LEADING OFF - KNIGHT NOTES

CHAMPS!

- UCF earned the American Athletic Conference regular season title with their series victory over Wichita State in the final weekend of the regular season. The Knights clinched a share of the title after taking one game of the series and took it outright with the series victory.
- The title is the first for UCF since 2015, a year in which the Knights won both the regular season and conference tournament.
- Overall, the Knights now have three regular season conference championships, all in The American (2014, 2015 and 2022). UCF has a tournament championship from each league they've been a part of, winning the ASUN in 2005, Conference USA in 2008 and The American in 2015.
- UCF won 16 conference games in the regular season, which is tied for the most in program history, joining the '04, '08, '10, '15 and '21 teams for most conference victories in a season. The two losses in conference play were tied for the fewest with the 2015 squad.

THE ORLANDO REGIONAL?

- DI Softball's predicted Field of 64 released on May 10 had UCF as the No. 15 seed in the NCAA Tournament, slated as a regional host. It would be the first time that the Knights have hosted a regional in program history. Their super-regional matchup would be against 2-seeded Virginia Tech.
- The Knights are currently ranked 16th in the NCAA RPI's and 17th in three of the four polls recognized by the NCAA.
- UCF has more wins vs. Top 50 RPI teams (13) than other bubble host teams such as Duke (11), Notre Dame (11), Oregon (10) and Texas (9).
- The Black and Gold have the 16th overall non-conference strength of schedule, thanks to wins against four top 25 RPI teams in Georgia, Texas, Virginia Tech and Ohio State. That brings UCF's non-conference RPI to 11, better than Washington, Duke, Florida, Georgia and other bubble hosts.
- The Knights have head to head wins over bubble hosting teams this season such as Georgia and Texas.

IT'S AN HONOR

- The Knights took home three major awards and had eight members listed in The American's regular season awards.
- Micaela Macario was named Rookie of the Year and has started in 54 games, posting a .311 batting average with 27 RBI and 19 stolen bases.
- Justene Molina was named Defensive Player of the Year after not making an error in conference play and has been the everyday starter for 3 yrs.
- Five Knights were named First Team All-Conference; Jada Cody and Kennedy Searcy were unanimous while Molina, Schappacher and Mancha all made the squad. It's Schappacher's third First Team nod and Cody's second.
- Three Knights were named to the Second Team; Kama Woodall, Ashleigh Griffin and Macario. Griffin and Macario were named All-Rookie Team.

GOING OUT WITH A BANG

- A better script could not have been written when it came to UCF's Senior Day. Gianna Mancha and Kama Woodall combined for a no-hitter, the 20th no-no in program history and third time that Mancha has been involved with a no-hitter.
- Not only did the UCF senior pitcher duo combine for a no-hitter, but senior Justene Molina walked-off Tulsa via the run rule in the sixth inning, smashing a triple that just stayed fair as it whizzed by the first base bag, scoring the game-clinching run in an 8-0 win.

JADA CODY, THE RBI QUEEN, CHASING THE BEST

- Heading into the weekend, Jada Cody is fourth in the nation in RBI, collecting 64 to this point in the season. The mark is a career high for her, more than doubling her previous best of 28 in 61 games in 2021. She is now alone in second on UCF's single-season RBI list, trailing only Stephanie Best's program record 66 RBI set in 2003. Cody was the fastest to 30, 50 & 60 RBI in a season, passing Best to be the fastest to that point.
- While Cody may not catch Laura Espinoza's NCAA single-season record of 128 RBI, she has a shot at reaching the century mark. If she does, she would be just the fifth player in NCAA Softball history to reach 100 RBI. If she gets to 90, Cody would be the 15th to ever do so.
- In her third season, the Sophomore is already on UCF's all-time RBI list, sitting in 7th all-time with 110 career RBI.
- She had a brilliant 10 RBI week in California, collecting three homers and seven RBI in one day (3/12) in a double header.
- On Mar. 7, Jada Cody had one of the more memorable weekends in UCF history, going 8-for-15 with 4 homers and 14 RBI. Her performance over the entire week earned her American Athletic Conference Player of the Week honors, her first of two POTW honors this season.

PITCHING PROWESS

- UCF's pitchers have held opponents to a 1.47 ERA in conference play so far this season along with a 2.29 ERA over the entire campaign.
- Both Gianna Mancha and Kama Woodall are in the top 100 in ERA nationally, with Mancha posting a 1.70 ERA, putting her 43rd in the country, while Woodall has posted a 2.10 mark, 96th in the nation. Mancha's 1.70 ERA is currently in the hunt to be top 10 on UCF's single-season list.
- In the Knights' last time out, Mancha and Woodall combined for a no-hitter, the 20th no-no in program history and the second combined no-hitter, with the only other one taking place in 2014.
- Mancha has her name on two no hitters this season. She tossed her second career no-hitter against Furman in game one on Mar. 19, striking out eight Paladins while walking four through six innings in an 8-0 win. She has accomplished the feat in back-to-back seasons, earning 13 strikeouts at Memphis on Apr. 23. Her combined no-hitter with Woodall on 5/1 vs. Tulsa is the third of her career. She is one of four Knights in program history to pitch more than one no-hitter, joining Allison Kime, Mackenzie Audas and Shelby Turnier as the only to do it. Those 4 names combined have posted 13 of UCF's solo no-hitters, with a 14th & 15th being combined. UCF has 20 total no-hitters.
- UCF pitchers had held the opposition to three hits or less through nine games, ending in game three of the Houston series. Gianna Mancha and Kama Woodall had complete game one-hitters against ECU during that streak.
- Mancha has four complete game one-hitters this season. They were against Longwood on 2/12 before then one at FIU on 2/23 and the third at South Florida on 3/27.

KNIGHTS TO THE BIG 12

UCF has accepted an invitation to join the Big 12 Conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept. 10.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II, the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC, Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement. The bases were already loaded, and I feel very blessed and honored to get to step up to the plate on behalf of UCF." - Terry Mohajir

FRIDAY THE 13TH

- UCF will play their AAC semifinal against Houston on Friday the 13th.
- UCF is 5-4 all-time on Friday the 13ths outscoring opponents 42-36.
- The Knights have gone 0-2 in conference tournament games on Friday the 13th, both losses to Tulsa, one in the C-USA tournament in 2011 (6-1) and the other in The American in 2016 (4-0).
- The Black and Gold have scored big in their Friday the 13th wins, beating Fairfield and Monmouth 10-2 and 8-3 on 3/13/15, beating UT Arlington 5-1 on 2/13/09, and topping Jacksonville and FAU 9-5 and 3-2 on 5/13/05.

A RECORD CONFERENCE START

- UCF started off American Athletic Conference play 11-0 this season before dropping the series finale to Houston.
- The 11 straight wins to begin the conference slate beat the program record by one. UCF went 10-0 to start the 2004 season as part of the A-SUN.
- The Black and Gold earned a total shutout of Memphis in their three-game series, which is only the second time UCF has blanked an American opponent over an entire series, the other being in 2015 at ECU. The only other non-conference time it occurred in program history was last season when the Knights shutout FAU over the course of a three-game set.
- For the 1st time in program history, UCF was able to sweep their War On 1-4 rivals of South Florida to start conference play 3-0. The sweep leveled the all-time series at 19-19. They went toe-to-toe with Georgia Corrick and came away with two wins.

HEY! WE'RE WALKIN' HERE!

- UCF is 6th in the country in drawing walks, earning 219 free passes through 56 games. They have had two separate games where they have worked 10 walks each and drew a total of 9 against #4 Florida. UCF was first in the country in walks all season, up until this week.
- Doherty has 14 hit by pitches this season, which is the single-season record at UCF. She is ranked 51st in the country in hit by pitches per game, averaging 0.25 per game.
- The free passes have helped the Knights earn a .399 on base percentage, ranking them 19th in the country in that category.

BEATING #5 VIRGINIA TECH

- After tallying just one hit in 14 innings in a double header against Virginia Tech, the Knights came back with 9 hits to beat the Hokies.
- It's UCF's first win over a top-five team this season and fourth over the last two campaigns. The Black and Gold beat No. 2 Arizona and No. 5 Florida twice last year and now add a 5-4 win in 11 innings over #5 Virginia Tech to the resume.
- The Knights have three wins over ranked opponents this year, bringing Ball-Malone's total to 11 over her four years as head coach of UCF.

A STREAK TO REMEMBER

- UCF's 18-game winning streak was snapped at Florida on Mar. 31 and was three away from tying their all-time record of 21 achieved in 2002.
- The Knights had the third-longest active winning streak in the NCAA. Oklahoma and UCLA were the other two programs ahead of UCF.
- The last time UCF won 15 straight or better was in 2016 when the Knights went 38-22 and earned a trip to the Gainesville Regional Final.
- During the winning streak, the Knights hit .350 as a team while holding opponents to a .211 batting average. Three Knights had hit over .420 on the winning streak with seven hitting over .350. Jada Cody led the way with a batting average of .463 with 9 homers and 37 RBI, followed by Denali Schappacher, who hit .435 with five stolen bases, and Kennedy Searcy who hit .422 with four homers and 13 RBI.

BIG 12 PREVIEW

- The Black and Gold are 3-0 against current Big 12 opponents this season, most recently beating Iowa State 7-5 in a neutral site game in California.
- They went 2-1 against future Big 12 conference-mate in Houston, bringing their total to 5-1 against "the new Big 12"
- The Knights earned two victories against Big 12 opponents during the St. Pete/Clearwater Elite Invitational, topping Texas Tech 7-3 in eight innings and #11 Texas 15-10 in a wild softball game that few will forget.
- UCF beat both teams in comeback fashion, erasing a 3-2 deficit against Texas Tech heading into the 6th inning and a 7-4 deficit against #11 Texas, a game that the Black and Gold found themselves trailing in three different times. They used a 7run 6th inning to beat the Longhorns 15-10.

PROTECTING THE PLEX

- The Knights are 26-5 at home this season and staying true to their team mantra of "Protect the Plex"
- UCF's 26 wins at home this season is the most since the 2016 season.
- The Knights hosted their highest home attendance in program history, currently ranked 21st in the country, filling the seats with 18,945 fans.
- The Black and Gold have already had some big time wins at home, beating No. 12 Georgia, and teams that were receiving votes such as Fresno State, Liberty, and James Madison, as well as handling Ole Miss one of its four losses.
- UCF's home losses this season are against No. 4 Florida, Minnesota and South Carolina.
- The Knights are 77-27-1 at home in Ball-Malone's four seasons so far, good enough for a .740 winning percentage.

SCHAPP GETS 200TH HIT, CLIMBING CAREER CHARTS

- Denali Schappacher earned her 200th career hit in game two of UCF's double header on 3/19, becoming the 10th player in program history to reach the 200 hit milestone. She climbed even higher against Florida, going 2-for-2, climbing from 9th all-time in hits at UCF to a tie of 7th.
- She is currently 5th all-time in hits at UCF, doing so on Apr. 24.
- She tied her career high of an 8-game hitting streak this season and has seven multi-hit performances. She had reached base 10 games in a row, also a new career high. On the team's California trip, Schappacher hit .550.
- All-time hits at UCF isn't the only top 10 list that Schappacher will be a part of, as she is already in great position to finish top five in career batting average and on base percentage. She is currently in the top ten with a chance to be in the top five in career runs scored, stolen bases and career triples. She is making a case to crack the top 10 of career stolen base percentage, games played, games started and at bats.

CALIFORNIA GURLS

- The Knights swept their California road trip, going 7-0. They scored at least six runs in every game and earned two run-rule victories, both true road games against Cal State Fullerton and Long Beach State.
- UCF made a point of scoring early and often, collecting 15 runs combined in the first inning during the trip.
- 11 student-athletes are from California. Head coach Cindy Ball-Malone and assistant coach Whitney Jones also hail from The Golden State.
- The Knights' return to Pacific was the first time that Ball-Malone had faced her former team as a head coach. She graduated from Pacific in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in sports sciences and earned her master's in education in 2006. She is considered the greatest two-way player in Pacific's history, earning back-to-back All-America honors and holds nine career pitching records for the Tigers.

SHANNON'S SHOTS HEARD 'ROUND THE WORLD

- Doherty has had two walk-off homers this season, both over SEC teams and both with bat flips that have been viewed all over the internet.
- In total, Doherty's two bat flips combined have tallied over 1.48 million views on Twitter alone, as other accounts such as NCAA Softball, Fox Sports: MLB, B/R Walk-Off, Barstool Sports, and Baseball Quotes sharing one or both videos.
- The 8-second clip of her posted on social media celebrating the win over Georgia to begin the year generated over 946,000 views on Twitter.

A LOOK BACK

- The Knights finished the 2021 season with a record of 41-19-1, the winningest season since the 2015 campaign when UCF posted a 50-9 record. The campaign was one of seven seasons that the Black and Gold earned 40 or more wins.
- UCF finished the year sitting third in the American Athletic Conference standings with a 16-7-1 mark. The conference tournament saw the Black and Gold reach the championship game, where they were defeated by Wichita State 7-4.
- The Knights earned a nod to the NCAA Tournament and competed in the Tallahassee regional, in which they reached the final, defeating Auburn and Kennesaw State along the way with a Florida State loss. They matched up with the Seminoles again in the final, falling 2-0.

BACK TO THE TOURNEY

- UCF is looking to return to the NCAA Tournament in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 2014-16 campaigns.
- The Knights have reached the regional final in each of their last four appearances in the NCAA Tournament, but have yet to make the Supers.
- Overall, the Knights have been to the NCAA Tournament eight times, making a regional final in five trips.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- The Knights are scheduled to play 10 teams who begin the 2022 season in the USA Today/NFCA Preseason Poll
- Three opponents begin the season ranked in the top 10 (#4 Florida State, #6 Florida, #10 Texas)
- Four additional teams on UCF's schedule were receiving votes in the first edition of the poll

BEATING THE BEST OF THE BEST

- The Knights earned three top-five victories in 2021, beating No. 2 Arizona 2-0 at home on March 8 and sweeping No. 5 Florida in a home-and-home, with UCF posting a three-run seventh to walk it off at home on Mar. 24 and taking a 7-0 win back from Gainesville on Apr. 14.
- The Black and Gold earned four ranked wins in 2021, the first time in program history that has happened.
- In total, the Knights went 4-6-1 against ranked opponents during the regular season. Since head coach Cindy Ball-Malone's arrival, UCF is 8-18-2 against ranked opponents.
- Each season under Ball-Malone has seen the Knights pick up more ranked wins than the last, earning one ranked win in 2019, three in 2020 and four in 2021.

NEW STAFF, WHO THIS?

- Ball-Malone has brought in an entirely new staff for the 2022 campaign, her fourth year at the helm of the Knights.
- Assistant Coaches Whitney Jones and Tyler Heil, Volunteer Assistant Coach Kaija Gibson and Graduate Student Assistant Alea White make up the new staff, with all parts having a connection to at least one other member in some way shape or form.
- Heil was an assistant coach for three seasons at New Mexico while Ball-Malone was a head coach at Boise State. Heil works on the defensive side of the game and will coach first base when the Knights are at-bat.
- Jones joins the Knights and will help coach the offense after being a volunteer assistant coach at Washington, which is her alma-mater. As an assistant coach, Ball-Malone coached Jones during her freshman and sophomore seasons as a Husky.
- The Washington connection continues as Gibson just finished her five-year playing career as a Husky, with four of them with Jones on staff as a volunteer assistant. Gibson's connection to Washington goes all the way back to 2008 where she was a bat girl for the Husky team.
- White is a name that Knight fans know and love, as she wrapped up her legendary career at the end of the 2021 season. She holds the UCF career records for wins (99), appearances (180), games started (139), complete games (103), innings pitched (969.1) and most batters faced (4142). She held batters to a .189 batting average (4th all-time at UCF) and struck out 688 batters (4th all-time at UCF).

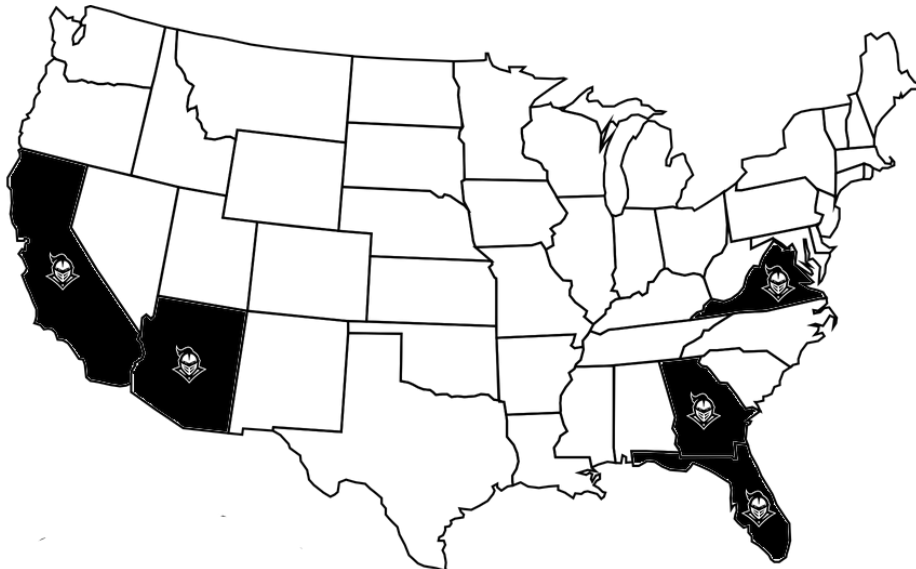

HOW IT HAPPENED

2021 - 3 seed

UCF used a three-run fourth inning to go up 4-2 on ECU in the quarterfinals. With the score 4-3 in the top of the seventh, the Pirates loaded the bases with one out. Gianna Mancha came out of the bullpen and got the next two batters to go down swinging, sending the Knights to face their War On I-4 rivals of South Florida. The Black and Gold plated two in the first inning before seeing the ballgame tied at the end of the third 2-2. Karissa Ornelas smashed a homer on a 2-0 pitch to put UCF up 3-2 in the fourth, which went on to prove as the game winner. In the AAC championship game, UCF led 3-0 in the top of the third and were making a push for their first conference title since 2015. Wichita State put up two in the bottom of the third and five in the fifth, handing the Knights a 7-4 loss.

2020

No championship held due to the COVID-19 shutdown

2019 - 5 seed

UCF and Wichita State were locked up at 1-1 until the bottom of the sixth where a Neleigh Herring homer put the Shockers on top and sent them onto the next round with a 2-1 final. It was the third straight season that UCF had been one-and-done in AAC tournament play, but it was the first season under then-new head coach Cindy Ball-Malone.

2018 - 4 seed

The Knights were upset by Memphis in their first contest of the competition. Memphis went on to lose the following round by a single run to top-seeded South Florida.

2017 - 3 seed

UCF was a first round exit against the host school in ECU, the six seed in the tournament. The Pirates used a back-to-back homers in the sixth inning to win the ballgame.

2016 - 2 seed

The Knights were able to slide past UConn by a one run margin before falling to Tulsa. UCF beat Tulsa in the championship game in 2015 and saw the Golden Hurricane get revenge and go on to win one of their three American titles that year.

2015 - 1 seed

The top-seeded Knights earned a bye through the first round on their home field and matched up with South Florida in the semifinals. The Knights were the away team for some reason in the semis, but paid no mind to it, plating two runs in the top of the seventh to secure the victory. UCF legend Shelby Turner held Tulsa to one hit in the championship game, but the offense couldn't back her up with any run support, bringing a 0-0 game into the seventh. Samantha McCloskey won UCF the title with one swing of the bat, walking it off on a solo shot. McCloskey went three-for-three that day, accounting for half of UCF's hits.

2014 - 1 seed

UCF was the inaugural regular season champs of the American, finishing first in the first season of the American Athletic Conference's existence. The Knights posted a 15-3 record in conference and won the regular season by two games over South Florida. In the quarterfinals, the Black and Gold homered five times, setting a new school record, in a 6-0 route of UConn. Rutgers struck first in the semifinal, scoring twice in the first inning. UCF answered with a five run second inning.

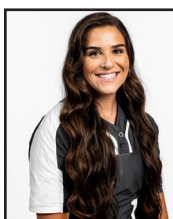

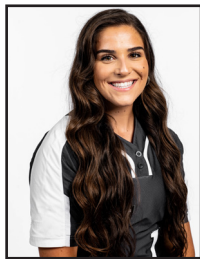

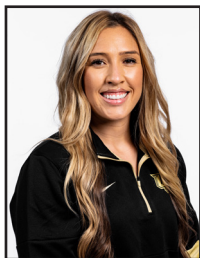
