### HUSKERS BEGIN WEST COAST SWING AT PRESTIGE

The Nebraska men's golf team kicks off spring stroke play as they travel west for The Prestige in Palm Springs, Calif., Feb. 20-22.

The University of Stanford and U.C. Davis co-host the tournament, which annually boasts one of the strongest fields in collegiate golf. This year is no exception, as the 27-team field features 11 top-50 teams according to GolfStat.

The Huskers will arrive in Palm Springs on Sunday, Feb. 19, competing in a practice round at the Greg Norman Course at PGA West and its Par-71, 7,156 yard layout. The tournament will commence on Monday with a shotgun start at 8:45 a.m. (CT).

The Prestige is the second straight weekend Nebraska will be in California. The Huskers travel to Scottsdale, Ariz. to continue their west coast swing for the Desert Mountain Collegiate at Desert Mountain Golf Course March 4-5 and a five day Husker Alumni Dual March 14-18 at the Quintero Golf Club, also in Scottsdale.

### LAST TIME OUT

Nebraska dropped two of three matches at Big Ten Match Play in Palm Coast, Fla., at the Hammock Beach Resort Golf Course.

After dropping his first matchup against Minnesota's Harrison Arnold, Sisson picked up a 6&5 win against Rutgers' Luke Wells before tying Penn State's Jake Griffin on Saturday afternoon. He finished with a 1-1-1 record.

After Friday mornings practice round against Michigan State, the Huskers dropped their first match to Minnesota 5-0. Evan McDermott, the true freshman from Spring Lake, Mich., lost a close matchup with Minnesota's Jacob Pedersen, dropping a 1 up decision. McDermott bounced back and won a 3&2 decision over Rutgers' Weston Jones on Saturday.

Nebraska bounced back Saturday morning, handling Rutgers 4-1 in the morning match.

In the Saturday afternoon match, Nebraska lost a close 3-0-2 decision to Penn State. Caleb Badura tied Penn State's Jud Langille, and Reed Malleck lost a 2 up decision to PSU's Jimmy Myers.

## CORNELL RETURNS TO LEAD HUSKER PROGRAM

Former Nebraska's men's golfer and assistant coach Judd Cornell will return to his alma mater to lead the Husker program, NU Vice Chancellor, Director of Athletics Trev Alberts announced on Thursday, Aug. 11.

"We are excited that Judd Cornell will be coming back to Nebraska to lead the young men in the Husker golf program," Alberts said. "Judd is a hard-working, high-character leader who knows the importance of helping student-athletes develop both on and off the course. He knows our program as well as anyone in the country and will take great pride in continuing the growth of our program."

Cornell returns to Lincoln after spending the past three seasons as the head coach at Creighton. An Omaha native, Cornell was an assistant coach at Nebraska for six seasons, including his final two years in Lincoln as associate head coach (2017-18 and 2018-19).

"My family and I are thrilled to be back in Lincoln, and I can't wait to lead the Husker men's golf program," Cornell said. "I want to thank Trev Alberts and Bob Burton for giving me the opportunity to return to the University of Nebraska and lead a program that means so much to me. The Husker program has been climbing in the national standings the past several years, and we plan to keep moving forward in the years to come."

Cornell's hiring is effective pending the completion of his formal background check.

## HUSKERS SET MULTIPLE RECORDS TO CLOSE FALL

Harry Crockett fired a final round 67 (-5) and Jeremy Sisson were among the multiple Huskers who set career-highs to lead the Nebraska men's golf team to a season-best 13 strokes under par and a new fall season stroke average at the White Sands Invitational on Sunday, Oct. 30.

Nebraska opened the tournament by matching its best round of the fall season on Friday with a 280 (-8). After a second round 288 (E), a final-round 283 (-3) was not enough for the Huskers, but their three-round score of 851 (-13) set a new record for fall season stroke average. Nebraska's mark of 289.64 beat the previous record average of 290.67, which was set in Fall 2021. Evan McDermott also notched a 67 (-5).

## TWO FORMER HUSKERS PREPARE FOR KORN FERRY TOUR

Scott Gutschewski and Brandon Crick, two former Huskers, made their 2023 professional debuts as members of the Korn Ferry Tour competing at the Bahamas Great Exuma Classic at the Sandals Emerald Bay Course on January 15-18.

Gutschewski, who made his 234th career professional start, is an Omaha native and led the 1999 Husker squad to a 14th place finish at the NCAA Championships, completing one of the best careers in Nebraska history. He spent 2022 as a member of the PGA TOUR, his sixth season on the circuit. He also competed in five Korn Ferry Tour events in 2022, notching one top-25 performance with a 16th place finish at the AdventHealth Championship in Kansas City, Mo. in May 2022.

Crick, the 35-year-old native of McCook,

turned pro in 2010 after a stellar career at Nebraska. During his time on the Husker golf team, he earned a berth to NCAA Regionals as an individual, doing so in 2010. He returned to the University in 2015, earning a degree in sociology. He has competed on the Korn Ferry Tour for six seasons and will also be making his 2023 debut at the Great Exuma Classic. Crick competed in this same event last year, finishing T-19th with a four-round score of 284 (-4). He enjoyed one of his best professional seasons in 2022, setting career-bests with a 54th place finish in the Korn Ferry Tour standings along with seven top-25 finishes. In addition to his accomplishments on the Korn Ferry Tour, he also competed in his first major at the U.S. Open, where he failed to make the cut.

## JEREMY SISSON WINS DIXIE AMATEUR

Jeremy Sisson flew to the top of the leaderboards with a first-round 69 (-3) and never looked back as he captured a wire-to-wire victory at the Dixie Men's Amateur Tournament in Coral Springs, Fla. on December 17, 2022.

Sisson, the Skaneateles, N.Y. native, finished with a four-round score 284 (-4) and finished one stroke ahead of second-place Tristan Wieland (Jupiter, Fla.) He also held off the 2021 Dixie Amateur winner Evan Myers (Texas A&M).

This is Sisson's second amateur tournament championship, with his other victory coming at the 2017 Golfweek International Junior Invitational.

Sisson's title caps off a stellar 2022 fall season for the junior from Skaneateles, N.Y. In 11 rounds of action for Nebraska this fall, Sisson accumulated a 72.73 stroke average in 11 rounds of action. He will look to carry his momentum into spring play in Palm Coast, Fla. on February 3-4, where Nebraska will compete in Big Ten Match Play.
