## About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter the game 14-1 on the season and 3-0 in ACC play ... The Cavaliers are $15-0$ this season and $3-0$ in the ACC ... The Hokies are ranked ninth in the AP poll and seventh in the USA Today Coaches poll and the Cavaliers are ranked fourth in the AP poll and first in the coaches poll.

## Last Time Out: VT 52, GT 49

The Hokies picked up their first ACC road win of the season, 52-49 at Georgia Tech on Jan. 9 ... The Hokies shot a seasonlow 29.8 percent from the floor, including a season-low 18.5 percent from three-point range, but forced GT into 18 turnovers and out rebounded the much taller Yellow Jackets, 35-32 ... Ahmed Hill led the Hokies with 15 points and Kerry Blackshear Jr., recorded his second double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds ... Justin Robinson added 10 points in the victory.

## Vs. Virginia

The Hokies are 56-91 all-time against Virginia ... Virginia Tech won the last meeting, 61-60, in overtime in Charlottesville last season ... The two schools have split the seaon series in each of the past three seasons ... Tech is 3-5 against Virginia under Buzz Williams ... Virginia Tech is $14-37$ in road games and 4-8 against the Cavaliers in John Paul Jones Arena.

## More About the Tech-UVa Series

This is the Hokies most-played rivalry ... The series dates back to Feb. 20, 1915, when the Cavaliers defeated Tech, 39-21, in Charlottesville ... Along with Blacksburg and Charlottesville, the series has also been played in Roanoke, Lynchburg, Richmond, Salem, Hampton, Norfolk and Greensboro, North Carolina (the 2006 ACC Tournament) ... After many years of neutral site games, the series returned to each campus, beginning in the 2000-01 season, the year Tech joined the Big East Conference ... This has been a home-and-home series since Tech joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season.

## Strong Start Continues

Entering tonight's game, the Hokies are 14-1 overall and 3-0 in ACC action ... The 14-1 start is the best start to a season for the Hokies, tying the 14-1 start to the 1982-83 season.

In the win over Notre Dame, Justin Robinson moved past Jamon Gordon into third place in career assists at Virginia Tech ... He and Gordon, along with Bimbo Coles and Malcolm Delaney, are the only Virginia Tech players with 500 career assists ... He now has 529 career assists and trails Delaney by 14 assists for second place and Coles by 18 assists for first place on the all-time list.

## ACC Starts

Entering tonight's game, the Hokies are 3-0 in ACC action ... The 3-0 ACC start is the best start for the Hokies since the 2006-07 season ... Tech has now won nine consecutive games for the first time since the 2009-10 season.

## Tech-UVa Ranking History

Tonight's game will mark just the third time that the two teams have met when both teams were ranked ... Tech won the last meeting, 72-64, in the Roanoke Civic Center on Dec. 28, 1995, when Tech was ranked 21 st and UVa was $22 \mathrm{nd} \ldots$ UVa won the first meeting, 74-64, in Richmond on Jan 19, 1983, when the Cavaliers were seventh and the Hokies were 17 th ... Tech is $1-2$ against UVa in meetings when Tech was ranked.

## More About Tonight's Match-Up

Tonight's game will be just the second game ever involving Virginia Tech in which two top 10 teams have played ... The only other was on Feb. 17, 1996, when topranked Massachusetts defeated the 10thranked Hokies, 74-58, in Cassell Coliseum.

## KJ Starts the New Year with a Bang

In the Hokies' win over Notre Dame on New Year's Day, Kerry Blackshear Jr., got 2019 started in style ... Blackshear led all scorers with a seasonhigh 21 points and seven rebounds ... Blackshear scored his 800th career point in the win ... In the
 win over Boston College, Blackshear scored 20 points and in the win at Georgia Tech, Blackshear recorded his second doubledouble of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds ... He is averaging 18.3 points and 8.0 rebounds per game in ACC action.

## Bede, Too

In the Hokies' win over Maryland Eastern Shore, Wabissa Bede recorded the best game of his collegiate career ... The sophomore earned the start and played a careerhigh 34 minutes ... He scored a career-high with 14 points and also recorded career-highs with seven rebounds and six assists ... His seven rebounds led the Hokies ... In the win over Boston College, Buzz Williams said that Bede had his best-ever game, as he defended BC top-scorer Ky Bowman, holding him to 14 points on 14 field goal attempts.

## Winning Low

When the Hokies defeated Georgia Tech, 52-49, on Jan. 9 in Atlanta, it marked the fewest points for the Hokies in an ACC regular season victory since defeating Miami, 52-45 in Blacksburg on Feb. 2014 ... The last time the Hokies scored fewer than 52 points in an ACC victory was on Jan. 22, 2012, when the Hokies won 47-45 over No. 15 Virginia in Charlottesville ... The Georgia Tech win was just the third time the Hokies have won an ACC regular season game with 52 points or fewer.

## They are Free

The Hokies enter tonight's game having made 176 of 239 free throw attempts (73.6 precent) ... Tech has made 115 of its last 149 attempts ( 77.2 percent) ... In the win over BC, the Hokies made 21 of 25 from the line, for 84.0 percent, season highs in all three categories ... Two Hokies, Ahmed Hill (93.3 percent) and Justin Robinson ( 80.0 percent) are shooting better than 80 percent from the line ... Tech has made 58 more free throws than its opponent and five more free throws than its opponents have attempted.

## Take a 3, Make a 3

Virginia Tech is fourth nationally and leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage, at 42.3 percent ... Tech leads the ACC and is 16 th nationally in three-point field goals made per game, at 10.4

.. Tech has made at least 10 three-pointers in 10 of the 15 games this season, including a school-record 18 made three-pointers in the win over Central Connecticut State ... The top individual in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC is Ty Outlaw.

## Assisting for the Score

In the win at Georgia Tech, the Hokies assisted on 12 of the teams 17 made baskets, for 70.6 percent ... This was the seventh time this season that the Hokies had assisted on at least 60 percent of their made field goals and the fourth time that number has exceeded 70 percent ... In the win over Central Connecticut State, Tech assisted on 77.8 percent of its made baskets ... Tech is averaging 60.5 percent for the season on assists per made field goals.

## The 40s

Virginia Tech has held its opponents to less than 50 points five times this season... This is the first season since the 2007-08 season that the Hokies have accomplished that feat ... Tech opponents are averaging 57.3 points per game this season.

## Vs. Ranked Teams

The Hokies are 1-0 against ranked teams this season ... The Hokies were 4-3 against ranked teams last season and 3-6 in the 2016-17 season ... The seven combined wins against nationally-ranked teams in the two previous season are the most in a two-year span in school history ... The wins over No. 10 UNC and No. 2 Virginia last season marked the first time Tech won two straight against top 10 teams since winning three straight against top 10 teams in 2007 ... The win at UVa was Tech's second-ever against a team ranked second and first since 1986 ... Tech's last previous road win against a ranked team was on Jan. 22, 2012, when Tech defeated No. 15 Virginia in John Paul Jones Arena.

While the Hokies have gotten off to a great start on the court, their fall semester in the class room was even better ... Ten Hokies recorded at least a 3.00 grade point average, as the team recorded a 3.22 overall GPA, the best semester in program
 history ... Two Hokies, Ty Outlaw and Ahmed Hill entered the semester with their undergraduate degrees and two more, Kerry Blackshear Jr., and Justin Robinson, completed their requirements for graduation and will walk in Spring 2019 ceremonies

## Pomp and a Neat Circumstance

When the Hokies tipped off at Georgia Tech in its most recent game, Tech starters were a rather unique group ... Four of the five starters, Ty Outlaw, Ahmed Hill, Kerry Blackshear Jr., and Justin Robinson had all completed their requirements for graduation.

## Much Improved

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is fourthbest among ACC players in improved scoring average from last year to this year ... The sophomore averaged 10.7 points per game as a freshman and is currently at 17.8 ppg, for an increase of 7.1 points per game ... He is the only listed player to have averaged double figures last season

## Selling Out the Cassell

Virginia Tech announced on Jan. 10 that the home game against Virginia was sold out ... Games against Duke, Syracuse and Miami have also sold out ... Earlier this season, the Central Connecticut State game was a sell out ... The Hokies sold out nine games in the 2017-18 season, including seven of the nine home ACC games ... Single game tickets for Tech's other home games are still available ... Virginia Tech's ACC single game tickets are on sale now.

## Now Boarding

Ty Outlaw missed his first career double-double in the win over VMI by one point ... The sixth-year player grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds, the most boards by a Tech player this season ... Outlaw, who missed last season with a knee injury, averaged 2.8 rebounds per game in the 2016-17 season, but has increased that to 5.1 boards per game this year.

## Hitting the Boards

Virginia Tech grabbed a season-high 42 rebounds in the win over North Carolina A\&T, out rebounding the Aggies, 42-20 ... That's the most rebounds in a game for the Hokies since grabbing 42 rebounds in the win over Maryland-Eastern Shore on Dec. 10, 2017 ... The last time the Hokies had more than 42 rebounds in a game was 51 rebounds against The Citadel on Nov. 12, 2017 ... The 22-rebound difference also dates back to the win over The Citadel last season, when the Hokies out rebounded the Bulldogs, 51$24 \ldots$ Tech grabbed 39 rebounds in the win over Boston College, the most rebounds for the Hokies in an ACC game since grabbing 41 rebounds in a home overtime win against Virginia on Feb. 12, 2017 ... The last time Tech grabbed more than 39 rebounds in a non-overtime ACC game was on Feb. 3, 2015, when Tech grabbed 40 rebounds at Syracuse.

## KJ Doubles

In the win over South Carolina State, Kerry Blackshear Jr., recorded his first double-double of the season, with 12 points and 13 rebounds ... Blackshear's doubledouble is the first for the Hokies this season and the first by any Hokie since Justin Robinson had 10 points and 12 assists at Boston College on Jan. 31, 2018 ... The 13 rebounds are the most by a Hokie this season ... He had his second doubledouble of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds in the win at Georgia Tech.

## Getting on Track

In the win over Saint Francis, Ty Outlaw was 5 -of-9 from three-point range ... Outlaw entered the game with just four made threepointers in the first four games combined ... Outlaw followed that by going 4-of-5 from behind the arc at Penn State and followed that with a 3-of-5 effort in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Outlaw holds the Virginia Tech record for most threepointers in a game, with eight against Miami two years ago ... He is 90 -of-184 in this Tech career, for 48.9 percent.

## Climbing the Lists

Justin Robinson passed Loyd King in the win at Georgia Tech and is now tied with Sumner Tilson for 30th on the career scoring list at 1,256 and Ahmed Hill passed Dorenzo Hudson in the win at Georgia Tech and is in 33rd place with 1,205 .

## Commonwealth Notes

Virginia Tech is 433-317 (.577) all-time against schools from Virginia ... Tech is $1-0$ against Virginia schools this season and was 2-1 last season ... The Hokies have played 14 schools from the state all-time ... The only state Division I school that Tech has not played is Hampton ... Tech holds winning records against 10 of the schools and even records against two others ... The win over VMI on Dec. 5 was the 750th all-time game against Virginia schools.

## Tech in the Polls

The Virginia Tech Hokies are currently ranked ninth in the AP poll, the school's highest AP ranking since the 1995-96 season... Tech peaked that season in late February at No. 8, its all-time highest ranking ... The last time the Hokies played a game ranked ninth or higher was on Jan. 27, 1996, an 81-57 win over Fordham in Cassell Coliseum when the Hokies were ranked eighth ... Tech is seventh in the USA Today Coaches poll.

## New Tech Record

In the win over Central Connecticut State, Justin Robinson dished out a career-high 13 assists, breaking the old school mark of 12 assists in a game, most recently set by Robinson at Boston College last season ... Others with 12 assists in a game include Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and Troy Manns ... It is the fourth time he has had double figures in assists in a game ... Robinson accomplished the feat in just 28 minutes of action.

The school record is 37 forced turnovers, twice, most recently against VMI in $1983 \ldots$ Tech has forced its opponents into double figure turnovers in all but one game this season.

## Call It a Comeback

In the win over No. 5 Duke, the Hokies came back from a 15-point first half deficit ... It was the second-largest deficit Tech overcame last season, as the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit at Ole Miss ... The Duke comeback was the largest in an ACC game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech's largest come-from-behind victory this season is 12 points against No. 23/22 Purdue.

Horne topped that performance with 13 points and six rebounds in just 22 minutes of action in the win over North Carolina A\&T, making 5-of-6 from the field ... Horne has made 24 of his last 29 field goal attempts, for 82.8 percent ... Horne is shooting 64.6 percent from the field this season... Horne's dunk in the win over Notre Dame was a viral sensation on the internet.

## Top Returner

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is one of only seven returning sophomores in the Power 6 to start every game during their rookie season and one of just two in the ACC ... Last season, 30 freshmen in the Power Five and BIG EAST started 25 or more games for their squads, including Alexander-Walker ... Among that group, arguably the best sophomores in the country, Alexander-Walker had the third-best 3-point field goal percentage, trailing Stanford's Daejon Davis (.403) and Wigginton (.401).

## Head Coach Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad is in his fifth season in Blacksburg and has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach - "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 241-147. Williams has compiled a 88-61 record, now in his fifth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season,
the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and $10-8$ in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20 -win season and three consecutive 10 -win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the nonconference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of
healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity - one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 13969 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season - the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regularseason title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A\&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (200001 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A\&MKingsville (1998-99) and TexasArlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A\&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
