• Tech opens with Purdue at 2:30 p.m. on Friday before facing Penn State and Boilermakers again on Saturday. The Hokies wrap up the Challenge with a 10 a.m. contest against the Nittany Lions on Sunday.

 All of the games will be streamed live on ACC Network EXTRA via the WatchESPN platform

The Hokies are coming off of a 2-2 season opening weekend at the Sand Dollar Classic with wins over Florida A&M and Penn State.

 Tech wasn't originally scheduled to face the Nittany Lions but, in an effort to play a fourth game due to weather, the two played and the Hokies pulled out a 3-1 win.

HOKIES VS. THE FIELD

• The Hokies trail the all-time series with Penn State, 3-1, after picking up their first win over the Nittany Lions last weekend.

 Penn State got the best of Tech in both games at the ACC/Big Ten Challenge last season, claiming a 1-0 win in eight innings and a 7-1 victory.

Friday will be only the second time that 1. Duke - 12 Virginia Tech has faced Purdue.

The Boilermakers won the lone previous 4. Virginia - 9 meeting on March 7, 2002, a 7-6 victory.

• Scot Thomas has had 17 winning seasons in 23 years, building the program from the ground up starting in 1996.

Became Tech's first head softball coach when he was hired on July 7, 1995.

• In 22 seasons, he has recorded 773 wins averaging 36 wins per season and making the conference tournament championship game eight times (2 Atlantic 10; 2 Big East; 4 ACC). Tech has also advanced to at least the semifinals of eight of the 12 ACC Tournaments its played in since joining the league.

• Has led the Hokies to eight NCAA Regionals - four-straight from 2005-08 and fourconsecutive from 2012-15.

• Guided Tech to its fourth-straight NCAA Regional in 2008, a program first. Tech was seeded 16th nationally and No. 1 at the Columbus Regional in 2007. Overall Tech, has been to eight NCAA Regionals.

• Led Tech to the Women's College World Series in 2008, a first for the program. The Hokies also finished a program-best eighth in both final polls that year.

• Led the Hokies to a 1-0 upset win over the USA National Team in an exhibition game on March 26, 2008 at Oklahoma City, snapping the team's 185-game pre-Olympic exhibition tour winning streak.

• Led the Hokies to Atlantic Coast Conference tournament titles in both 2007 and 2008. Also led the Hokies to the regular-season title in 2007, a program first.

• Has coached two NFCA/Louisville Slugger All-Americans: Angela Tincher (2nd team in 2007; 1st team in 2008 and 1st team in 2009) and Jenna Rhodes (3rd team in 2009).

• Has had 35 different players named to the VaSID All-State University Team 68 different times, including at least three on each of the last nine teams.

• Had four former players play play in the NPF: Angela Tincher and Kelsey Hoffman with the Akron Racers; Jenna Rhodes with the Rockford Thunder/Tennessee Diamonds; and Courtney Liddle with the NY/NJ Comets/Pennsylvania Rebellion.

Has had six current or former players represent their respective country in international events: Angela Tincher (USA), Shanel Garofalo (Italy), Charisse Mariconda (Puerto Rico), Ashlee Dobbe, Richelle McGarva and Jess Hodge (Canada).

 Schoenewald went 5 for 5 with four runs scored and five RBI, all three career highs, and set a new personal best with two home runs.

• The senior from Jamison, Pa., fell a triple short of hitting for the cycle, a feat that no Hokie has ever accomplished.

DAVENPORT AND AIKEN SIDELINED IN EARLY-GOING

Expected to be key contributors on this year's team, senior Breanna Davenport and redshirt junior Mikaela Aiken are still out as they rehab from shoulder surgeries.
Davenport was a second-team All-ACC selection and a third-team All-Mid-Atlantic Region pick after hitting .333 last season with 10 doubles, eight home runs and 29 RBI.
Aiken had a 2.91 ERA and went 7-3 in 18 appearances as a true freshman in 2015.

2008 WCWS SQUAD TURNS 10

• The 2018 campaign marks 10 years since Virginia Tech's magical run to its second consecutive ACC Championship and the Women's College World Series.

Tech finished the 2008 season with a 49-19 overall record and a 16-5 mark in conference play en route to claiming its second consecutive ACC Championship.
After beating Michigan in the Super Regionals, Virginia Tech became only the second ACC program to advance to the Women's College World Series. The Hokies and Florida State are still the only two ACC schools to reach Oklahoma City.
