2019 SPARTAN QUICK HITS

San José State has faced one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the country to date, playing three road matches, two teams that made the 2018 NCAA Tournament and one top-10 opponent. Stanford will likely be the No. 1 team in the country when Tuesday's polls are released after top-ranked Wake Forest lost last week. The program's last trip to Stanford resulted in a 0-0 draw against the No. 1 team and three-time defending national champion in the 2018 season opener. Head coach Simon Tobin had spent the previous 27 seasons at CSU Bakersfield before being hired by SJSU in 2014. Four different players have scored a goal this season. Senior Suliman Khorami is leading the team in goals (2) and points (14).

THE SCHEDULE:

San José State returns to the pitch for two contests this week, traveling to Stanford on Tuesday before kicking off WAC play at home against CSU Bakersfield on Saturday. Both matches are set to kickoff at 7:00 p.m.

FOLLOW ALONG:

Tuesday's match will be televised nationally on the Pac-12 Networks with Troy Clardy on the call. Live stats will be available for both matches and you can follow every San José State men's soccer game live on Twitter, @SanJoseStateMS.

FIRST TOUCHES:

- Four different players (Eduardo Buenfil, Suliman Khorami, Danny Sanchez, Rodolfo Castro) have scored a goal this season.

- Khorami tops the team with two goals and four points on the year.

- Midfielder Max Allen leads the club with 14 shots and (six on goal) through six matches.

- Midfielder Carlos-Gomez Zavala has seen a team-high 529 minutes of action on the pitch in 2019.

- SJSU faced No. 1 Stanford on the road to open last season and played the Cardinal to a 0-0 draw.

- The Spartans' 1-0 lead in its September 9 match against Saint Mary's marked the first time the Gaels have trailed in a match since September 16, 2018 (0-1 at UC Riverside).

- Allen was named to the All-WAC Preseason Team last month.

WAC-Y STARTS:

- San José State holds a 2-1-3 record in conference openers since joining the WAC and has earned results in the last five.

- Last year's WAC lid-lifter came in Bakersfield and the Spartans emerged with a 2-1 victory. The club jumped out to an early advantage, striking in the ninth and 13th minutes on goals from Eduardo Buenfil and Omar Lemus.



SCOUTING STANFORD:

- San José State has played Stanford 67 times in program history, trailing the all-time series with a record of 27-32-8.
- The Spartans earned a draw against the Cardinal in Stanford last season, their first result in the series since playing Stanford to a 1-1 draw at Spartan Stadium in 2008. The program's last victory in the series came in 2-1 fashion in 2006.
- The Cardinal are 6-0 (1-0 Pac-12) on the season and could be ranked as high as No. 1 in the country when the new polls are released ahead of Tuesday night's match. The club last hit the pitch on Friday at rival California, topping the Golden Bears for a 2-1 win in the Big Clasico.
- The club finished the 2018 campaign with a 12-4-5 record and advanced all the way to the NCAA Quarterfinals.

CHECKING ON CSU BAKERSFIELD:

- San José State and CSU Bakersfield have met 18 times in program history, leading the all-time series with a record of 10-7-1.
- Spartan head coach Simon Tobin has coached in all 18 meetings, leading the Roadrunners in the first 12 matches before taking over at the helm in San José for the final six. All 18 of the meetings have been played over the course of the last 12 years.
- SJSU faced CSU Bakersfield three times in 2013 (Tobin's final year with CSUB), matching a program-high for meetings with an opponent in a single season (1972 vs. UCLA, 2013 vs. Seattle and UNLV).
- San José State has won two in a row against the Roadrunners and has earned results in four of the last five meetings, outscoring them 6-3 in that stretch. It has not lost to CSU Bakersfield in San José since 2013, dropping a 4-3 decision at Spartan Stadium.
- CSUB currently holds a record of 1-5, falling by a tally of 1-0 at Pacific in its last match.

TOBIN'S TEAM:

- 2019 marks the sixth season at the helm in San José for Tobin, who joined the Spartans after spending the previous 27 seasons as the head coach at CSU Bakersfield.
- Tobin is a native of London, England, graduating from Nonington College in 1983.



- His 338 career victories ranks No. 10 in all of Division I among active coaches.
- Postseason success has been a staple of Tobin's time in San José as the Spartans have made the Western Athletic Conference title match in both the 2017 and 2018 seasons.
- He has continued to turn out some of the top talent in the conference year in and year out, placing a total of 15 players on the All-Western Athletic Conference Team throughout his tenure.
