### **About Tonight's Game**

The Hokies enter the game 16-3 on the season and 5-2 in ACC play ... The Hurricanes are 9-10 this season and 1-6 in the ACC ... The Hokies are ranked 12th in the AP poll and 11th in the USA Today Coaches poll.

### Last Game: #10/8 VT 78, Syracuse 56

The Hokies picked up a big home win, 78-56, over Syracuse on Saturday night ... Justin Robinson had a career night, scoring a career-high 35 points on a school-record nine three-pointers and eight assists ... He also became Tech's all-time leader in career assists ... Ahmed Hill added 16 points and Nickeil Alexander-Walker dished-out a career-high eight assists ... Tech shot 52.1 percent from the field, including 50 percent from three-point range, while holding the Orange to 36.4 percent from the field.

#### Vs. Miami

The Hokies is 14-22 all-time against Miami ... Tech has lost its last two meetings with the Hurrricanes, including a 69-68 loss in the Watsco Center last season ... Tech is 4-11in road games against the Canes, including a 4-9 mark in the Watsco Center ... Tech is 2-8 against Miami under Buzz Williams ... Tech has dropped its last four at Miami.

### A New All-Time Leader

In the win over Syracuse, Justin Robinson dished out eight assists, and in doing so, became the alltime leader in career assists at Virginia Tech, passing Malcolm Delaney and former leader Bimbo Coles ...

Robinson averages 4.6 assists per game in his career and is averaging 5.6 assists per game this season ... He leads the ACC in assists this season and is first among active ACC players in career assists.

### 5 is Honored

Justin Robinson has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week, for the week ending Jan. 27, 2019 ... This is the first time Robinson has been honored by the ACC ... This is the second time this season that a Hokie has received the honor ... Nickeil Alexander-Walker was honored for the week ending Nov. 18, 2018.

### **More About 5**

In the record-breaking night against Syracuse, Justin Robinson also set a new Virginia Tech record for three-point field goals in a game, with nine ... The nine 3s is tied for fourth-best in ACC history ... That breaks the old mark of eight, set two seasons ago against Miami by teammate Ty Outlaw ... Robinson's 35 points is also a career-high and is tied for second in Virginia Tech school history for points in an ACC game, trailing on Malcolm Delaney's 37 points against Clemson in 2009 ... He is the first Hokie to score more than 30 points in a game since he scored 32 points in the win over NC State last February ... The 35 points is tied for the fourth-highest total by an ACC player this season and the nine three-pointers are the most by an ACC player this season.

### Wrapping Up the Cuse Game

Nickeil Alexander-Walker dished out a career-high eight assists in the win ... The Hokies' 23 assists ties the school record for most assists in an ACC regular season game ... The 22-point margin of victory is the largest for the Hokies against the Orange ... The Hokies are now 4-9 all-time against Syracuse ... Tech is now 4-0 in ACC home games this season.

### They are Free

The Hokies enter tonight's game having made 237 of 314 free throw attempts (75.5 percent) ... Tech has made 176 of its last 224 attempts (78.6 percent) and is shooting 79.8 percent from the line in

ACC competition ... In the win over BC, the Hokies made 21 of 25 from the line, for 84.0 percent, season highs in all three categories ... Tech exceeded the percentage in the game at North Carolina, when Tech was 15 of 16 from the line, for 93.8 percent ... Two Hokies, Ahmed Hill (85.2 percent) and Justin Robinson (81.7 percent) are shooting better than 80 percent from the line ... Tech has made better than 80 percent from the line in eight of 19 games so far this season and five of its seven ACC games ... The school record for field goal percentage in a season is 75.0 percent in the 1980-81 season ... Tech is second in the ACC in free throw percentage and leads the league in free throw percentage in conference games.

### KJ Doubles Kerry Blackshear

Jr., had his best-ever collegiate game at North Carolina ... KJ had 19 points and a career-high 17 rebounds in the loss, including 10 offensive rebounds ... In the win over Central Connecticut

State, he recorded his first double-double of the season, with 12 points and 13 rebounds ... It was the first for the Hokies this season and the first by any Hokie since **Justin Robinson** had 10 points and 12 assists at Boston College on Jan. 31, 2018 ... He had his second double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds at Georgia Tech.

### More on KJ's Rebounds

Kerry Blackshear Jr., had 17 rebounds at North Carolina on Jan. 21 ... That is the third-highest rebounds in an ACC regular season game in school history ... Jeff Allen had 19 rebounds at Boston College on Feb. 5, 2011 and Coleman Collins had 18 rebounds in a win over Duke on Feb. 17, 2005 in Cassell Coliseum ... The 17 rebounds marks the first time a Hokie has had more than 15 rebounds in an ACC game in more than five years.

### Being Ranked

The Hokies are currently ranked 12th in the AP poll ... Tech is ranked for the 13th consecutive week (including the preseason poll), the second-longest streak in school history ... The longest is 17 consecutive weeks in the 1995-96 season.

### Providing A Spark

In the win over Wake Forest, the Hokies got 25 points off the bench ... That is the most points off the bench in an ACC game this season ... The last time the Hokies had more than 25 points off the bench in an ACC game was March 3, 2018 at Miami, when Tech had 28 bench points.

#### **NAW** on the Lists

Virginia Tech guard **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** has been named to both the Lute Olson Award and John R. Wooden Award Midseason Watch Lists ... He is also on the Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List ... He was named to *The Sporting News*' Midseason All-American third team ... The awards are given annually to the nation's top player.

### Winning Low

When the Hokies defeated Georgia Tech, 52-49, on Jan. 9 in Atlanta, it marked the fewest points for the Hokies in an ACC regular season victory since defeating Miami, 52-45 in Blacksburg on Feb. 2014 ... The last time the Hokies scored fewer than 52 points in an ACC victory was on Jan. 22, 2012, when the Hokies won 47-45 over No. 15 Virginia in Charlottesville ... The Georgia Tech win was just the third time the Hokies have won an ACC regular season game with 52 points or fewer.

### Much Improved Nickeil Alexander-

Walker is fifth-best among ACC players in improved scoring average from last year to this year ... The sophomore averaged 10.7 points per game as a freshman and is currently at 17.5 ppg, for an increase of 6.8 points per game ...

He is the only listed player to have averaged double figures last season.

### Take a 3, Make a 3

Virginia Tech is third nationally and leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage, at 42.4 percent ... Tech leads the ACC and is 18th nationally in three-point field goals made per game, at 10.6 ... Tech has made at least

10 three-pointers in 13 of the 19 games this season, including a school-record 18 made three-pointers in the win over Central Connecticut State ... The top individual in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC is **Ty Outlaw** and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** (4th) and **Ahmed Hill** (5th) join him in the top 5.

### **Assisting for the Score**

In the win over Syracuse, the Hokies assisted on 23 of its 25 made baskets, for 92.0 percent, a new season-high ... Against North Carolina, the Hokies assisted on 21 of the teams' 26 made baskets, for 80.8 percent ... This was the ninth time this season that the Hokies had assisted on at least 60 percent of their made field goals and the fifth time that number has exceeded 70 percent ... Tech is averaging 62.1 percent for the season on assists per made field goals.

### **More About Assisting**

Tech assisted on 92.0 percent of their made baskets against Syracuse (23-of-25), which is the highest percentage by an ACC team this season ... Across the Power 6, only two other teams have done so ... Ohio State assisted on 26 of 28 made field goals (92.9 percent) versus UCLA, and Kansas State, just like the Hokies, was 23 of 25 for a 92-percent clip against Georgia State.

### **Climbing the Lists**

**Justin Robinson** passed multiple players in the North Carolina game and is now in 24th place on the career scoring list at 1,330 and **Ahmed Hill** passed Sumner Tilson in the win over Syracuse and is in 30th place with 1,276.

### **BIG Again This Season**

The Hokies will host two more "Big Monday" games, Feb. 4 game against Louisville and the Feb. 18 game against Virginia ... Tech was 2-0 in "Big Monday" games last season, both at home and both against top 10 teams, including a win over No. 10 North Carolina ... The game at North Carolina on Jan. 21 was the Hokies' first of three Big Monday games this season and its first-ever on the road ... Last season was the first year the Hokies had ever been part of the "Big Monday" package.

### **Analytics and All**

As of Jan. 29th, the Hokies are ranked ninth by Kenpom.com ... Tech is second nationally in effective field goal percentage, defensive three-point field goals and threepoint percentage, third in raw offensive efficiency and sixth in adjusted offensive efficiency ... Tech is 12th in defensive turnover percentage and assist percentage, 19th in offensive three-point field goals, 21st in defensive free throw rate, 26th in two-point percentage and 29th in free throw percentage and raw defensive efficiency ... Ty Outlaw is 24th in threepoint percentage, 28th in effective field goal percentage and 49th in true shooting percentage.

### **Buzz Williams Facts**

**Buzz Williams** is in his fifth season at Virginia Tech ... He has a record of 243-149 in his 12th season as a collegiate head coach ... He is 90-63 at Tech ... With the 90 wins, Williams is sixth in career wins at Virginia Tech.

### The 40s

Virginia Tech has held its opponents to less than 50 points five times this season ... This is the first season since the 2007-08 season that the Hokies have accomplished that feat ... Tech opponents are averaging 58.8 points per game this season.

### **Vs. Ranked Teams**

The Hokies are 1-2 against ranked teams this season ... The Hokies were 4-3 against ranked teams last season and 3-6 in the 2016-17 season ... The seven combined wins against nationally-ranked teams in the two previous season are the most in a two-year span in school history ... The wins over No. 10 UNC and No. 2 Virginia last season marked the first time Tech won two straight against top 10 teams since winning three straight against top 10 teams in 2007 ... The win at UVa was Tech's second-ever against a team ranked second and first since 1986 ... Tech's last previous road win vs. a ranked team was Jan. 22, 2012, when Tech defeated No. 15 Virginia in Charlottesville.

### **Getting on Track**

In the win over Saint Francis, **Ty Outlaw** was 5-of-9 from three-point range ... Outlaw entered the game with just four made three-pointers in the first four games combined ... Outlaw followed that by going 4-of-5 from behind the arc at Penn State and followed that with a 3-of-5 effort in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Outlaw holds the Virginia Tech record for most three-pointers in a game, with eight against Miami two years ago ... He is 99-of-204 in this Tech career, for 48.5 percent.

### Home is Where the Wins Are

Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 63-20 (.759) in Cassell Coliseum and is 54-11 (.831) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won a school-record 24 consecutive home non-conference regular season games ... The nine non-con home wins last season are second-best at Virginia Tech since the Hokies joined the Metro Conference in 1978.

### 599 in the Cassell

The Hokies have a 599-194 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .755 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in Cassell ... Tech was 12-4 in Cassell Coliseum last season and is 11-0 this season on its home court.

### That's a TO

Virginia Tech forced Gardner-Webb into 29 turnovers in the season-opener ... That is the most forced turnovers for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams** ... The 29 forced turnovers are the most by a Virginia Tech team since forcing UNC Greensboro into 29 turnovers on Nov. 21, 2010 in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies forced 30-or-more turnovers in a game was 35 forced turnovers against Maryland-Eastern Shore on Nov. 23, 2004 in Cassell Coliseum ... The school record is 37 forced turnovers, twice, most recently against VMI in 1983.

### **Tech in NCAA Stats**

As of Jan. 29, the Hokies are third nationally in three-point field goal percentage, seventh in scoring margin, ninth in field goal percentage, 10th in three-point field goals per game, 12th in scoring defense and assist turnover ratio, 15th in assists per game and 16th in turnover margin ... Nickeil Alexander-Walker is tied for 45th in steals per game ... Justin Robinson is tied for 37th in assists per game.

### Where It Counts the Most

While the Hokies have gotten off to a great start on the court, their fall semester in the class room was even better ... Ten Hokies recorded at least a 3.00 grade point average, as the team recorded a 3.22 overall GPA, the best semester in program history ... Two Hokies, **Ty Outlaw** and **Ahmed Hill** entered the semester with their undergraduate degrees and two more, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson**, completed their requirements for graduation and will walk in Spring 2019 ceremonies.

### **Pomp and a Neat Circumstance**

When the Hokies tipped off at Georgia Tech in its most recent game, Tech starters were a rather unique group ... Four of the five starters, **Ty Outlaw, Ahmed Hill, Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson** had all completed their requirements for graduation.

### 517 and Counting

Tech has now hit a three-point field goal in 517 consecutive games ... Since the three-point arc was added for the 1986-87 season, the Hokies have hit at least one three in all but three games ... The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

### **Hitting the Boards**

Virginia Tech grabbed a season-high 42 rebounds in the win over North Carolina A&T (42-20) ... That's the most rebounds in a game for the Hokies since grabbing 42 rebounds in the win over Maryland-Eastern Shore on Dec. 10, 2017 ... The last time the Hokies had more than 42 rebounds in a game was 51 rebounds against The Citadel on Nov. 12, 2017 ... The 22-rebound difference also dates back to that win over The Citadel, when the Hokies out rebounded the Bulldogs, 51-24 ... Tech grabbed 39 rebounds in the win over Boston College, the most rebounds for the Hokies in an ACC game since grabbing 41 rebounds in a home overtime win against Virginia on Feb. 12, 2017 ... The last time Tech grabbed more than 39 rebounds in a non-overtime ACC game was on Feb. 3, 2015, when Tech grabbed 40 rebounds at Syracuse.

### **Commonwealth Notes**

Virginia Tech is 433-318 (.577) all-time against schools from Virginia ... Tech is 1-1 against Virginia schools this season and was 2-1 last season ... The Hokies have played 14 schools from the state all-time ... The only state Division I school that Tech has not played is Hampton ... Tech holds winning records against 10 of the schools and even records against two others ... The win over VMI on Dec. 5 was the 750th all-time game against Virginia schools.

The Hokies' 11 non-conference wins in the last three seasons are tied for the best at Virginia Tech since the ACC went to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2012-13 season.

On Monday, Nov. 19, Alexander-Walker was named the ACC Player of the Week for the first time in his career ... His 25 points in the win over Purdue was his second-highest career point total.

### **Top Returner**

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is one of only seven returning sophomores in the Power 6 to start every game during their rookie season and one of just two in the ACC ... Last season, 30 freshmen in the Power Five and BIG EAST started 25 or more games for their squads, including Alexander-Walker ... Among that group, arguably the best sophomores in the country, Alexander-Walker had the third-best 3-point field goal percentage, trailing Stanford's Daejon Davis (.403) and Wigginton (.401).

### **Keep It Low**

The Hokies held St. Francis to 37 points ... That is the fewest points allowed under Buzz Williams and the fewest since allowing Mount St. Mary's 34 points in a 99-34 win over the Mountaineers on Jan. 2, 2011 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is the second-fewest points allowed by an ACC team this season ... Tech allowed SFU just 15 points in the second half, the fewest points allowed in a half under Williams and the fewest points allowed in any half since allowing Miami just 15 points in the first half on Feb. 15, 2014 ... The last time Tech allowed fewer than 15 points in a half was on Dec. 22, 2011, when Tech allowed Eastern Michigan just nine first half points ... Tech held Central Connecticut State and Maryland Eastern Shore to 40 points and South Carolina State to 41 points ... Tech is holding its opponents to 49.7 points per game in home games thus far this season.

### **About Attendance**

Virginia Tech has increased percentage of capacity in each of the last four seasons ... Tech ranked seventh in percent of capacity in the ACC last season at 83 percent ... The year before, the Hokies were eighth at 76 percent ... This past season, the Hokies had an average attendance of 7,678, up from 7,476 the year before and 5,744 in the 2014-15 season ... Tech is second in average attendance growth in the ACC over the past four seasons, with a 34 percent increase in attendance, trailing only Miami ... Season ticket sales increased by more than 1,000 last season and has a 62 percent increase in sales in the past four seasons ... Tech had an all-time high of 6,107 season tickets sold last season ... Tech is averaging 7,765 in Cassell Coliseum this season.

### Call It a Comeback

In the win over No. 5 Duke, the Hokies came back from a 15-point first half deficit ... It was the second-largest deficit Tech overcame last season, as the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit at Ole Miss ... The Duke comeback was the largest in an ACC game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum ... Tech's largest comefrom-behind victory this season is 12 points against No. 23/22 Purdue.

### **Getting Better All the Time**

In the win over VMI, P.J. Horne had, perhaps, his best game as a Hokie ... The sophomore scored a season-high 12 points on 6-of-6 from the field and added five rebounds in 26 minutes of action ... Horne was making his second consecutive start of the season ... Horne topped that performance with 13 points and six rebounds in just 22 minutes of action in the win over North Carolina A&T, making 5-of-6 from the field ... Horne has made 24 of his last 29 field goal attempts, for 82.8 percent ... Horne is shooting 64.6 percent from the field this season ... Horne's dunk in the win over Notre Dame was a viral sensation on the internet.

#### **December was a Good Month**

Virginia Tech finished 6-0 in December ... Tech was 5-1 last December, with only a loss at No. 8 Kentucky marring the record ... The last time the Hokies had an undefeated December was the 2016-17 season, when the Hokies were 6-0 in the month, that included a home win on New Year's Eve over No. 5 Duke to open the ACC schedule.

### **Through the Non-Con Slate**

The Hokies finished with an 11-1 non-conference record ... This is the third consecutive season the Hokies have won 11 non-conference games ... The 11-1 start is tied for the best-ever through 12 games for the Hokies since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season and since becoming a "Power 6" team in the 2000-01 season.

### **Now Boarding**

**Ty Outlaw** missed his first career double-double in the win over VMI by one point ... The sixth-year player grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds, the most boards by a Tech player this season ... Outlaw, who missed last season with a knee injury, averaged 2.8 rebounds per game in the 2016-17 season, but has increased that to 4.9 boards per game this year.

Virginia Tech has announced the signing of four players to NLIs ... The clubs at Clemson and Florida State were just shy of 25,000 members during the previous academic year ... # Head Coach Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad is in his fifth season in Blacksburg and has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 243-149. Williams has compiled a 90-63 record, now in his fifth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season,

the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and 10-8 in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20-win season and three consecutive 10-win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the nonconference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. **UNO** claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season

as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.




