tie for fifth at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21).

Last season, Baete fired a final-round 70 (-2) to help the Big Red surge to a tie for second at the 2021 Big Ten Championship. She tied for 16th individually with a season-best 218. She won the Nebraska Women's Match Play Championship to highlight a solid summer of preparation for the 2021-22 campaign.

Baete closed the 2021 fall season with the best

performance of her career in winning the White Sands Intercollegiate in the Bahamas (Oct. 22-24). Baete fired a career-best 206 that included back-toback rounds of 67 before closing with a final-round 72. She led the Huskers to a runner-up team finish that included wins over 2021 NCAA qualifiers Miami and Mercer. Not only did Baete bag her first collegiate title, she added the first Big Ten Golferof-the-Week award of her career (Oct. 27).

Baete tied for 14th (219) at the Dale McNamara Invitational (Oct. 11-12) and notched back-to-back ties for 17th (Tulane Classic, Westbrook Invitational) to open the spring. She matched her career best with a second-round 66 (-6) at Tulane, before adding a

215 (-1) at Westbrook that included a final-round 68 (-4).

Fellow Nebraskan Megan Whittaker was also a major player in NU's postseason push in 2021. The second generation Husker from Elkhorn tied for 18th at the Big Ten Championship with a season-best 219.

A consistent contributor for four seasons, Whittaker produced one of the best performances of her career with a tie for sixth at 215 (-1) with teammate Vanessa Bouvet at the Dale McNamara Invitational (Oct. 11-12). She closed the fall with a tie for 13th (218) at the White Sands Intercollegiate.

Whittaker opened the spring by going 3-0 at the Big Ten Match Play before adding a top-25 finish at the Tulane Classic. She produced the best effort of her career to tie for seventh with a career-best 209 (-7) at the Westbrook Spring Invitational (Feb. 27-28) on her way to the first Big Ten Golfer-of-the-Week award of her career (March 2).

Whittaker took her seventh straight top-25 finish by tying for 23rd at the Lady Buckeye Invitational (April 15-16). It followed a tie for 18th at the Briar's Creek Invitational (March 14-15).

She closed her 2021-22 season with a tie for 33rd (223) at the Big Ten Championship and just missed an NCAA Regional berth. She closed the regular season at No. 233 in the GolfStat rankings with a 74.04 season stroke average.

A three-time WGCA Scholastic All-American alongside Baete, Whittaker is the daughter of former Husker women's golfer Kim (Lefler) Whittaker, who was a member of Nebraska's first-ever NCAA Regional team in 1994.

SUTHERLAND NAMED HEAD COACH

After spending a season as associate head coach, Jeanne Sutherland was named the new Nebraska Head Coach on Thursday, May 5, 2022.

Sutherland came to Nebraska after spending 10 seasons (2011-21) as the head coach at SMU. She previously spent 15 seasons as the head coach at Texas A&M (1992-2007).

In 2018, Sutherland was named the inaugural winner of the WGCA Kim Evans Award. She also earned the WGCA Founders Award in 2017.

A four-time conference coach of the year at Texas A&M (3 Big 12, 1 Southwest Conference), Sutherland was also a two-time NCAA Regional Coach of the Year (1997, 2007). She led 13 Texas A&M teams to NCAA Regional play, including four NCAA Championship appearances in 1997 (17th), 2004 (24th), 2005 (22nd) and 2006 (19th).

In her head coaching career, Sutherland has guided 18 teams to NCAA Regional appearances. She has coached three individual All-Americans, five individual conference champions and three conference players of the year.

BOUVET RETURNS TO LINEUP WITH FOUR TOP-10 FINISHES

Vanessa Bouvet produced a breakout 2021 fall campaign with three consecutive top-10 finishes.

A fourth-year Husker from Brunei by way of France, Bouvet had an outstanding season as a true freshman in 2018-19, posting a 75.79 stroke average over 24 rounds. A big hitter with an aggressive approach, Bouvet was unable to crack Nebraska's lineup last season after playing just six rounds in a COVID-19 shortened campaign in 2019-20.

However, Bouvet's game continued to improve and she represented Nebraska at the 2021 PGA WORKS Collegiate Championship, where she tied for fifth with teammate Noor Ahmed to earn a Symetra Tour Invite to the Guardian Championship.

Bouvet just missed a lineup spot to open the fall of 2021 at Michigan, before tying for fifth at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21). She added a tie for seventh at The Molly Collegiate (Sept. 27-28), before leading the Huskers with a tie for sixth (215, -1) at the Dale McNamara Invitational (Oct. 11-12). She closed the fall with a tie for 17th (221) at the White Sands Intercollegiate (Oct. 22-24).

Bouvet tied for 13th with a career-best 213 (-3) at the Westbrook Spring Invitational (Feb. 27-28) to help Nebraska to a runner-up team finish. She added a tie for ninth at the Lady Buckeye Invitational (April 15-16), before tying for 24th (221) as Nebraska's No. 3 finisher at the 2022 Big Ten Championship. Her performance in Pittsburgh included an even-par 71 in the second round, as she finished the season with a 74.67 stroke average.

SOPHOMORES VAVROVA, THIELE HELP SOLIDIFY HUSKER LINEUP

Two more regulars in Nebraska's 2021 spring lineup returned with second-year golfers Michaela Vavrova and Lindsey Thiele.

Vavrova, a member of the Slovakian Elite National Team, competed in all 21 rounds in the 2020-21 Husker lineup, posting NU's fourth-best stroke average (76.33). She notched three straight top-25 finishes (Arizona Wildcat, Allstate Sugar Bowl, Indiana Spring Invite). Vavrova also put up a solid 224 to tie for 33rd individually in helping Nebraska at the Big Ten Championship, before posting NU's No. 2 finish at the NCAA Columbus Regional with her tie for 45th (229). She closed her first season in Lincoln with 16 consecutive rounds of 78 or better.

Vavrova captured her first career collegiate title by firing a career-best 217 (+1) over three rounds at the Stampede at The Creek in Elkhorn, Neb. (Oct. 4-5). She was named the Big Ten Co-Golfer of the Week (Oct. 6, 2021), and closed the 2021 fall campaign strong with her tie for 10th (217) that included a career-best second-round 69 (-3) to help the Huskers to a runner-up team finish.

Vavrova capped her sophomore season by tying for 17th with a three-round total of 220 (+7) at the 2022 Big Ten Championship. She opened with a career-best 68 (-3) to sit atop the leader board after one round and was tied for fifth at 141 (-1) through two rounds in Pittsburgh.

Thiele competed in 15 rounds for the Huskers last season. The Wahoo, Neb., native who is the most recent of three sisters (Haley, Hannah) to play golf for the Big Red, was NU's sixth golfer in the count-four format at the 2021 Big Ten Championship.

She produced a career performance when she shared medalist honors with Nicole Hansen at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invite (Sept. 20-21). Thiele opened with the best two rounds of her career (70-71) on her way to a career-best 219 (+3) at Colbert Hills. Thiele's effort earned her Big Ten Co-Golfer-of-the-Week honors with Hansen (Sept. 22).

An outstanding student, Thiele is a Regents Scholar at Nebraska and was one of six Huskers to earn WGCA Scholastic All-America honors in 2021.

FRESHMEN MAKING IMPACT

In addition to Nebraska's six returning golfers, three freshmen have made impacts for the Huskers.

Miu Takahashi (Nasu-machi, Japan) was the most consistent newcomer to the Big Red lineup. She produced a 77.55 stroke average over 29 rounds and made eight lineup appearances, including the Big Ten Championship.

Takahashi produced a career-best 219 (+3) to tie for 30th at the Westbrook Spring Invitational (Feb. 27-28). She tied for fifth individually with a 222 to help Nebraska's "B" lineup to the team title at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21).

Takahashi earned a lineup spot to open her college career at the 2021 Wolverine Invitational (Sept. 13-14). She closed the fall with three straight lineup appearances, including a tie for 18th (226) at The Molly Collegiate and a tie for 25th (224) at the White Sands Intercollegiate, 22-24).

One of the top young golfers in Colombia, Andrea Velez spent the 2021 spring semester in Lincoln after having her initial arrival to campus delayed by COVID-19 restrictions in the fall of 2020.

In her collegiate debut, Velez helped Nebraska's "B" lineup to the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational title by producing a top-20 individual finish with three rounds of 75 (225, +9).

Lena Hassert (Kreuzau, Germany) is a two-time Austrian Junior Stroke Play champion and a German National Championship runner-up (2017). She made her college debut in NU's five-player lineup at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21).

ALL-AMERICAN SMITH ETCHES NAME IN HUSKER GOLF HISTORY IN 2021

Kate Smith won Nebraska's first-ever Big Ten women's golf individual title and the Huskers produced their best conference finish since a runner-up finish in the Big Eight in 1984, as the Huskers tied for second at TPC River's Bend in Maineville, Ohio.

Smith tied her own school record with a final-round 64 (-8) to finish at 207 (-9) to defeat runner-up Irene Kim from Northwestern by three strokes. Smith became Nebraska's first conference champion since Sarah Sasse won the Big 12 in 2003. Smith is just the third individual champion in school history, also joining Big Eight champ Rachelle Tacha in 1996.

Smith went on to earn third-team All-America honors from Golfweek after capturing honorablemention accolades from the Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA). She also became the first Husker in history to represent Nebraska at the Augusta National Women's Amateur Championship, before becoming the first Husker golfer (men's or women's) to represent Nebraska at the Palmer Cup. She went 3-1 to help Team USA to a 33-27 win over the International collegians.

HUSKERS SET PACE IN CLASSROOM

Nebraska leads NCAA Division I with 347 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans all-time across all sports, including seven in 2020-21. The Huskers also lead all schools in history with 18 NCAA Top 10 Award winners across all sports.

Nebraska women's golf leads the nation with 87 WGCA Scholastic All-Americans since 1989, including five in 2020-21. NU also owns a 95 percent graduation success rate across all student-athletes.
