## **LEADING OFF - KNIGHT NOTES**

#### JADA CODY, THE RBI QUEEN

- Heading into the weekend, Jada Cody is still leading the nation in RBI, collecting 56 to this point in the season. The mark is a career high for her already, doubling her previous best of 28 in 61 games in 2021. She is already in a third place on UCF's single season RBI list with 12 games left in the regular season. Cody was the fastest to 30 and 50 RBI in a season, passing UCF Hall of Famer Stephanie Best to be the fastest to that point.
- · While Cody may not catch Laura Espinoza's NCAA single-season record of 128 RBI, she has a shot at reaching the century mark. If she does, she would be just the fifth player in NCAA Softball history to reach 100 RBI. If she gets to 90, Cody would be the 15th to ever do so.
- In her third season, the Sophomore is already on UCF's all-time RBI list, sitting 9th all-time with 102 career RBI.
- On Mar. 21, Cody won her second AAC Player of the Week nod after going 7-for-12 with six extra base hits (3 2B, 2 3B, HR) and 10 RBI.
- She had a brilliant 10 RBI week in California, collecting three homers and seven RBI in one day (3/12) in a double header. • On Mar. 7. Jada Cody had one of the more memorable weekends in UCF history, going 8-for-15 with 4 homers and 14 RBI. Her performance over the entire week earned her American Athletic Conference Player of the Week honors.

## **CLEAN CONFERENCE START**

- UCF is off to a 6-0 start in conference play, sweeping South Florida and Memphis for their first 6-0 American Athletic Conference start since 2019 and for just the third time, with the other occurance in 2015.
- The Knights only shutout an American opponent over an entire series once before which was back in 2015 at ECU. The only other time it occurred in program history was last season when the Knights shutout FAU over the course of a three-game series.
- Gianna Mancha and Kaitlyn Felton tossed complete game shuouts while Kama Woodall tossed six scoreless along with an inning from G. Jewell
- For the 1st time in program history, UCF was able to sweep their War On I-4 rivals of South Florida. The sweep leveled the all-time series at 19-19. They went toe-to-toe with one of the best pitchers in college softball in Georgina Corrick and came away with two wins. Corrick had shut down the Black and Gold until the fifth inning in game one of the series before UCF plated five runs in the final three innings. She pitched again in game 3 as UCF scored their three runs on a pair of homers in a 3-0 win. Kennedy Searcy had a solo shot in the first and homered against Corrick twice on the weekend, while Cody blasted a two-run shot in the sixth inning. The Knights homered 4 times that weekend.

#### MANCHA MOWS 'EM DOWN

- Gianna Mancha brings an 11-inning shutout streak into the weekend, blanking Memphis plus four clean innings at the end of the UNF game.
- Mancha went toe-to-toe with one of the top pitchers in college softball against South Florida and came away with two victories for UCF.
- After a tough start Friday against South Florida, Mancha retired 13 Bulls in a row, pucnhing out nine in a 5-2 victory. She was even better on Sunday, tossing a complete game one-hitter for the third time this season, allowing just one infield single and striking out 10.
- All in all, Mancha tossed 14 innings with 19 strikeouts and allowed just three hits, holding batters to a .065 batting average against. Her performances earned her honors of being named the D1Softball.com Pitcher of the Week and The American Pitcher of the Week.
- Mancha had been on a roll coming into the weekend as she tossed her second career no-hitter, striking out eight Paladins while walking four through six innings in an 8-0 win over Furman. She has accomplished the feat in back-to-back seasons, earning 13 strikeouts at Memphis on Apr. 23. She is one of four Knights in program history to pitch more than one no-hitter, joining Allison Kime, Mackenzie Audas and Shelby Turnier as the only to do it. Those 4 names combined have posted 13 of UCF's solo no-hitters, with a 14th being combined. UCF has 19 total no-hitters.
- Mancha has three complete game one-hitters this season. Her first was against Longwood on 2/12 before then one at FIU on 2/23 and the third at South Florida on 3/27.

## **BEATING #5 VIRGINIA TECH**

- After tallying just one hit in 14 innings in a double header against Virginia Tech, the Knights came back with 9 hits to beat the Hokies on Monday. • It's UCF's first win over a top-five team this season and fourth over the last two campaigns. The Black and Gold beat No. 2 Arizona and No. 5
- Florida twice last year and now add a 5-4 win in 11 innings over #5 Virginia Tech to the resume. • The Knights have three wins over ranked opponents this year, bringing Ball-Malone's total to 11 over her four years as head coach of UCF.

- UCF's 18-game winning streak was snappeda at Florida on Mar. 31 and was three away from tying their all-time record of 21 achieved in 2002.
- The Knights had the third-longest active winning streak in the NCAA. Oklahoma and UCLA were the other two programs ahead of UCF.
- The last time UCF won 15 straight or better was in 2016 when the Knights went 38-22 and earned a trip to the Gainesville Regional Final.
- During the winning streak, the Knights hit .350 as a team while holding opponents to a .211 batting average. Three Knights had hit over .420 on the winning streak with seven hitting over .350. Jada Cody led the way with a batting average of .463 with 9 homers and 37 RBI, followed by Denali Schappacher, who hit .435 with five stolen bases, and Kennedy Searcy who hit .422 with four homers and 13 RBI. In the circle, UCF pitchers posted a 1.78 ERA while striking out 111 batters; 72 being Gianna Mancha's. UCF had only made 6 errors in that time.

- UCF is 4th in the country in drawing walks, earning 177 free passes through 44 games. They have had two separate games where they have worked 10 walks each and drew a total of 9 against #4 Florida. UCF was first in the country in walks all season, up until this week.
- Shannon Doherty and Kennedy Searcy are ranked nationally in walks per game, both tied and sitting at 133rd, walking 0.57 times a game.
- Doherty has 12 hit by pitches this season, which is the single-season record at UCF. She is ranked 42nd in the country in hit by pitches per game, averaging 0.27 per game.

#### **UCF SOFTBALL COMPLEX**

Since its groundbreaking on March 14, 2006, the UCF Softball Complex is where the Knights call home. The state-of-the-art facility speaks volumes for how far the program has come under the direction of head coach Cindy Ball and where it is headed. The 600-capacity stadium is one of the finest in the American Athletic Conference and on the national scene.

The entire facility received massive upgrades in the fall of 2021, giving "The Plex" a fresh look. The upgrades included a brand new locker room, padded outfield walls and backstop, new foul poles, a fresh coat of paint on the exterior of all buildings, and updated branding in team offices.

The field is professionally manicured by the UCF Facilities and Operations staff and includes a covered batting pavilion, roomy dugouts, home and visitor bullpens and an outfield fence lined with trees.

UCF student-athletes have access to everything they need to prepare for gameday at the UCF Softball Complex. The Knights have a spacious locker room, a lounge area complete with a television, couches and chairs, an equipment room and their own training room complete with a top-notch athletic training staff.

Along with having comfortable offices for each coach, the UCF Softball Complex also has a conference room, a video room and locker rooms for both the coaching staff and for umpires. The press box at the stadium has room enough for home and visitor radio broadcasts, as well as multi-level media seating.

On game days, fans have access to a ticket booth, concession stand and gift shop, while also being able to participate in multiple promotions and events throughout the season.

#### PROTECTING THE PLEX

- The Knights are 20-5 at home this season and staying true to their team mantra of "Protect the Plex"
- The Black and Gold have already had some big time wins at home, beating No. 12 Georgia, and teams that were receiving votes such as Fresno State, Liberty, and James Madison, as well as handing Ole Miss one of its four losses.
- UCF's home losses this season are against No. 4 Florida, Minnesota and South Carolina.
- The Knights are 71-27-1 at home in Ball-Malone's four seasons so far, good enough for a .722 winning percentage.

#### SCHAPP GETS 200TH HIT, CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS

- Denali Schappacher earned her 200th career hit in game two of UCF's double header on 3/19, becoming the 10th player in program history to reach the 200 hit milestone. She climbed even higher against Florida, going 2-for-2, climbing from 9th all-time in hits at UCF to a tie of 7th. She needs just 8 hits to jump into 5th all-time.
- She tied her career high of an 8-game hitting streak this season and has seven multi-hit performances. She had reached base 10 games in a row, also a new career high. On the team's California trip, Schappacher
- All-time hits at UCF isn't the only top 10 list that Schappacher will be a part of, as she is already in great position to finish top five in career batting average and on base percentage. She is currently in the top ten with a chance to be in the top five in career runs scored, stolen bases and career triples. She is making a case to crack the top 10 of career stolen base percentage, games played, games started and at bats.

#### **CALIFORNIA GURLS**

- The Knights swept their California road trip last week, going 7-0 throughout the state. They scored at least six runs in every game and earned two run-rule victories, both true road games against Cal State Fullerton and Long Beach State.
- UCF made a point of scoring early and often, collecting 15 runs combined in the first inning during the trip.
- 11 student-athletes are from California. Head coach Cindy Ball-Malone and assitant coach Whitney Jones also hail from The Golden State
- The Knights' return to Pacific was the first time that Ball-Malone had faced her former team as a head coach. She graduated from Pacific in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in sports sciences and earned her master's in education in 2006. She is considered the greatest two-way player in Pacific's history, earning back-to-back All-America honors and holds nine career pitching records for the Tigers.

#### A LOOK BACK

- The Knights finished the 2021 season with a record of 41-19-1, the winningest season since the 2015 campaign when UCF posted a 50-9 record. The campaign was one of seven seasons that the Black and Gold earned 40 or more wins.
- UCF finished the year sitting third in the American Athletic Conference standings with a 16-7-1 mark. The conference tournament saw the Black and Gold reach the championship game, where they were defeated by Wichita State 7-4.
- The Knights earned a nod to the NCAA Tournament and competed in the Tallahassee regional, in which they reached the final, defeating Auburn and Kennesaw State along the way with a Florida State loss. They matched up with the Seminoles again in the final, falling 2-0.

#### BACK TO THE TOURNEY

- UCF is looking to return to the NCAA Tournament in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 2014-16 camapaigns.
- The Knights have reached the regional final in each of their last four appearances in the NCAA Tournament, but have yet to make the Supers
- Overall, the Knights have been to the NCAA Tournament eight times, making a regional final in five trips.

#### STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- The Knights are scheduled to play 10 teams who begin the 2022 season in the USA Today/NFCA Preseason Poll
- Three opponents begin the season ranked in the top 10 (#4 Florida State, #6 Florida, #10 Texas)
- Four additional teams on UCF's schedule were receiving votes in the first edition of the poll

## BEA<u>ting the best of the best</u>

- The Knights earned three top-five victories in 2021, beating No. 2 Arizona 2-0 at home on March 8 and sweeping No. 5 Florida in a homeand-home, with UCF posting a three-run seventh to walk it off at home on Mar. 24 and taking a 7-0 win back from Gainesville on Apr. 14.
- The Black and Gold earned four ranked wins in 2021, the first time in program history that has happened.
- In total, the Knights went 4-6-1 against ranked opponents during the regular season. Since head coach Cindy Ball-Malone's arrival, UCF is 8-18-2 against ranked opponents.
- Each season under Ball-Malone has seen the Knights pick up more ranked wins than the last, earning one ranked win in 2019, three in 2020 and four in 2021.

#### **NEW STAFF, WHO THIS?**

- Ball-Malone has brought in an entirely new staff for the 2022 campaign, her fourth year at the helm of the Knights.
- Assistant Coaches Whitney Jones and Tyler Heil, Volunteer Assistant Coach Kaija Gibson and Graduate Student Assistant Alea White make up the new staff, with all parts having a connection to at least one other member in some way shape or form.
- Heil was an assitant coach for three seasons at New Mexico while Ball-Malone was a head coach at Boise State. Heil works on the defensive side of the game and will coach first base when the Knights are at-bat.
- Jones joins the Knights and will help coach the offense after being a volunteer assistant coach at Washington, which is her alma-mater. As an assistant coach, Ball-Malone coached Jones during her freshman and sophomore seasons as a Husky.
- The Washington connection continues as Gibson just finished her fiveyear playing career as a Husky, with four of them with Jones on staff as a volunteer assistant. Gibson's connection to Washington goes all the way back to 2008 where she was a bat girl for the Husky team.
- White is a name that Knight fans know and love, as she wrapped up her legendary career at the end of the 2021 season. She holds the UCF career records for wins (99), appearances (180), games started (139), complete games (103), innings pitched (969.1) and most batters faced (4142). She held batters to a .189 batting average (4th all-time at UCF) and struck out 688 batters (4th all-time at UCF)
