TEAM

- Captains: Hudson Card, Gus Hartwig, Sanoussi Kane.
- The Boilermakers wore their all black uniforms for the first time this season.
- \cdot For the third time out of seven games this season, Purdue did not turn the ball over.
- \cdot Ohio State won the toss and elected to defer to the second half.
- Jayden Dixon-Veal made his first career start for the offense.
- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ Ben Farrell made his first start at Purdue.
- Second career start for Derrick Rogers Jr. on the defense.

OFFENSE

• Devin Mockobee eclipsed 100 yards for the first time this season and finished with 18 carries for 110 yards, the most rushing yards allowed to a single player by Ohio State this season.

- It was Mockobee's fifth career 100-yard game, tied for 13th all-time in program history.
- · Mockobee logged 10 carries for 64 yards in the first half, averaging 6.4 yards per attempt.
- Mockobee posted his longest run of the season as he dashed down the sideline on a 21-yard carry in the second quarter.
- Two plays later, Mockobee matched his newly-set season long with another 21-yard rush down to the Ohio State 1-yard line.
- Elijah Canion recorded his first catch as a Boilermaker on a four-yard reception in the second quarter.
- Mershawn Rice made his first reception of the season, a nine-yard catch in the third quarter.
- On the next play, Rice recorded his second catch for a 35-yard gain, the longest reception of his career.
- Rice had a team-high three catches for 50 yards, becoming the fifth Boilermaker to lead Purdue in receiving yards this season.
- Deion Burks put the Boilermakers on the board with a six-yard touchdown catch in the fourth quarter, his fifth score of the season.
- The throw gave Hudson Card his seventh touchdown pass of the year.

· Jaron Tibbs notched his first career catch in the fourth quarter, an eight-yard pass from Bennett Meredith. The play was also Meredith's first completion of his career.

DEFENSE

· Yanni Karlaftis and Dillon Thieneman led the Boilermakers in tackles with nine apiece.

- · It is the fourth game this season Thieneman has been on top of the tackles list for Purdue. The true freshman now has a team-leading 62 tackles on the season.
- The Indiana native now sits only nine tackles shy of entering the Top 10 in program history for a freshman. Landon Johnson (2000) has the 10th most with 71.
- It is a new career high in tackles for Karlaftis with nine (six solo). It is also his first time leading the team in a game.
- Markevious Brown punched the ball out from Ohio State quarterback Devin Brown as he was diving for the goal line, leading to a fumble recovery by Kydran Jenkins for a touchback in the second quarter.
- The play marked Brown's second forced fumble of the season, third of his career, and the first fumble recovery of Jenkins' career.
- · Jenkins also logged a sack on the day, making this his 14th career game with at least one.
- Nic Scourton logged his first forced fumble of the season, second of his career, on a strip-sack of Ohio State quarterback Kyle McCord in the third quarter.
- Karlaftis fell on the loose ball for the first fumble recovery of his career.
- · Jeffrey M'ba recorded his first sack as a Boilermaker, bringing down Devin Brown for a loss of four in the fourth quarter to force a punt.
- Purdue held the Buckeyes offense to just one score in their final five possessions.

SPECIAL TEAMS

• Ohio State missed an extra point attempt in the first quarter, the first missed PAT by a Purdue opponent since Rutgers (Nov. 28, 2020).

• Caleb Krockover converted his first extra point attempt of the season in the fourth quarter.
