GAME NOTES

• The Hokies' 833.0 sacks leads the FBS since Bud Foster's first season as sole defensive coordinator in 1996.

• The loss marked Tech's first conference defeat on the road this season. The Hokies are now 3-1.

• 52 points is the most scored by Pitt against Virginia Tech and is the tied for the third most in a single game for any Tech opponent since 1987.

• The Panthers have won seven of its last 10 games against the Hokies.

• Pitt's 654 yards of total offense is the second most allowed by Virginia Tech in program history.

• The last time Virginia Tech lost three-consecutive games was during the 2014 season (at Pitt, 10/16; vs. Miami, 10/23; vs. Boston College, 11/1).

• 17-play scoring drive in the third quarter was Tech's second-longest of the season behind the game-winning 18-yard drive at North Carolina (10/13).

JUSTIN FUENTE

• Moves to 3-3 on the season, 14-8 at Virginia Tech and 14-11 in his career vs. the ACC.

• Falls to 9-3 following a loss at Virginia Tech.

• Tech has lost three-consecutive games for the first time under Fuente.

RYAN WILLIS

• 231 passing yards - sixth 200-yard passing game of the season, 11th of his career.

 Three touchdown passes - 16 TD passes on the season, sixth-consecutive multi-TD game.

DAMON HAZLETON

24-yard TD catch - eighth of the season, 12th of his career.

• Has caught a touchdown in eight of his first nine games as a Hokie.

• His eight TD catches ties Ricky Hall

(1998) for the most by a first-year player in program history and is tied for the fourth most in a single season in program history.

ERIC KUMAH

• Two TD catches - five on the season, seven for his career, first multi-TD game of his career.

Six receptions - tied career high.

STEVEN PEOPLES

• 45-yard kick return - career long.

 Four kick returns for 98 yards - both career highs.

DAX HOLLIFIELD

• 1.0 sack - first of the season and his career.

JERMAINE WALLER

• One forced fumble - first of the season and his career.

RICO KEARNEY

• One fumble recovery - first of the season and his career.

TYJUAN GARBUTT

• 3.0 TFL - career high, tied for the most by a Hokie this season.

RICKY WALKER

1.5 TFL - 5.0 on the season, 25.0 for his career.

REGGIE FLOYD

• 1.5 TFL - 8.5 on the season, 12.0 for his career.

BY THE NUMBERS

• **305** - straight games Virginia Tech has scored, the third-longest active streak in the nation among FBS schools. It's also the sixth-longest streak in FBS history.
