About Tonight's Game

The Hokies enter the game 13-1 on the season and 2-0 in ACC play ... The Yellow Jackets are 9-5 this season and 1-0 in the ACC ... The Hokies are ranked ninth in the AP poll and seventh in the USA Today Coaches poll.

Last Time Out: VT 77, BC 66

The Hokies improved to 2-0 in the league with a 77-66 win over Boston College on Saturday afternoon in Cassell Coliseum ... Nickeil Alexander-Walker led all scorers with 25 points ... Kerry Blackshear Jr., scored 20 points and Justin Robinson added 12 points and tied a career-high with eight rebounds ... Tech trailed by two points at the half, but through its defensive intensity, built the lead to 16 points before claiming the 11-point victory.

Vs. Georgia Tech

The Hokies are 18-6 all-time against Georgia Tech ... Virginia Tech has won the last four meetings and are 4-0 against GT under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech won the last game between the two school played in McCamish Pavilion, 76-56, on Feb. 17, 2018 in last season's only meeting between the two schools ... Virginia Tech is 7-3 against the Yellow Jackets in road games and 3-1 in McCamish Pavilion ... The first game between the two schools was a 31-15 Virginia Tech win in Blacksburg on Feb. 16, 1921 ... The Hokies are 1-0 against Georgia Tech as a ranked team.

Getting Closer

In the win over Notre
Dame, **Justin Robinson**moved past Jamon Gordon
into third place in career
assists at Virginia Tech ...
He and Gordon, along with
Bimbo Coles and Malcolm
Delaney, are the only Virginia

Tech players with 500 career assists ... He now has 526 career assists and trails Delaney by 17 assists for second place and Coles by 21 assists for first place on the all-time list.

Strong Start Continues

Entering tonight's game, the Hokies are 13-1 overall and 2-0 in ACC action ... The 13-1 start is the best start to a season for the Hokies since the 1982-83 season, when Tech opened the season 14-1.

Back with a Vengeance Nickeil Alexander-

Walker missed the Hokies' win over Maryland Eastern Shore with a sprained right ankle, but he returned to action in the win over Notre Dame ... He extended his double-figure scoring streak to all 12 games in which he has played by scoring 17 points ... He

was 7-of-8 from the field and made his only three-pointer ... In Saturday's win over Boston College, NAW set a new personalbest in an ACC game, as he scored 25 points to lead all scorers.

ACC Starts

Entering tonight's game, the Hokies are 2-0 in ACC action ... The 2-0 ACC start is the best since the 2015-16 season and for the second time under Buzz Williams ... This is just the third time since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season that the Hokies have started 2-0 in the league ... Tech has now won eight consecutive games for the first time since the 2016-17 season.

They are Free

The Hokies enter tonight's game having made 163 of 220 free throw attempts (74.1 precent) ... Tech has made 102 of its last 130 attempts (78.5 percent) ... In the win over BC, the Hokies made 21 of 25 from



the line, for 84.0 percent, season highs in all three categories ... Two Hokies, Ahmed Hill (92.9 percent) and Justin Robinson (81.8 percent) are shooting better than 80 percent from the line ... Tech has made 54 more free throws than its opponent.

KJ Starts the New Year with a Bang

In the Hokies' win over Notre Dame on

New Year's Day, Kerry Blackshear Jr., got 2019 started in style ... Blackshear led all scorers with a season-high 21 points and led the Hokies with seven rebounds ... Blackshear scored his 800th career point in the win ... In Saturday's win

over Boston College, Blackshear scored 20 points for Tech.

Bede, Too

In the Hokies' win over Maryland Eastern Shore. Wabissa Bede recorded the best game of his collegiate career ... The sophomore earned the start and played a careerhigh 34 minutes ... He scored a career-high with

14 points and also recorded career-highs with seven rebounds and six assists ... His seven rebounds led the Hokies ... In the win over Boston College, Buzz Williams said that Bede had his best-ever game, as he defended BC top-scorer Ky Bowman, holding him to 14 points on 14 field goal attempts.

Hot, Hot, Hot!

In the win over Maryland Eastern Shore, the Hokies shot a season-best 65.9 percent from the field ... The last time Tech shot better than 65.9 percent from the field was 68.6 percent in the win over The Citadel last season on Nov. 12, 2017 ... Tech is second in the ACC, shooting 51.8 percent from the field this season ... The 65.9 percent is the best by an ACC school this season.

Hot, Hot, Hot!, Part II

Virginia Tech shot 60.0 percent from the floor, including 61.1 percent from three-point range in the win over Notre Dame ... That is the highest field goal percentage against ACC competition since Tech shot 63.5 percent in a home win over NC State last season ... The 61.1 percent from threepoint range is the highest against ACC competition since the Hokies shot 66.7 percent from three in the win at Boston College on Feb. 25, 2017.

Take a 3, Make a 3

Virginia Tech is second nationally and leads the ACC in three-point field goal percentage, at 44.2 percent ... Tech leads the ACC and is seventh nationally in three-point field goals made per game, at 11.2 ... Tech has made

at least 10 three-pointers in 10 of the 14 games this season, including a schoolrecord 18 made three-pointers in the win over Central Connecticut State ... The top individual in three-point field goal percentage in the ACC is Ty Outlaw.

Hitting the Boards

Virginia Tech grabbed a season-high 42 rebounds in the win over North Carolina A&T. out rebounding the Aggies, 42-20 ... That's the most rebounds in a game for the Hokies since grabbing 42 rebounds in the win over Maryland-Eastern Shore on Dec. 10, 2017 ... The last time the Hokies had more than 42 rebounds in a game was 51 rebounds against The Citadel on Nov. 12, 2017 ... The 22-rebound difference also dates back to the win over The Citadel last season, when the Hokies out rebounded the Bulldogs, 51-24 ... Tech grabbed 39 rebounds in the win over Boston College, the most rebounds for the Hokies in an ACC game since grabbing 41 rebounds in a home overtime win against Virginia on Feb. 12, 2017 ... The last time Tech grabbed more than 39 rebounds in a non-overtime ACC game was on Feb. 3, 2015, when Tech grabbed 40 rebounds at Syracuse.

Strong Night for Med

In the Hokies' win over Maryland Eastern Shore, Ahmed Hill had one of his best performances ... The fifth-year player led all scorers with 20 points and he tied a careerhigh with six made three-pointers, shooting 7-of-10 from the field, including 6-of-9 from beyond the arc.

Assisting for the Score

In the Hokies' win over Maryland Eastern Shore, Tech had 22 assists on 29 made field goals, assisting on 75.9 percent of all baskets ... This is the sixth time this season that the Hokies have assisted on at least 60 percent of its made field goals and the third time that number has exceeded 70 percent ... In the win over Central Connecticut State, Tech assisted on 77.8 percent of its made baskets ... Tech is averaging 60.1 percent for the season on assists per made field goals.

Where It Counts the Most

While the Hokies have gotten off to a great start on the court, their fall semester in the class room was even better ... Ten Hokies recorded at least a 3.00 grade point average, as the team recorded a 3.22 overall GPA, the best semester in program history ... Two Hokies, Tv Outlaw and Ahmed Hill entered the semester with their undergraduate degrees and two more, Kerry Blackshear Jr., and Justin Robinson, completed their requirements for graduation and will walk in Spring 2019 ceremonies.

Pomp and a Neat Circumstance

When the Hokies tipped off Saturday, Dec. 15's game against Washington in Atlantic City, Tech starters were a rather unique group ... Four of the five starters, **Ty Outlaw, Ahmed Hill, Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, and **Justin Robinson** had all completed their requirements for graduation.

December was a Good Month

Virginia Tech finished 6-0 in December ... Tech was 5-1 last December, with only a loss at No. 8 Kentucky marring the record ... The last time the Hokies had an undefeated December was the 2016-17 season, when the Hokies were 6-0 in the month, that included a home win on New Year's Eve over No. 5 Duke to open the ACC schedule.

Selling Out the Cassell

Virginia Tech announced on Dec. 17 that the home games against Duke, Syracuse and Miami have all sold out ... Less than 50 tickets remain for the home game against Virginia on Feb. 18 ... Earlier this season, the Central Connecticut State game was a sell out ... The Hokies sold out nine games in the 2017-18 season, including seven of the nine home ACC games ... Single game tickets and mini plans for Tech's other home games are still available ... Virginia Tech's ACC single game tickets are on sale now.

KJ Doubles

In the win over South Carolina State, **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, recorded his first double-double of the season, with 12 points and 13 rebounds ... Blackshear's double-double is the first for the Hokies this season and the first by any Hokie since **Justin Robinson** had 10 points and 12 assists at Boston College on Jan. 31, 2018 ... The 13 rebounds are the most by a Hokie this season.

Getting on Track

In the win over Saint Francis, **Ty Outlaw** was 5-of-9 from three-point range ... Outlaw entered the game with just four made three-pointers in the first four games combined ... Outlaw followed that by going 4-of-5 from behind the arc at Penn State and followed that with a 3-of-5 effort in the win over Central Connecticut State ... Outlaw is 29-of-51 from three in the last eight games, for 56.9 percent ... Outlaw holds the Virginia Tech record for most three-pointers in a game, with eight against Miami two years ago ... He is 90-of-181 in this Tech career, for 49.7 percent.

Getting Better All the Time

In the win over VMI, **P.J. Horne** had, perhaps, his best game as a Hokie ...
The sophomore scored a season-high 12 points on 6-of-6 from the field and added five rebounds in 26 minutes of action ... Horne was making his second consecutive start of the

season ... Horne topped that performance with 13 points and six rebounds in just 22 minutes of action in the win over North Carolina A&T, making 5-of-6 from the field ... Horne has made 24 of his last 29 field goal attempts, for 82.8 percent ... Horne is shooting 64.6 percent from the field this season ... Horne's dunk in the win over Notre Dame was a viral sensation on the internet.

Much Improved

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is third-best among ACC players in improved scoring average from last year to this year ... The sophomore averaged 10.7 points per game as a freshman and is currently at 18.8 ppg, for an increase of 8.1 points per game ... He is the only one of the five listed players to have averaged double figures last season.

Now Boarding

Ty Outlaw missed his first career double-double in the win over VMI by one point ... The sixth-year player grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds, the most boards by a Tech player this season ... Outlaw, who missed last season with a knee injury, averaged 2.8 rebounds per game in the 2016-17 season, but has increased that to 5.2 boards per game this year.

Lots to Get To

In the win over Central Connecticut
State, the Hokies set a new school record
by making 18 three-point field goals in the
game, surpassing the former mark of 17
three-pointers made at Louisville on Feb.
8, 2017 ... The 94-40 final score marks
the 11th time a **Buzz Williams**-coached
Virginia Tech team has scored at least 94
points and the first time since defeating
Radford, 95-68, in Cassell Coliseum on
Dec. 6, 2017 ... The 54-point margin of
victory is the most for the Hokies under
Williams and the most since Tech defeated
Mount St. Mary's, 99-34 (65 points) on Jan.
2011 in Cassell Coliseum.

Tech in the Polls

The Virginia Tech Hokies are currently ranked ninth in the AP poll, the school's highest AP ranking since the 1995-96 season ... Tech peaked that season in late February at No. 8, its all-time highest ranking ... The last time the Hokies played a game ranked ninth or higher was on Jan. 27, 1996, an 81-57 win over Fordham in Cassell Coliseum when the Hokies were ranked eighth ... Tech is seventh in the USA Today Coaches poll.

New Tech Record

In the win over Central Connecticut State, **Justin Robinson** dished out a career-high 13 assists, breaking the old school mark of 12 assists in a game, most recently set by Robinson at Boston College last season ... Others with 12 assists in a game include Dave Sensibaugh, Bimbo Coles and Troy Manns ... It is the fourth time he has had double figures in assists in a game ... Robinson accomplished the feat in just 28 minutes of action.

Climbing the Lists

Justin Robinson passed Damon Watlington in the UMES game and is 31st on the career scoring list at 1,246 and Ahmed Hill passed Rolan Roberts, Jeff Schneider and Jarell Eddie in the win over Notre Dame and is in 34th place with 1,190.

As of Jan. 8th, the Hokies are ranked eighth by Kenpom.com ... Tech leads the nation in effective field goal percentage, is second in raw offensive efficiency, threepoint percentage and defensive three-point field goal percentage, fourth in adjusted offensive efficiency and defensive free throw rate and seventh in raw defensive efficiency ... Tech is 13th in defensive turnover percentage, 22nd in two-point percentage, 24th in assist percentage, 25th in steal percentage, 27th in three-point field goal percentage and 36th in adjusted defensive efficiency ... Ty Outlaw is 16th in effective field goal percentage and threepoint percentage and 41st in true shooting percentage ... Nickeil Alexander-Walker is 23rd in steal percentage, 34th in true shooting percentage and 35th in effective field goal percentage.

Virginia Tech guard **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** has been named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List ... Alexander-Walker is one of 20 players on the list and one of five ACC players on the watch list ... The trophy is given annually by the USBWA to the nation's top player.

Through the Non-Con Slate

The Hokies finished with an 11-1 non-conference record ... This is the third consecutive season the Hokies have won 11 non-conference games ... The 11-1 start is tied for the best-ever through 12 games for the Hokies since joining the ACC in the 2004-05 season and since becoming a "Power 6" team in the 2000-01 season.

That's a TO

Virginia Tech forced Gardner-Webb into 29 turnovers in the season-opener ... That is the most forced turnovers for the Hokies under Buzz Williams ... The 29 forced turnovers are the most by a Virginia Tech team since forcing UNC Greensboro into 29 turnovers on Nov. 21, 2010 in the Greensboro Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies forced 30-or-more turnovers in a game was 35 forced turnovers against Maryland-Eastern Shore on Nov. 23, 2004 in Cassell Coliseum ... The school record is 37 forced turnovers, twice, most recently by VMI in 1983 ... Tech has forced its opponents into double figure turnovers in all but one game this season.

Top Returner

Nickeil Alexander-Walker is one of only seven returning sophomores in the Power 6 to start every game during their rookie season and one of just two in the ACC ... Last season, 30 freshmen in the Power Five and BIG EAST started 25 or more games for their squads, including Alexander-Walker ... Among that group, arguably the best sophomores in the country, Alexander-Walker had the third-best 3-point field goal percentage, trailing Stanford's Daejon Davis (.403) and Wigginton (.401).

Ah, Youth

Isaiah Wilkins is the 10th-youngest player in Division I basketball this season and the fourth-youngest among Power 6 players ... Wilkins was born on September 29, 2000.

More About Wilkins

Isaiah Wilkins was 5-of-7 from three-point range in the win over Gardner-Webb ... That is the most three-pointers in a game by a Virginia Tech freshman since Justin Bibbs was 5-of-6 from three-point range in a win over Miami of Ohio in the 2014-15 season ... The school record for three-pointers in a game by a freshman at Virginia Tech is six, by Carlos Dixon against High Point on Dec. 30, 2000.

Virginia Tech has held its opponents to less than 45 points four times this season ... This is the first season since the 1996-97 season that the Hokies have accomplished that feat ... Tech opponents are averaging 56.6 points per game this season.

Head Coach Buzz Williams

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad is in his fifth season in Blacksburg and has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now beginning his 12th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 240-147. Williams has compiled a 87-61 record, now in his fifth season in Blacksburg.

To cap off the 2017-18 season,

the Hokies made a second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, the first time the school could claim that in more than three decades. The Hokies finished the season 21-12 overall and 10-8 in the ACC. Tech made it three consecutive 20-win season and three consecutive 10-win ACC seasons.

The Hokies took care of business in the regular season. They defeated four nationally-ranked teams for the first time in school history, including three wins against top 10 programs. The Hokies also finished 11-2 in the nonconference regular season slate.

The 2016-17 season was their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned its first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 record in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2018-19 will mark his 12th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New

Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. **UNO** claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season

as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.


