- Boston College snaps a three-game losing streak in the series and wins its first game in Lane Stadium since a 33-31 win on Nov. 11, 2014.
- Virginia Tech has now lost three games in a row at Lane Stadium for the first time since the final home game of 1994 (vs. UVA, 11/12/94) and the first two home games of 1995 (vs. Boston College, 9/7; vs. Cincinnati, 9/16).
- The last time the Hokies dropped three games in a row in the same season was 1992 (vs. Miami, 10/24; vs. Southern Miss, 11/14; vs. Virginia, 11/21).
- The Hokies held BC's AJ Dillon to 96 yards rushing, his second-lowest total of the season.
