TEAM

- Purdue captains: Jeffrey M'Ba, Antonio Stevens, Hudson Card, Marcus Mbow
- Purdue won the toss. Elected to defer. Oregon State elected to receive with Purdue kicking to the south.
- The Boilermakers amassed 263 yards on the ground, its highest rushing output since totaling 303 yards at Northwestern on Nov. 18, 2023.

OFFENSE

- Purdue rushed for 263 on the night, its second game this season over 200 yards and fourth in the Walters era.
- Devin Mockobee powered the ground game, rushing for 168 yards and a touchdown on 16 carries, averaging 10.5 yards per attempt.
- Mockobee recorded his seventh career 100-yard rushing game, moving him into a tie with Leroy Keyes and Jerod Void for seventh in Purdue history.
- He is the sixth Boilermaker since 1996 to record a 100-yard rushing game in three separate seasons.
- With his 168 yards on the ground, Mockobee became the 14th player in Purdue history to reach 2,000 yards in a career.
- Mockobee ran his way from 14th to 11th on Purdue's all-time rushing yardage leaderboard, surpassing Ralph Bolden, Perry Williams and Akeem Hunt.
- Mockobee moved up the career charts with his 16th career touchdown, good for 12th with Wally Jones (1978-81) and Tony Butkovich (1943).
- Reggie Love III found paydirt from two yards out in the fourth quarter. It was his second touchdown of the year and eighth of his career.
- Card got Purdue on the board with a 32-yard strike to Max Klare in the second quarter. It was the second time this season the two hooked up for a touchdown.

DEFENSE

- Kydran Jenkins led the way on the defensive side with 16 tackles, 8 solos, 2 sacks and 3 tackles-for-loss. The senior recorded a career high in tackles and sacks.
- Jenkins climbed up the Purdue career charts on Saturday night, moving into eighth in career sacks with 20.0 and 13th in tackles-for-loss with 37.0.
- Dillon Thieneman's 14 tackles matched his career high, which he set against Syracuse on Sept. 16, 2023.
- Thieneman totaled 10-plus tackles for the fifth time in just 15 career games.
- Will Heldt posted half a tackle-for-loss. He has made a stop behind the line in all three games this season.
- CJ Madden recorded the first tackle-for-loss of his career with a half stop in the first quarter.
- Purdue stopped Oregon State on 4th down on the Beavers' first possession. It was the first 4th-down attempt against Purdue this year.
- The Boilers also stuffed the Beavers on 4th down again in the third quarter.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Spencer Porath converted all three PAT attempts. The freshman is 4-for-4 on PAT attempts this season.
- Keelan Crimmins punted four times for a 43.3-yard average. He dropped one inside the 20.
- Dillon Thieneman posted a career-long punt return of 20 yards in the second quarter.
