LEADING OFF - KNIGHT NOTES

SARAH SPECTACULAR AGAIN

- UCF right-hander Sarah Willis turned in another strong weekend in the circle during the Knights' conference play-opening three-game series against the No. 22 Wichita State Shockers last weekend, throwing her third complete game in her previous four appearances during the series-opener and tossing 1.1 scoreless frames in the Sunday finale to finish the series with a 0.84 ERA (8.1 IP, 1 ER) and 7 SO accompanied by a .133 opponent batting average. Her standout performance garnered weekly Honor Roll honors from the American Athletic Conference for the fourth consecutive week.
- Her seven-inning complete game Friday night marked her third of the season, and her second of 7 IP. During her career debut season with the Knights, Willis has now recorded 5 appearances of 5 IP (or more) in her first 17 appearances of 2023 alone, after doing so just twice in 28 appearances throughout her first two collegiate seasons with Washington.
- Her efforts last weekend also factored into her recent string of dominance in the circle, as in her last 12 appearances (7 starts) spanning 47 IP since UCF's Feb. 23 doubleheader against the Gardner-Webb Runnin' Bulldogs, Willis has posted a team-low 1.19 ERA (8 ER) with a team-leading 50 SO against just 18 BB and a .158 opponent batting average in that span.
- Willis also became the Knights' ERA leader following the weekend's action against the Shockers, boasting an overall mark of 2.43 (63.1 IP, 22 ER) accompanied by 64 SO, just two shy of tying RHP **Kaitlyn Felton** for the team lead, and a .206 opponent batting average.

FIRST CONFERENCE ROAD TRIP

- Following UCF's midweek matchup against UNF Wednesday evening, the Knights will embark on their first conference road trip of the 2023 season at East Carolina this weekend. The Knights have enjoyed historical success in their meetings with ECU, boasting a 31-19 overall record against the Pirates in their 50 total matchups. The Knights swept the Pirates in three games at the UCF Softball Complex a year ago, outscoring ECU by a combined 9-2 in the series.
- The Pirates, who entering play Wednesday rank third in The American in ERA with a team mark of 3.11 (222.2 IP, 99 ER), are led in the circle by the duo of junior left-hander Addy Bullis and sophomore southpaw Jordan Hatch. The pair has posted respective ERAs of 1.52 (96.2 JP. 21 ER) and 3.11 (81 IP, 36 ER) while combining for 136 strikeouts (70 and 66, respectively).
- At the plate, graduate student Taylor Edwards represents ECU's most potent offensive threat thus far, as the utility player has posted a .371/.459/.596 (33-for-89) slashline accompanied by a 1.055 OPS, 13 extra-base hits, 53 total bases and 18 RBI entering play Wednesday.
- Last season, the Knights tied the program record for most conference wins in a single season with 16, going 16-2 in their 18 conference games in 2022. UCF also set the program record for longest conference win streak last season with wins in its first 11 games within The American against RV South Florida, Memphis, Eastern Carolina and Houston from March 25–April 23.

ELITE EIGHT (HUNDRED)

- The Knights are approaching a major program milestone, as UCF, currently with a 789-480-3 (.621) all-time record, can record the 800th victory in program history with 11 more wins.
- Should UCF achieve the milestone in 2023, the Knights would tie ECU for the second-fastest program currently a part of The American by seasons to reach 800 wins, with both collecting their 800th win in their 22nd season. South Florida won its 800th game in its 21st season of action, and Tulsa (27th season) and Wichita State (28) are the other two schools to reach the milestone

JADA CODY CHASING THE 'BEST'

 After breaking Stephanie Best's single-season RBI record with 75 RBI in 2022 (previous record was 66 by Best set in 2003). UTL Jada Cody made UCF softball history once again during the Knights' Friday, March 24 game against No. 22 Wichita State. Cody entered the evening tied with Farrah **Sullivan** (136 RBI, 2012-15) for third place on the UCF all-time RBI list, and with her first-inning RBI triple, collected her 137th career RBI to claim sole possession of third place in Knights program history. Cody can continue quickly climbing the ranks on the list throughout the 2023 season, as only 2 RBI separate where she currently sits in third place, with 138 RBI, and second place (Jania Shinhoster, 140). Best holds UCF's all-time RBI crown, with 213. Cody also became the third Knight in team history to hit 30 career HR with her first-inning solo shot March 26.

• On the heels of her breakout 2022 season that most notably saw her set the UCF single-season RBI record, Cody was recognized among the top players in the nation in many preseason rankings. D1Softball.com ranked the Knights junior as the *top* utility player in the nation, a Preseason First Team All-American, and the No. 14 player in the nation overall. Extra Inning Softball slotted Cody No. 5 in the country among its catcher/ utility player rankings. Softball America ranked Cody as the No. 31 player in the country overall and added her to its Preseason Third Team All-

KNIGHTS TO THE BIG 12

UCF has accepted an invitation to join the Big 12 Conference, as announced by Big 12 commissioner, Bob Bowlsby, UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir, and UCF President Alex Cartwright on Sept. 10.

The Knights athletics program has now moved from Division III, Division II, the FCS level, the FBS level that included time in the MAC, Conference USA, the AAC, and now to the Big 12 Conference.

"This is a landmark day for anyone ever associated with UCF or UCF Athletics. As we anticipate a future move to the Big 12 Conference, we first owe a vote of thanks to all those at UCF who have gone before us. There's a long list of student-athletes, coaches, athletics directors, university presidents and support staff, fans and donors and, of course, our student body, plus so many others whose hard work and successes have helped pave the way for today's announcement. The bases were already loaded, and I feel very blessed and honored to get to step up to the plate on behalf of UCF." - Terry Mohaiir

American list. Cody was also named to the preseason USA Softball Top 50 Player of the Year award watchlist.

 Following the conclusion of the 2022 season, Cody was also awarded DISoftball First Team All-American, Softball America Second Team All-American, NFCA Mideast All-Region Second Team, American Athletic Conference Most Outstanding Player, American Athletic Conference All-Tournament Team, and American Athletic Conference All-Conference First Team honors, the last of which was a unanimous selection.
 In addition to breaking the Knight's single-season RBI record. Cody set

First Team honors, the last of which was a unanimous selection.

• In addition to breaking the Knights' single-season RBI record, Cody set season-highs in a myriad of statistical categories a year ago, including games played and started (63), average (.361), on-base percentage (.439), slugging percentage (.701), runs scored (48), hits (70), doubles (15), triples (3), home runs (15), total bases (136) and walks (27). Her 75 RBI also ranked 4th-most in the nation and 2nd-most in The American. Cody is also approaching the top few spots on a handful of other UCF career leaderboards. She is already second on the Knights' all-time batting average list (.333) and slugging percentage (.419). Cody also sits third on UCF's all-time home run list with 30, just 3 HR behind Shinhoster's 33, and she ranks 3rd on UCF's all-time RBI list with 138, just 2 RBI behind Shinhoster's second-place total of 140.

CROWN JEWELL

• During the March 17-19 OSU Mizuno Classic in Stillwater, Oklahoma, right-hander **Grace Jewell** threw the first no-hitter of her collegiate career Friday, March 17 against No. 22 Arizona State. It came in a sixinning 8-0 run-rule win over the Sun Devils after the Knights scored 2 runs in the second inning, 2 runs in the third inning and 4 runs in the bottom of the sixth inning.

 Jewell yielded only 4 BB and 1 HBP in her 6 IP against Arizona State, collecting 4 SO and needing just 91 pitches to complete her outing. Her no-hit display also marked her fourth complete-game shutout of the season, a mark that slots her T-10th in the nation in Division I softball and first in the American Athletic Conference entering play Friday night

Jewell's effort marked the 21st no-hitter in UCF progam history overall
and the 19th individual no-hitter, as well as the first since Gianna
Mancha's no-hit performance almost a year ago to the day of Jewell's
outing, on March 19, 2022 vs. Furman, also an 8-0 win in 6 innings.
Mancha and Kama Woodall also combined for UCF's second and final
no-hitter of 2022 on May 1 against Tulsa.

 Her no-hitter also marked the first for UCF against a program ranked within the top 25 in the nation.

The no-hitter marked the latest chapter in a breakout junior season for Jewell, as she represented the Knights' ERA leader through 34 GP with a 2.35 mark (59.2 IP, 20 ER), also boasting career-highs in IP and SO (38), and a career-low BAA (183). Among pitchers with at least 50 IP as of March 25, Jewell ranked 3rd in The American in ERA, trailing only USF's **Payton Dixon** (1.47 ERA, 90.2 IP) and ECU's **Addy Bullis** (1.53 ERA,

187.0 IP)

•For her efforts throughout the Knights' play last week, Jewell was also named to The American's weekly Honor Roll after posting a 2.06 ERA (17 IP, 5 ER) to accompany 2 complete game shutouts, 11 SO and a batting average against of just .15I in her 3 starts. In garnering the weekly honors, Jewell became the sixth Knight to be recognized by the conference this season, joining utility INF Aubrey Evans, OF Chloe Evans, RHP Sarah Willis, UTL Savannah Adams and RHP Kaitlyn Felton.

WELCOME TO THE HIT COLUMN, SHELLI

 Freshman infielder Shelli DiPuma recorded the first hit of her collegiate career during last weekend's OSU Mizuno Classic in Stillwater, Oklahoma, clinching right-hander Grace Jewell's first career no-hitter against No. 22 Arizona State with a single to right field in the bottom of the sixth inning that plated UCF's 8th run of the game and ended the contest by the 8-0 run rule.

 Her game-clinching RBI single highlighted her perfect weekend at the plate, as DiPuma completed her play in the tournament 1-for-1 with 2 RBI and 2 BB, also adding a bases-loaded walk in the top of the 4th inning against No. 2 Oklahoma State March 19 to her weekend resume.

AUBREY EVANS. FRESHMAN PHENOM

• Utility INF **Aubrey Evans** enjoyed another strong weekend during the 2023 OSU Mizuno Classic in Stillwater, Oklahoma last weekend, highlighted by her hitting her first collegiate home run against No. 2 Oklahoma State March 19. Evans also joined OF Olivia Elliott and INF Micaela Macario as the third Knight this season to hit the first home run of their respective collegiate careers. Overall, Aubrey went 3-for-11 in Stillwater, adding 1 RBI, 3 R, 1 HR and 3 BB to complete her weekend. The freshman's strong weekend added on to an already-impressive collegiate debut season, as the Apopka, Florida, native now boasts an overall .296 average (24-for-81), a .387 on-base percentage and a .494 slugging percentage, along with 13 extra-base hits (11 doubles, one triple and one home run), 14 RBI, 40 total bases and 12 walks against just nine strikeouts entering play Wednesday, March 29. Her .296 average ranks fourth-best on the team among qualified hitters (2 PA/GP and 75 percent of games played), behind Chloe Evans (.315), Jada Cody (.313) and **Johneisha Rowe** (.299), and her 40 total bases rank 4th-most on the team through 34 games, trailing only Cody (64), Chloe Evans (62) and Jasmine Williams (47).

POWER SURGE

• The Knights have collectively produced impressive power numbers at the plate throughout their first 37 games, recording 86 extra-base hits (46 28, 12 38, 28 HR) entering Wednesday's game against North Florida. The number ties UCF's total through this point last season, as the 2022 Knights had recorded 86 extra-base hits (47 2B, 12 3B, 27 HR) through the team's first 37 games last season.


