TEAM

 ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ Captains: Hudson Card, Gus Hartwig, Sanoussi Kane

- \cdot Purdue won the toss and elected to defer to the second half.
- The Boilermakers won the turnover battle with four forced fumbles, resulting in 12 points.
- Purdue allowed just 97 yards and a two-of-seven third-down conversion rate in the second half.

OFFENSE

- Jayden Dixon-Veal posted career highs in receptions (four) and receiving yards (38), and caught his first touchdown as a Boilermaker.

• On his first collegiate scoring play, Dixon-Veal laid out for an acrobatic 29-yard catch in the end zone on a 3rd-and-15 in the fourth quarter.

• Daniel Johnson made his first start of the year.

• Hudson Card completed 16 of 32 passes for 100 yards and one touchdown.

• Garrett Miller had a team-leading five catches for 26 yards.

• Devin Mockobee led the Purdue backfield with 42 yards on seven attempts, averaging six yards per carry.

DEFENSE

• Kydran Jenkins had a career day with 4.5 tackles-for-loss, finishing with eight stops, seven solos, two sacks and a forced fumble.

• Dillon Thieneman again paced the defense with 12 tackles, seven solos, one tackle-for-loss and two forced fumbles.

• Thieneman's two forced fumbles tied the Purdue record for a single game, last accomplished by DaMarcus Mitchell in the Music City Bowl vs. Tennessee on Dec. 30, 2021.

• Nic Scourton amassed a career-high 10 tackles, six solos, and notched half a sack and three tackles-for-loss.

· Sanoussi Kane also finished with a career-best 10 tackles, four solos and one pass deflected.

• Jenkins stripped the ball from Nebraska quarterback Jeff Sims and returned it 55 yards for a touchdown, Purdue's second fumble recovery touchdown of the season (Illinois on Sept. 30).

· Jenkins sacked Nebraska quarterback Heinrich Haarberg for a loss of 11 yards to force a three-and-out in the first quarter.

• On the following drive, Jenkins made another big tackle for a loss to force a third down. He has notched a TFL in seven of eight games this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS

• To open the game, Ben Freehill recorded his first kickoff since the season opener vs. Fresno State on Sept. 2.

• Anthony Brown forced a fumble on the opening kickoff, his first career forced fumble. Ben Furtney fell on the loose ball for his first career fumble recovery.

· Jack Ansell matched his season long entering the game with a 54-yard punt that pinned Nebraska's offense at its own 12-yard line in the third quarter.

• Ansell later set a new season best with a 65-yard punt for a touchback in the third quarter.

• Andrew Sowinski caught a pass from Hudson Card for a successful two-point conversion in the fourth quarter, the Boilermakers' first two-point conversion since Nov. 30, 2019, vs. Indiana.
