KNIGHT NOTES

LOOKING TO SNAP THE STREAK

- UCF is in the midst of a three-match losing streak, which has been rare under head coach Scott Calabrese. The only two losing streaks of three were this year and last, both during American Athletic Conference play.
- The Knights have not lost four consecutive matches in the Calabrese era and looking to avoid doing so for the first time since 2014. The Black and Gold went 2-10-6 that year and suffered four straight one goal defeats (3-2 OT loss at Memphis, 2-1 loss at FIU, 1-0 losses vs. UConn and vs. USF).

- Historically, the month of October has been scary for UCF's opposition, with the Knights going 18-5-3 since head coach Scott Calabrese's arrival.
- The first three Octobers of Calabrese's tenure all ended with a record of 5-0-1. UCF did not experience its first October loss until the 2021 season, falling to Memphis 3-0 on Oct. 3. The Knights went 3-3 in an uncharacteristic month of October in 2021, finishing with a 5-0 loss on Halloween.
- With the Oct. 1 & 5 losses to FAU and SMU this year, the Black and Gold have now lost four straight October matches, all of them at home.

- UCF is once again one of the highest scoring teams in college soccer, scoring at a rate of 2.00 goals per game, a top 40 mark in the country.
- Despite being 9-8 in 2021, the Knights were consistently among the top scoring programs in the country, finishing the year with a 2.53 goals per game mark, placing them fifth in the country. In total, UCF scored 43 times to tie 14th in the national landscape in goals.
- The goal scoring trend is nothing new to the Knights in the Scott Calabrese era, as they have finished in the top 50 nationally in goals per game in four of his five years as head coach and have finished in the top 11 in three instances (2022: 5th, 2.53 goals per game; 2019: 11th, 2.25 goals per game, 2018: 5th, 2.32 goals per game).

GOAL STREAK / RECORD WATCH

- Lucca Dourado brings a six-match goal streak into the contest, scoring at least one goal over his last six games. His streak is the second longest active in the country, behind LIU's Emil Jaaskelainen who has scored in seven straight matches.
- In just his junior year, Dourado has already entered sole possesion of 10th place on UCF's all-time goals list with 25 career goals.
- Mauricio Villalobos and Gino Vivi had their streaks of four consecutive matches each snapped on the road at Memphis on Sep. 24.
- · Vivi's collection of points has allowed him to climb in a few career categories at UCF, needing just three more points to crack into the top 10 in scoring. He sits at 18 goals and 22 points, equalling 58 points. Vivi is already in the top 10 in all-time assists at UCF, sitting in a tie of 6th currently.

THE NATION IS WATCHING LUCCA AND GINO

- Lucca Dourado and Gino Vivi have been named as Players to Watch by the United Soccer Coaches. This is the first year that the organization has put out watch lists, which include all players from last season's All-Region First and Second Teams.
- The Knights have found a majority of their offense from Dourado and Vivi over the past two seasons. The pair has 37 of UCF's last 67 goals, dating back to the 2020-21 season (played in the spring of 2021) have come from either of the two.
- Dourado and Vivi were responsible for 20 of UCF's 43 goals in 2021, with Dourado netting 13 and Vivi collecting seven.

IT'S NOT HOW YOU START, BUT HOW YOU FINISH

- Inlocuting the 2022 campaign, UCF has lost the opening match in four straight seasons. Until this year, the Knights had not won more than one match in their first three contests, starting 1-1-1 in 2019 and 1-3 in both the 2020-21 and 2021 seasons.

 The Knights typically experience an upswing after the first handful of matches, ripping off 14 straight unbeaten after a 1-1-1 start in 2019,
- winning nine straight after the 1-3 start in 2020-21 and coming out victorious in seven of eight in 2021 after the same start as the year prior. Despite starting slow, the Knights reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament in two of those seasons (2019, 2020-21). Each of those three years, they have at least reached the championship match in the American Athletic Conference tournament.
- UCF has finished 15-3-2, 9-4-1, and 9-8 over the last three seasons.

FIFTEEN NEW KNIGHTS

- The amount of newcomers outweigh the returners on this season's men's soccer squad, with 15 new players set to take the pitch this fall.
- Headlining the group are three ACC transfers, with defenders Raphael Crivello and Zane Bubb coming from Pittsburgh and Virginia Tech respectively, as well as midfielder AJ Seals, an Orlando native who transfers in from NC State.





KNIGHT NOTES - CONTINUED

• A total of 11 freshmen join the Knights this season, plus another transfer in Ousmane Ba from Oregon State. Two goalkeepers, three defenders, two midfielders and four forwards make up the 10 new members of the Black and Gold. The 15th newcomer, Gouin was added Aug. 30.

DEFENDING THE KINGDOM

- Since head coach Scott Calabrese took over at the beginning of the 2017 season, the Knights have posted a record of 32-11-6 at home.
- The 2021 season was the first time the Knights have lost more than two regular season home matches. UCF has lost just nine regular season home matches during Calabrese's tenure. Prior to the 2020-21 season, UCF only had one regular season home loss thru the first three campaigns.

KNIGHTS PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN AAC, THREE ON PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

- UCF was voted to finish second in this year's American Athletic's preseason poll. The last time UCF was picked to finish second in the preseason poll was before the 2020-21 season, played in the spring of 2021. The Knights went on to win the regular season and tournament title.
- Tulsa led the way with nine of 10 possible first place votes this season, coming in first with 81 points. UCF was second with 66 points, followed by Charlotte and FIU tied with 60 points. FIU earned one first place vote. Rounding out the poll is SMU (58 pts.), South FIa. (36), Memphis (31), FAU (27), Temple (19) and UAB (14).
- Lucca Dourado, Anderson Rosa and Gino Vivi were named to the American Athletic Conference's Preseason All-Conference Team ahead of the 2022 season. Dourado was unanimously named to the squad, one of just four student-athletes to be named by all voters in the poll.
- UCF boasts three members on the Preseason All-Conference Team, tied for second with FIU and behind only Tulsa who has four.

CHAMPIONSHIP MINDSET

- With last season's American Athletic Conference Championship final appearance, UCF made its fifth straight appearance in the conference tournament final. They have only ever won one tournament title, beating Tulsa 1-0 in the final in 2020-21. The Knights have been a top two seed in each of the last five seasons and have reached the final each time.
- The Knights have won three regular season conference titles during Calabrese's five seasons.

ONE FINAL RUN IN THE AMERICAN

- The Knights are set to embark on their final season in the American Athletic Conference, as the athletics department as a whole is making the jump to the Big 12 Conference in July of 2023.
- For the first time since COVID-19, the league will host more than six teams with the addition of FIU, FAU, UAB and Charlotte. They join SMU, Tulsa, Memphis, Temple and South Florida to make a 10-team league. Cincinnati and UConn were formerly members of The American, but COVID-19 caused Cincinnati's program to shut down while UConn left with the rest of its athletic department for the Big East.
- UCF is 39-22-11 (.618) in American play in its nine seasons as a member of the conference with four total titles (3 regular season, 1 tournament)
- The Knights have been either a No. 1 or No. 2 seed at the AAC tournament over the last five seasons, earning the No. 1 seed in three.

UCF MENS SOCCER SUN BELT BOUND

The UCF men's soccer team will compete in the American Athletic Conference for one more athletic season before transitioning to become an affiliate member of the Sun Belt Conference beginning in 2023-24. The move is in tandem with the rest of UCF's sports moving to the Big 12 Conference in 2023-24, a league which does not sponsor men's soccer. The Knights have been part of The American for nine seasons and in August will embark on their 10th and final campaign as part of the conference.

"I'm very excited to be partnering with Commissioner Keith Gill and Deputy Commissioner Kathy Keene. They are great people and I'm excited to work with them again. We believe the move to the Sun Belt positions our men's soccer program for great success in the coming years. Coach Calabrese has shown his teams can compete with the best of the best in The American, and we can't wait to see the program continue to grow and compete in the very strong Sun Belt Conference." - Terry Mohaiir, UCF Vice President & Athletics Director

FUN IN THE SUN

- Following the 2022 season, UCF will make the jump to the Sun Belt, as the rest of the athletic department leaves The American for the Big 12, a conference that doesn't sponsor men's soccer.
- The Sun Belt will be the fourth conference the UCF men's soccer program has been a part of, playing in the Atlantic Sun from 1993-2004, Conference USA from 2005-2012 and The American from 2013 through the 2022 season.
- The Sun Belt recently re-emerged as a conference, resuming play in 2022 after previously sponsoring men's soccer from 1976-1995 and 2014-20. The Knights will join Kentucky, South Carolina and West Virginia as men's soccer members only. Those four teams will join James Madison, Marshall, Old Dominion, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern and Georgia State.
- The members of the revamped Sun Belt have enjoyed great success lately. Marshall won the national championship during the 2020 season, played in the spring of 2021. West Virginia and Kentucky reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament in 2021 and finished No. 8 and No. 11 in the United Soccer Coaches Poll, respectively. Coastal Carolina is one of the winningest programs in the NCAA and has made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances since 2010. Overall, six of UCF's nine future conference mates finished in the top 75 of the 2021 season's RPI, with four of those finishing in the top 35.

THE UNBEATEN RUN

- The Knights are unbeaten in 63 of their last 87 matches, a solid run dating back to Oct. 4, 2017.
- UCF had gone unbeaten in 16 consecutive matches before their loss to SMU in the conference tournament in 2019. It was their longest such streak in program history.
- The 16-match unbeaten streak topped the previous best of 10 matches, acheived in '80, '82 and '18.
