UCF 31 (7-3, 4-2) at Tulsa 34 (3-7, 1-5)

Nov. 8, 2019 | Chapman Stadium | Attendance: 16,331

Weather: Partly cloudy | Temp: 47 degrees | Wind: 3 MPH from the south-southeast

General

- UCF captains: Senior running back Adrian Killins Jr., junior wide receiver Tre Nixon, junior defensive tackle Kenny Turnier, junior cornerback Aaron Robinson and sophomore defensive back Jon Powell
- Coin Toss: UCF won the toss and elected to defer to the second half. Tulsa chose to receive and defend the north end zone.

Team

- The Knights fell to 18-4 with Josh Heupel at the helm
- UCF now trails Tulsa 8-3 in the all-time series and has still never won on the road against Tulsa
- The Knights have still won 32 of their last 36 games
- The Knights scored on the ground and through the air, its 36th straight game doing so, a streak that leads the nation (Oklahoma, 2nd – 22)

Offense

- The Knights failed to score on their first offensive drive for just the third time in 10 outings, but the second straight contest
- Jordan Johnson made his team-leading 48th straight start on the offensive line
- UCF had two scoring drives under two minutes, increasing the season total to 43 scoring drives under two minutes, but had an uncharacteristic three scoring drives over two minutes
- Bentavious Thompson scored for the fourth straight game and now leads the Knights with eight rushing touchdowns on the season
- Otis Anderson scored his fourth rushing touchdown of the season and his second receiving touchdown of the season
- He now has 21 total touchdowns in his career
- Adrian Killins Jr. scored his sixth rushing touchdown of the season and is now tied for fifth all-time at UCF with 24 career rushing touchdowns
- He also is fourth all-time, now with 33 total touchdowns in his career
- Gabriel Davis caught six passes for 98 yards and surpassed 1,000 receiving yards on the season for the first time in his career
- Dillon Gabriel threw a touchdown pass for the 10th straight game to start his career
- It also marked just the third game this season that he threw an interception, throwing two to increase his season total to seven
- Gabriel threw 115 straight passes without an interception, having come into the weekend sixth in the nation with 92 consecutive passes without a pick

Defense

- It marked the third straight game UCF's opponent has scored first, but just the fourth time overall this season

- Kenny Turnier recorded a sack and 2.5 tackles for loss, now leading the Knights with 12.0 tackles for loss on the season
- UCF hadn't allowed its opponent to score in the third quarter in the last two games, but allowed seven third-quarter points to Tulsa
- Tulsa's 34 points were the second most UCF has given up this season (35, Pittsburgh)

Special Teams

- Dylan Barnas connected on a 35-yard field goal to improve to 9-for-10 on the season
