## UCFACTS - KNIGHT NOTES

### BEATING FLORIDA FOES

- The Knights earned their first win of the season on Friday night, beating FSU 68-54.
- The Black and Gold have now won back-to-back games against the Seminoles after losing the first 11 meetings, beating FSU in December of 2020 and November of 2022.
- UCF has found success against in-state opponents under head coach Johnny Dawkins, going 20-5 since his arrival against teams from Florida.
- The Knights went 5-1 against teams from Florida last season, beating Miami 95-89, Jacksonville 63-54, Bethune-Cookman 81-45, and taking two of three meetings against South Florida, including a 50-48 victory at the American Athletic Conference Championship in the first round.

### JAY LEADS THE WAY

- Jaylon Young led the Knights in scoring in UCF's win over FSU on Friday, netting 17 points.
- Young was one of three UCF players in double digits and was joined by Taylor Hendricks (15) and Ithiel Horton (14).

### TAYLOR HENDRICKS IS HIM

- Taylor Hendricks is off to a phenomenal start in the Black and Gold. After what could have been one of the best debuts by a UCF freshman, he followed it up with a double-double the next night out.
- The rookie posted a team best 23 points and added five rebounds and three blocks on opening night against UNC Asheville and had 15 points and 12 rebounds against FSU

### FIVE NEW KNIGHTS HIT DOUBLE FIGURES IN GAME ONE

- A total of nine Knights made their debut in the Black and Gold on Monday. P.J. Edwards was the only player on the roster from last year to play in the game, but redshirted in 2021-22
- Of the nine Knights to play, five of them hit double figures. Two of the five reached 20 points, with Taylor Hendricks tallying 23 and CJ Walker scoring 20. Brandon Suggs racked up 16, Ithiel Horton scored 12 and Michael Durr had 11.
- It was the first time since Mar. 11, 2021 (vs. ECU) that five Knights had scored double digits. Darius Perry (15), Darin Green Jr. (12), Averty Diggs (12), Jamille Reynolds (10) and Brandon Mahan (10) all were in double figures that night.

### PROTECTING HOME COURT

- The Knights have made a habit of protecting home court under head coach Johnny Dawkins, going 72-22 at Addition Financial Arena.
- Johnny Dawkins had started all six of his previous seasons as head coach with a win on Opening Night but saw the streak snapped with this year's 98-95 double overtime loss to UNC Asheville. UCF is now 6-1 in home openers under Coach Dawkins.

### UNIQUENESS IN NUMBERS

- Head coach Johnny Dawkins is one of 23 former NBA players that are current head coaches in NCAA Division I.
- Taylor and Tyler Hendricks are one of 33 sets of brothers in the NCAA and are one of 12 sets of twins.

### NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- The Knights landed a pair of highly-touted freshmen, signing twins Taylor and Tyler Hendricks. Taylor was ranked as a four-star recruit out of high school and was ranked 54th in the nation in his recruiting class by ESPN, including the 11th player in Florida and the 13th overall power forward. Taylor and Tyler have enjoyed plenty of success together, including winning back-to-back state championships. The two led Calvary Christian Academy to Florida 3A state titles in their final two years under coach Cilk McSweeney.
- UCF welcomed six transfers to the team for the 2022-23 season. Lahat Thioune joins UCF from Utah, while Jaylon Young comes from Baton Rouge CC, Michael Durr from Indiana, Brandon Suggs from ECU, Ithiel Horton from Pitt and C.J. Kelly from UMass.
- To round out the 12 newcomers to the team, the Knights added Thierno Sylla, Charlie May, Michael Kalina and Poohpha Warakulnukroh.

## UCFACTS - KNIGHT NOTES (CONT.)

### NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- UCF will play a total of 12 non-conference games this season, up two from last year (8-2 record).
- Of the 12 non-conference games in 2022-23, five will be against teams that finished 110th or better in the final edition of the 2021-22 NET rankings. They are Oklahoma State (45), Miami (47), Florida State (104), Ole Miss (110) and either Santa Clara (70) or DePaul (103) depending on who is victorious in the first round of games in the Baha Mar Hoops Championship.
- UCF beat Miami and Michigan in non-conference play last season. The Knights capitalized on the energy of 9,358 strong at Addition Financial Arena on Dec. 30, 2021, the third largest crowd in UCF history, to secure the 85-71 win over the Wolverines.

### DAWKINS ERA AT UCF

- Johnny Dawkins picked up career win No. 100 in the Knights' win over N.C. A&T on Dec. 11, 2022, becoming just the third coach in UCF history to reach the milestone.
- Dawkins is 113-73 since starting with the Knights in 2016, a win percentage of .605, the second best of any UCF coach (Torchy Clark, .754 from 1969-83).
- He has the third most wins over any UCF coach, trailing only Clark's 274 and Kirk Speraw's 247 from 1993-2010.
- Dawkins is the fastest coach to reach 100 wins in program history in the Division I era, needing only 162 games to do so.
- Dawkins had his squad off to a 4-0 start to begin the 2021-22 season, tying his 2017-18 mark for his best start to a season at UCF.
- Dawkins has led UCF to its first NIT Final Four (2017), first at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament (2019) and first NCAA Tournament win (2019).
- Prior to Dawkins' arrival at UCF, the program had won three games against ranked opponents from 1984-2016. Since Dawkins has taken over, the Knights have won five games against ranked opponents.
- UCF had never won two games against ranked teams in a single season, and the Knights did it in a span of five days, taking down No. 6 Houston and No. 19 Cincinnati late in the 2018-19 season.
- UCF is now 8-52 all-time against ranked opponents, but 5-18 against ranked teams under Dawkins.

### SHINING SOPHOMORE

- Second-year guard Darius Johnson was steady for UCF all last season, picking up AAC All-Freshman team honors for the 2021-22 season.
- Johnson saw action in all 30 games for the Knights last season, one of four players to do so.
- Johnson averaged 6.4 points, 3.3 rebounds and 3.3 assists last season.
- His 30 steals last season ranked third on the team.
- Johnson was named AAC Conference Freshman of the Week on Jan. 24 and Feb. 21.
- He is the son of current UCF Director of Player Development Kelvin Johnson (sixth year).

### SKYWALKER

- Forward C.J. Walker returned to the Knights for his senior year after starting 19 games for the Knights last season. He saw action in all 30 games.
- Walker averaged 8.6 points for UCF along with 5.7 rebounds.
- Walker's 170 rebounds ranked second on the team last season.
- The senior forward's best game last season happened at Tulsa on March 6, 2022 where he recorded a career-high 19 points, four rebounds and a steal.

### SO LONG, SENIORS

- The Knights honored their six senior players (as well as their two graduate managers and four student managers) ahead of the game against Cincinnati on Feb. 23.
- UCF went on to win the game 75-61.
- The game marked the final regular season home appearance for Darius Perry, Brandon Mahan, Dre Fuller Jr., Cheikh Mbacke Diong, Levy Renaud and Ryan Anders.
- UCF's seniors have accounted for 43 percent of all scoring and the same percentage of minutes played for the Knights this season.
- Senior Darius Perry currently leads all Knights with 125 assists.
- Senior Cheikh Mbacke Diong leads the team with 179 rebounds and 43 blocks.
- Entering Thursday, three of the Knights' top five scorers are seniors (Perry, Mahan and Diong).

### SHOCKED THE SHOCKERS

- UCF picked up its first win in program history over Wichita State on Feb. 8, 2022 taking down the Shockers 71-66 at Addition Financial Arena.
- The win was UCF's first over Wichita State in nine tries.
- The Knights have still yet to win in Wichita.
- Fifth-year guard Brandon Mahan had 19 points and a game-high-tying nine rebounds for UCF.
- Junior guard Darin Green Jr. added 17 points on five three-point goals.
- Senior front-liner Cheikh Mbacke Diong contributed 11 points and nine rebounds, while Darius Perry also had 10 points.

### TAMED THE TIGERS

- The UCF men's basketball team defended its home court in a big way on Jan. 12, 2022 against visiting Memphis, taking down the Tigers 74-64 to move to 10-4, 2-2 on the season.
- In the process, UCF wiped out a handful of streaks as Memphis had defeated the Knights five straight times--and the Tigers had won three straight games (and four of five) at the time.
- Meanwhile, UCF had lost two in a row after winning five straight. All that came to an end after a superior early shooting exhibition by UCF paved the way in the victory over Memphis despite multiple late runs by the Tigers.
- Junior guard Darin Green Jr. notched 20 points (eight of 14 from the field). His four three-point goals keynoted a 45.8% shooting effort by the home team (11 of 28 on long-distance attempts).
- Junior C.J. Walker and freshman Darius Johnson added 12 points each--and Walker and senior Cheikh Mbacke Diong had seven rebounds apiece.
- Fifth-year guard Darius Perry had 11 points and five assists for UCF, as six different Knights connected for at least one three-pointer.
- The Tigers missed 12 of 18 free throws, turned the ball over 19 times and shot only 39.7%.
- The win marked the Knights' first over Memphis since Feb. 16, 2019 (W, 79-72), and moved the all-time series to 27-7 in favor of the Tigers.

## UCFACTS - KNIGHT NOTES (CONT.)

### DECEMBER STREAK

- UCF was riding high on a five-game winning streak after defeating Bethune-Cookman (12/5), North Carolina A&T (12/11), Temple (12/15), North Alabama (12/22) and Michigan (12/30) before their streak came to an end with a loss at SMU on Jan. 2.
- Over that stretch, the Knights outscored opponents 389-296 while shooting 49.6 percent from the field and 37.7 percent from three-point range.
- The Knights held a +7.2 rebounding margin over opponents during their winning streak.
- Meanwhile, UCF was holding opponents to a 36.9 field goal percentage, including 27.6 percent from deep.
- Junior Darin Green Jr. led the team over the five-game streak with 17.0 points per game and was shooting 48.7 percent from three (19-of-39).
- Darius Perry was dishing the ball out with solid efficiency as he led the Knights with 29 assists over that stretch (5.8 per game).

### HANDLED THE HURRICANES

- UCF took care of business on the road in Miami as the Knights bested the Hurricanes, 95-89, at Watsco Center in Coral Gables, Florida on Nov. 13.
- UCF's 95 points marked the most scored over a 'Power 5' opponent in program history.
- The Knights' 95 points marked the most they have scored since Feb. 24, 2019, when UCF defeated SMU 95-48 in Orlando.
- UCF's Dec. 22, 2015 win over Bethune-Cookman was the last time the Knights had scored more than 95 points in a game (101).
- The Knights' win at Miami marked UCF's first over the Hurricanes since Nov. 21, 2013, when UCF won 63-58.
- Darin Green Jr. and Darius Perry knocked down a pair of early threes to give UCF the quick 10-4 lead and the Knights didn't look back from there as they didn't surrender the lead for the remainder of the game and were up as high as 17 points after going on a 9-0 run to open the second half.
- Darin Green Jr. finished three points shy of his career-high as the junior led the team with 23 points after hitting 5-of-9 from three-point range.
- C.J. Walker posted the first double-double of the year for UCF, scoring 14 and grabbing 11 rebounds, while two more Knights contributed with double-digit points in Brandon Mahan (15) and Isaiah Adams (12).
- UCF posted 16 offensive rebounds (27 total) in the win, the most offensive boards the Knights have tallied in a game since Nov. 28, 2019 against Penn.

### HAPPY TO HAVE YOU ON BOARD, MAMADOU AND CHARLES

- The Knights added a pair of newcomers to the staff over the summer of 2021 in assistant coach Mamadou N'Diaye and head strength coach Charles Stephenson.
- N'Diaye comes to UCF after two seasons as an associate coach at the University of San Francisco, having previously been an assistant at Coastal Carolina (2011-13) and Georgia Tech (2014-16).
- A former NBA player for the Toronto Raptors (2001-03), Dallas Mavericks (2003-04), Atlanta Hawks (2003-04), and Los Angeles Clippers (2004-05), N'Diaye was a four-year standout at Auburn and enjoyed a 10-year professional career before joining the coaching ranks.
- Stephenson brings nearly 35 years of experience as a strength coach at the collegiate level. Most recently, he was the Director of Performance with the Utah men's basketball team from 2012-2021, where he was the first basketball-specific strength coach in Runnin' Utes program history. Before that, Stephenson was the strength coach for men's basketball at North Carolina State from 1996-2011 and previously held the same position at Auburn from 1994-96. Prior to Auburn, he was an assistant strength and conditioning coach at the University of Virginia from 1987-94.

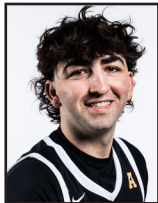

# JOHNNY DAWKINS

Head Coach | Seventh Season



Johnny Dawkins was named UCF's seventh head men's basketball coach on March 23, 2016. In five seasons at the helm, Dawkins has led the program to new heights, including guiding UCF to its first at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament in 2018-19, as well as helping the Knights to their first NCAA Tournament victory in the same season.

Dawkins closed out the 2021-22 with an 18-12 overall record, including a 9-9 mark in The American. UCF accrued a number of impressive victories on the season, taking down Michigan, Miami, Memphis and Wichita State (for the first time) in the regular season, as well as rivals South Florida in the first round of the conference tournament to end the Bulls' season. Junior Darin Green Jr. was named third team all-conference and freshman Darius Johnson picked up conference all-freshman team accolades. In UCF's Dec. 11 win over N.C. A&T, Dawkins picked up his 100th career-victory, becoming the fastest coach in program history and just the third one to ever do so.

Following the end of the 2021-22 season, Dawkins is now 112-72 all-time as head coach of the Knights, a winning percentage of .609, currently the second-highest in program history, trailing only Torchy Clark's .755 mark.

Dawkins led UCF to a 11-12 overall record for the COVID-19 affected 2020-21 season, including an 8-10 record in league play. The Knights had one of the most difficult non-conference schedules in the nation, including Oklahoma, Auburn, Michigan and Florida State. The game against the Sooners was canceled, but UCF went 2-1 in the other three games, defeating Auburn at home and winning at 15th-ranked Florida State, the program's first victory over the Seminoles.

The Knights won five of their last six games to end the season, and three members of Dawkins' 2020-21 team were recognized by the conference for their efforts on the court throughout the season as Darius Perry and Brandon Mahan earned third-team all-conference honors while Isaiah Adams was named to the all-freshman team.

It marked just the second time that the Knights have put multiple student-athletes on The American's all-conference teams and the ninth time in the program's Division I history that multiple Knights have earned all-conference honors in the same season, dating back to the 1993-94 season. With two players on the three all-conference teams, only Houston had more players earn all-conference honors.

The COVID-19 pandemic halted the 2019-20 season before the AAC Tournament could get underway, and the Knights finished the year with a record of 16-14. UCF earned wins over rival South Florida, Tulsa, SMU and on the road at Cincinnati for the first time in program history.

The 2018-19 season was one of Dawkins' best to date as he guided UCF to a nine seed in the NCAA tournament, their highest seed in five all-time NCAA Tournament appearances, and defeated eighth seeded VCU, 73-58 in first-round action.

UCF then came inches away from upsetting top overall seed Duke in the second round, ultimately falling 77-76 to Mike Krzyzewski, Zion Williamson, RJ Barrett and company as BJ Taylor's floater rimmed out and Aubrey Dawkins' tip-in barely missed at the buzzer.

The Knights were stellar down the stretch to secure their at-large NCAA Tournament berth winning on the road at No. 6/8 Houston to snap the Cougars' 33-game home win streak, and then topping No. 19/20 Cincinnati in Orlando on Senior Knight. It marked the first time UCF had earned multiple victories over ranked opponents in the same season, and the Knights did it in back-to-back games.

UCF finished the year 24-9, tied for the fourth most wins in a single season in program history. The Knights' 23 regular season wins marked a new record in UCF's Division I era. The team went 13-5 in American Athletic Conference play, the team's most league wins since joining The American, and earned the four seed in the conference tournament for the second time in three seasons.

Known for their defense under Dawkins, the Knights ranked 11th in the nation in defensive field goal percentage, holding opponents to just 39.4 percent from the floor in 2018-19. UCF was also 27th in scoring defense, allowing 64.5 points per game.

That same season, UCF cracked the Associated Press Top 25 Poll for the first time since 2011, earning a ranking of 25 late in the regular season. It was the latest into a season that the Knights have ever been ranked. The home finale against Cincinnati marked the first matchup of ranked teams at Addition Financial Arena.

Dawkins led UCF back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2005, and the first time as an at-large selection. The previous four NCAA Tournaments were as champions of the Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament in 1994, 1996, 2004 and 2005. He helped three individuals earn all-conference accolades from The American in 2018-19, as UCF led the league with three honorees. B.J. Taylor became the first Knight to earn first team honors from The American, while Aubrey Dawkins was named second team and Tacko Fall added third team honors.

Following the end of the 2018-19 regular season, Dawkins was named a finalist for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award and the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

In five years, Johnny Dawkins has led UCF to new heights on the basketball court, including four winning seasons, but he has done a similarly successful job with his players in the classroom. With Dawkins at

the helm, the Knights men's basketball program recorded an average semester team GPA over 3.0 for the first time in recorded history. They then did it again, setting a new program record with an average semester GPA of 3.03 in the spring of 2019.

When Dawkins took over at UCF, the Knights had gone 12-18 the season before and hadn't finished above .500 since 2012-13. He then led the Black and Gold to a 24-12 record in his first season at the helm, the sixth best turnaround in the nation. With just seven scholarship players due to transfers and injuries, the Knights earned the fourth seed – their highest ever – in the American Athletic Conference Tournament, eventually falling to league champion SMU in the semifinals.

It was a season full of firsts in 2016-17, as UCF hosted its first NIT game, defeating Colorado for the program's first win in an NIT or NCAA Tournament game. The Knights went on to defeat top seeded Illinois State on the road, before coming home to the first sell-out crowd at Addition Financial Arena and winning 68-58 over Illinois to earn a spot in the NIT Final Four.

Under Dawkins' leadership, UCF led all NCAA Division I teams in defensive field goal percentage in 2016-17, holding opponents to just 36.5 percent from the floor. The Knights were also sixth in the nation, allowing only 61.2 points per game, and gave up 45 or less points in four games over the course of the year. Dawkins was named a finalist for both the Jim Phelan and Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year awards his first season at UCF.

In year two at the helm, Dawkins had to deal with significant injuries to his three best players. His son, Aubrey Dawkins, missed the entire season with a shoulder injury, B.J. Taylor missed the first half of the season, and Tacko Fall missed the second half of the year. Taylor and Fall only played one game together.

Through the injuries, Dawkins led the Knights to a 19-13 record, at that point second only to his first season record in the last five years of UCF Basketball. The team also had a number of firsts in year two under Dawkins.

And the defense was as good as ever in Dawkins' second year coaching the Black and Gold.

### STANFORD STINT

Stanford put together four 20-win seasons in Dawkins' tenure as head coach. He is only the second coach in Stanford history with at least four 20-win seasons. Stanford's success on the court came against some of the toughest schedules in the nation. During the 2015-16 season, the Cardinal faced the sixth-most difficult slate in the country. A nation-leading 17 of Stanford's 30 games came against RPI Top 50 squads. Stanford's strength of schedule was rated in the top 50 each of the past four seasons, including two in the top 20, with an average rank of 27.75.



The Cardinal basketball program also excelled in the classroom during Dawkins' tenure, earning at least three Pac-12 All-Academic selections for five consecutive seasons and producing back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athlete of the Year recipients (2014, 2015). Stanford also received annual national academic recognition, with three players earning National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Honors Court status in 2015. The Cardinal was one of 20 NCAA Division I teams to earn an NABC Team Academic Excellence Award last season.

In 2012, Dawkins mentored Chasson Randle to become the consummate student-athlete. Randle finished that season as Stanford's all-time leading scorer and earned the program's first Academic All-America First Team selection since 2006. Under Dawkins, Stanford recorded back-to-back perfect Academic Progress Rate scores of 1000 in both the 2012-13 and 2013-14 reports, the two most recent to be released by the NCAA.

Player development was also markedly improved at Stanford under Dawkins' tutelage. Four Cardinal players were selected in the NBA Draft following their collegiate careers.

#### LEARNING FROM A LEGEND

The Washington, D.C. native coached for 10 years under the legendary Mike Krzyzewski at Duke. During Dawkins' decade as a coach at Duke, the Blue Devils won a national championship (2001), tallied six ACC regular season championships, recorded seven ACC Tournament titles and posted a 330-60 record. In four consecutive seasons from 1999-2002, Duke finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both national polls, a first in college basketball history. Duke reached a No. 1 national ranking in seven of the 10 seasons with Dawkins on the coaching staff.

While at Duke, he also served as the Player Personnel Director for the USA Basketball Senior National Team from 2006-08.

#### DECORATED DUKIE

Following a prolific high school career at Mackin Catholic in Washington, D.C., Dawkins made his way to Duke, where he would become one of the most decorated players to step foot in Durham, North Carolina. Dawkins played for the Blue Devils from 1983-86, earning Consensus All-America honors twice (1985, 1986). Dawkins was also voted as the 1986 Naismith National Player of the Year and named a Freshman All-American in 1983. During his collegiate career, he helped lead Duke to three NCAA Tournament berths, including an NCAA National Championship Game appearance in 1986. He was listed as an All-ACC honoree in all four seasons as a Blue Devil.

Dawkins finished his career as the school's all-time leading scorer and held that honor until 2006 when J.J. Redick surpassed his mark of 2,556 points. He recorded double-figure point totals in 129-of-133 collegiate games. Dawkins led the Blue Devils in scoring all four years, recording the fourth-highest season point total in school history with 809 in 1986. Dawkins remains Duke's career record-holder in field goals (1,026) and field goals attempted (2,019) while also owning the school's best single-season mark for field goals (331) during the 1986 campaign.

Dawkins was inducted into the Duke Sports Hall of Fame in September 1996. His jersey number 24 was retired by the school.

#### PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

A 1986 first-round draft pick (10th overall) by San Antonio, Dawkins saw action in nine NBA seasons with the Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Detroit Pistons. He averaged 11.1 points and 5.5 assists over 541 career NBA games.

#### GIVING BACK TO THE GAME

Dawkins has served as a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches Board of Directors since 2012. He also currently serves on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition, an independent committee of current and former coaches, charged with promoting ethical conduct through leadership, education and mentoring opportunities, while identifying key issues challenging the coaching community.
