#### KNIGHT **NOTES**

#### BEEN HERE BEFORE

- The Knights started last season 1-3, falling out of the top 25 of the United Soccer Coaches Poll and into last place in the American Athletic Conference table.
- UCF finds themselves in the same spot they were last season, starting 1-3 once again.
- Despite the slow start in 2020-21, the Knights were able to rally, piecing together a six-match
  winning streak to finish the regular season at the top of the conference for their third straight regular
  season crown. The momentum continued as the Knights rolled through the AAC tournament, beating
  rival-SMU in PKs in the semifinals and then triumphing over Tulsa 1-0 in the final to secure UCF's first
  conference tournament title.

### DYNAMIC DUO

- The Knights have found a majority of their offense from Lucca Dourado and Gino Vivi. 13 of UCF's last 16 goals (dating back to last season) have come from either of the two, with Dourado responsible for seven in that tally.
- Dourado scored three of the final four goals during the 2020-21 camapaign while Dourado and Vivi scored the eight of the last nine goals to finish the year.
- Vivi tallied the first goal of the 2021 season with Dourado following him up with two goals of his own, meaning that at one point during last match, the pair had scored 11 of UCF's last 12 goals.
- The tandem scored the first three goals of UCF's 2021 season and the final five of 2020-21.

### **TROPHIES**

- The Knights earned a pair of conference championships last season, winning the regular season as well as the conference tournament title.
- UCF has won the American Athletic Conference regular season title for the third straight season, but won the championship tournament for the first time in program history.
- After a 1-3 start, the Knights charged on to the top of the table, winning six matches in a row.
- It's the sixth conference title in the team's Division I history. The Knights three-peated for their first conference titles in their Division I era from 2002-2004 when they were members of the ASUN.

#### **OH HOW SWEET IT IS!**

- For the second time in program history and for the second conecutive season, the Knights advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament during the 2020-21 season.
- In 2019, the #9 nationally-seeded Knights defeated an unbeaten Missouri State team ranked #12 in the country in the second round while the spring of 2021 saw UCF down 5-0-3 17th ranked James Madison in their first matchup of the tournament.

#### **HIGH POWERED OFFENSE**

- The Black and Gold finished the 2020-21 campaign outscoring teams 18-8 during their final 10 matches. Four of those goals against came in the NCAA Tournament in a 4-0 loss to No. 2 Pittsburgh.
- Despite losing three starting forwards and midfielders, the Knights still have a potent attack, as they return leading scorer Gino Vivi and the talented young striker Lucca Dourado.
- The Knights were ranked in the top 10 in nearly every offensive category in 2018 and 2019 and look to return to that level in 2021 after falling to 69th in goals per match (1.50) in 2020-21









#### THE HEIR TO THE GOALKEEPING THRONE IS...UNDECIDED

- After Yannik Oettl's departure for the New England Revs II of the USL League One, the heir to the goalkeeping throne has yet to be decided.
- · Matt Douglass, Bernardo Brandao and Tyler Lavigne are all options to jump into the starting role.
- Douglass is the only one who has seen match action, earning a 1-1 mark during the 2020-21 season.
- · Douglass got the start in game one this season while Lavigne earned the start in game two before exiting with an injury in the 72nd minute.

#### **NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK**

- UCF's recruiting class for this season is an expereinced one. They've landed eight newcomers, including five transfers, three of which are fifth-year seniors.
- The five transfers have a combined 14 years of experience in collegiate soccer, with three transfers coming in as fifth year seniors (Nick Taylor, Alessandro Campoy and Rainer De Jesus), one as a junior (Robbie Soronellas) and another as a sophomore (Lucas Mauro)
- Three talented rookies join the Knights as Asher J'n Pierre, Kevin Andrews and Ryan Jani are set for their first season of collegiate soccer.

#### LUCKY 13

- The Knights began the season at No. 13 in the United Soccer Coaches Poll.
- UCF was the only member of the AAC in the rankings and the only Florida school in the top 25.
- The Black and Gold ended 2020-21 at No. 13 in the rankings and open the 2021 campaign there again

#### DEFENDING THE KINGDOM

- Since head coach Scott Calabrese took over at the beginning of the 2017 season, the Knights have posted a record of 27-6-6 at home.
- One of those losses was the 2018 NCAA second round match in which UCF were hosts. Another was in The American championship match in 2019 (officially goes down as a tie in 2018 finals)
- · UCF's 2020-21 home losses were two of just four regular season home losses in Calabrese's tenure, the other two being a 1-0 loss to UC Irvine in overtime on August 27, 2018 and the 2021 opening loss to FIU.

#### **IT'S AN HONOR**

- The Knights were picked to finish first in the American Athletic Conference's Preseason Coaches Poll, earning three first place votes and a total of 22 points
- UCF's Yanis Leerman was picked as The American's Preseason Defensive Player of the Year after earning an All-American bid during the 2020-21
- · Leerman and Anderson Rosa were unanimously named to the All-Conference Preseason Team while Vivi made his way onto the squad as well.
- · Vivi earned a spot on the TopDrawer Best XI Second Team while also earning a No. 14 ranking in TopDrawer's Top 100 list. Leerman also landed on the list, checking in at No. 42.

#### THE UNBEATEN RUN

- The Knights are unbeaten in 51 of their last 66 matches, a solid run dating back to Oct. 4, 2017.
- UCF had gone unbeaten in 16 consecutive matches before their loss to SMU in the conference tournament in 2019. It was their longest such streak in program history.
- The 16-match unbeaten streak topped the previous best of 10 matches, acheived in '80, '82 and '18.
