LAST TIME OUT:

- UCF surrendered just one goal, but wound up falling in The American final to SMU for the third consecutive season.
- Louis Perez took five shot attempts and landed two on goal, but was unable to find the back of the net.
- The Knights dominated possession in the 2nd half
- This was the third straight time that UCF had fallen to SMU in The American championship.

KNIGHT NOTES

BACK IN THE BIG DANCE

- The Knights earned the #9 national seed, the highest in program history, for the 2019 NCAA Tourney.
- This is UCF's second NCAA Tournament nod in as many seasons, making it the first time they've reached the big dance in back to back seasons since 2010-2011.
- Overall, this is the seventh time UCF has been to the NCAA Tournament. They went in three straight seasons from 2002-2004 before earning

BACK-TO-BACK!

- UCF clinched the outright American Athletic Conference regular season title with their final win of the regular season. The conference crown is UCF's second consecutive regular season championship and fifth in program history, with the other three in the A-Sun from 2002-2004
- The Black and Gold have clinched the No. 1 seed in The American postseason tournament for the second consecutive season. They wound up falling to SMU in the conference championship final.

HIGHEST RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- The Knights checked in at #5 in the United Soccer Coaches Poll on Nov. 12, giving UCF their highest ranking in program history. This is the second time the Knights have topped their program best this season. Their original previous best ranking was #7 in the nation which was achieved on Nov. 6, 2018. The Black and Gold broke that record on Oct. 29 this season when they were #6.
- UCF has been ranked since Oct. 9th, 2018 when UCF broke into the United Soccer Coaches Poll at #19. The Knights have not left the top 20 since that time and haven't left the top 15 since Sept. 17, 2019.
- The Black and Gold began their 2019 season ranked at #15, one spot lower than their #14 national seed they earned in the NCAA Tournament in 2018.

WORKING OVERTIME

- The Knights have gone to overtime in 8 of their matches this season. They have posted a record of 6-0-2 when going to an extra segment. UCF played in four straight overtime matches and saw five of their six matches in October reach OT.
- Freshman Gino Vivi has netted three of UCF's game winners in overtime this season. Cal Jennings has two overtime game winners, bringing his total to six. Yoni Sorokin scored the remaining OT GWG.

PROTECTING THE KINGDOM

- Since head coach Scott Calabrese took over at the beginning of the 2017 season, the Knights have posted a record of 21-3-5 at home, good enough for an .810 winning percentage.
- One of those losses was the 2018 NCAA second round match in which UCF were hosts. The other two were in The American championship matches in 2018 and 2019.

RECORD SETTING ATTENDANCE

- 1,237 fans packed the stands for the AAC championship match, a new attendance record for the men's soccer program at UCF.
- This topped the previous best attendance mark of 1,108 set in last season's American championship.

ADDITIONAL KNIGHT NOTES

ITS AN HONOR

- UCF took home five major AAC Awards at the end of the regular season and had seven players on an all-conference team.
- Three of the awards were repeats. Cal Jennings won his second consecutive Offensive Player of the Year Award, Yannik Oettl took home his second straight Goalkeeper of the Year Honor, and the UCF coaching staff won The American Coaching Staff of the Year award for the second year in a row.
- Yoni Sorokin was named conference Midfielder of the Year while Gino Vivi is the Rookie of the Year.
- Jennings, Oettl, Sorokin and Yanis Leerman were named First Team All-Conference while Louis Perez wound up on the second team. Vivi and Glademir Mendoza found themselves on the All-Rookie team.
- With Jennings winning the Offensive Player of the Year award, UCF has now taken home the award in the last 5 seasons and in 6 of the 7 years of men's soccer in The American.

THE UNBEATEN STREAK

- UCF had gone unbeaten in 16 consecutive matches before their loss to SMU. It was their longest such streak in program history.
- The streak tops the previous best unbeaten streak of 10 matches, achieved in '80, '82 and '18.

SKY HIGH RPI

- UCF sits at #5 in the latest edition of the NCAA men's soccer RPI, climbing as high as #3 this season. When UCF achieved their previous best coaches poll ranking of #7, they were #13 in the RPI, which led to the Knights getting a #14 national seed in '18. UCF ended up with the #9 national seed this season.

OVER THE HILL (40 GOAL CLUB)

- Cal Jennings scored his 40th goal as the golden goal in UCF's win over Stetson. He is just the fourth player in UCF history to reach that mark.
- Heikki Ritvanen (88), Randy DeSield (56) and Ari Nurmi (47) are the other members of the 40 goal club, as Jennings needs 4 goals to climb into 3rd place all time at UCF; he is currently at 44.

WINNER WINNER, CHICKEN DINNER

- In his time at UCF, Cal Jennings has scored 16 game winning goals. He has tallied 6 so far this year.
- The mark of 16 places him second all-time in the conference in game winning goals, trailing only Abdou Mbacke Thiam who played at UConn from 2015-18. He tallied 22 game winners.
- He currently leads all active players in NCAA game-winning goals.

#UCFast...SCORING EARLY AND OFTEN

- UCF has scored within the first 15 minutes in 8 of their last 16 matches and within the first 7 minutes in 5 of their last 13 matches. The streaks of 7 and 4 respectively ended against SMU as the Knights didn't score until the 47th minute.
- Currently, UCF sits at 7th in the nation in goals scored per game with a mark of 2.33. The Knights finished with 2.32 goals per game last season which ranked them 5th in the NCAA.

DO YOU REMEMBER? THE UNBEATEN MONTH OF SEPTEMBER (AND OCTOBER)

- The Knights haven't lost a match since their season opener against then No. 4 Wake Forest and finished the month of September with a record of 6-0-1. The only non-win was to Penn State.
- October was just as successful, finishing the month with a mark of 5-0-1, with the draw at SMU.
- Since Scott Calabrese has taken over as head coach at UCF, the team has not lost a match in October. Overall, the Knights are 15-0-3 in October over the past three seasons, posting a 5-0-1 mark in each season.





COACHING STAFF



Scott Calabrese
 Head Coach - 3rd Season at UCF

Scott Calabrese was named the sixth head men's soccer coach at UCF on Dec. 5, 2016.

In just his second season with UCF, Calabrese and the staff earned the American Athletic Conference Coaching Staff of the Year after winning the conference regular season title with a 5-1-1 record in conference play. Overall, the Knights finished 13-3-3. Since becoming a Division I program, it is the third best record the Knights have garnered. UCF put together an impressive 8-2-3 record at the UCF Soccer Complex scoring 29 goals and grabbing 86 points. The two-time conference coach of the year has posted a 106-76-25 overall mark throughout his career.

Calabrese coached one of the best offenses in all of Division I in 2019. For the entire regular season, the Knights had been ranked top 10 in the nation in almost every offensive category including total assists, total goals, total points, scoring offense, points per game, assists per game, goals per game, and have been the top team in shots per game and shots on goal per game. UCF was also the top team in The American in all of those categories.

The 2018 team moved into the program record books after recording eight goals and eight assists in the 8-1 win over Jacksonville for 24 points, the fifth most in program history. The Knights also went on a 10-match unbeaten streak, which breaks their previous record of nine. In his first season with UCF (2017), the Knights went 8-6-2 overall and 4-2-1 in conference play. The team went undefeated at home posting four wins and finished second in the American Athletic Conference under Calabrese's leadership.

Calabrese spent the previous three seasons before coming to UCF at FIU, taking the program to its first NCAA Tournament appearance in over 10 years by capturing the 2015 Conference USA Championship. He helped the Panthers to consecutive appearances in the finals at the C-USA Championship.

The Newton, Conn., native has been known for building programs and started the program at East Tennessee State in 2008. In three short years, he guided the Bucs to the 2010 Atlantic Sun Championship behind 10 shutout victories, earning a berth in the NCAA Tournament. The 2010 NSCAA South Region Coach of the Year tallied four seasons with 10-or-more victories and also aided ETSU to the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

Prior to taking the head coaching position at ETSU, Calabrese served four seasons as an assistant at Clemson from 2003-06. He aided the Tigers to three NCAA Tournament appearances, including the 2005 College Cup and a No. 1 national ranking. He additionally worked as the director of the Clemson Soccer Academy, which hosts over 1,800 youth soccer players a year.



Paul Souders
 Associate Head Coach - 3rd Season at UCF

Paul Souders joined the men's soccer staff in the spring of 2016 as an assistant coach and was promoted to Associate Head Coach in the fall of 2018.

The two-time NSCAA Far West Region Assistant Coach of the Year spent eight seasons at New Mexico before coming to Orlando, Fla. During a nine-year stint with the Lobos, Souders helped the program to three NCAA Sweet 16 appearances, including a run to the 2013 NCAA College Cup in Philadelphia, Pa. New Mexico's success includes qualifying for five NCAA Tournaments, four conference championships and an undefeated (18-0-4) campaign in 2011. The Lobos posted a 101-42-21 overall and 45-18-7 league mark during that span. While serving as associate head coach over the past seven campaigns, Souders was responsible for recruiting, academics, scheduling and coaching the offensive attack.

Academics are a point of emphasis for Souders, who aided the Lobos to a program-record 3.43 grade point average in the fall of 2013. He mentored two-time COSIDA Academic All-America selection Levi Rossi and NSCAA Scholar Athlete Kyle Venter. Lobo student-athletes had also earned eight COSIDA Academic All-Region and 27 academic all-conference honors under his guidance. Prior to arriving at New Mexico, Souders spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Dayton, helping the Flyers to a 27-18-11 overall record. During his tenure, four former Flyers who have played professionally in North America and Europe.
