### THE NOTES TO KNOW

►►► **THE FINAL TALLY:** Purdue ended the season with a 24-12 record and a spot in the Sweet 16 for the sixth time in the last eight years. The Boilermakers lost a heartbreaker to eventual national runner-up Houston in the Sweet 16, preventing Purdue its fourth straight 25-win season.

►►► **IN THE TOP 25:** Purdue finished the season ranked No. 14 in the final AP Top 25 poll released Tuesday after the National Championship game.

- It marks the fifth straight year that Purdue was ranked in the final poll (20th - 2021; 10th - 2022; 3rd - 2023; 2nd - 2024; 14th - 2025).
- Purdue is now one of four teams to be ranked in the top 15 in the final poll in four straight years (Purdue, Houston, Duke, Arizona).
- The five straight years ranked in the final poll is the longest streak in school history.
- The Boilermakers were also ranked 12th in the final coaches poll.

►►► **SOME KEY NOTES:** Purdue made the NCAA Tournament for the 10th straight time, the fourth-longest streak in the country and the fourth-longest streak ever by a Big Ten team.

- Purdue has reached the Sweet 16 six times in the last eight tournaments, behind only Gonzaga's seven Sweet 16 appearances.
- Purdue finished tied for fourth in the Big Ten race, the fifth straight year it has finished in the top four of the Big Ten standings. Purdue has finished top four in 10 of the last 11 seasons.
- Purdue has won nine games over the last four NCAA Tournaments, tied for the fourth most in the country (UConn - 13; Duke - 12, Houston - 12).
- **Matt Painter's** eight Sweet 16 appearances at Purdue are the third most in Big Ten history (Izzo - 16; Knight - 14).

►►► **ALL-AMERICA U.:** With **Braden Smith** earning first-team All-America accolades, Purdue is the only current team in America to have three straight seasons of having a first-team consensus All-American (2023, 2024 - **Zach Edey**).

• With **Jaden Ivey** earning second-team consensus honors in 2022, Purdue is the first school since Kansas (6 yrs; 2009 to 14) to have four straight years of consensus All-American honors.

►►► **1 OF 1:** **Braden Smith** became the first player in NCAA history with 500 points, 300 assists, 150 rebounds and 75 steals in a season.

• Smith is the only player in NCAA history with 1,300 points, 700 assists and 500 rebounds through the end of his junior season.

►►► **NATION'S LEADER AGAIN:** **Trey Kaufman-Renn** led the country in field goals made with 292.

• It marked the second straight season that a Purdue player will lead the country in field goals made (2024 - **Zach Edey**, 336).

►►► **SCHOOL RECORDS:** Senior **Caleb Furst** tied a school record with 141 career games played.

• **Braden Smith** now ranks 1-2 on the single-season minutes played list (1,333 in 2025; 1,327 in 2024).

• **Braden Smith** also ranks 1-2 on the single-season assists list at not only Purdue, but the Big Ten Conference (313 in 2025; 292 in 2024).

• **Braden Smith** owns the school record for career assists (758).

►►► **SHARP SHOOTERS:** Purdue led the Big Ten (league games only) in field goal percentage (.503) for the third time in the last four seasons (3rd in 2023).

• The 50.3 percent shooting was the third-highest percentage in Big Ten play in the last 25 years.

• In addition, Purdue finished the season 16th nationally in 3-point percentage, the third time in the last four years that Purdue has finished in the top 20 of 3-point percentage.

• Over the last two seasons, Purdue leads the country in 3-point percentage (.393), making 615-of-1,566 from long range. Kentucky is second at 39.1 percent.

►►► **FINAL LEADER BOARD:** Purdue ranks high in several categories both in the Big Ten and NCAA rankings.

... 1st 3-point percentage (first in four of last nine seasons)

... 1st field goal percentage (first in three of last four seasons)

... 1st in steals per game (led league for first time since 2008).

... 16th in 3-point percentage (top 20 in 3 of last 4 seasons).

▶▶▶ THE QUICK HITTERS: Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament for the 16th time in 20 seasons under head coach **Matt Painter**. Purdue has only missed three NCAA Tournaments since Painter's watch started in the 2005-06 season (2006, 2013, 2014, 2020 - CoVid year).

- In his first nine NCAA Tournaments of his career, **Matt Painter** went 8-9. In three last eight NCAA Tournaments, Painter is 16-8.
- Purdue is now 9-4 in NCAA Tournament action since the 2022 tournament (2-1 in 2022; 0-1 in 2023; 5-1 in 2024; 2-1 in 2025).
- Purdue is one-of-six schools to have made both the 2024 and 2025 Sweet 16 (Alabama, Arizona, Duke, Houston, Purdue, Tennessee).
- Purdue is one-of-six schools nationally with two Elite Eight appearances in the last five seasons (Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Duke, Gonzaga, Houston, Miami, Michigan State, Tennessee, Texas Tech, UConn).
- Since 2016-17, Purdue has six trips to the Sweet 16, while Michigan also has six. The rest of the Big Ten has six combined (Wisconsin - 2; MSU - 2; Illinois - 1; Maryland - 1).
- Purdue went 16-4 when having more free throw attempts than its foe. When its foe has more (or the same) attempts, Purdue is 8-8.
- With **Braden Smith** earning first-team All-America honors, a Purdue player has earned at least one first-team accolade in four straight seasons (**Jaden Ivey** - 2022; **Zach Edey** - 2023, 2024; **Braden Smith** - 2025).
- Braden Smith** had just four games this year (Marshall, Penn State, Auburn, Indiana) in which he didn't score at least 10 points or dish out at least 10 assists.
- When **Braden Smith** has a double-double during his career, the Boilermakers are 18-1 (losing to Illinois in the regular-season finale).
- Smith has had at least five assists in all 10 NCAA Tournament games, including three games of 10 or more (15 vs. Houston; 15 vs. Gonzaga; 10 vs. Grambling).
- When **Fletcher Loyer** makes at least three 3-pointers this season, the Boilermakers are 14-0. During his career, Purdue is 27-3.
- When **Trey Kaufman-Renn** has at least three assists, Purdue went 11-2. When he has two or fewer assists, Purdue went 13-10.

▶▶▶ STREAKING IN MARCH: Purdue has earned nine straight NCAA Tournament berths. The streak is the second-longest among Big Ten teams (Michigan State - 26; Purdue - 9) and the fourth-longest streak nationally.

►►► **25 PER YEAR OVER 10:** Head coach **Matt Painter** is one of five coaches nationally to average at least 25 wins over the last 10 seasons (2016-25), including this season.

►►► **70 IS THE LIMIT:** When Purdue holds opponents to 69 or fewer points, the Boilermakers are 14-1, losing to Houston in the Sweet 16. When foes score 70 or more points, Purdue is just 10-11.

• Under Painter (20th year), Purdue is 354-68 (.839) overall when holding foes to 69 or fewer points. When opponents score at least 70 points, Purdue is 107-147 (.421).

• Purdue saw a 35-game winning streak end against Houston when holding foes to under 70 points.

►►► **WINNING WITH TURNOVERS:** Since the 2021-22 season, Purdue is 62-7 when forcing 10 or more turnovers in a game. With single-digit turnovers, Purdue owns a 42-6 record in that span.

►►► **WINNING AT 80:** Purdue is 106-5 since the 2017-18 season when scoring at least 80 points (Illinois, 3-7-25; Wisconsin, 2-15-25; Northwestern, 12-1-23; Notre Dame, 12-15-18; Virginia Tech, 11-18-18).

►►► **THE EXTRA-POSSESSION BATTLE:** Purdue is 161-15 under Painter when winning both the rebound and turnover battles. On the flipside, Purdue is 6-52 when losing both the rebound and turnover battles, including 0-3 this season.

►►► **90 IS AUTOMATIC:** Purdue has gone 13,648 days (April 8, 2025) since losing when scoring 90 or more points, having won 128 straight games (66-0 under **Matt Painter**). Purdue's last loss when scoring 90 or more points was on Nov. 26, 1987 to Iowa State (L, 104-96).

►►► **NATION'S BEST SHOOTING TEAM?:** Purdue is one of eight teams nationally to rank in the top 20 of both field goal percentage and 3-point percentage.

►►► **BIG MAN U IS ALSO GUARD U:** Purdue has long been called "Big Man U", but it also has a legitimate claim to "Guard U" as well.

• Purdue is on its way to have three different consensus All-American guards since the 2018-19 seasons (**Carsen Edwards**, **Jaden Ivey**, **Braden Smith**), being one-of-two schools to accomplish that.

- ▶ **Record at Purdue:** 471-215 (.687) / 20th year | **Career Record:** 496-220 (.693) / 21st year
- With 17 NCAA Tournament berths, eight Sweet 16 appearances, five Big Ten regular-season championships, two Big Ten Tournament titles, two Elite Eight appearances, a trip to the Final Four, an appearance in a National Championship game and an international gold medal on his résumé, 20th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
  - Painter was named the 2019 and 2024 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to 10 straight NCAA Tournaments – the fourth-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in six of the last eight tournaments.
  - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2028-29 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
  - Painter entered the 2024-25 season second on the school's all-time wins list (447) behind legendary mentor **Gene Keady** and ahead of **Ward “Piggy” Lambert**, both of whom have been inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.
  - Has averaged over 23 wins a season in his 20 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.3 wins per year over the last 19 seasons.
  - Has won at least 25 games in 12 of his 21 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
  - Painter has averaged 12.0 wins per year in conference play, the third-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
  - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
  - Coach Painter's 16 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2025 – Painter is 54 years old).
  - Purdue has finished first, second or third in Big Ten play in 11 of the last 18 years, including in eight of the last 11 years.
