HUSKERS OPEN FALL CAMPAIGN AT GREEN WAVE CLASSIC

First-year Head Coach Jeanne Sutherland leads the Nebraska women's golf team into its 2022 fall season starting with the Green Wave Classic in New Orleans, Sept. 12-13.

Sutherland, who was the Associate Head Coach at Nebraska last season, has guided 18 teams to NCAA Regional appearances as a head coach at Texas A&M (1992-2007) and SMU (2011-21). A four-time conference coach of the year (Big 12 - 1997, 2006, 2007; Southwest Conference - 1995), Sutherland will lead a Nebraska team that just missed an NCAA Regional bid in 2021-22.

The Huskers will be part of a 14-team field in New Orleans that includes, Central Arkansas, Chattanooga, Incarnate Word, Little Rock, LSU, Mercer, Northern Colorado, Sam Houston State, Seattle, South Florida, Tulsa and UNC Asheville along with the hosts from Tulane.

"It's always good to get started and see where we are as a team," Sutherland said. "The team has worked very hard to prepare for the first event, and we are excited to see them in action."

The Huskers finished No. 67 in the final 2022 GolfStat rankings, a year after advancing to 2021 NCAA Regional play. Nebraska lost NCAA Regional individual qualifier Kirsten Baete, along with regular starter Vanessa Bouvet and Nicole Hansen from last year's squad, but return a strong nucleus for 2022-23.

Graduate student Megan Whittaker (Elkhorn, Neb.) is Nebraska's top returning player after finishing with a 74.04 stroke average last season. Whittaker, who will be pursuing her fifth letter as a Husker golfer, is coming off an outstanding summer with a sweep of the Nebraska Women's Amateur and Nebraska Women's Match Play championships. She also competed at the U.S. Women's Amateur.

Kelli Ann Strand could make an immediate impact in replacing Baete's presence in the lineup. A true freshman from Challis, Idaho, Strand was the top Husker in qualifying for the Green Wave Classic. Strand competed at the U.S. Junior Amateur this summer after winning her third consecutive Idaho Class 2A high school title.

Junior Lindsey Thiele has continued to show improvement and could be ready to make a competitive jump this season, while sophomores Miu Takahashi and Andrea Velez round out the Husker lineup in New Orleans.

WHITTAKER BACK FOR FIFTH YEAR TO LEAD HUSKERS IN BIG TEN

A hard-working golfer who has shown impressive improvement throughout her four collegiate seasons, Megan Whittaker returns to lead Nebraska in the hunt for an NCAA Regional bid in 2022-23. The graduate student from Elkhorn, Neb., produced Nebraska's No. 2 stroke average (74.04) in 2021-22, just missing an individual NCAA Regional bid. She trailed only NCAA Regional qualifier Kirsten Baete (73.94) among the Huskers.

Whittaker is coming off a big summer that included a sweep of the Nebraska women's match play and stroke play championships and a berth in the U.S. Women's Amateur. She joined teammates Michaela Vavrova and Kelli Ann Strand as Big Ten Golfers to Watch heading into the 2022-23 season.

Whittaker produced the first two top-10 individual finishes of her career while matching Baete and Vanessa Bouvet for the team lead with seven top-25 performances in 2021-22.

A star in the classroom and the community, Whittaker earned her bachelor's degree in finance in May of 2022, and is a four-time WGCA Scholastic All-American, a three-time Big Ten Distinguished Scholar and a three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection. In the community, she earned a prestigious Sam Foltz 27 Hero Leadership Award at Nebraska in 2021. She

was also Nebraska's 2021 Big Ten Sportsmanship Award winner for women's golf.

Whittaker's ties to Nebraska women's golf are very strong, as her mother Kim (Lefler) lettered as a golfer for the Huskers from 1991 to 1994, helping Nebraska advance to the 1994 NCAA West Regional as a senior.

GREEN WAVE CLASSIC, SEPTEMBER 12-13, 2022

FRESHMAN STRAND PREPARED TO MAKE INSTANT IMPACT

The top player in the state of Idaho throughout her high school career, Kelli Ann Strand was a three-time Idaho state champion who was ranked among the top-310 players in the world (WAGR 308) before arriving at Nebraska.

A leading contender to earn a second straight Idaho Golf Association Women's Player of the Year award, Strand produced a strong summer of 2022. After winning the Idaho Women's Match Play title she took second at the Idaho Women's Amateur. She was also the runner-up at the Girls Junior Americas Cup (July 24-28) for the second straight year with a three-round total of 205 (-11). She captured third at the IMG Academy Junior World Championship (July 12-15) with a four-round total of 280 (-8), which came before competing at the U.S. Girls Junior Amateur in Kentucky (July 18-23), where she advanced to Match Play before finishing in a tie for 33rd.

Strand earned the No. 1 position in Nebraska's lineup for the season-opening Green Wave Classic by winning Nebraska's competitive qualifying rounds in advance of the tournament.

BIG GOLFER-TO-WATCH VAVROVA COMPETES FOR SLOVAKIA AT WATC

Michaela Vavrova missed the first week of fall classes while competing as a member of the Slovakian Team at the World Amateur Team Championships in Paris in late-August. The third-year Husker was Slovakia's top finisher in a field that featured 56 of the world's best amateur teams.

Vavrova, who is not traveling to the Green Wave Classic, capped her sophomore season at Nebraska by tying for 17th with a three-round total of 220 (+7) at the 2022 Big Ten Championship. She opened with a career-best 68 (-3) to sit atop the leader board after one round and was tied for fifth at 141 (-1) through two rounds in Pittsburgh.

Vavrova captured her first career collegiate title by firing a career-best 217 (+1) over three rounds at the Stampede at The Creek in Elkhorn, Neb. (Oct. 4-5, 2021). She was named the Big Ten Co-Golfer of the Week (Oct. 6), and closed the 2021 fall campaign with a tie for 10th (217) that included a career-best second-round 69 (-3) to help the Huskers to a runner-up team finish at the White Sands Collegiate.

As a true freshman, Vavrova competed in all 21 rounds in the 2020-21 Husker lineup, posting NU's fourth-best stroke average (76.33). She notched three straight top-25 finishes (Arizona Wildcat, Allstate Sugar Bowl, Indiana Spring Invite). Vavrova also put up a solid 224 to tie for 33rd individually in helping Nebraska to a runner-up team finish at the Big Ten Championship. She was NU's No. 2 finisher at the NCAA Columbus Regional with her tie for 45th (229).

THIELE CONTINUING TO IMPROVE; PREPARING FOR STRONG JUNIOR YEAR

Lindsey Thiele earned a lineup spot at the Green Wave Classic to start her third season as a Husker. As a sophomore, Thiele produced a solid 76.89 stroke average while competing in five tournaments.

She shared the individual title with teammate Nicole Hansen at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower

Invitational (Sept. 20-21, 2021). Thiele opened with the best two rounds of her career (70-71) on her way to a career-best 219 (+3) at Colbert Hills. Thiele's effort earned her Big Ten Co-Golfer-of-the-Week honors with Hansen (Sept. 22).

After a solid summer, Thiele (pronounced TEEL) could be ready for bigger things as a Husker.

The Wahoo, Neb., native who is the most recent of three sisters (Haley, Hannah) to play golf for the Big Red, was NU's sixth golfer in the count-four format at the 2021 Big Ten Championship.

An outstanding student, Thiele is a Regents Scholar at Nebraska and a two-time WGCA Scholastic All-American.

SOPHOMORES GET EARLY CHANCE TO HELP HUSKERS AT GREEN WAVE

Sophomores Miu Takahashi (Nasu-machi, Japan) and Andrea Velez (Pereira, Colombia) earned lineup spots to open the 2022 fall campaign at the Green Wave Classic, while fellow sophomore Lena Hassert (Kreuzau, Germany) will travel to New Orleans as an individual.

Takahashi was the most consistent newcomer to the Big Red lineup in 2021-22. She produced a 77.55 stroke average over 29 rounds and made eight lineup appearances, including the 2022 Big Ten Championship.

She produced a career-best 219 (+3) to tie for 30th at the Westbrook Spring Invitational (Feb. 27-28). She tied for fifth individually with a 222 to help Nebraska's "B" lineup to the team title at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21).

Takahashi earned a lineup spot to open her college career at the 2021 Wolverine Invitational (Sept. 13-14). She closed the fall with three straight lineup appearances, including a tie for 18th (226) at The Molly Collegiate and a tie for 25th (224) at the White Sands Intercollegiate.

One of the top young golfers in Colombia, Andrea Velez spent the 2021 spring semester in Lincoln after having her initial arrival to campus delayed by COVID-19 restrictions in the fall of 2020.

In her collegiate debut, Velez helped Nebraska's "B" lineup to the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational title by producing a top-20 individual finish with three rounds of 75 (225, +9).

Lena Hassert (Kreuzau, Germany) is a two-time Austrian Junior Stroke Play champion and a German National Championship runner-up (2017). She made her college debut in NU's five-player lineup at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21).

SUTHERLAND NAMED HEAD COACH

After spending a season as associate head coach, Jeanne Sutherland was named the new Nebraska Head Coach on Thursday, May 5, 2022.

Sutherland came to Nebraska after spending 10 seasons (2011-21) as the head coach at SMU. She previously spent 15 seasons as the head coach at Texas A&M (1992-2007).

In 2018, Sutherland was named the inaugural winner of the WGCA Kim Evans Award. She also earned the WGCA Founders Award in 2017.

A four-time conference coach of the year at Texas A&M (3 Big 12, 1 Southwest Conference), Sutherland was also a two-time NCAA Regional Coach of the Year (1997, 2007). She led 13 Texas

A&M teams to NCAA Regional play, including four NCAA Championship appearances in 1997 (17th), 2004 (24th), 2005 (22nd) and 2006 (19th).

In her head coaching career, Sutherland has guided 18 teams to NCAA Regional appearances. She has coached three individual All-Americans, five individual conference champions and three conference players of the year.

ALL-BIG TEN BAETE LED BIG RED DURING STRONG 2021-22 SEASON

Kirsten Baete completed her fifth season at Nebraska by capturing an individual berth to the 2022 NCAA Stanford Regional.

The Beatrice, Neb., native took fourth at the 2022 Big Ten Championships to earn a spot on the Big Ten All-Championship Team while claiming second-team All-Big Ten honors. She was also Nebraska's Big Ten Sportsmanship Award winner for not only women's golf but for all women's sports during the 2021-22 campaign.

Baete capped an impressive career by tying for 30th at the NCAA Stanford Regional while finishing with a 73.94 stroke average on the year.

She produced seven top-25 finishes in 2021-22, including her first career tournament title at the White Sands Intercollegiate in Nassau, Bahamas (Oct. 22-24). She added a fourth-place individual finish at the Big Ten Championship and earned another top-five finish with her tie for fifth at the Marilynn Smith/Sunflower Invitational (Sept. 20-21).

In 2020-21, Baete fired a final-round 70 (-2) to help the Big Red surge to a tie for second at the 2021 Big Ten Championship. She tied for 16th individually with a season-best 218. She won the Nebraska Women's Match Play Championship to highlight a solid summer of preparation for the 2021-22 campaign.

Baete was also a four-time WGCA Scholastic All-American.

HUSKERS SET PACE IN CLASSROOM

Nebraska leads NCAA Division I with 348 CoSIDA Academic All-Americans all-time across all sports. The Huskers also lead all schools in history with 18 NCAA Top 10 Award winners across all sports.

Nebraska women's golf leads the nation with 90 WGCA Scholastic All-Americans since 1989, including three in 2021-22. Kirsten Baete, Lindsey Thiele and Megan Whittaker all captured WGCA honors for at least the second straight season in 2021-22.

Baete and Whittaker became the seventh and eighth four-time WGCA Scholastic All-Americans in Nebraska history in 2021-22. This season, Whittaker could become the first five-time WGCA Scholastic honoree in the Husker record book. Megan's mother, Kim (Lefler), was also a three-time WGCA Scholastic All-American at Nebraska (1992, 1993, 1994).

Lindsey is the third Thiele sister to be a WGCA Scholastic All-American, joining Haley (2016, 2018, 2019, 2020) and Hannah (2018).

NU also owns a 95 percent graduation success rate across all student-athletes.
